KEENELAND SEPTEMBER CONCLUDES

When Book 1 failed to produce any serious fireworks and, subsequently, average took a 20-percent hit, the Keeneland September sale in Lexington, Kentucky, looked like it was off to an inauspicious start. But in the end, the marathon event rebounded strongly and yesterday concluded its 15-day stand with sale officials praising the market. "There's no mistake," said Keeneland Director of Sales Geoffrey Russell. "We were confident the middle part of this sale would be strong, but it has definitely exceeded our expectations. We

knew that we would have a lot more international players because of the weakness of the American dollar. They came early and stayed late, which bolstered the sale dramatically. We had strong domestic participation all the way through. We came up with the word 'phenomenal,' and I really do believe it's been a phenomenal sale. I think there's been a lot more electricity at this sale, even more than last year's." **Keeneland Coverage cont. p2**

STREET SENSE WORKS

James Tafel's **Street Sense** (Street Cry {Ire}) tightened the screws for his showdown with **Hard Spun** (Danzig) in Saturday's GI Kentucky Cup Classic with a five-furlong drill yesterday. Working at his home track of Churchill Downs, the GI Kentucky Derby hero covered the distance in 1:01.80 under regular jockey Calvin Borel. The move was the seventh-fastest of 29 at the distance and was achieved through fractions of :13.80, :26, :38.20 and :49.20. Street Sense galloped out six furlongs in 1:14.20. "That's what Carl [trainer Nafzger] wanted--1:01 and change," said Borel. "He settled down right, galloped out good and he's sharp. He's ready to roll. Come

Saturday, he'll be ready." With the likes Street Sense and Derby runner-up Hard Spun--recent winner of the GI King's Bishop--in the race, Kentucky Cup is having trouble attracting challengers. A field as small as four horses is a possibility for the nine-furlong event over Turfway's Polytrack. That could make the speedy Hard Spun even more of a threat, and both Nafzger and Borel acknowledge that Street Sense might have to alter his usual late-running tactics. "Match races are won by speed horses," said Nafzger. "I want to win every time I go over there, and I want to win this because my cowboy buddy [J. Larry Jones] trains the other one."

OAK TREE GETS ITS FREAK ON

The Oak Tree meet at Santa Anita begins its six-week stand this afternoon with the grassy GIII Senator Ken Maddy H. kicking things off. Today's feature finds **Super Freaky** (Smart Strike) in search of her fourth win from five starts down Santa Anita's hillside turf course. She'll be piloted in the about-6 1/2-furlong event by jockey Jon Court. "She's won the course and Jon knows her well," said conditioner Doug O'Neill. 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Near Record Sale...

When the hammer dropped on 2007 Keeneland September yesterday, it concluded the second- highest grossing September sale ever. The ending gross of \$385,018,600 was down only 3.7 percent from last year's record 14-day, \$399,791,800 event. Despite a lackluster start and a slow final day--an unprecedented 15th day of selling at September--the sale enjoyed gains in 13 consecutive sessions. When all was said and done, the cumulative average of \$101,347 represented a 9.9 percent dip from the last year's record \$112,427. The cumulative median of \$42,000 was down 6.7 from \$45,000. The declines can in part be attributed to the final two days of selling; the average, for instance, was down just 4.6 percent going into the penultimate session, while the median was *up* 4.4 percent before yesterday's selling. The extra session did equate to an industry record for number of horses sold, with 3,799 yearlings selling compared to 3,556 a year ago, and many agreed that the market correction predicted before the sale was largely countered by the strength of the middle market. "We leave this sale feeling very confident that the market is in a very good position," said Geoffrey Russell. "Saying that, it doesn't mean there aren't some concerns out there. There's been discussion about stud fees these last two works and also about overproduction and some 'non-commercial horses' showing up in the sales rings. All those sorts of things need to be addressed."

Mancini Filly Tops Sale Finale...

Hip [5550](#), a filly by Unbridled's Song's brother Mancini, topped the final day of selling yesterday, eliciting a bid of \$50,000 from agent P.A. Everard. A daughter of Are You Kidding (Demaloot Demashoot), the gray is a full-sibling to a pair of stakes winners, Whatsitgonnatake and Hurry Home Warren, winner of this year's Harry Henson S. at Hollywood Park. Hip 5550, who was the second-to-last horse through the ring yesterday, was bred in Kentucky by John O'Meara and was consigned by O'Meara's Milestone Farm. The top-priced colt on the day was hip [5412](#), a colt from the first crop of graded stakes winner Scrimshaw (Gulch). A son of the Belong to Me mare Painting the Town, he was purchased for \$47,000 by Hal & Patti Earnhardt from the draft of Forbush Farm.

Buzz Chace, bloodstock agent

"I thought it was a fair sale. We paid for a good horse that went in there. I think it was a fair market. The nice horses sold well and brought a fair price. I thought maybe it was a little to the buyers' mode sometime and sometimes to the sellers', so I think it all evened out. I've been optimistic about the market. I looked at the market optimistically and I think it worked out that way. I thought it went pretty well. Everything went smooth for me."

Pat Costello, Paramount Sales

"I think the market probably outperformed my expectations, especially the middle market. We had a decent-enough Book 1, but I thought Books 2, 3 and 4 were really strong. There was plenty of bidding on the horses and there was a lot of people for each horse. It got a little tougher at the end, but they were lesser horses. But the market still held up. Every sale that we had up to this one was down about 10 percent, so I thought if we had a 10-percent drop in the market it was going to be a good result. Obviously it was better than that. The domestic market was very strong and the Europeans came in really strong, too. I heard one Irish transporter say that he had over 200 horses to go home."

"The sale went great. We had a really solid sale, especially here in the middle and later days. We had high clearance rates and very few RNAs. We were very pleased. I was somewhat optimistic coming in. The big boys hooked up a lot last year and that didn't happen this year, so that was a big difference. While the average is down slightly, the big thing to me and the more important thing to me is that the median held up. That means, to me, that there's more people willing to buy horses and that shows the strength of the market. I thought it was a good sale."

Mike Akers, Dapple Bloodstock

"I couldn't see anything to complain about, myself. I thought there was plenty of money there for a nice horses. We were trying to buy a few to resell in the two-year-old market and we had 25 or so in the marketplace, so we were kind of playing both sides of the game. If you had the right product, there was plenty of money there for it. I thought the middle showed some strength, which was very encouraging. I guess everyone was talking the "10-percent" thing. Keeneland is going to end up down \$15 million and those are the horses last year that they got in a tug-of-war over. It seemed to be very strong. The end of the story is that for \$200,000 to \$400,000 you should be able to buy a good horse and you certainly can."



Same Number of Seven-Figure Horses...

The 2007 September sale was a long way off from realizing an eight-figure yearling, like the 2006 renewal did when John Ferguson fought off Demi O'Byrne for an \$11.7 million Kingmambo colt. But Keeneland officials took solace in the fact that the same number of yearlings--32--brought \$1 million or more in '06 and '07, and that individual buyers that spent \$1 million or more on yearlings actually increased this year. "There is very much strong demand for horses," asserted Keeneland's Geoffrey Russell. "The top of the market is rarified air--there are two people that breathe it and it's difficult when they're not on the same page. But then again, it opens up opportunities for other people to participate and that makes the market healthier if there's more people playing in there. We had more individual million-dollar purchasers than last year. We had the same number of million-dollar horses, just bought by more people, and that's very healthy."

Breaking through in this contest last year, Musical Way has enjoyed an eventful campaign this term including when brought down in La Coupe at Longchamp June 14 before running seventh in the G1 Pretty Polly S. at The Curragh June 30. "She is all heart, never gives up and is a joy to train," enthused winning trainer Philippe van de Poele. "At one stage during the race I feared she would be caught for speed, but she asserted in brave fashion. There are various possibilities for her next race, including the [Oct. 21] GI E. P. Taylor S. in Canada or [Oct. 28] G1 Premio Lydia Tesio in Italy and then Hong Kong later in the season. The key with her is decent ground and that is what we will be looking for first." 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STRIKING FROM UNDER THE RADAR

Sunday's 68th running of the GI Vosburgh S. is expected to feature the much-anticipated return of Discreet Cat. As part of the Breeders' Cup "Win and You're In" Challenge, the Vosburgh victor will automatically earn a berth in the \$2-million GI Breeders' Cup Sprint at Monmouth Oct. 27, a key consideration to several entrants, including the connections of Fabulous Strike (Smart Strike).

The Pennsylvania-bred won six of his nine outings last year at three, including the Romano Gucci S. at Belmont, and finished up 2006 by earning a 119 Beyer Speed Figure in taking Mountaineer's Christmas S. by 11 lengths Dec. 26. After getting some time off, the dark bay returned at the West Virginia oval to capture the May 5 Panhandle S., getting a 118 BSF, then took his act to Churchill. He ran his rivals off their feet in the June 2 GIII Aristides H. and received a 115 BSF.

Those credentials saw the Tea Party Stable homebred go postward as the second choice to Smokey Stover in the GII Smile Sprint H. July 7 at Calder, but, after getting his first quarter in :21 2/5, faltered in the lane and wound up fifth. He does have a pretty good excuse, though.

"He had what they call the thumps," trainer Todd Beattie said during a national teleconference yesterday. "He got wobbly after the race while cooling out." Officially known as synchronous diaphragmatic flutter (SDF), the thumps are a symptom of heat stress and are associated with an electrolyte imbalance. "We gave him plenty of time to recover," Beattie continued. "He wasn't as sharp as he normally was...we've had no problems since."

Beattie had a string at Presque Isle Downs in Erie, Pennsylvania, this summer, and sent his stable star there in hopes of running him in the \$175,000 Karl Boyes Memorial Northwestern PA S. Sept. 15.

"We were eyeing up a race there," Beattie said. "But, in evaluating how many points it would take to get to the Breeders' Cup, we changed our minds and started to lean towards the Vosburgh."

"I'm looking forward to Sunday."

DE SEROUX AND JACKSON SETTLE LAWSUIT

A lawsuit leveled against bloodstock agent Emmanuel de Seroux by prominent owner and breeder Jess Jackson has been settled out of court. In the agreement, de Seroux will pay \$3.5 million to Jackson, who in turn will drop his suit alleging that de Seroux engaged in fraudulent practices when representing Jackson in the purchase of the number of horses and in his involvement in Jackson's purchase of the former Buckram Oak Farm. The settlement was reached a week before the suit involving the purchase of horses was to go to trial in California Oct. 1. In addition, de Seroux has agreed to drop a counter-suit which claimed that Jackson failed to pay de Seroux and his Narvick International bloodstock agency for services rendered. Jackson's suit was launched in 2005, when the billionaire accused a number of parties, including de Seroux, Narvick, and another de Seroux-affiliated business, Continental Bloodstock, of defrauding him. Also named in the original suit were Bruce Headley and Brad Martin, who have since settled for \$900,000 and \$250,000, respectively. Jackson later included in his suit the South American bloodstock agent Fernando Diaz-Valdez, French agent Frederic Sauque and Buckram Oak Holdings. Diaz-Valdez settled with Jackson on undisclosed terms, while Buckram Oak and Sauque were dismissed from the California suit on jurisdictional grounds. Still ongoing is Jackson's Kentucky suit that claims Buckram Oak Holdings, a company headed by the late owner and breeder Mahmoud Fustok, and Sauque, worked in collusion to defraud Jackson of at least \$1.5 million in the sale of Buckram Oak Farm, which has been renamed Stonestreet Farm.

PEEPING FAWN TO GET A VACATION?

Trainer Aidan O'Brien has hinted that star filly **Peeping Fawn** (Danehill) will be put away for the season ahead of a four-year-old campaign. Michael Tabor and Susan Magnier's four-time Group 1 winner has a series of options in the fall, but the Ballydoyle conditioner is thinking of a 2008 campaign now. "She might not run any more this year as we're thinking of next year," O'Brien told the *Racing Post*. "We hope to keep her in training as a four-year-old and she has been very busy in the last few months."



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AUSTRALIAN EQUINE INFLUENZA UPDATE

QUEENSLAND RACING HALTED Racing in Queensland will be halted until February after horses tested at Eagle Farm and Albion Park returned positives for equine influenza yesterday. Racing Minister Andrew Fraser said the discovery of EI at stables in the Brisbane suburbs of Hendra and Deagon meant it was unlikely any racing events would be scheduled in the city before Feb. 1 next year. "We have a very significant issue that will require the industry as a whole to take a number of drastic measures to secure the long-term future of the industry," he said. "This is Queensland racing's darkest hour." Fraser added that Queensland Racing hoped to move quickly to vaccinate horses in the areas surrounding Brisbane, including the Gold Coast, Ipswich and Toowoomba, once the first vaccines arrive in Australia Thursday. "The real name of the game at the moment is to make sure we get the vaccine by the weekend and get it out to horse populations that don't have [EI] yet," he said. The EI outbreak is also causing officials to consider pushing back some of Australia's biggest races. The G1 Golden Slipper, scheduled for Mar. 15, could be postponed until mid-April, while the G1 AJC Derby could be held Apr. 26.

LAW FIRM INUNDATED WITH CLASS ACTION

ENQUIRIES Enquiries concerning class action suits are making their way into the offices of several lawyers in Australia and it is suspected this trickle could turn into a flood. Attwood Marshall Lawyers senior partner Jeff Garrett, whose firm is preparing a legal class action on behalf of people and businesses affected by the equine influenza outbreak, said, "We have had enquiries from equestrian photographers, produce store proprietors, stallion and broodmare owners, transport companies, racehorse owners & trainers, non-Thoroughbred breeders and various associations of people who work in the industry. It's amazing the extent of the losses that everyone has suffered, and will continue to suffer, until this mess is sorted out. Everyone will probably have to wait until the outcome of the Federal Government inquiry, before any concrete steps can be taken. It's early days yet and people are still suffering losses as we speak. These losses probably won't crystalize until well into next year." It was not immediately clear who would be the target of any such action. Already it is estimated billions of dollars have been lost and, with certain stud farms excluded from the arbitrarily drawn purple zone, effectively meaning the stallions on those farms in New South Wales cannot cover a mare this year, the suits are just going to compound.

"I bought my first horse in 1960 for \$3,500--he won his first two races and I was hooked," admitted Caesar Kimmel, who quickly adds horse racing just after real estate as his primary business.

Kimmel owns parts of 25 mares and babies and has between 10 and 12 horses in training, including Pennsylvania Derby winner Timber Reserve, whom he owns in partnership with Lee Einsidler's Circle E. Also in partnership with Circle E, he also owns a weanling by Unbridled's Song out of a Storm Cat mare.

Timber Reserve made an instant impression on Kimmel.

"I actually thought he was the epitome of a good-looking horse," Kimmel explained of his two-year-old purchase. "He was nice and big and he looked like he had the makings of a nice horse."

While not locked into buying exclusively two-year-olds, Kimmel does see the advantages of the juvenile sales.

"At the two-year-old sales you can get a better idea of conformity," he said. "You can see how the horses move and you can see them work. Although, I don't pay attention to the ones that work in :10--I'm usually suspicious of that. I think that's asking too much of a horse. I usually look at the ones that go in :11 or :11.2. And my son [John] is a vet and a trainer, so he'll scope them for me."

But Kimmel is open to finding racing talent wherever he can find it.

"You never know when you're going to get a bargain," he said. "So many people are looking to find a horse that's a 10. Sometimes you have to find a horse that's an eight or a seven and correct what's wrong."

In his close to 50 years in the racing business, Kimmel has gained a reputation for choosing some entertaining horse names.

"I have a lot of fun with the names," admitted the man who has given the racing world Bodacious Tatas and her daughter Indicators On. "[Retired Jockey Club registrar] Buddy Bishop had four stars next to my name and said all of my submissions had to be checked by three people. It's very difficult to make money in this business, so you have to have fun."

What names can we look forward to down the road?

"I just sent a yearling to Live Oak by More Than Ready and he's named Morethan Fourhours," Kimmel said, dispensing medical advice for men who are more than ready for too long, along with a sense of humor.

Timber Reserve has been slowed by a sore foot since his Pennsylvania Derby win, but Kimmel hopes the colt will be back by the end of the month. "We're looking towards the [Oct. 27] GIII Pegasus S. or the \$1-million Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile [Oct. 26]," he said.

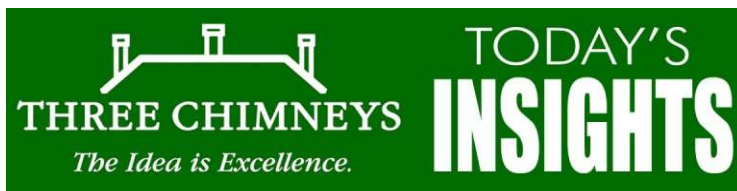

Baze was not seriously hurt. Drill Down was being pointed toward Sunday's GI Norfolk S.

at Santa Anita. "There was no way we could save him," an emotional trainer Mike Machowsky told *DRF*. "You don't expect it to end like this. You expect it to end with a few nice wins to his career. I am shell-shocked; this horse never missed a beat." Drill Down's breakdown came after a weekend of rain that some trainers felt made for an uneven surface at Santa Anita. Machowsky, however, didn't blame the footing. "You're always hearing things about the racetrack, but I can't say the track is bad," Machowsky told *DRF*. "It's just one of those things, and it's a tough one to choke down." Purchased for \$350,000 at this year's Barretts March sale, Drill Down broke his maiden by 2 1/4 lengths at Del Mar July 28 and was the 2-1 favorite in the Del Mar Futurity.
