DARLING DARJINA

She faced a couple of substantial elders in yesterday's G1 Qatar Prix du Moulin de Longchamp, but Princess Zahra Aga Khan's homebred **Darjina (Fr)**

(Zamindar) showed them all a clean pair of heels to strike for the sophomore division. Starting at odds just short of 4-1, the homebred filly could not be caught after taming **Ramonti (Fr)** (Martino Alonso {Ire}) approaching the eighth pole, and she had two lengths to spare over that rival at the line. Only Sendawar (Ire) and Starcraft (NZ) have recorded faster times in the race in the last 20 years. The G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches and G1 Prix d'Astarte heroine proved herself a rare commodity yesterday. "I am amazed and over the moon," the proud Princess commented. "She has so much talent and the trainer has done such a great job with her--I couldn't ask for more." OPTIMISM ABOUNDS AT KEESEP

As Airdrie Stud owner Brereton Jones puts it, "Listen, if you're not on the optimistic side, you should find another business." That appears to be the majority mindset as the Keeneland September Yearling Sale, the largest horse auction in the world. With 5,553 youngsters catalogued for the 15-day stand, it gets under way this morning at 10 a.m. in Lexington. And why not see the glass as half-full? Buyers from all over the globe are already on the grounds. From Sheikh Mohammed, whose 747 jumbo jet sits near the hangars at Bluegrass Field, to representatives from Coolmore to many of America's top trainers and every major pinhooker, consignors can rest assured that the buying bench is as big and hungry as ever. "I've seen quite a bit of enthusiasm out here," Jones continued. "I think there will be a continuation from what we had last year. The fact that we have a few more horses in numbers could pose a problem to some degree, but I think a good horse is still going to bring good money. Overall, I have a very positive feeling." A perennial leading consignor at Keeneland, Lane's End Farm owner Will Farish is equally bullish. "The Select Sale here is going to be a good sale," Farish commented. "From the people who are here, you can sort of judge. It's an excellent draft of horses across the board. I've heard nothing but good things and that's not always the case. The economy is good, fundamentally, and that's a very good sign. So, I'm very optimistic." **Keeneland Coverage cont. p2**

Finsceal Beo (Ire) was not on top of her game in Saturday's G1 Irish Champion S., but that rival was in her prime when **Darjina** cut her down in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulaches over this track and trip May 13. Trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre has made no secret of the fact that Darjina requires fast conditions; those are usually assured at Royal Ascot, but the heavens opened before her bid for the June 22 G1 Coronation S. and she struggled home third there. Deauville's ground was livelier for her latest, the G1 Prix d'Astarte July 29, and she prevailed once again, but she encountered a genuinely quick surface for the first time yesterday. With that in mind, jockey Christophe Soumillon stayed close to the sound early pace and was in striking range as Frankie Dettori committed **Ramonti** at the top of the straight. Swamping that foe soon after, Darjina was beyond recall as Kieren Fallon found top gear on **George Washington**. "We did the right thing staying in France and not going for the Matron," de Royer-Dupre said. "The ground is key, but she is much more mature than in the spring and I'm not surprised with the result. It was her first run against older colts and, against such a level of competition, she passed the test with flying colors. I'm not too tempted by the G1 Prix de l'Opera [at this track Oct. 7] and am thinking more of the G1 Sun Chariot S. [at Newmarket Oct. 6], but again the ground will be the key factor. She is not Breeders' Cup eligible and would have to be supplemented, but again I am not keen as the turf track at Monmouth is very tight." The female line which produced Darjina, one of the most prolific in the Aga Khan's stud book, descends from fifth dam Djebellina (Fr), who was acquired in the late 1970s in a package deal from Marcel Boussac. She is the third French Classic winner from the family. Granddam Daralbayda, in foal to Dubai Destination, was sold by the Aga Khan Studs in 2005, going to Richard Frisby for €210,000 at the Goffs November sale.

Saeed bin Suroor was satisfied with the effort of the runner-up. "Ramonti is entered in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot [Sept. 29]," he said. "We will see how he comes out of this race before making any plans, but that is an option." **Stakes Results cont. p7-10**

Thornbury Sees Blue Skies...

Keeneland's Associate Director of Sales is Tom Thornbury, who is also part of the yearling selection team. He likes what he has seen thus far. "We're delighted with the first book," Thornbury stated. "I go down and I look at the individuals that we looked at earlier and they've become even better. The second book is as deep as the first and the third book--all we do is put emphasis on the physical there, so it's going to be sensational." He anticipates a lot of activity over the next 16 days. "I see a lot of American owners and American trainers going up and down the hill, shopping frantically, and more Europeans than I've ever seen. I've met guys that I've never met before. There have been more seat requests and a great big pile of credit requests. I think it's better than what we forecast. Everything seems to be coming together right on time." Thornbury is not particularly concerned about the size of this year's catalogue or the somewhat shaky performance of the yearling market in 2007. "I think this market is the market," he commented. "You can find a good horse anywhere in the sale. It's deep, because it has to be deep. It's everybody's sale. No matter where you're from, no matter what you're producing, your hope is to sell here, because you have the broadest buying audience in the world. It's truly created a market within itself. It gets back to what kind of stock you're selling, and we're really proud of what we have here."

While there are a good deal of positive vibes on the grounds, the year's previous major yearling sales have not supported that statistically. Fasig-Tipton's Kentucky Yearling Sale failed to sustain a larger catalogue, posting decreases in average (-11.2 percent) and median (-11 percent). That auction house's Saratoga Yearling Sale followed suit, losing 10.6 percent on average and 7.1 percent on the median. The picture was a bit brighter at the select session of the OBS August Sale, with the average falling just 2.2 percent, while the median, a record \$50,000, was up 11.1 percent.

Strength in the Middle...

As Tom Thornbury points out, however, middle-market sales have held their own. "If you also look at regional sales this year, they weren't as bad as forecast either, particularly in the median, which is where I look first to see what the sale is doing," Thornbury explained. "If the median is up, that means that generally the money is being broadcast around more horses and more guys are putting money in their pocket at the end of the day." His contention is borne out statistically. Fasig-Tipton's New York-bred sale saw a slight decrease in the average price, but the median rose by 8.6 percent. The four open sessions at OBS August saw the average increase by 4.3 percent, while the median was ahead by a healthy 7.7 percent.

Good Things, Small Packages...

Keeneland is only too happy to crow about the race-track performances of horses like Rags to Riches, Maimonides and Any Given Saturday, for example, who all realized seven-figure prices when they went under the hammer. But try these on for size. Jambalaya (Langfuhr) carried hip number 3133 when he went through the 2003 September sale, when he was sold for \$2,500. He is a dual Grade I winner in 2007 and a leading candidate for the GI Breeders' Cup Turf. Unbridled Belle (Broken Vow), winner of the \$1-million GII Delaware H. in July, was purchased for \$4,000 when offered as hip 2998 at the 2004 September sale. King of the Roxy (Littleexpectations) was hammered down for just \$8,000 as hip 4816 at KEESEP in 2005 and is now a graded-stakes winner at two and three. Last, but not least, Curlin (Smart Strike) landed in Book 4 at the 2005 September sale and was purchased for \$57,000 before going on to Classic glory.

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Hip 32, c, Gone West--Clever But Costly, by Clever Trick
Consigned by Three Chimneys Sales, agent

This May 26 foal is from a family of hard-knocking competitors. He is a half to millionaire and MGSW Sun King (Charismatic) and to Traitor (Cryptoclearance), who was a Grade I winner at two. Other siblings include MGSW Ocean Drive (Belong to Me) and SP Artful Pleasure (Nasty and Bold), the dam of GISW Peeping Tom (Eagle Eyed). "He was raised on the farm, and he's really a very nice colt," said Case Clay of Three Chimneys Farm.

Hip 44, c, A.P. Indy--Denebola, by Storm Cat
Consigned by Lane's End, agent

Blood rarely gets bluer; this pedigree features the likes of Coup de Genie, Machiavellian, Exit to Nowhere, Bago (Fr) and, further back, the great Northern Dancer. This well-made, sturdy-looking dark bay is the first foal from Denebola, who was named highweight two-year-old filly in France in 2003 with wins in the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac S. and G3 Prix de Cabourg.

Hip 65, c, Storm Cat--Fiji (GB), by Rainbow Quest
Consigned by Eaton Sales, agent

Betty Moran's Brushwood Stable went to \$3.1 million to secure champion Fiji (GB), in foal to Danehill, at KEENOV in 2002. The resulting colt, named Marcus Adronicus after going to Demi O'Byrne for \$1.5 million as a 2004 KEESEP yearling, was second in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains last term. "He's an exceptional individual," said Eaton Sales' Reiley McDonald.

Hip 66, c, A.P. Indy--Fire the Groom, by Blushing Groom (Fr)
Consigned by Denali Stud (Craig and Holly Bendoroff), agent for Crystal Springs Farm

Denali Stud sold a full-sister for \$975,000 at this sale a year ago. The Mar. 5 foal is out of European highweight and U.S. Grade I heroine Fire the Groom, making him a half-sibling to champion European sprinter Stravinsky (Nureyev) and SW & GISP Moscow Ballet (Ire) (Sadler's Wells). "He's a nice horse," said Denali Stud's Craig Bendoroff. "He's got a lot of Blushing Groom in him. He's not a big, strapping A.P. Indy type; he actually resembles more of a Northern Dancer type."

Hip 112, c, Kingmambo--Last Second (Ire), by Alzao
Consigned by Indian Creek (Dave C. Parrish Jr.), agent

Hailing from a top European family, this colt is a half to the very good Aussie Rules (Danehill), who produced one of his best efforts when winning the GI Shadwell Turf Mile last season. Also the winner of last year's G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains, Aussie Rules banked \$875,309 while capturing four of 12 starts. Hip 112 is also a half to SW and MGSP Approach (GB) (Darshaan {GB}), and a full to the as yet unraced Bold Glance, who sold for 1.25 million guineas to Gainsborough Stud at the 2005 TATOCT yearling sale.

Hip 183, c, Vindication--Serena's Tune, by Mr. Prospector
Consigned by Hill 'n' Dale Sales Agency, agent

Boasting the great Serena's Song as his second dam, this colt doesn't need much help on the page. But he hasn't been hurt by the early exploits of his sire Vindication, whose first crop to hit the track has included GI Adirondack S. winner More Happy, GI Hopeful S. third Maimonides and the sharp maiden winner Sargent Seattle. What's more, a full-brother to hip 183, named Noble Sound, sold for \$2.8 million at last year's sale to John Ferguson, a year after Shadwell bought Serena's Tune's son Mutawahej (Storm Cat) for \$3.1 million.

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Hip 186, f, Storm Cat--She's a Winner, by A.P. Indy

Bluegrass Cat, a full-brother to this young lady, put forth one of the better sophomore efforts last season with his record-setting victory in the GI Haskell Invitational S. at Monmouth Park. Tracing back to a very good Phipps family that includes champion Rhythm and the useful sire Not For Love, hip 186 is also a half to MGSW Lord of the Game (Saint Ballado) and is out of a full to graded winners Daydreaming and Accelerator. He was bred in partnership by WinStar Farm and Overbrook Farm in Kentucky.

Hip 195, f, Smarty Jones--Sky Legend, by Deputy Minister
Consigned by Three Chimneys Sales, agent

This filly is from the first crop of dual Classic winner Smarty Jones, and Three Chimneys Director of Sales Case Clay said she is a good example of what her sire is throwing. "She's got a lot of Smarty's qualities," said Clay. "She's got a huge walk. She's well-balanced, has a great body, and has a great family on top of that." Hip 195 is out of the unraced Sky Legend, a daughter of MGISW and champion older mare Sky Beauty (Blushing Groom {Fr}), herself a daughter of MGISW Maplejinsky (Nijinsky II).

Hip 203, c, A.P. Indy--Storm Beauty, by Storm Cat
Consigned by Eaton Sales, agent

Storm Beauty's daughter Renaissance Lady (A.P. Indy) was already a graded-stakes placed juvenile of 2003 when, at the following year's Keeneland November sale, Brushwood Stable went to \$2.2 million for the then-nine-year-old Storm Beauty, who is a half-sister to champion sprinter Gold Beauty (Mr. Prospector) and GSW The Prime Minister (Deputy Minister). Storm Beauty, a stakes winner herself, saw a full to both Renaissance Lady and this colt sell for \$675,000 at this event a year ago. Talking about this year's offering, consignor Reiley McDonald commented, "He's a big, strong, good-looking, big-walking horse son of A.P. Indy. There's nothing not to like."

Half-sister Hollywood Story (Wild Rush) kept company with the best distaffers on the West Coast and won or placed in 15 graded stakes for earnings of \$1,171,105. Her resume includes a pair of Grade I wins at Hollywood Park, in the Hollywood Starlet S. in 2003 and the Vanity Invitational H. last year. Malibu Farm purchased Hollywood Story's dam, Wife for Life, for \$2.2 million at the 2005 Keeneland November sale, and this is the foal she was carrying at the time. "She's awesome," said consignor Case Clay of hip 234. "She's got an outstanding body and a very good walk. An A.P. Indy out of that family is very special."

Hip 243, c, Rahy--Al Theraab, by Roberto

Consigned by Indian Creek (Dave C. Parrish Jr.), agent

Dr. Demi O'Byrne was impressed enough with Al Theraab's son Albert Hall (GB) (Danahill), whom he'd purchased as a weanling for 510,000gns at the 2002 Tattersalls December sale, that he returned to buy a three-parts brother to that colt, the unraced Egyptian Hero (Danzig), for \$5.2 million at the 2006 Keeneland September sale. That sale represented a coup for consignor Indian Creek and breeder Bjorn Nielsen, and the pair return here with what appears to be another very solid prospect. "He's probably as nice a Rahy as you're going to get," said Indian Creek's Shack Parrish. "He's a big horse, but a different kind of horse than the one we sold last year. He's very nice."

What They're Saying At The Sales...

Brereton C. Jones, Airdrie Stud

"This is the premier horse sale in the world. With the exchange rate being so favorable, I think you'll find even more European interest than last year, and that might even be enough to take care of the extra numbers [in the record catalogue]."

Owner Jim Tafel

"The indication from all the sales that have preceded this is that the market is softer than it's been, but at this sale, you never know. The quality of the horses is second to none. This has taken over from what used to be the July sale, but the few people that I've talked to said that they're showing a lot of horses, so that's very encouraging. I hope it's a good sale for everyone."

Bloodstock agent John Warren, on the relative strength of foreign currencies

"It's a help, at least for a bid or two, but I don't know whether it's a help beyond that, in my mind. I wouldn't put it all down to the dollar. I think Europeans are much more fascinated by an American prospect rather than thinking they're necessarily going to buy value here."

Owner William S. Farish, Lane's End Farm

"I think it's the best book we've had in years and I think it's going to be an excellent sale. We have buyers here from all over and I look for nothing but a very exciting sale."

Owner Betty Moran, Brushwood Stable

"I've looked at a lot of very nice colts and fillies. My own are holding their own against the best that I've seen here and it makes you wonder why you're selling, but Uncle Sam is knocking on the door. The top ones are worth going back for a second look. It's going to be a high-quality sale."

Trainer John Kimmel

"If you can't find a horse here, then you're not looking hard enough, because there are plenty of nice horses that should fit everybody's budget. There are well-pedigreed fillies and colts and horses that are going to be outright runners. I think it's going to be a strong market. It's just a matter of how many of the big guys are on the horses you like. What we've been doing to buy some of the better lots is to put groups together."

Consigner Reiley McDonald, Eaton Sales

"I'd say this is going to be an exceptional filly market, based on the demand so far."

Bayne Welker, Mill Ridge Farm, on the emergence of "synthetic track" sires

"You know, we'll be having this conversation in eight years, and people will have identified who the synthetic track sires are, but right now's it's kind of up in the air. From what I've seen, it's the horses that throw some horses that do well on dirt and some horses that do well on turf that have been most successful, as opposed to true turf sires. Horses like El Prado (Ire), Gone West, many of the sons of Gone West, seem to be the ones that are really excelling on the synthetic surfaces. Lemon Drop Kid is another one who seems to be doing very well on the Polytrack."

Clearly Foxy was a 2 1/2-length maiden winner on the Woodbine turf at first asking, but was let go at

double-digit odds trying graded-stakes foes in her second start. A stalking third through an opening half in :47.52, she edged closer as they came out of the turn, drove to the front at midstretch and opened it up late for a handy score. "She was real sharp at the start,

but after the first couple of jumps, she relaxed perfectly. There was no catching her today," said jockey Jono Jones. "She's a lovely filly. Even galloping out, she never really got tired. I think you'll hear a lot from her later on." Added reigning Sovereign Award-winning trainer Mark Casse, who saddled the first three finishers, "Clearly Foxy could be any kind--we'll see what happens." As for what her next start might be, he remarked, "They've written a new race now for the Breeders' Cup [for two-year-old fillies] at a mile on the turf. 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AUSTRALIAN EQUINE INFLUENZA UPDATE

EI POSITIVES AT DARLEY AUSTRALIA Australia's equine influenza epidemic has reached the New South Wales base of Darley. Although the facility was under complete lockdown, three high-priced yearlings residing at the Hunter Valley farm have been confirmed with the virus. Darley's Australian General Manager Oliver Tait said, "EI is spreading quickly and we were not surprised when a small number of our yearlings began to display clinical signs of the virus. We contacted the DPI [Department of Primary Industries] immediately and their tests confirmed that it has reached our property." Darley's NSW neighbours include Segenhoe, where a teaser pony tested positive over the weekend. In addition to strictly adhering to bio-security protocols, Darley had been restricting the movement of people and horses on and off the property since Aug. 26. "It is apparent that the virus is airborne, as our NSW property has been in lockdown for two weeks," Tait added. "We have continually been seeking advice from leading epidemiologists in the UK and USA since the outbreak of EI in Australia and their advice to us is that vaccination is unequivocally the only way forward. Containment efforts have probably assisted in slowing the spread of the virus, but it is clear that they have not stopped it. Surely now we must focus on a vaccination strategy rather than a restriction of movement in order to stop the spread of EI into other parts of Australia. We have a stud in Victoria and I naturally have concerns it will, in time, also become a victim of EI." The DPI is still resisting vaccination, which will cost around A\$200 per horse.
