'SKY' CLEAR FOR CLOUDY'S KNIGHT

S J Stable's homebred **Cloudy's Knight** (Lord Avie) came up just short when runner-up in his last two in graded company, but the veteran gelding wouldn't be denied in yesterday's GII Sky Classic S. at Woodbine. Sent off the 3-1 third choice in the 1 3/8-mile turf event, Cloudy's Knight kept close tabs on the pacesetter before moving up to challenge entering the lane. The chestnut forged to the lead at the furlong grounds and edged way late under jockey Ramsey

Zimmerman. "He relaxed right where I needed him to be, putting pressure on the horses on the inside," said the rider. "When I turned for home, I just smooched to him and hollered at him a bit and he kicked on from there." Cloudy's Knight, winner of the GIII Fair Grounds BC H. earlier this year, just failed to last in a second-place effort in the July 4 Stars and Stripes BC Turf H. at Arlington Park before running second again, beaten 3/4 lengths, in the GII Nijinsky II S. over this lawn Aug. 26. Winning trainer Frank Kirby said the \$2 million, Oct. 21 GI Pattison Canadian International is the next target. DARJINA TO BE ADDED TO QEII

Princess Zahra Aga Khan's **Darjina (Fr)** (Zamindar) is to be supplemented to Saturday's G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot, connections have announced. Having beaten **Ramonti (Fr)** (Martino Alonso {Ire}) and **George Washington (Ire)** (Danehill) in the Sept. 9 G1 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp, the sophomore will renew rivalry with that duo in the mile contest. Trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre revealed the plan to the *Racing Post*. "It is our intention to supplement Darjina into the Queen Elizabeth on Monday," de Royer-Dupre said. "We have had a look at the weather forecast next week and it doesn't forecast much rain. The filly is in great shape since her Moulin victory." Officials at the Berkshire venue are keeping a keen eye on the developments surrounding the ongoing foot-and-mouth virus close by, as the track currently sits on the verge of the exclusion zone around the latest infected farm. "The latest incident occurred within the existing surveillance zone, but Ascot remains about two miles outside the total-exclusion zone," the course's Public Relations Manager Nick Smith told *PA Sport*. "So, unless the situation changes again, we're looking forward to the coming fixture and racing as normal."

Schiaparelli will be vying for his country's Horse of the Year honors after recording another success at the highest level here. He had shown a liking for testing conditions when taking last year's G1 Deutsches Derby at Hamburg in July, and it may not have been slow enough underfoot when he was subsequently sixth in the G1 Grosser Preis von Baden in September. After a sign-off win in Dortmund's G3 Deutsches St Leger the following month, the chestnut took a break, and he was rusty on his four-year-old bow. Eighth in the G2 Gerling-Preis over this track and trip Apr. 22, he improved to be third under a penalty in the May 20 G2 Grosser Mercedes-Benz-Preis at Baden-Baden. Schiaparelli was giving Poseidon Adventure four pounds when winning the G2 Hansa-Preis at Hamburg June 24, and he was coming off a victory in Dusseldorf's G1 Deutschlandpreis July 22. The bay filling third spot in the G2 Oettingen-Rennen at Baden-Baden last time Aug. 28. Receiving three pounds from his arch-rival here, he was reserved in rear of the tightly packed field early. König Turf wore down Apollo Star to deny him an all-the-way success in the final strides as Santiago joined up late for a thrilling three-way go. It's a 1,285-mile trip from trainer Rafael Bacerra's barn at Santa Anita to Hastings Park in Vancouver, British Columbia, but former claimer Celtic Dreamin made the journey more than worthwhile with an overwhelming victory here. The gelding was claimed by Bacerra for K.K. Sangara for just \$40,000 out of a winning debut effort facing statebred maiden claimers at Santa Anita in April. He followed up with a Hollywood starter allowance win in May, a statebred allowance win in June, and a nose runner-up effort in an open allowance July 8. He got back to winning ways at that level at Del Mar Aug. 22 and was looking to improve to five for six in his stakes bow. Part of a trio of horses vying for the early lead, Celtic Dreamin began to get away on the far turn and was full of run down the lane to win by daylight. "I was looking for a three-year-old to claim, and Rafael told me he'd find me one--and he did," said a happy Sangara, who was winning the Derby on his fifth attempt. 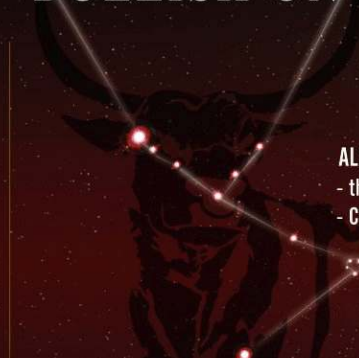

VICTORY GALLOP FILLY TOPS SUNDAY'S

ACTION A filly by Victory Gallop led the way during another strong day of selling at Keeneland September. WinStar Farm, agent, purchased the session topper, a daughter of the Dehere mare Mild Maggie, for \$95,000. Catalogued as hip [4671](#), the Apr. 4 foal is a granddaughter of the Grade II-placed Future of Gold (Fountain of Gold). Knocked down as a weanling to Baccari Bloodstock for \$12,000 at last year's Keeneland November sale, she was consigned here by Baccari Bloodstock, agent. Hip 4617 was bred in Kentucky by Woodlynn Farm and Brian Hoeweler.

The session's top-priced colt was a son of freshman sire Van Nistelrooy (Storm Cat) who was purchased by Alice Cohn, agent, for \$85,000. Out of the 20-year-old SW & GSP Sabina (Cox's Ridge), hip [4738](#) is a half-brother to stakes winner and stakes producer Wright Lite (Majestic Light) and a grandson of MGISW Sabin. Tym Mar Farms, agent, consigned hip 4738, who was bred in West Virginia by Alan Parker and Janet W. Hoke DVM. Alan Parker purchased Sabina, carrying this colt, for \$9,000 at the 2005 Keeneland November sale. Sunday's session witnessed double-digit gains on 2006 figures, with average up 52.6 percent, from \$9,645 to \$14,716. The median was up 38.5 percent, from \$6,500 to \$9,000. "The sale has been phenomenal," said Geoffrey Russell, Keeneland's director of sales. "Buyers are still very active and enthusiastic to buy a good horse." The sale continues today at 10:00 a.m.
