

FLOWER BOWL DRAWS WHILE-D CHILD

A year ago, trainer Todd Pletcher decided to ship Arindel Farm's **Wait a While** (Maria's Mon) to California in search of her preferred fast ground. A rainy forecast for the greater New York area never materialized late this week and the reigning Eclipse Award winner will get the top of the ground as the likely favorite in a contentious running of today's G1 Flower Bowl Invitational S. She was victorious in the GIII Honey Fox H. to begin her four-year-old season in March, but the contrarians had their day when the gray filly finished fifth over the Keeneland Polytrack in

the GII Jenny Wiley S. the following month and again when she could not catch **My Typhoon** (Ire) (Giant's Causeway) in the GII Just a Game S. June 9. Scratched on the eve of the GIII CashCall Mile in July, Wait a While made her return to the races in the GII Ballston Spa H. at Saratoga Aug. 23 and showed the brilliance of 2006, scoring by 2 1/4 lengths in near course-record time. "She proved in her last race she's in top form," Pletcher commented. "She won the American Oaks and the Yellow Ribbon at a mile and a quarter, so the distance is no problem." Pletcher is also happy that the weather prognosticators got it wrong. "The way the turf now is perfect," he added. **Royal Highness** (Ger) (Monsun {Ger}) has never been off the board in five starts since her arrival in the U.S. last year. The two-length winner of the GIII The Very One H. at Gulfstream Park Feb. 27, she returned to miss by a neck to **Rosinka** (Ire) (Soviet Star) in the Robert G. Dick Memorial H. July 14. She appeared to relish the off going when she came from well back to run down Iridescence (SAf) in the GI Beverly D. S. Aug. 11 and could prove very tough with a repeat performance. The five-year-old is not nominated to the Breeders' Cup and would have to be supplemented for \$180,000. "Our goal has been the Flower Bowl and then we'll go from there," commented trainer Christophe Clement.

Princess Zahra Aga Khan's **Darjina** (Fr) (Zamindar), who proved stronger than all-aged competition in the G1 Prix du Moulin at Longchamp Sept. 9, bids to defy the colts and her elders again in today's G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot. Supplemented Monday by trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre, the three-year-old is coming in at the top of her game. "She is a very strong filly who can travel and, if the ground is good, I think she will run well," de Royer-Dupre commented. 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A RACE FIT FOR A QUEEN

Rain at Ascot yesterday would not have been a welcome sight for Darjina's connections, as soft ground at this venue proved her undoing when she finished third in the June 22 G1 Coronation S. Her career high last time in the Sept. 9 Moulin came on good to firm at Longchamp, and her conditioner is concerned that the ground may deteriorate. "She has been beaten only once, and that was when it was soft at Ascot, so I hope we have a normal track," said de Royer-Dupre.

"The difficulty is if you have rain just before the race--if

it is two days before, it is no problem."

Godolphin, looking for their fourth winner of this contest, have similar concerns about **Ramonti (Fr)** (Martino Alonso {Ire}). His best performances have been over quick surfaces, including a score in the G1 Queen Anne S. over this track and trip

June 19 and G1 Sussex S. at Goodwood Aug. 1. He has two lengths to find on Darjina on their Longchamp running, and his connections are hoping different tactics can bring about a reversal. "He's pretty good on all types of ground, but his best form is on fast ground," Racing Manager Simon Crisford said. "I think the only way we can try to reverse form with Darjina is to employ a pacemaker [Blue Ksar] and make it a true test. She's a filly with a great turn of foot and won in decisive fashion, so it will be a tough ask, but the greatest testament to him is his toughness. He gives everything he's got in all his races, but he's been on the go for six months now, and we're just hoping he can maintain his form for one more battle." Despite the absence of last year's winner George Washington (Ire), Ballydoyle still have strong representation in **Excellent Art** and **Duke of Marmalade**. First and second respectively in the course-and-distance G1 St James's Palace S. at the Royal meeting June 19, the former took a step a forward when a neck second to Ramonti in the Sussex. Duke of Marmalade has hardly stood still as well, improving off a fourth in York's G1 Juddmonte International S. Aug. 21 to finish second, 1 1/2 lengths second behind Dylan Thomas (Ire), in the Sept. 8 G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown last time.

Off color when a disappointing fifth behind Manduro (Ger) in Deauville's G1 Prix Jacques le Marois last time Aug. 12, the grey returns to the scene of his runner-up finish in last year's St James's Palace. "It will probably be his last race, and we are hoping he goes out in style with a good run," conditioner Nicolas Clement told *PA Sport*. "He enjoyed Ascot in the St James's Palace S. last season, and we hope he does so again. He had mucus and did not run his race at Deauville. We think he will do better this time." Nannina (GB) (Machiavellian) has been withdrawn from the race. (see related story p10)

Andre Fabre's runners in Britain command the utmost respect, and ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ **Proviso** looks up to standard on her success in the G3 Prix du Calvados at Deauville last time Aug. 18. While it was widely accepted that the homebred had encountered a smart rival in Laureldean Gale on that occasion, she was always in control as the duo pulled away from their peers. "She's done very well so far and seems to have come out of the race in Deauville nicely," Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe told *PA Sport*. "We think she has come on since, but she'll need to have as it will be a really tough race. Everyone seems to be really pleased with her at the moment and, hopefully, she can prove she is a really good filly." Jim Bolger, in unstoppable form this term, saddles the G1 Phoenix S. and G1 Moyglare Stud S. heroine **Saoirse Abu**. After besting Henrythenavigator over six furlongs in the former contest at The Curragh Aug. 12, she handed a comprehensive 1 1/2-length beating to **Listen** in the G1 Moyglare Stud S. over a furlong further at that track last time Sept. 2. Listen represents the Aidan O'Brien team, while **Kotsi** bids for a notable first major-race success for trainer Ed Vaughan. Frankie Dettori thinks she can go one better than her second in Doncaster's G2 May Hill S. 16 days ago. "She's a nice filly who is very placid, and showed signs of being very green at Doncaster," Dettori said. "She was the only filly really finishing there and, although it's a tough race, she won't be out of place." Brian Meehan saddles the impressive Salisbury maiden winner **Joffe's Run**, who has to improve off her 3 1/2-length success in that Sept. 6 contest, but her trainer is hoping she can reward his faith. "I think it was a fairly serious maiden at Salisbury and she looked very impressive to me," Meehan commented. "We've gone from maidens to Group 1s so many times, and this is the logical step."

Nashoba's Key puts her perfect six-for-six record on the line as she stretches out beyond a mile and an eighth for the first time. The four-year-old filly started her career with three straight wins on the turf, then switched to all-weather and captured the June 3 GII Milady BC H. Sent off the even-money chalk in the

July 7 GI Vanity H., she handed Balance at 3/4-length defeat, and kept the streak alive with a 1 1/2-length tally in the Aug. 5 GII Clement L. Hirsch H. at Del Mar. Trainer Carla Gaines is not worried about the added distance today. "I think she'll love it," Gaines told *Daily Racing Form*. "In the morning, she gets stronger and stronger. It's hard to get her pulled in her gallops." The biggest obstacle in the way of her continued success is the talented **Citronnade**. The four-year-old put together five straight victories on the grass, including the Jan. 7 GII San

Gorgonio H., Mar. 25 GII Santa Ana H., May 28 GI Gamely S. and July 1 GII Beverly Hills H. Taken out of her game when she hit the gate at the start of the Aug. 11 GI Beverly D. S., the free-running filly ended up in fourth early and that's where she finished, suffering her first loss of the year. Trainer Bobby Frankel hopes it's business as usual today. "I want to see her in front," Frankel told *DRF*. The Yellow Ribbon won't necessarily prove to be a match race between the top two. **Imagine**, first or second in all six turf tries, steps up after taking an overnight stakes at Del Mar Aug. 24; and New Zealand import **Black Mamba** comes off a second behind Precious Kitten in the Sept. 1 GII Palomar H.

Trainer Bob Baffert removed several of his horses from Del Mar due to its synthetic surface, but ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ **Cry and Catch Me** was not one of them, much to the disappointment of her rivals this afternoon. Runner-up on debut to Tasha's Miracle in a Hollywood Cushion Track maiden July 1, the dark bay was given ample time to recover from that effort, and sizzled in a similar event over the Polytrack at the Seaside, graduating by 6 1/4 lengths Aug. 26. She has trained sensationally since that appearance, including a best-of-22 three furlongs in :33 4/5 over this newly installed surface Sept. 26. Team Valor purchased an interest in **Tasha's Miracle** following her July 1 maiden win and gained an instant return on their investment when the bay outfinished **Set Play** for a 3 1/4-length score in the GIII Sorrento S. at Del Mar Aug. 8. The form of that race was franked when Set Play upset the GI Del Mar Debutante S. at odds of 14-1 Sept. 3. Third that afternoon was ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ **Izarra**, whose lone previous appearance saw her graduate at Del Mar July 29. By one of the world's leading sires, she is a granddaughter of the great Bayakoa (Arg), and will certainly appreciate this trip and beyond.

Making his third start since contesting all three legs of the Triple Crown, **Hard Spun** figures the one to catch as he preps for the Breeders' Cup. Not bad for a horse reputed to be part of his owner's third string. "We probably couldn't have imagined what has happened

since we were last at Turfway," said trainer Larry Jones. "This is a great thing for the track to have the top two horses from the Derby. Hard Spun's doing real well right now." Those who wish to knock **Street Sense** will

argue that he was not nearly as brilliant in winning the GI Jim Dandy S. and GI Travers S. as he was in the Derby and the GI Preakness S. While those Classics were honestly run affairs, his previous two races were characterized by more moderate paces. Displaying the hallmark of an outstanding horse, Street Sense was out of his element while closer to the front and still managed to find his way home first. While both horses are eligible for a \$150,000 bonus for having won a Grade I in the last two years, Pennsylvania-bred Hard Spun is running for base purse money of \$200,000. Of the total gross value of the race, \$150,000 is for horses registered with the KTDF.

After Market, who starts the 124-pound highweight, has some things to prove this afternoon. Winner of his first four trips to the races last year, the Wygod homebred proceeded to lose his next four. But the handsome dark bay has since righted the ship with wins in the GI Charles Whittingham H., the GI Eddie Read H. and the GI Del Mar H. He is winless in two efforts going a mile, but is blessed of a tremendous turn of foot and would benefit from a hot pace. The consistent **Strike a Deal** has been one of the leading turf horses of his generation this season, missing taking down the lion's share of \$1.75 million by a nose and a head in the GIII Colonial Turf Cup June 16 and the GII Virginia Derby July 21. Those two efforts might have exacted their toll, as he was beaten into third by Nobiz Like Shobiz in the GIII Kent Breeders' Cup S. in his latest appearance Sept. 1. **English Colony** carries a four-race winning streak into his graded-stakes debut. The ridgling comes into the Kelso off a 2 3/4-length victory in the Sept. 9 Lights and Music S. over this turf course. He tries a mile for the first time today.

Sharp Nephew bids to maintain his unbeaten record here, having gone from a six-furlong Windsor maiden July 9 to Aug. 18 Listed Washington Singer S. over a panel further at Newbury. Trainer Brian Meehan believes the extra trip will be of benefit. "I'm very pleased with him and he did it well at Windsor and stepped up to the mark at Newbury," Meehan said. "We feel he's improved since, and we're all in agreement that a mile will suit him." Meehan also saddles **City Leader**, who was no match for Raven's Pass when seven-lengths behind in second to that formidable rival in Sandown's G3 Solario S. last time Sept. 1. "The winner looked outstanding, but not everything went City Leader's way that day--he probably prefers a bit more ease and will certainly be better suited by Ascot's mile," Meehan explained. "In his pedigree, it's all staying blood, and he's big and rangy." ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆

The chestnut gelding was third in a Mountaineer allowance test May 28 in his first start for trainer Mike Maker, and followed with a back-to-back wins in starter-allowance company at Churchill in June. He made it three in a row in an Ellis Park stakes test Aug. 4 and comes off a 1 1/2-length score in an allowance at Presque Isle Downs Sept. 3.

"Curlin is a talented colt and I'm sure he's going to run well." While **English Channel** (Smart Strike) figures a heavy favorite in the GI Joe Hirsch Turf Classic Invitational S., the GI Beldame S. is a more wide-open affair, with **Ginger Punch** (Awesome Again) facing the likes of California invader **Balance** (Thunder Gulch) and the talented **Indian Vale** (A.P. Indy). The least valuable stakes of the day, the GI Vosburgh S., marks the return of Godolphin's **Discreet Cat** (Forestry). The GI Cigar Mile H. winner was last seen bringing up the rear in the GI Dubai World Cup, but, with the Breeders' Cup on the horizon, it's time to re-engage. "He's done well over the last six weeks," said Rick Mettee, assistant to trainer Saeed bin Suroor. "Obviously he's a top-class horse and it's exciting getting him back to the races." NO NANNINA IN QE II Cheveley Park's **Nannina (GB)** (Medicean {GB}) was scratched out of the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. The stud's Managing Director Chris Richardson told *PA Sport*, "The ground has unfortunately gone against her, and she will not be running. They have had a lot of rain at Ascot on Friday." Heroine of the 2006 G1 Coronation S., the bay filly returned to Ascot this year to annex the G2 Windsor Forest S. Cheveley Park will still be represented by the G2 Summer Mile S. winner and G2 Celebration Mile runner-up **Cesare (GB)** (Machiavellian). Richardson added, "It won't be easy, but we've targeted this race for some time, and he really enjoys himself at Ascot."

AUTHORIZED UPS THE ANTE Saleh Al Homaizi and Imad Al Sagar's **Authorized (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) delighted connections with his workout in Newmarket yesterday ahead of next Sunday's G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp. The G1 Epsom Derby hero, second in the G1 Coral-Eclipse S., has not raced since taking the G1 Juddmonte International S. at York Aug. 21. After overseeing the seven-furlong spin under big-race rider Frankie Dettori on the Racecourse Side gallop, trainer Peter Chapple-Hyam said, "I am very happy with Authorized, as is Frankie. He is in superb form, and now I can't wait for the Arc. We will just keep him ticking over until the race and he will have a little blow-out early next week." Dettori added, "That is the first time I have ridden him since York, and he felt good. He is never the flashiest of workers, but that was one of his better pieces. The Arc is not an easy race to win, but I've got a good horse, and I just hope we have a bit of luck."

PICO CENTRAL TO KOREA **Pico Central (Brz)** (Spend a Buck-Sheila Purple {Brz}, by Purple Mountain) has been sold to the Korean Racing Association, where he will begin stud duties next year at their Jeju Stud Farm. The transaction between the KRA and Satish and Anne Sanan's Padua Stables was brokered by Rollin Baugh. Brazil's champion sprinter and Horse of the Year, Pico Central came to the United States in 2004, winning the G1 Metropolitan H., the G1 Vosburgh S., G1 Carter H. and the GII San Carlos. He retired that year with five Grade/Group 1 wins on dirt and turf from five furlongs to a mile, and entered stud at Padua Stables in Summerfield, Florida. "We're delighted to have a horse of this incredible caliber," said the KRA's Dr. Ja-Ho Moon. Pico Central's first weanlings hit the auction block this year.

KEENELAND APRIL TO SPAN TWO DAYS IN 2008 The 2008 Keeneland April Two-Year-Olds in Training Sale has been moved on the calendar and will be held during two evenings sessions, Apr. 8-9, it was announced yesterday. The sale will also have just one preview next year. The single under-tack show is set for Monday, Apr. 7. "The dynamics of two-year-old sales have changed, and this move is in response to industry buyers and consignors who have indicated their preference for a one-day preview show," said Geoffrey Russell, Keeneland's director of sales. "Having a Polytrack racing surface, we are confident we can hold a single preview show the day before the sale regardless of the weather."

SEALY HILL DQ REVERSED ON APPEAL After a hearing Wednesday, the Ontario Racing Commission reversed the disqualification of Melnyk Racing Stables' **Sealy Hill** (Point Given) in the July 1 Bison City S. at Woodbine. The three-year-old filly had finished first, but her number was taken down and placed third behind Street Sounds and Quiet Jungle; with the reversal, the purse of the C\$250,000 has been redistributed. With victories in the Woodbine Oaks and Wonder Where S. to go along with her returned Bison City crown, Sealy Hill becomes the first winner of Canada's Triple Tiara, established in 1999. According to *Daily Racing Form*, both trainer Mark Casse and jockey Patrick Husbands appealed the original stewards' decision. The ORC will release the reasons for the reversal at a later date.

KELSO BREEDERS' CUP H.-GII, \$250,000, 3yo/up, 1mT

As we have said before, stakes-level grass horses run figures in a very tight range, so ground loss and weight often determine the outcome of turf stakes. The Kelso is basically a one-turn affair, so trips will be less important than usual, but it's a handicap, with a big weight spread. The high weight was one of the reasons we said Octave was a bet-against last week, and a similar situation exists in the Kelso.

2 Jet Propulsion Double Honor Nunez 116

Jet Propulsion has developed steadily with age, and his recent grouping of races is the best of his life. He goes in a little slower than several others, but with his early speed should get the rail and save a length or two in ground loss, and it's not impossible that he still has improvement left. He has a good chance for a check, and is a borderline contender for the win.

3 Kavafi (Ire) Zafonic Coa 116

Kavafi was erratic in Europe, often a sign of bleeding, and adds Lasix here. He goes in a little slower than several others, but is tough to throw out completely at a big price.

4 English Colony (GB) Rock of Gibraltar (Ire) Velasquez 113

English Colony has marched forward steadily, then jumped to a big figure last time. A repeat of that would give him a big shot here at the weights, and stakes level three-year-olds often do pair up top efforts. But that was a 4-point new top, and he's coming back on only three weeks rest and stretching out. Overall he's probably less than 50/50 to repeat his last, but tough to throw out on sheer ability.

5 After Market Storm Cat Solis 124

After Market has good but not super ability, and has been beating up on a soft division in California. That has earned him 124 pounds here, and he spots a ton to the field--remember, five pounds is worth one point on the Thoro-Graph scale. At the weights After Market is just another horse here, which at the odds makes him a major bet-against. The GII Oak Tree Mile Oct. 7, where he would have spotted much less weight, would have been a much better idea, especially if Lava Man goes in the Goodwood.

6 Trippi's Storm Trippi Castellano 115

Trippi's Storm comes out of a series of very strong races, and his last five Thoro-Graph figures are almost as strong as After Market's, even before working in the nine-pound weight differential. He shortens up here, but it's worth noting that he ran the best race of his life sprinting on dirt earlier last year. This gelding is fast, very consistent, and a strong contender.

7 Strike a Deal Smart Strike Dominguez 114

Strike a Deal is a good grass sophomore by a versatile stallion that is having quite a year. He ran a big one two starts back before bouncing last time, and a return to his top would make him a borderline contender here. This could be one to watch for next year.

8 Icy Atlantic Stormy Atlantic Velazquez 117

Icy Atlantic comes from the Pletcher barn, which has been ice cold in New York, except in stakes. This horse has been amazingly consistent this year even by grass stakes horse standards, but he's unlikely to find the rail trip here that he got in his last two. It's not too tough to figure out how fast this guy will run, which makes him a borderline contender, with a much better shot to get a check than win.

9 Got the Last Laugh Distorted Humor Desormeaux 112

Got the Last Laugh ran big in his second lifetime start, and it took so much out of him that he didn't get back to that level for almost a year. We don't like that, we don't like that he bore out (bo) in his last, and we don't like that he's never run fast enough to contend here, Mott or no Mott.

10 Woodlander Forestry Castro 114

Woodlander is a borderline contender even if he runs his absolute best. The outside post, combined with a late-running style, almost guarantees some ground loss, even around only one turn.

11 Art Master Royal Academy Gomez 117

Art Master has a history of running well fresh, and then falling apart or tailing off. We didn't like him in the Woodbine race and we don't like him now, as he gets even further into a campaign, and does it on only two weeks' rest. Since he's only run one figure in his life that would give him a real shot here and is unlikely to run that well, Art Master is a bet-against as the second choice.

Bottom Line: Trippi's Storm is a clear play here at anything close to the morning line, and since it's worth taking a stand against After Market and Art Master, some of that play should be in exotics. Jet Propulsion, English Colony, Strike A Deal, Icy Atlantic and possibly Kavafi are others that can be used.

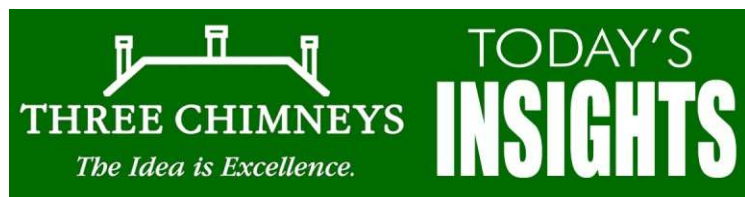

VICTORIA VACCINES The importance of the Melbourne Cup Carnival has won out, and the government Friday announced it would increase its number of E1 vaccination vials to Victorian trainers from 1,500 to 4,100. All Victorian horses competing in the Spring Carnival will be vaccinated against equine influenza within weeks. Victoria has secured access to the 4,100 vaccines from the first shipment of 20,000, and has also been guaranteed at least 3,000 vaccines from the second batch next week to ensure that all 7,100 horses competing in the Spring Carnival will be vaccinated. But Victorian Minister of Racing Rob Hulls urged caution. "Vaccination is not the panacea for E1," Hulls said. "Everyone involved in the industry has to continue to be vigilant, regardless of whether horses are vaccinated, and ensure that horse movements are limited and border patrols continue." The first batch of vaccines are due to arrive in Melbourne Saturday; the vaccination process is expected to begin within days. The second batch will arrive in Australia late next week. Horses need to receive a booster shot within 14 days of the original vaccine to be fully inoculated against this particular strain of E1.

INGLIS REVISES 2008 SCHEDULE William Inglis & Son have announced a revised schedule for their major 2008 yearling sales after recent discussions with industry representatives and consultations with buyers and consignors. "It is important that the racing industry is given time to recover from the E1 outbreak prior to holding major yearling sales in 2008," said Mark Webster, managing director for Inglis. "It is also important that young sires are given the opportunity to prove themselves on the track to maximise returns for breeders. We feel that holding our two Sydney yearling sales after the Melbourne carnival, and alongside the rescheduled major Sydney Autumn feature races, will benefit all industry participants. Feedback from local and international yearling buyers suggests the Classic Yearling Sale should also benefit by immediately following the Easter Yearling Sale. This is good news for breeders." "I must express our deep regret and disappointment that the convention agreed between Tattersalls, Goffs, TBA and ITBA of respecting each other's sales dates has been broken, as demonstrated by Henry Beeby's final decision that Goffs will be staging the first day of their November Sale to clash with the last day of our November National Hunt Sale. The factors that have led to this blatant disregard for protocol are in no way excusable. Goffs accepted an extra day of horses for their sale, in full knowledge that it would lead to a clash either with our sale or the Tattersalls December Yearling Sale in Newmarket, and they would have been well aware of their entry numbers long before their published closing date of Sept. 7. Only on Monday, Sept. 24 was I told of their plan to stage the extra day, at a meeting that had been arranged to discuss a completely different sale date issue that had been under debate for a few weeks. The extra Goffs November day had not been mentioned before and at no point was it up for negotiation or discussion to find a solution, but was presented to us as a done deal or fait-accompli, despite the fact that we had been having an ongoing conversation about another sale date.

"It is not at all reasonable to expect either ourselves, or vendors, or purchasers to be agreeable to a clash at such short notice, when our catalogue was at the printers and our sales dates published for over a year. To add insult to injury it has been implied that we are being intransigent and unhelpful by not agreeing to move our sale earlier or fill our blank day in the November Sale, which of course can be discussed for next year, but not once the catalogues had gone to print.

"I would feel very poorly treated by Goffs if I were a vendor or consignor at their sale unfavoured enough to be selling on the Sunday, which is one of the strongest days of our entire National Hunt sale, at which several records for broodmares were set last year, and at which any buyer or agent who has even a remote interest in NH bloodstock will be attending."
