WinStar Farm and Padua Stables' **Any Given Saturday** (Distorted Humor) was made the 1-10 chalk for yesterday's GII Brooklyn H. at Belmont Park and the GI Haskell Invitational S. hero obliged, punching his ticket to the Oct. 27 GI Breeders' Cup Classic with a 2 1/2-length victory over pacesetter **Tasteyville** (With Approval). Away in a tangle, the dark bay colt settled nicely as

Tasteyville raced loose on the lead. Given his cue by Garrett Gomez approaching the stretch, he methodically reeled in the front runner and drew clear, leaving something in the tank for the next one. STREET SENSE TO TURFWAY

Street Sense (Street Cry {Ire}), the GI Kentucky Derby and GI Travers S. winner, will have his final Breeders' Cup Classic prep in Saturday's GII Kentucky Cup Classic at Turfway Park, where he will square off with GI King's Bishop S. winner **Hard Spun** (Danzig).

Trainer Carl Nafzger and owner Jim Tafel had also been considering the GII Hawthorne Gold Cup the same afternoon and the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup Sept. 30. "The main thing is that we'll ship over [from Churchill Downs] and ship back the same

day," Nafzger reasoned. "Secondly, it'll be run on Polytrack. I know we've been beat on Polytrack, but we won two good races off of [races over] Polytrack." Street Sense followed his third-place effort in last year's GI Lane's End Breeders' Futurity at Keeneland with his smashing score in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile. Prior to this year's Derby, he was caught at the wire of the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. Despite those defeats, Nafzger cited familiarity with the surface as another contributing factor. "He's never run at Hawthorne or Belmont, so they'd be totally new racetracks to him," Nafzger added. Street Sense is likely to have one more work at Churchill prior to Saturday's race.

BALLISTIC TURNS IN SUPER PERFORMANCE

Unheralded **Going Ballistic** (Lite the Fuse) had just one victory from eight previous efforts over the main track. JAZZING IT UP ON THE DIRT

Team Valor International's Barry Irwin was keen to try **Jazzy (SAf)** (Mutakddim) on the main track, and picked a tough spot to do it in yesterday's GII Gallant Bloom H. at Belmont Park. The five-year-old handled the test with aplomb and could be heading for Monmouth Park. **Gallant Bloom H. cont. p4**

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REDEMPTION FOR BRASS HAT Brass Hat (Prized) has experienced the highs and lows of the Thoroughbred game, winning the GI Donn H. in 2006 and finishing second in the G1 Dubai World Cup, only to be disqualified for a disputed drug positive. The six-year-old gelding has also endured a pair of potentially career-ending injuries, but fought through those successfully and returned to national prominence yesterday with a minor upset over **Fairbanks** (Giant's Causeway) in the rejuvenated Mass 'Cap. Brass Hat broke his maiden in the 2004 Rushaway S. and added victories in the GII Ohio Derby and the GII Indiana Derby, but went missing for 13 months following a ninth in the GIII Lone Star Derby. He returned to take three of his first four races, capped by his Donn success, and would have bankrolled \$1.2 million for his runner-up effort to Electrocutonist in the World Cup. Fifth in the 2006 GI Stephen Foster H., Brass Hat suffered a fractured ankle in a July 2006 workout and was sidelined for over a year. He made a triumphant return to racing, besting subsequent GI Pacific Classic S. hero Student Council in a July 8 Churchill allowance, breaking a 36-year-old track record in the process. Brass Hat found Lawyer Ron a bit too tough in his two most recent efforts, an eighth in the GI Whitney H. July 28 and a sixth in the GI Woodward S. Sept. 1.

assumed command entering the far turn, but his older rival was just hitting his best stride while three deep around that final bend. The two hooked up at midstretch and Brass Hat gradually wore down his stubborn rival for the victory. "My goal

was to keep my horse happy and to get a nice position," Martinez commented. "Once I got to the first turn, I was very confident and I knew that we had Fairbanks to beat." Winning trainer Buff Bradley, who conditions Brass Hat for his father Fred, says not to expect the winner on Championship Day. "I don't think we have the money to get in there, so we'll have to look for something else," he said.

Bear Now had a little something to prove, as each of her previous five tallies had come over Woodbine's synthetic surface. She'd never so much as finished on the board in four tries over conventional dirt, but that all changed yesterday with an upset over odds-on Octave. Winner of the May 20 GIII Selene S. and June 16 Hill 'n' Dale S. by a combined 17 3/4 lengths, the stout filly attended the pace in the GII Delaware Oaks July 14, but weakened to be fourth to Moon Catcher (Malibu Moon). Returned to the Toronto oval for her latest, she stormed away with the seven-furlong Duchess S. by 6 1/4 lengths Aug. 11. Hustled away from the gate by Jerry Baird, Bear Now set solid fractions of :23.45 and :46.52 as Octave was guided outside to chase three wide. That duo was joined to the inside by Talkin About Love at the head of the lane, but Bear Now dug in gamely and summoned the necessary stamina to register the upset. "I had watched the races all day and it just appeared the rail was dead," the winning rider commented. "I wanted to be sure to take my filly out to about the four path, what seemed to be the best part of the track." A Vindication half-brother to Bear Now was sold to Todd Pletcher, agent, for \$310,000 at Keeneland September.

The latter, sent off the 3-10 chalk, was carried out a bit into the stretch, but worked his way to the front at the eighth pole. However the lead was short-lived, as Going Ballistic was storming home down the center of the track and won going away.

Jazzy was already a stakes winner in the U.S. and group-placed in South Africa on the turf, and she proved she could be just as effective on the dirt while making her first start on the surface here. The bay mare ended her South African campaign with a third in Group 1 company in May of 2006. Out of action for nearly 14 months thereafter, she made her U.S. bow in the July 21 Incredible Revenge S. at Monmouth Park and was second, beaten a nose. She came from out of the clouds to win the Aug. 22 Capades S. on the turf at Saratoga, and was the third choice in this closely matched five-horse field. Jazzy tracked Great Intentions (Cat Thief) and Pussycat Doll through a half in :45.66. She ranged up on the outside in the stretch and put away Pussycat Doll for her first graded success. "The race didn't quite unfold the way we thought it would," trainer Mark Hennig said. "[Jockey Garrett Gomez] thought the speed would be to the outside, but it turned out to be to his inside. She got a good trip because of it." Looking ahead, he added, "We'll discuss things with [Barry Irwin of Team Valor International]. I'm sure if he's got an opportunity and she's worthy, we'll take a look at the Breeders' Cup F/M Sprint [Oct. 26]." Dark Angel handled Chester's tight turns in his May 9 graduation, but found everything happening too quickly when unplaced in Royal Ascot's Listed Windsor Castle S. June 19. Upped a panel to contest the July 12 G2 July S. at Newmarket, the grey acquitted himself with credit to be fourth before collecting the £300,000 St Leger Yearling S. at York Aug. 23. Seventh when dropped back to five furlongs for Doncaster's G2 Flying Childers S. eight days ago, he benefitted from this rise back to his optimum trip to make every yard of the running as Strike the Deal threatened in the final strides. "He's got a high cruising speed, can really lengthen off a good pace and is strong enough to hold out," said winning rider Michael Hills. "He's a quick-actioned horse and loves this ground; he is very competitive and reminds me of [recent G1 Haydock Sprint Cup winner] Red Clubs (Ire)." 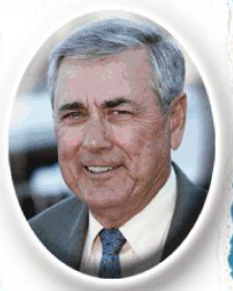

General Jumbo graduated by five lengths over Lingfield's all-weather for trainer Brian Meehan in his second and final start at two before shipping to the U.S. It took the dark bay a while to acclimated, but he continued to show improvement and finally earned his first stateside score in a Keeneland allowance during April of 2006. He followed up with an allowance tally at Delaware a month later, but promptly hit another dry spell. Eight starts later, the five-year-old missed by a head in an optional claimer at Delaware Aug. 4, and came into this contest off a runner-up finish to Revved Up in Saratoga's John's Call S. Aug. 19. Unhurried at the back of the pack in the early stages, General Jumbo began to draw closer with a four-wide move approaching the stretch. Last of six in this event a year ago, Now Victory sped to the lead from the outside box and was never headed, lighting up the toteboard as the second-longest shot in the field. The chestnut gelding returned from a seven-month absence to finish a decent fourth in the GIII Golden Gate Fields Breeders' Cup S. May 28., then dropped into state-bred competition to finish runner-up in the June 30 Korbel H. at Hollywood Park. He proved a popular winner of the Joseph T. Grace H. during the fair meeting at Santa Rosa Aug. 4, but was coming into this off a third-place effort to Jack's Wild in the California Turf Championship H. at this track Aug. 25. Carefully nursed along by jockey Frank Alvarado, Now Victory maintained a clear advantage into the stretch and remained in control as none of his more-fancied rivals could make any impact.

Favored Bon Hoffa stamped himself as one of the country's best sprinters with this barnstorming performance, but had to survive an objection from the runner-up's rider. At the end of the hearing, chief steward Des Gleeson announced that interference had occurred, but it was not severe enough to reverse the placings. "Whilst interference did happen, given the 3/4-length winning margin, we took the view that it did not affect the result of the race," Gleeson said. Bon Hoffa rated in midfield as a torrid pace developed up front. He began his move turning for home, quickly reached contention with half a furlong remaining and crossed the line narrowly in front of Niconero. Bon Hoffa's trainer Wendy Kelly, who trains a small team of 15 horses at Cranbourne in Victoria, was ecstatic with the win, her first at the elite level. "He's just a sensational horse," she said after leading Bon Hoffa back to scale. It was also the first Group 1 win for jockey Vlad Duric. "I've come close a few times, but this is awesome," said Duric, who has been riding for 15 years. "I just hope this puts my name up into lights a bit more." The lightly raced Bon Hoffa was given time to develop into his growthy frame. He has now earned A\$504,000 for winning eight times in 14 starts.

Illinois Ruling Closes Last Slaughterhouse:

In a unanimous decision, the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Seventh Circuit Friday upheld an Illinois law that bans horse slaughter for human consumption. The ruling forced Cavel International in Dekalb, Illinois--the last slaughterhouse in the U.S. that produced horsemeat for humans--to close its doors. Horse slaughter could be banned completely in the U.S., and it would become a crime to transport horses to Canada and Mexico for slaughter, if the American Horse Slaughter Prevention Act is passed. The bill is currently before a House of Representatives subcommittee.

From the draft of leading consignors SARL Srl, the bay filly's third dam is Cocotte (GB) (Troy {GB}), who produced star performers Pilsudski (Ire) and Fine Motion (Ire). Earlier, Chemin de Fer purchased hip [200](#), a son of Night Shift named Il Regalo (Ire) for €44,000 from Razza del Sole. Produced by La Rendita (GB) (Hector Protector), he hails from the family of MGSW Magna Graduate and this year's G3 Noblesse S. winner Nick's Nikita (Ire). Despite the strength of the first session, the sale was anchored by a poor clearance rate of 69 percent, and the average of €34,517 was slightly down on 2006.
