A TOTAL ECLIPSE?

Today's G1 Coral-Eclipse S. is the first major stand-off between the top sophomores and older horses, but the betting suggests a one-sided contest heavily in favor of **Authorized (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}). Hawk Wing was sent off at 8-15 when successful in 2002, but

Saleh Al Homaizi and Imad Al Sagar's sensational G1 Epsom Derby hero could trade shorter as he bids to become the first since Nashwan in 1989 to complete the Derby-Eclipse double back. Last year's G1 Racing Post Trophy winner offered portents of what was to come when

recording a facile score in York's G2 Dante S. May 17, and he proved up to all the expectations when delivering by five lengths in the June 2 blue riband. Trainer Peter Chapple-Hyam has been getting all the right signs since. "He seems very well and we've had no problems whatsoever--everything has gone sweetly," Chapple-Hyam commented. "There's no easy race in the Derby, because you want to win it so much and you make sure that everything is 120 percent, but in my opinion, he is working the same as before." **Cont. p2**

history will be made this afternoon's when **Anamato (Aus)** (Redoute's Choice {Aus}) becomes the first to represent her country in the 10-furlong test over the Hollywood turf course. A four-year-old filly on Northern Hemisphere time, Anamato is sent out by 44-year-old David Hayes, who descends from one of the most prominent racing families in Australia. "I've been here before, but this is the first time with a horse," said Hayes, who also spent a successful decade training in Hong Kong. "Anamato is one of the top three fillies in Australia. [Stablemate] Miss Finland (Aus) is tops and Anamato is not far behind. If she brings her A-game, she will be competitive."

THAT'S WHY THE 'LADY' IS THE CHAMP

Owner Marty Schwartz was blessed in 2006 to be represented by Gorella (Fr), who used a devastating turn of foot to great effect in winning the G1 Beverly D. S. and GII First Lady S. Following in those giant hoofprints, **Lady of Venice (Fr)** (Loup Solitaire) received a perfect sit-and-pounce ride from Julien Leparoux, angling out for the drive and powering past the Bobby Frankel-trained duo of **Precious Kitten** (Catienus) and favored **Price Tag (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) to win the \$1-million GII CashCall Mile at Hollywood Park. Held up in the rear as Precious Kitten cut out fractions of :22.85 and :46.04, Lady of Venice was shuffled back nearly last as they raced on the far turn. Leparoux allowed his mount to sneak up the inside leaving the quarter pole and, once switched out, she leveled off beautifully and came home a convincing winner. 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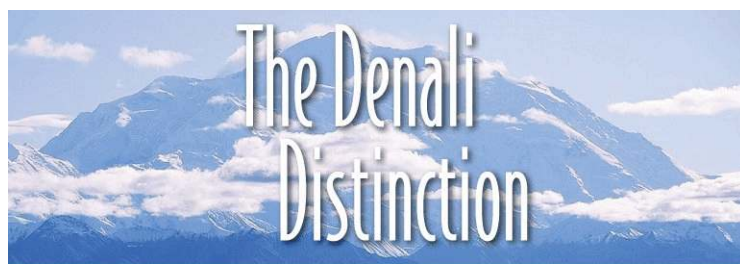

The elders with proven Group 1-winning form are Susan Magnier, Michael Tabor and Derrick Smith's **George Washington** and Anthony and David de Rothschild's **Notnowcato**, and Peter Chapple-Hyam is under no illusions as to Authorized's task here. "We will soon find out just how good we really are," he said. Notnowcato hails from the Sir Michael Stoute stable successful four times, and the five-year-old has strong credentials to better his second to David Junior 12 months ago. He subsequently demonstrated his toughness with battling successes in York's G1 Juddmonte International last August and in the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup at The Curragh May 27.

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Fast ground was against him when third in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot June 20, but he should find underfoot conditions in his favor here. "My horse is in great shape, but the Derby winner looks very good," Stoute told *PA Sport*. "Saying that, I think my horse has a great each-way chance and I will be disappointed if he's not in the first three." Clive Brittain, not one to shirk a challenge, relies on Tony Richards' **Kandidate** in his bid for a second renewal following the exploits of Pebbles (GB) in 1985. Showing his versatility when adapting to the Nad Al Sheba dirt to win the Feb. 8 G3 Round 2 of the Maktoum Challenge, he was sixth in the Mar. 31 G1 Dubai World Cup before returning to turf to be third in the G3 Gordon Richards S. over course and distance Apr. 27. Fifth in the G1 Singapore Airlines International Cup at Kranji last time May 20, the five-year-old is reported in rude health by his ebullient trainer. "He has never been in better form than he is at the moment and it wouldn't be the wildest thing for me to go and win it," Brittain said.

Anamato hinted at her ability when she ran the aforementioned Miss Finland (Aus) to a neck in Australian Group 2 company last September. She faced a classy male in the form of Haradasun (Aus) in the G1 Doncaster H. Apr. 9, finishing 12th by just over six lengths, but most recently stretched to this distance to annex the G1 Australasian Oaks Apr. 21. Jockey Michael Rodd, aboard for that success, makes the trans-Pacific journey. **Robe Decollette**, a \$180,000 Keeneland September yearling, flies the flag for Japan and enters this off a narrow success in the May 20 Japanese Oaks. **Valbenny** looks the best of the locals, having swept the GIII Seniorita S. May 12 and the GII Honey-moon Breeders' Cup H. June 9.

Better Talk Now, fifth in last year's event, seems to be better than ever and has managed to finish ahead of the morning-line favorite in their last two head-to-head meetings. The eight-year-old was second, 2 1/4 lengths better than **English Channel**, in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Turf at Churchill Downs and most recently snuck through along the wood to get his head down in front of his younger foe to take Belmont's GI Manhattan H. June 9 while in receipt of two pounds. Not insignificantly, there is a six-pound shift in the weights this afternoon. **Honey Ryder** tries the boys for the third time in her last four starts. Beaten a neck into second in the GI Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup S. Feb. 24, the gray mare was never in it when 11th in the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic Mar. 31. She returned to her own division and handed stablemate Safari Queen (Arg) a one-length defeat in the May 26 GII Sheepshead Bay H., running her record at this specialist distance to six wins from nine starts.

Miraculous Miss won six of her first seven trips to the races, including, in succession, the GII Forward Gal S. last March, the GII Comely S. the following month and the GIII Endine S. in September. Fifth as the favorite in the GII Cotillion BC H. in October, the chestnut was last seen running third in the Nov. 25 Stefanita S. at Laurel. She has been training up a storm at Fair Hill and trainer Steve Klesaris shows great confidence bringing her back in this spot. **Indian Flare**, runner-up in the GIII Las Cienegas H. down the hill at Santa Anita Apr. 15, returned from a freshening to take down the GII Vagrancy H. at Belmont Park June 17 and is an obvious threat. The consistent **G City Gal** posted triple-digit speed figures when third in the GIII Safely Kept BC S. last October and the Top Secret S. in November before getting a breather. The bay returned to take a second-level allowance at Monmouth Park June 1 and shoots for Grade I black-type today.

This select field has won nearly 50 percent of its starts, but **Nashoba's Key** has done better than that, as she looks to remain undefeated in five career appearances. The bay took her first three outs, all in Cal-bred company, including a 3/4-length success in the Apr. 29 Fran's Valentine S. The homebred most recently came from off the pace to register a 3/4-length victory over **Hystericalady** in the GII Milady Breeders' Cup H. June 3. **Balance** was back in third that afternoon and requires a return to her best form, which saw her take the GI Santa Margarita H. Mar. 10.

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Surf Cat makes his first appearance since taking the 1 1/16-mile GII Mervyn Leroy H. at Hollywood in May of 2006. The five-year-old, winner of the GII Swaps BC S. at three, was a perfect three-for-three last year, including the GII Potrero Grande BC S. going 6 1/2 panels in April. He was sidelined by chronic foot problems last summer and makes his first start in nearly 14 months, but has been working bullets for his return. **Siren Lure** won three straight sprint stakes in 2006, taking the May 13 GIII Los Angeles H., last year's edition of the Triple Bend July 2 and the Aug. 2 GII Pat O'Brien BC H. The six-year-old gelding was eighth after a wide trip in the Nov. 4 GI Breeders' Cup Sprint and ended the season with a second in the Dec. 2 GIII V. O. Underwood S. Seventh in the Feb. 17 GII San Carlos H. in his return, he improved to be third in the Apr. 21 GIII San Simeon S. and comes off a second-place finish behind **El Roblar** in the June 9 GIII Ack Ack H. **Silent Name** switched off the turf for the first time and was an impressive four-length winner in the Apr. 14 GII Commonwealth BC S. on the Keeneland all-weather. He lost all chance after stumbling badly at the break in the May 28 GI Met Mile H., but he suffered just minor cuts and body soreness and could rebound with the return to a synthetic surface. "I've never seen a horse fall so hard and not do anything to his feet," trainer Gary Mandella told *Daily Racing Form*. "He was stiff for awhile--it took a couple of weeks to get the kinks out."

Dream Rush made her stakes debut in the Feb. 10 GIII Old Hat S. at Gulfstream Park, winning by 3 1/2 lengths, and came back to post a 9 1/4-length score in the May 5 GII Nassau County BC S. going seven panels at Belmont. The dark bay filly stretched out to a mile for her latest, the June 9 GI Acorn S., but couldn't quite hold off Cotton Blossom after setting a fast pace and finished second. She drops back to a sprint here, and trainer Rick Violette Jr. does not necessarily expect her to be on the lead. "It looks like there is a lot more speed in this race," said Violette. "We drew post nine of nine, and I think that's a good thing. If somebody gets stupid and wants to go in :21 and :43, we can lay off. I don't think she is a one-dimensional speed horse. We may even try two turns with her down the road." **Her Majesty** dued through an opening half in :44 3/5 before pulling away to a four-length score in a Churchill Downs allowance test June 8 and will likely have something to say about the early fractions here. The dark bay was third in the GII Alcibiades S. at Keeneland last October, but beat only one home after a troubled trip in the Nov. 4 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies. **Ticket to Seattle** went gate to wire in the May 19 Peach Blossom S. at Delaware Park, then switched to the turf and was third in the June 16 Crank It Up S. at Monmouth.

Smokey Stover has never been worse than second, and rides a four-race winning streak into this event. The four-year-old gelding made his graded bow in the Mar. 11 Bay Meadows BC Sprint H., scoring by a length, and cruised to a 4 1/2-length triumph in the Apr. 7 GII Potrero Grande BC H. last time out. **Fabulous Strike** has also reeled off four consecutive victories, following up on three Mountaineer successes with a gate-to-wire tally in the June 2 Aristides S. at Churchill Downs. His Beyers over that span were 115, 119, 118 and 115. Local hopeful **Mach Ride** comes off a 7 1/2-length decision in the June 16 Champali S. to run his Calder record to three-for-five.

On Wednesday, Idiot Proof shipped east after a Hollywood allowance score and romped to an easy victory in the GIII Jersey Shore BC S. at Monmouth. **Black Seventeen** will try to surpass that accomplishment here. The chestnut colt tired to eighth when stretched out for the Apr. 7 GI Santa Anita Derby, but bounced back to take an entry-level allowance going six furlongs May 1 and made it two in a row in an optional claimer at the Inglewood oval May 28. **Teuflesberg**, fourth in the GI Blue Grass S. after setting a slow pace, faded fast in the May 5 GI Kentucky Derby and finished 17th. He dropped back to seven panels for the June 9 GII Woody Stephens S. at Belmont and came from the back of the pack to win it by two lengths. He appears to have found his niche in sprints. **Fate Takes a Hand** was claimed for \$75,000 from trainer Todd Pletcher after breaking his maiden by 8 1/4 lengths in his career opener at Gulfstream Park Feb. 23. A troubled fifth in a Mar. 31 allowance at that track, he ships down from Churchill after a 5 1/4-length allowance tally May 23 and a bullet five-furlong breeze in :59 2/5 July 1.

“BISCUIT” CONNECTIONS CONFIDENT Gai Waterhouse's **Bentley Biscuit (Aus)** (Peintre Celebre) was yesterday reported to be in fine form ahead of Friday's £375,000 G1 Darley July Cup at Newmarket. The owner/trainer's husband Rob Waterhouse gave the latest lowdown on the six-year-old, last seen when trailing in Royal Ascot's G2 King's Stand S. June 19. “Gai tells me that he's absolutely flying,” he said. “He was over the Ascot race within two or three days and, in terms of the ground, the softer the better with him. We think that the six furlongs at Newmarket will suit him far better than the five furlongs at Ascot. He'll have no trouble with the track or the distance.” Bentley Biscuit will be ridden by Ryan Moore in the six-furlong contest, for which the five-day declarations will be made today.

REBEL TO RETURN TO WORK Phil Cunningham's **Cockney Rebel (Ire)** (Val Royal {Fr}) is likely to make a return to action in September after receiving encouraging results on his latest scan. Sidelined by a stress fracture of his pelvis sustained during the June 19 G1 St James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot, the G1 English and G1 Irish 2000 Guineas winner has this week been given the green light to return to cantering. “The outcome of the scan was great news and we can now start to prepare Cockney Rebel for the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. [at Ascot Sept. 29],” trainer Geoff Huffer told the *Racing Post*. “He has been out for a trot this morning and we're looking forward to building up his exercise programme.” Other plans for the colt include Newmarket's G1 Champion S. Oct. 20, and connections have not ruled out bringing him back at four. “I'll never have another like him and I'm told there is every likelihood that he'll continue to improve,” Cunningham added. “Next year, I'd like to see him in races like the G1 Juddmonte International, and perhaps the Breeders' Cup.”

HALF OURS INJURED Aaron and Marie Jones's **Half Ours** (Unbridled's Song) recently suffered a fracture to a hind cannon bone, had surgery to insert a pair of screws in that leg and will be out indefinitely, *Daily Racing Form* reports. The publication reports that the four-year-old son of Zing (Storm Cat) has been sent to

Taylor Made Farm in Kentucky, where a decision on his future will be made later. Originally a \$625,000 purchase out of the 2004 Keeneland September sale, Half Ours was campaigned by Barry K. Schwartz in partnership with the Joneses and won his first two career starts, including the Three Chimneys Juvenile S. Sidelined 19 months thereafter, the gray colt took an Aqueduct allowance in the fog in December, then sold for \$6.1 million at the Keeneland January Sale to dissolve the

Jones/Schwartz partnership. He ran his winning streak to five with a half-length victory in the GII Richter Scale Breeders' Cup H. Mar. 3, but was second in the May 4 GIII Alysheba S. at Churchill and seventh in the GI Met Mile May 28. Trainer Todd Pletcher told the *Form* that the injury was detected following a half-mile breeze in :50.30 at Belmont Park June 21. Bred in Kentucky by Brilliant Stables, Half Ours has a current record of 7-5-1-0 and earnings of \$319,680.

SALES TRANSPARENCY AT HEART OF FLORIDA LAW

A bill that empowers Florida's state government to set rules regarding transparency issues in the sale of horses was recently signed into law by Gov. Charlie Crist. The law gives the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services the right to examine conditions of sales and adopt rules to "prevent unfair or deceptive trade practices" in regards to relevant ownership, dual agency, medical and surgical disclosures, as well as mandate the need for written bills of sale. An exception is made for sales resulting from claiming races at licensed pari-mutuel facilities. The law's 133 words of language covering horse sales, which was an amendment offered by Republican representative Juan Zapata of Miami-Dade, is part of a broader bill sponsored by Zapata involving agritourism and other agricultural matters. A Florida Department of Agriculture spokesman contacted July 6 said there wasn't anyone immediately available to comment on the new law. Ocala Breeders' Sales Co. Director of Sales and General Manager Tom Ventura said the law lays ground work for fine-tuning existing Florida laws involving horse sales. "We are looking forward to working with the Department to put out rules that make sense for everyone, and coincide with the health and welfare of the horse," Ventura said. **For the complete story, click [here](#).**

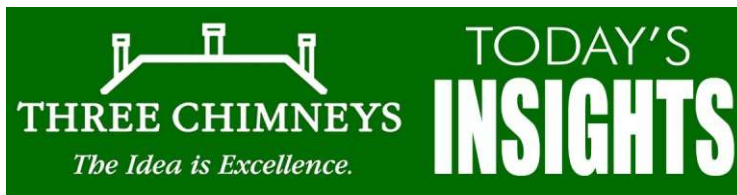

Dominican Set for Return:

Silverton Hill LLC's **Dominican** (El Corredor), who upset Street Sense in the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. back in April, is set to make his return to the races in next Saturday's \$100,000 Round Table S. over the Polytrack at Arlington Park. Trainer Darrin Miller elected to give the chestnut gelding 30 days off following his rough run in the GI Kentucky Derby, in which he was 11th. Given that each of Dominican's three career victories has come over a synthetic surface, the Round Table seemed a logical spot, the conditioner explained. "That was attractive, as was the possibility that the race might be an easier spot," said Miller. "This race, time-wise, looked like a nice prep for anywhere we wanted to go beyond that." Dominican has turned in three solid works since being put back into training, including a sharp five-furlong move in :59.80 July 2. Miller added that his other Derby runner, Kentucky Derby fifth-place finisher **Sedgefield** (Smart Strike), would return to his Churchill barn this coming Tuesday.
