winner **Ready's Image** (More Than Ready), who weakened to be second in the Hopeful. Todd Pletcher believes the colt can turn the tables here. "We had a tough dilemma [in the Hopeful] in a field with one horse who had a lot of speed and another horse that figured to drop out the back," Pletcher said. SHE'S A LITTLE BIT ROCK AND ROLL

Country Star (Empire Maker) was a maiden before the GI Darley Alcibiades S., but she proved ready to take center stage yesterday. The Stonerside homebred

closed from the back of the pack to post a one-length victory over **A to the Croft** (Menifee) at Keeneland. Making her debut on the Belmont Park turf just 15 days ago, Country Star closed well to be second going a mile and a sixteenth, and trainer Bobby Frankel opted to take a chance in this test. It wasn't much of a stretch--the filly was sent off the 4-1 second choice.

Rated in eighth through six panels in 1:14.79, she swept wide around the far turn and was on the far outside as she drove to the front inside the eighth pole before edging clear. "She just exploded," jockey Rafael Bejarano said. "I know she could do that because I've ridden her before. She's a superstar horse." **Irish Smoke** (Smoke Glacken), the 13-10 chalk off her win in the Sept. 2 GI Spinaway S., overcame an awkward start to sit off the leaders early, but had nothing left in the stretch and finished last. "I think she just got tired," jockey Julien Leparoux said. "She's a good filly. I don't know what happened today." **Chart, p3**

AUTHORIZED HEADS ARC DOZEN

Saleh Al Homaizi and Imad Al Sagar's **Authorized (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) will face 11 rivals in tomorrow's G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe Lucien Barriere as he bids to emulate Mill Reef, Lammtarra and Sinndar (Ire) in adding Longchamp's pinnacle to his G1 Epsom Derby success. Many others have tried, with some of the blue riband's best in Motivator (GB), High Chaparral (Ire), Generous (Ire) and Reference Point (GB) failing to land a serious blow in this thorough examination. Trainer Peter Chapple-Hyam, who came close with runner-up White Muzzle (GB) in 1993, has been meticulous in preparing Authorized for the Arc, and chose York's G1 Juddmonte International S. as his final prep so that the imposing bay could have a clean run up to his date with destiny. His length defeat of **Dylan Thomas (Ire)** (Danehill) in that Aug. 21 10-furlong contest helped make up for his unsatisfactory second in the July 7 G1 Eclipse S., where he raced far away from the winner Notnowcato (GB). He is in Chantilly now, far from the madding crowd. "He can be a bit of a boy and attack things, so it's best that he's out of the way of people and at Longchamp everyone will want to see him," commented Chapple-Hyam. "After York, he had two weeks doing nothing but enjoy himself, then we started building him up and it's gone smoothly. I couldn't be happier with him--he seems good, and I don't want any more rain. Good will be fine and it doesn't matter really, as long as it's not firm." **Arc cont. p2**

Boasting three Arc wins, Authorized's pilot Frankie Dettori knows his way around this circuit, but he is aware that a large slice of luck is required, particularly with the outside post. "I've definitely got the horse and he has a tremendous cruising speed for a mile-and-a-half horse, which is what you need to hold a position here," Dettori said. "But sometimes you can get unlucky losers here and you need to be in the right place at the right time." One of many serious rivals standing in his way is Khalid Abdullah's **Zambezi Sun**, who has the slow-burner profile of his owner/breeder's 2006 Arc hero Rail Link (GB). Despite the controversial nature of the G1 Grand Prix de Paris, where chief rival Eagle Mountain (GB) unseated Kieren Fallon, his five-length success in that prestigious course-and-distance contest July 14 left a lasting impression. His third behind **Soldier of Fortune** in the Sept. 16 G2 Prix Niel came after an interrupted preparation, and he is in the same boat as Bago (Fr) and Peintre Celebre, both of whom suffered reversals in that trial before emerging victorious in the main event. "He has come on very well since last time, when he was not fit enough to win," trainer Pascal Bary said. "He should be in top form on Sunday."

Natagora sped to the front and made all the running to provide Pascal Bary with a landmark first winner on these shores. Her natural pace and imposing physique saw her overwhelm her peers in the June 14 Listed Prix la Fleche at Longchamp and Maisons-Laffitte's July 1 G3 Prix du Bois and July 22 G2 Prix Robert Papin, but neither was enough to repel Myboycharlie (Ire) when she was runner-up in the G1 Prix Morny at Deauville on her latest start Aug. 19. In front after a matter of strides here, she was allowed to bowl by Christophe-Patrice Lemaire and soon had most rivals in difficulty. Only Fleeting Spirit and Frankie Dettori could make it a match, but despite that foe's determined effort up the rising ground, Natagora was always maintaining control. "I've been waiting a long time to win a race in England and it's very difficult," her conditioner said. "She is a wonderful filly to train and a very good character who likes the competition. She has always shown that kind of speed, but next year over a mile she will have to settle better. I'm not sure if she will stay that far, but on pedigree and physique she should and we have all winter to get her to settle. I think that will be it for this year, as she has run seven times and needs a rest, before maybe coming back here for the G1 1000 Guineas." As Natagora had an hour earlier, Dark Angel kept it simple from the front to emulate the success of his paternal grandsire Royal Applause (GB) back in 1995. Since his graduation at Chester, Dark Angel had been campaigned over five and six furlongs with markedly superior form over the longer trip. Off the board in a pair of five-furlong stakes, the grey improved to fourth in the six-furlong G2 July S. on the other track here July 12 and took the Aug. 23 £300,000 St Leger Yearling S. at York. His career-best came last time when defeating Strike the Deal by a neck in receipt of three pounds in the G2 Mill Reef S. and he made the necessary progression to confirm those placings here. Sent straight to the head of his group racing up the middle of the track, Dark Angel assumed command at halfway and responded with a decisive surge when asked to repel stable companion Tajdeef and later Strike the Deal. "He's got a high cruising speed and really wants to race for you," rider Michael Hills commented. "He can pick up off a fast pace, so I wanted them to come to me--when you have a horse like this, you can ride with all heart. He's relaxed, but has a lot of sprinting blood in him and dad [Barry] tried and failed to get Royal Applause to get a mile, so it could be the same with him." The G2 Gimcrack S. winner Sir Gerry (Carson City) was sent off the 2-1 crowd's choice, but never looked likely to threaten and beat only one rival. Trainer Rick Dutrow Jr. saddled a pair of horses in the GII Meadowlands Cup, but Mr. Umphrey (Jules) was in there only to provide an honest pace for stable-mate Diamond Stripes. That he did, carving out fractions of :23 1/5, :46 1/5 and 1:10 on a daylight lead as favored Diamond Stripes saved ground in the second flight. The gray was momentarily trapped at the rail as they headed toward the far turn, but jockey Cornelio Velasquez extricated him from the pocket and found clear sailing on the outside. Mr. Umphrey was still in front as they straightened for home, but Diamond Stripes and Magna Graduate went after him, finally collaring the frontrunner just inside the eighth pole. It was the crowd's choice who proved strongest in the waning yards, edging clear late for the victory. The four-year-old had raced under the lights at the Meadowlands once before, taking the GIII Pegasus S. last year. He opened 2007 with a win against optional-claiming company at Aqueduct in April, then finished third in the June 16 GI Stephen Foster H., July 28 GI Whitney H. and Sept. 1 GI Woodward S. Where will the gelding appear next? "It seems he likes Jersey racing, so I'd like to fit him in somewhere for the Breeders' Cup," Dutrow said. "I just don't know where yet." Transduction Gold appeared to be the controlling speed in the opening-day co-feature, but trainer John Glenney's instructions to James Graham were to get the four-year-old to relax off the pace. The Irish jockey did his part and the gelding held up his end of the deal, rallying to best Bee Charmer in the shadow of the wire. Transduction Gold employed front-running tactics in the GIII Elkhorn S. over this course and distance Apr. 27 and led the field into the lane before yielding grudgingly to be fourth. He was never involved in his next start, the GIII Louisville H. at Churchill, and finished last of 11 in that Memorial Day test. Freshened up thereafter, the dark bay was most recently fourth in a one-mile allowance prep over the Turfway Polytrack Sept. 7. Racing comfortably while covered up in midfield, Transduction Gold angled towards the rail while gaining ground on the final turn. Switched out four wide for the drive, he leveled off nicely and was along in the nick of time.

VISIT TESTS POSITIVE FOR ACP Khalid Abdullah's **Visit (GB)** (Oasis Dream {GB}) tested positive for the tranquilizer acetylpromazine (ACP) following her second placing in York's G2 Lowther S. Connections of the G3 Princess Margaret S. winner, who was unplaced when favorite in yesterday's G1 Cheveley Park S. at Newmarket, revealed that the British Horseracing Authority had alerted them to the results a week ago. The Sir Michael Stoute-trained homebred is almost certain to be disqualified from the runner-up spot in that Aug. 23 six-furlong contest. "We found out about this a week ago when we got a letter from the BHA to say she had tested positive following the race," the owner-breeder's Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe explained yesterday. "There was nothing untoward and we obviously talked to all the people closely involved with her. Sir Michael said she was fine when saddling, Ryan Moore said nothing felt odd in the race and her lass said she had been normal throughout. The only thing I can say is that we don't know where it has come from."

CLASS FARE AT ARC SALE Arqana's Arc Sale will be staged at Saint-Cloud this evening, with several high-profile horses in training due to go under the hammer. Demand for potential international recruits has seen this auction's average rise by nearly 80 percent over the last two years, with an international presence now almost guaranteed. That is due mainly to the exploits of graduates Atlando (Ire), who went on to win the 2005 GII San Luis Obispo H.; the brilliant Megahertz (GB); 1997 GI Breeders' Cup Sprint winner Elmhurst; 1994 GI Yellow Ribbon S. scorer Aube Indienne (Fr); and 1993 G1 Prix Ganay scorer Vert Amante (Fr). The ultimate feather in its cap remains the sale of 1993 G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe heroine Urban Sea, now entrenched in legend as the dam of Galileo (Ire). This time, the 61-lot catalogue features horses from the empires of His Highness the Aga Khan, Baron Edouard de Rothschild, Michael Tabor, Wertheimer et Frere, Shadwell, Lady O'Reilly, Richard Strauss, Alec Head, Gestut Ittlingen, Gestut Ammerland and Madame Henri Devin, and they are consigned by trainers such as Andre Fabre, Robert Collet, Jean-Claude Rouget, Alain de Royer-Dupre, Nicolas Clement, John Hammond, Christiane Head-Maarek, Francois Rohaut, Freddy Head and Eric Libaud. "That said, those that most appealed attracted plenty of interest, headed by our new Sportsman's Sale record price of €240,000. All in all, we are very happy with the week's trade at Goffs." As on Thursday, yesterday's proceedings were highlighted by a son of Danetime (Ire) that was knocked down to Bobby O'Ryan for €40,000. From the consignment of Gary Swift's, hip [1055](#) is a descendant of the 1980 G1 Prix Marcel Boussac winner Tropicaro (Fr). "I just thought that he was a nice horse," said O'Ryan, who had already made plain his respect for the late Tally-Ho Stud-based sire when setting the sale's record the previous day. "He's been bought for a client and it will be decided later on where he will go." The agent also paid €30,000 for Derrinstown Stud's hip [987](#), a Linamix (Fr) half-brother to listed winner Rawyaan (GB). Majestic Warrior ran well in his first start, and then exploded to win The Hopeful and become favorite for The Juvenile. But there are some negatives here—that last was a 5-point jump to a level that could take a lot out of a young horse, and we don't like that he drifted out in that race. A repeat of that effort would give him a big shot here, but at a short price we're inclined to play him to bounce.

2 Z Humor Distorted Humor Desormeaux

Z Humor had some trouble in his latest, where he paired up the figure he ran in his debut. It's a positive that Mott thinks he's good enough to compete here, and he may like the distance—but he would have to improve quite a bit to contend.

3 Anakim Giant's Causeway Castellano

Anakim improved when he tried a mile last time. But he would have to do it again to get involved against this strong field.

4 War Pass Cherokee Run Velasquez

War Pass jumped forward in his second start for Zito, running a Thoro-Graph figure that makes him a contender, and has had six weeks since. This is a similar situation to that of Majestic Warrior, but the jump isn't as big, the effort last time wasn't as big, and he's had a little more time. Also note that Cherokee Run's runners have run surprisingly well going long.

5 Pyro Pulpit Bridgmohan

Pyro is virtually a twin of Z Humor—two starts, same figures. And like that one, he would need to improve a lot to contend here.

6 Lantana Mob

Lantana Mob ran well in his first few starts, and then exploded to win The Sapling. The big top from an established level makes him a bounce candidate, and he's a question mark at the distance.

7 Silver Edition Silver Deputy

Castro

Silver Edition ran big enough in his debut to contend here, and has had a month since. This is another that may not want to go long, and it's hard to tell how much that effort took out of him.

8 Ready's Image More Than Ready Velazquez

Ready's Image jumped way up to earn a huge Thoro-Graph figure to win The Tremont, paired that number in The Sanford, and then backed up a little last time. Does he have distance limitations, or was that just a bounce after two debilitating efforts?

Bottom Line: There are enough reasons to play against Majestic Warrior at a short price, though he is certainly one to watch going forward. Ready's Image has already twice run faster than any of the others have run, or figure to, so we consider him the most likely winner, distance questions notwithstanding. War Pass has been pointed for this and looks like one of Zito's late-season stars. *For sheets and complete Thoro-Graph data on the Race of the Week, click [here](#).*

BIANCONE BANNED FOR A YEAR Trainer Patrick Biancone has been suspended for one year by the Kentucky Horse Racing Authority, it was announced yesterday. "The Kentucky Horse Racing Authority is committed to ensuring the highest level of integrity for Kentucky's signature industry and sport," said Lisa Underwood, executive director of the KHRA. "The stewards' ruling sends a clear message to all industry stakeholders and participants that violations of this nature will not be tolerated." Biancone was found with three vials of the Class A substance cobra venom in his possession during a barn search at Keeneland in June. The vials were found in a refrigerator, and had the name of Biancone's veterinarian, Dr. Rod Stewart, on the label. Last month, Stewart was suspended for five years for possession of cobra venom and two other prohibited substances, but he has appealed his suspension. Biancone was also handed several 30-day bans for improper labeling and possession of injectables, and a year's suspension for failing to report Stewart's violations, but those sentences can be served concurrently with the one-year cobra venom ban. The suspension is scheduled to begin Oct. 15, but it is expected that Biancone will appeal. A KHRA press release stated that the investigation triggered by the search of Biancone's barns and Stewart's truck is ongoing. It is not the first time Biancone has drawn such a lengthy suspension. The 55-year-old horseman, who served a 15-day penalty in September after one of his horses tested positive for the Class B substances caffeine and theophylline after a race at Churchill in May, was banned by the Hong Kong Jockey Club for nine months in 1999 after drawing more than 20 positive tests. He took out his license in California when that suspension ended in 2000.

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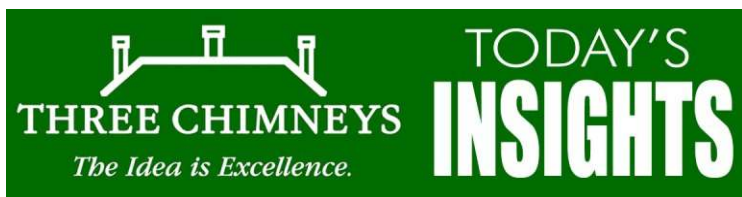
