

SUMMIT OF SPEED LIVES UP TO BILLING

The skies opened up at Calder Race Course in Miami, Florida moments before yesterday's second race, but even the wet weather couldn't put a damper on the \$2-million Summit of Speed program. **River's Prayer** (Devon Lane) outdueled **Shaggy Mane** (Bertrando) in a thrilling renewal of the GI Princess Rooney H. **Mach Ride** (Pentelicus) upset the nation's leading sprinters **Smokey Stover** (Put It Back) and **Fabulous Strike** (Smart Strike) in the GII Smile Sprint H. **Black Seventeen** (Is It True) made it three straight victories while defeating **Teuflesberg** (Johannesburg) in the GII Carry Back S., and **Sheets** (Scatmandu) splashed home a 4 1/4-length victress in the GIII Azalea Breeders' Cup S. **cont. p5**

TEAM AMERICA ONE-TWO IN THE OAKS

Yesterday's GI American Oaks Invitational S. had plenty of international flavor, but it was the U.S.-based duo of **Panty Raid** (Include) and **Valbenny** (Ire) (Val Royal {Fr}) who finished first and second. Australian raider **Anamato** (Aus) (Redoute's Choice {Aus}) completed the trifecta. "It was a beautiful trip," winning rider Edgar Prado said. "We were in the perfect position and when I asked, she really responded. In her other races she moved like she would love the turf and she showed today that she can handle it very well. I didn't think the distance would be a problem, the way she's been training. She proved today that she could go either way, turf or dirt." **cont. p3**

NOW THEN NOW THEN

Escaping all the attention focused on **Authorized** (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) and **George Washington** (Ire) (Danahill), Anthony and David de Rothschild's **Notnowcato** (GB) (Inchior {GB}) took his own course to success to usurp that duo in a dramatic renewal of Sandown's G1 Coral-Eclipse S. Sent off at 7-1 despite career highs in last year's G1 Juddmonte International and in the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup this term, the chestnut was sent into isolation against the stands' side at the top of the straight by Ryan Moore. His enterprise was rewarded, as the five-year-old stole a march on his rivals before holding a 1 1/2-length advantage over the 4-7 choice **Authorized**, who won his own private duel with **George Washington** against the far rail. "I walked the course earlier and thought it was a little bit quicker against the stands' rail; you couldn't go alone with most horses, but he is so honest," said Moore, recently returned from a serious arm injury which required pioneering cryotherapy. "He's so determined and gives you absolutely everything. He hasn't got the credit he deserves so far, but today he kept digging, and you've got to say what a brave horse he is." **cont. p2**

Kept under the spotlight in typical fashion by Sir Michael Stoute at three, Notnowcato emerged last term ready to bring his latent talent to the fore. Getting off on the right foot with wins in Newmarket's G3 Earl of Sefton S. in April and in the G3 Brigadier Gerard S. here the following month, he was fifth in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot in June before overcoming a troubled trip to run second in this contest the next month. Breaking through at the highest level with a battling score in York's International, he bombed uncharacteristically when trailing in Newmarket's G1 Champion S. on his next start in October. He was back to his reliable self on his return when a respectable fourth under a penalty in the G3 Gordon Richards S. over this track and trip Apr. 27 before ousting Dylan Thomas (Ire) by a head in the May 27 G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup. Third behind Manduro (Ger) and Dylan Thomas in the latest renewal of the Prince of Wales's, run on good to firm June 20, his chance here grew with every drop of rain wrought by the recent thunderstorms.

Settled towards the fore of the main peloton, which ignored the rabbit Champery (Bahri), Notnowcato closed on the pacesetter by halfway before taking a diagonal course after the home turn. Once hard against the stands' fence, he was in front approaching the quarter pole and stayed there as Authorized grafted his way to the head of affairs on the other side. "Ryan and I chatted about this on Wednesday morning, but it was soft then and we thought they'd all come across to this side," explained Stoute, collecting his fifth Eclipse victory. "Ryan was confident that's what he should do and that was a good bit of professionalism--he deserves a lot of credit. This horse has won three Group 1s now and that doesn't happen by fluke, but he does want it good or softer. He won at York last year and the [Aug. 21] International is probably where he'll go."

Winning the War, Losing the Battle...

For the connections of Authorized, the result was bitter-sweet. He managed to hold George Washington by a head only to lose out overall, joining recent G1 Epsom Derby winners Erhaab, Benny the Dip and Motivator (GB) in failing to follow up here. Traveling strongly in last throughout, he had mastered his group at the eighth pole and showed tenacity in the final drive. Jockey Frankie Dettori defended his decision to keep to the far side as the action unfolded in the stretch. "You can't follow everybody and I made my decision to stay with George Washington and my horse won his side," he said. "Notnowcato nicked three lengths and stole the race--hindsight is great, but take nothing away from Authorized, who was on his own from the furlong marker on. He's run a superb race and thinks he's won, so hopefully he'll redeem himself next time." Trainer Aidan O'Brien was pleased with the performance of George Washington, who appeared to stay the trip and fought to the line after Authorized enjoyed first run. "He ran a blinder and the ground was messy at the start," O'Brien told *PA Sport*. "The winner is the horse with the form and don't take anything away from him."

Panty Raid stamped herself as one to watch last summer at Saratoga, posting a 7 3/4-length win at first asking, but was put on the shelf for the rest of the season. The dark bay resurfaced with a sixth-place finish in a Gulfstream allowance Feb. 8, but got back on track with a game second-place finish in the GIII Bourbonette Breeders' Cup S. over the Turfway Polytrack Mar. 24. She cleared her first allowance condition over the Keeneland all-weather Apr. 13, then made it two straight at Pimlico, annexing the GII Black-Eyed Susan S. last out May 18. Making her turf debut here, she was kept within striking distance by Edgar Prado, ranged up three deep on the turn for home, gained a short lead in the stretch and dug down deep to secure the victory. Looking to become the fourth horse to win the U.N. two years running, English Channel followed in the hoofprints of champions Mongo (1962-63) and Manila (1986-87) and multi-millionaire Sandpit (Brz) (1995-96) with this decisive score. The final time for the 11 furlongs on the turf was a course-record 2:12.89, breaking the mark of 2:13.24 he set last year. The chestnut was four-for-seven in 2006, taking the Canadian Turf H., GI Woodford Reserve Turf Classic and GI Joe Hirsch Turf Classic in addition to the U.N. Third behind Red Rocks (Ire) and Better Talk Now in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf, he came back to win a Gulfstream allowance test Feb. 22. English Channel shipped to the U.A.E. for the Mar. 31 GI Dubai Duty Free S., but weakened to be 12th. The five-year-old was given a break after that adventure and looked none the worse for the wear in his return, finishing a head behind Better Talk Now in the June 9 GI Manhattan H. Getting a favorable six-pound shift in the weights, he threw his head at the break and gave jockey John Velazquez a hard time as 33-1 Fri Guy (Theatrical {Ire}) cut out moderate splits of :49.90, 1:14.45 and 1:38.33. Velazquez convinced his headstrong mount to settle down the backstretch, then pressed the accelerator at the top of the lane. English Channel drove to the lead and easily held off Honey Ryder as Better Talk Now closed from last in the five-horse field to be third. The winner goes next in the GI Sword Dancer Invitational S. at Saratoga Aug. 11 and will likely be retired at the end of the year. His final start could be in front of the Monmouth crowd in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf Oct. 27. "If everything goes our way, that could be his last start," said owner Jim Scatuorchio. "He was third in the race last year, and he has stamped himself a contender. We know he has the credentials, so we'll see how it goes and hope for the best." TDN Star of the Week

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PETE ANDERSON

This Week's Accomplishment: Trainer of Delightful Kiss, who won the \$250,000 Iowa Derby June 29

Birthplace: South Hampton, NY

Birthdate: Nov. 20, 1931

Current residence: Miami, Florida

Family: Wife Julia, daughter Aggie, son Robert

It's been reported that trainer Allen Jerkens played a small part in you getting Delightful Kiss. Is that right? He didn't play a small part; he played a major part. I had a few horses that

were about to be retired, so I called him and said, 'I need another horse.' He convinced the racing manager at Hobeau Farm to send me this one as a two-year-old. The rest is history.

How long have you know Allen? Oh, 50 or 60 years I guess. I met him when I was 16, 17 years old. I rode for him a few times and we used to go out to lunch sometimes.

You were a rider for a long time; in terms of excitement, how does riding compare to training? Well, if you mean what I'd rather be doing, I'd rather be young and still riding. There's nothing quite like that. But I'm 75, and I'm doing exactly what I love right now.

You rode Forego to a fourth-place finish in the Derby. Was he the best horse you ever rode? Well, that's a good question. He certainly turned out to be a good horse, but I was lucky to ride a lot of good horses. I rode a horse called Bold Bidder (sire of Spectacular Bid) who, on his best day, could beat any horse in America. He ran a mile in 1:32 and change. I won the Belmont Stakes on a horse that was cut out to be a good one, Cavan (in 1958), but he got hurt.

Any riders today impress you? Well, I don't really follow the New York guys. I do think too many guys today rely on the whip way, way too much. I don't stand for it on my horses. I see a guy trying to sneak in a left-handed whip when I thinks I'm not looking, and I'll get angry. I'm not afraid to change [riders].

Do you have any hobbies outside of horse racing? I used to be a pretty good golfer. I was down to a six handicap at one point, but I played a lot. I used to play with Jackie Gleason four times a week, along with the producer of the Honeymooners, Jack Philbin. I just played last week with [trainer] Tom Proctor's daughter. She's only 14, but is an amazing player. She hit a 72--at 14. She's going to be a great one someday.

Your daughter, Aggie Ordonez, is a trainer on the West Coast. Were you ever reluctant to let you're her go into training? You know, what I said to her is, if you've found something you love to do at a young age and can make money at it, you're way ahead of so many young people. Because it's not work--I don't consider what I do work. I love it.

"This was her race to step up and see how good she really is, and she came through," said winning trainer and co-owner Paula Capestro. River's Prayer finished ninth in the GI La Brea S. last December, then rattled off three straight wins in grass sprints, including the Irish O'Brien S. Mar. 17, the GIII Las Cienegas H. Apr. 15 and the Great Lady M S. most recently June 14.

Nashoba's Key didn't make it to the races until her four-year-old season, but has been worth the wait. The bay won her first three starts on the grass against Cal-breds, including an allowance tally at Santa Anita Feb. 7 and the Fran's Valentine S. at Hollywood Apr. 29. Sent off at 5-1 over the Hollywood Cushion in the GII Milady Breeders' Cup H. June 3, Nashoba's Key defeated all three of her GI Vanity Invitational H. rivals and was favored to stay unbeaten here. Allowed to save all the ground after breaking from the one hole, apprentice Joe Talamo awaited room on the turn for home, sent Nashoba's Key through a huge hole along the inside as pacesetter Ballado's Thunder drifted out and outkicked MGISW Balance to the wire. 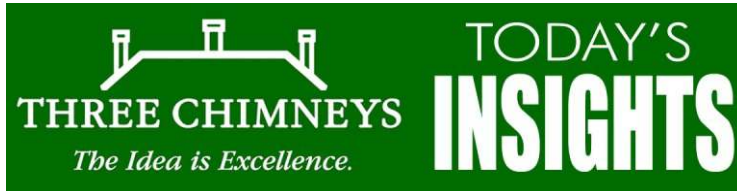
