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AGNES TACHYON COLT TOPS JRHA FINALE

Prices have traditionally cooled off during the final day of the Japan Racing Horse Association's Select

Sale, but the auction steamrolled to its conclusion yesterday at the Northern Horse Park, with six lots attracting bids over ¥100 million. Only three lots surpassed that mark during Tuesday's first foal session. The top price on the day was the ¥155 million (\$1,255,060) paid for lot 434, a son of Agnes Tachyon (Jpn) out of Rustic Belle (Mr. Prospector).

The chestnut colt was consigned by Northern Farm and purchased by Takaya Shimakawa of JHS Ltd. Japanese Classic winner Agnes Tachyon (Sunday Silence) was the country's leading juvenile sire last season, while Rustic Belle is the dam of Fusaichi Airedale (Jpn) (Sunday Silence), multiple Japanese group winner and the dam of Japanese champion juvenile Fusaichi Richard (Jpn). Fusaichi Airedale herself was well-represented yesterday when her foal by Kurofune brought ¥135 million (\$1,093,117) as the second-highest lot. Yoshimi Ichikawa, who was the underbidder on the session topper during both Monday's and Tuesday's bidding, finally got his colt after Yoshiomi Onizuka of Rohill Thoroughbred Management signed the ticket on his behalf. It is expected that Toshiaki Shirai will train the youngster at Ritto Training Center. The bay was consigned by Northern Farm. **Cont. p2**

Johnny Murtagh had a straightforward game plan for **Simply Perfect (GB)** (Danehill) in yesterday's G1 UAE

Hydra Properties Falmouth S. at Newmarket, and the filly's pillar-to-post success was the payback for his enterprise. Dropping back a half mile after a fair sixth in the June 1 G1 Epsom Oaks, Derrick Smith, Michael Tabor and Susan Magnier's grey took up the front-running duties from **Irridescence (SAf)** (Caesour)

and never looked back, recording a length verdict over that rival at odds of 6-1. "I didn't think there would be much pace in the race and thought I might get it easy in front," Murtagh explained. "When I got to the three marker, I knew she was not going to get beat today." **Cont. p2**

Teruya Yoshida, the vice chairman of the Japan Racing Horse Association, was pleased with the results at the close of business yesterday. "This is a good and consistent sale," Yoshida said. "The middle market was very strong and I have the feeling that the middle market was widely supported by newcomers at the sale. The existence of those new buyers is very important. The lots with beautiful pedigrees and the lots with wonderful conformation both sold well and I am very happy with that." Not content to rest on his laurels even for a moment, Yoshida was yesterday already looking forward to the 2008 JRHA auction. "Next year's catalogue will be featuring the first crop of Deep Impact (Jpn) and I do believe it will attract more buyers from all over the world," Yoshida said. During two foal sessions and a single yearling session, the JRHA sold 348 horses for a total of ¥11,576,900,000. The three-day average was ¥33,266,954--down 6.6 percent from 2006. The buy-back rate improved to 25.4 percent.

Simply Perfect ran into Dutch Art (GB) when second at Windsor on debut last June before filling the same spot later that month in Royal Ascot's G2 Queen Mary S. After a Lingfield maiden win and a third in the G3 Princess Margaret S. at Ascot, she met traffic when seventh in The Curragh's G1 Moyglare Stud S. Her fortunes changed in September, when she finally garnered the major success she deserved in the G2 May Hill S. at York before capping a fine campaign by annexing Ascot's G1 Fillies' Mile. Third on her return in the G1 1000 Guineas on the Rowley Mile May 6, she was not disgraced at Epsom on her latest start. Fresh from a break, she turned her rivals' reluctance to make this a test against them, quickening all the way up the rising ground to safely contain the challenge of her only credible threat in Irridescence. "Great credit to Johnny--he gave her a brilliant ride," trainer Jeremy Nosedo said. "She's a very tough filly and had been on the go pre-Royal Ascot last year, so this is her day. They all had their chance to come and beat her, but she fought them all off and deserves the credit, too, as a Group 1 winner at two and now three." Mike de Kock said of the runner-up, "I would have liked to have led earlier, but that didn't happen and I can't complain because it was a massive run. The GI Beverley D S. has always been the aim, but there is always [the Aug. 4 G1 Nassau S. at] Glorious Goodwood." Modestly bred but fleet of foot, the "bumper" performer Turbo Linn put a clutch of blue-bloods firmly in their place to strike another high-profile blow for the Alan Swinbank yard. By a sire whose closest scrape with a Classic came when he took a handicap on Epson Oaks day in 1989 and out of a national hunt mare, the dark bay had shown high-class form in that sphere when registering five wins in national hunt flat races this winter, culminating in a listed affair at Aintree. Her attentions were switched for a lowly Catterick maiden last time June 8, which she duly turned into a procession to win by 10 lengths. She received strong support in the market despite this steep class rise here. Kept under wraps against the rail behind the early leaders, she was short of room approaching the quarter pole, but shot through when the gap appeared on the fence to boss the final furlong of the contest. "She surprised me how well she picked up, and she's got any amount of improvement on her," jockey Neil Callan commented. Successful in the 2006 G2 Merchant S. at Clairwood, Tiza ran second in the G1 Mercury Sprint--his final outing in South Africa--last July, and returned off a four-race campaign in Dubai to claim a first Northern Hemisphere pattern win in this. Ninth in the Mar. 31 G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen at Nad Al Shebalast time out, he was anchored in rear until urged into contention at the 300-meter pole. Tiza made continued wide progress to lead with 100 meters remaining and drew off late to make a mockery of his exaggerated odds. "I purchased this horse in a private deal in South Africa, as he had good form there, with the intention of racing in Dubai," said the owner's Racing Manager Jean-Louis Branere. He added, "We brought him back to France with Alain de Royer-Dupre, who has given him plenty of time to adapt, but we didn't know what to expect. With the runners fanned across the width of the July Course, You'resothrilling escaped notice until the latter stages, but it was the 6-4 pick who emerged on top when it mattered. Michael Tabor and Susan Magnier's regal raider may have had excuses when second in the June 22 G3 Albany S. at Royal Ascot last time, but she had a clear passage to a length success this time. "She's a lovely filly, and when she steps up in trip, she's going to get better," jockey Mick Kinane commented. You'resothrilling began her career in the Listed Isabel Morris S. over five furlongs of The Curragh, and it was no surprise that the sister to Giant's Causeway was doing her best work at the finish when second in that May 26 contest. Relishing the extra panel at Naas next time June 4, she took the G3 Swordlestown Stud Sprint S. before finding the rain-softened turf and crowded field against her when runner-up in the Albany. Sticking to the stands' rail throughout the early stages as the majority went up the centre and Francesca d'Gorgio (Proud Citizen) stayed alone on the far side, the bay was roused along before halfway to stay in contention. In front of her group by the quarter pole, she was ahead overall as Francesca d'Gorgio faded passing the furlong marker and had done enough as Festoso and the slow-starting Elletelle fought out the action across the track. "It was make or break, as we were a good bit down by halfway, but fortunately the rail helped my filly," Kinane said. "Considering she had ground to make up, she's done it nicely." Connections of the runner-up are looking at the G2 Lowther S. at York Aug. 23, while Elletelle is under consideration for the G1 Phoenix S. at The Curragh Aug. 12. A Regional Powerhouse Goes for the Big Money...

It would be slightly ironic for Howard and Sondra Bender to register arguably their biggest-ever victory in Sunday's \$1-million GII Delaware H., having been a significant player for years in neighboring Maryland. Still, given their staunch support of regional racing and breeding, it would be fitting for the Benders to pull off the upset in the Midlantic's most lucrative distaff race with their five-year-old homebred **Promenade Girl** (Carson City). Last year, the Maryland-bred Promenade Girl, who is based with the Benders' personal trainer Larry Murray at Laurel, traveled to Monmouth Park to annex the GII Molly Pitcher Breeders' Cup S. and was also third in Keeneland's GI Juddmonte Spinster S.

Thus far, Promenade Girl, who runs in Sondra's name, has compiled a very solid record of 18-8-1-6, for earnings of \$549,990. Since getting into the racing business in earnest just over two decades ago, Howard Bender and his wife have used Maryland as a base from which they've enjoyed considerable success along the Eastern seaboard. They started off quickly, with homebred Southern Appeal upsetting the '85 GI Laurel Futurity, and more recently were named Maryland's Breeder of the Year for three straight years, from 2001 to 2003. In 2003 alone, their operation recorded an impressive 13 stakes victories. In addition to Promenade Girl, other Bender homebreds who have made a name for themselves include a number produced by their star broodmare Foufa. The daughter of Storm Bird's progeny includes Foufa's Warrior, who won Delaware's GIII Kent Breeders' Cup H.; MSW & GISP Maryland Moon; MSW & GSP Full Brush; MSW Certante; and SW Media Access. To date, the offspring of Foufa have earned \$2,031,726. The Benders also campaigned Maryland champion La Reine's Terms, who won the 2005 Maryland Million Turf S. as a 10-year-old. Now retired, La Reine's Terms, by Private Terms, stands at the Benders' Glade Valley Farm in Maryland. Howard Bender's family runs the D.C.-based Blake Construction Co., which has constructed buildings in the Washington area including the United States Holocaust Memorial Museum and Bethesda Naval Hospital.

Last year's G1 St Leger winner **Sixties Icon** is dropped in class after a surprise no-show in Epsom's G1 Coronation Cup on his latest start June 1. That flop followed an impressive three-length defeat of **Admiral's Cruise** on his four-year-old bow in the G2 Jockey Club S. on the Rowley Mile here May 6, and trainer Jeremy Noseda is hoping he can get back on track to book his ticket to the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot July 28.

Prince of Wales's S. cont.

"I am very happy with the horse," Noseda said. "He is approaching the race in good shape. I feel that he will put his blip at Epsom behind him." Sixties Icon has to defy a penalty in his bid to emulate former Leger heroes Light Cavalry (GB), Shantou and Millenary (GB), who was a dual winner of this in 2002 and 2003. Godolphin have yet to record a success in this race, but put forward last year's G1 Prix d'Ispahan and G1 Gran Premio del Jockey Club Italiano winner **Laverock**, who returns from an absence having finished out the back in the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic at Nad Al Sheba Mar. 31. "Laverock has been working nicely, but I think he will probably need this race and will improve for it," trainer Saeed bin Suroor said. "We will see how he runs--I think slightly softer ground may suit this horse."

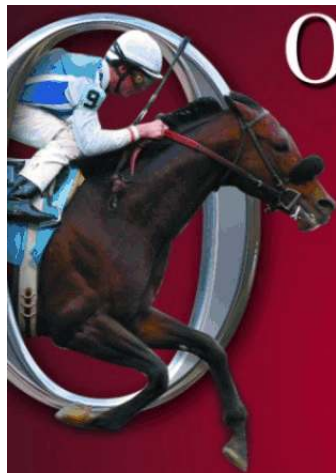

"She was the best-looking filly in the sale and I loved the pedigree," said Kennedy. "We also bought her half-sister [Carry On Ellie], who is in training in Ireland, at Goffs last year. We've got about 15 mares now and the aim is to eventually build that number up to around 30. This filly will go into training with Stan Moore before being bred." The pick of a draft from Juddmonte was five-year-old **Runaway (GB)** (King's Best), a dual Listed winner for Andre Fabre, who will join Rupert Pritchard-Gordon in France after selling to agent Dermot Farrington for 110,000gns.

Juddmonte Offering Headed to U.S.

Juddmonte's **Monzante** (Maria's Mon) will race for Mike Mitchell on the U.S. West Coast after selling for 100,000gns to Gordian Troeller, who was buying in partnership with California agent Jamie Lloyd. Darley's three-year-old **Finishing School (GB)** (Grand Lodge), a winner in France, was bought by agent Richard Frisby for 100,000gns to join the Ptarmigan Bloodstock investment scheme. "She'll most likely be covered to Southern Hemisphere time by a stallion here and then go to Australia. We've got a couple of mares going down there for the first time this year," said Frisby. The sale continues today at 9:30 a.m.

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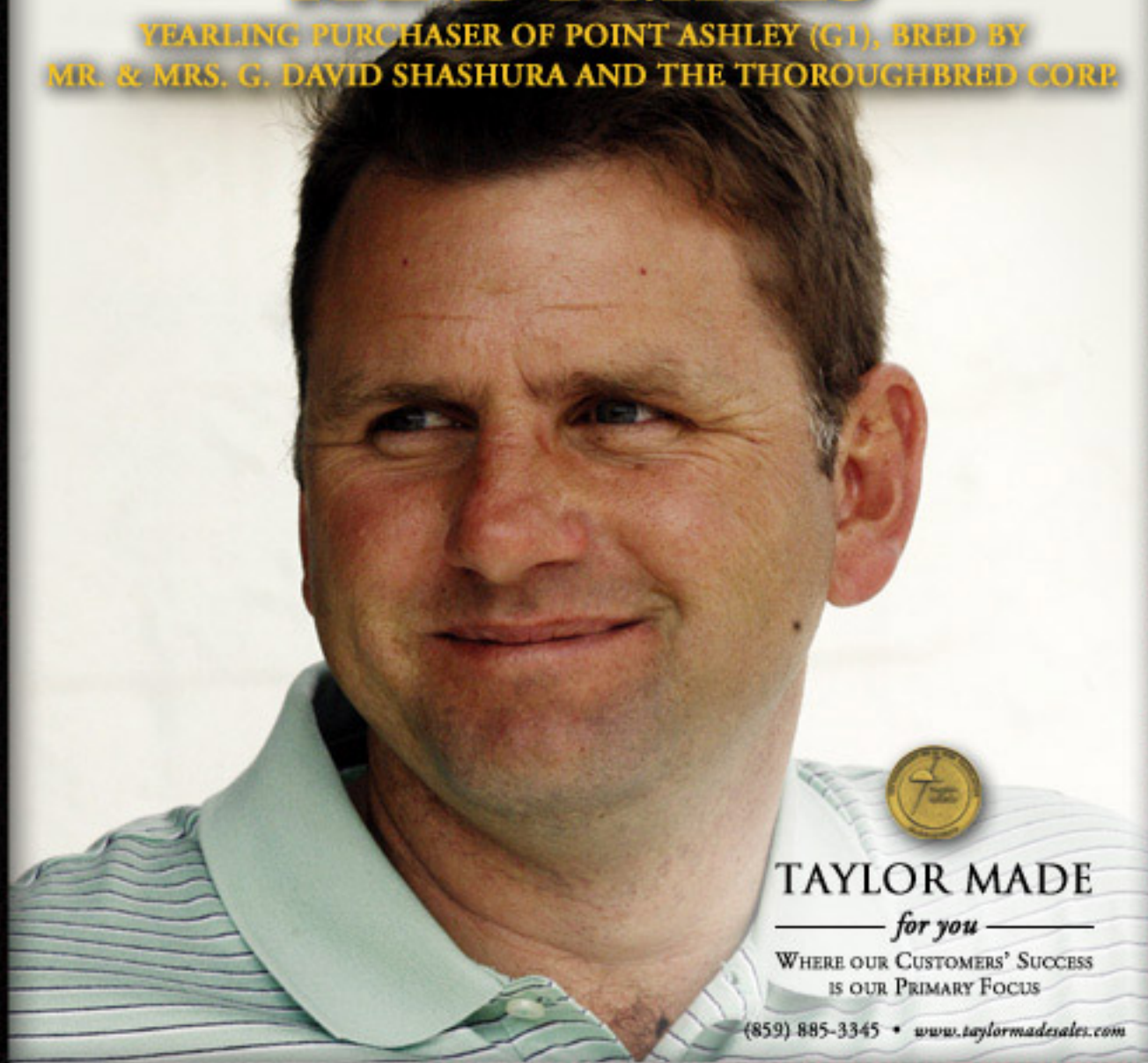

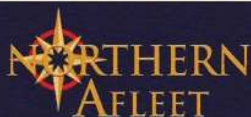

Dana Parham, a Standardbred owner/breeder and a fan of Thoroughbred racing, has donated \$250,000 to the National Thoroughbred Racing Charities Permanently Disabled Jockeys Fund. It is the single largest contribution ever made to the Fund. The Fund was established in April of 2006 by a partnership of race-tracks, racing organizations and the Jockeys' Guild, and aids disabled riders with health care and daily living expenses. "I have all the respect in the world for the riders who risk their lives every race and wanted to do something significant that will help," Parham said.
