Champion **Dreaming of Anna** (Rahy) tried to take them gate to wire, but couldn't withstand a strong late rally from **Bit of Whimsy** (Distorted Humor), who ran away with a 2 1/4-length tally in yesterday's GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup at Keeneland. Allowed to settle as Dreaming of Anna set honest fractions of :24.08 and :47.66, Bit of Whimsy rallied along the inside in the lane, was swung off the rail by Javier Castellano in deep stretch and finished full of run. *cont. p2*

BREEDERS' CUP BULLETIN

ONLY ONE WORK FOR 'WICKED'

Wicked Style (Macho Uno), unbeaten winner of last Saturday's GI Lane's End Breeders' Futurity, will have one workout prior to the Oct. 27 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile. "He will work a half mile next Sunday," trainer Rusty Arnold said. "I don't need to do much with him only 21 days between races. He will ship to Monmouth on the 24th." Wicked Style previously annexed Arlington Park's GIII Arlington-Washington Futurity in game fashion Sept. 1. "The race took a little bit out of him, but no more than his first two," Arnold said of the Breeders' Futurity. "If it had taken more out of him, I could have given him another day, but the weather really helped out. The cool air that came in Tuesday and Wednesday really picked him up."

NO BREEDERS' CUP FOR VACARE

Vacare (Lear Fan), winner of last Saturday's GII First Lady S. at Keeneland, will bypass the GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf in favor of the GI Matriarch S. at Hollywood Nov. 25. Trainer Christophe Clement said there were several reasons for skipping the Breeders' Cup. "The owners will be quite happy to keep her in training next year so we can always make the Breeders' Cup next year," he told *Daily Racing Form*. "Two, the Breeders' Cup this year is a mile and three-eighths at Monmouth, which [could] mean soft turf, and she's never raced further than a mile and an eighth. Three, the Matriarch is a flat mile and it will be run on firm turf and it's a very good race." Vacare was purchased by Jon and Sarah Kelly for \$2.8 million at last year's FTKNOV sale.

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Killing 'em With Consistency...

Bit of Whimsy began her career with a second-place finish over the Gulfstream lawn Apr. 1, then went one better at the Big A Apr. 29. The chestnut deadeated for first with Rutherienne in the GIII Sands Point S. June 2 and followed with a troubled fourth behind Dreaming of Anna in the Virginia Oaks July 21. Freshened following that effort, she resurfaced with a smart second-place finish in the GI Garden City S. Sept. 8. "We were tempted to run her one more time before this, but we thought we'd better have a fresh horse rather than an experienced one," trainer Barclay Tagg said. "I had a good jockey on her. I thought if he could take her back a little bit, she'd make a big run, and it worked out just perfectly."

Champ Continues to Live the Dream on the Lawn...

Dreaming of Anna had her three-race winning streak snapped, but last year's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies heroine gave it her all in defeat. "She ran real well," jockey Garrett Gomez offered. "She got pressured the whole way and never got a breather. She's a quality filly and I was glad for the opportunity to ride her. She kicked on a little bit [at the head of the stretch], but I could tell I needed just a little bit more to get her home. The gas tank was kind of hitting on empty. Outside the sixteenth pole, she kept digging and digging and fighting them off. The one horse [Bit of Whimsy] got her, but she still dug in. She had to work hard to even hold second. She ran a very good race." Following a sixth-place finish in the GI Kentucky Oaks, Dreaming of Anna posted victories in the Double Delta S. at Arlington June 2, the Virginia Oaks at Colonial July 21 and the GIII Pucker Up S. at Arlington Sept. 8.

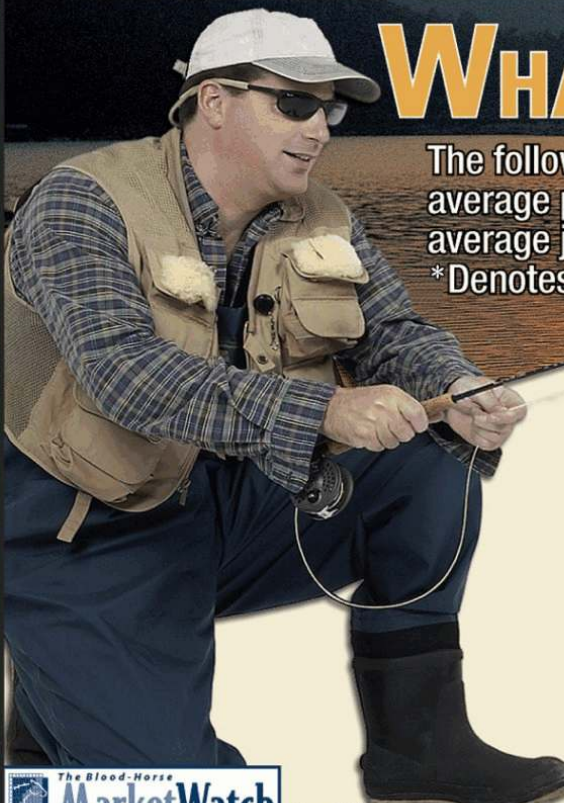

Oak Tree Derby cont.

Daytona began his career in Britain for trainer Mark Johnston with a pair of second-place finishes before earning his diploma at Lingfield in March. He finished off-the-board in his first two chances at Hollywood May 27 and July 1, but broke through with a 4 1/4-length victory in an \$80,000 optional claimer over the Del Mar sod July 20. The chestnut crossed the line third in a \$100,000 optional tagger Aug. 9, then repeated that performance over the Del Mar Polytrack in the El Cajon S. Aug. 31. Back on the grass here, he showed speed from the git-go and left little doubt about the outcome in the stretch. "Dan [Hendricks] said to just keep him happy and if he's happy, he's got some turn of foot," jockey Mike Smith said. "Believe me, he's got some turn of foot. When we opened up there at the top of the stretch, I was expecting somebody to come after us. We were five or six [lengths] in front and I looked over at the big screen and I said, 'Man, this is sweet,' there was nobody coming." According to Hendricks, the GI Hollywood Derby Nov. 25 will be next.

Bold Hawk posted a smart 4 1/4-length maiden win at second asking over the Belmont lawn July 21, then completed the trifecta in a Saratoga allowance Aug. 27. He returned to Belmont to clear his first allowance condition Sept. 23 and was backed as the third choice for this stakes debut. With regular rider Jean-Luc Samyn aboard, he was allowed to settle toward the rear in the early stages. Awaiting racing room in the stretch, the bay fought his way through traffic to post the narrow victory. "I walked the course this morning and I knew what spot I wanted to be in," Samyn said. "I knew that the inside appeared to be the best place. Plus I didn't want to move too early so he would get the lead and loaf around. He should definitely be back as a four year old. He's a gelding. Just look at him; he's a big horse, really immature."

He crossed the line sixth in a Saratoga allowance Aug. 4, but bounced back in his next attempt at the Spa, scoring by 3 3/4 lengths Sept. 3. Making his stakes debut here, he sat a close third as Shrewd Operator showed the way through fractions of :22.88 and :45.38.

Soldier's Dancer kicked off the year with a victory over this course in the Jan. 1 GIII Tropical Park Derby and came within a nose of adding Gulfstream's GIII Palm Beach S. Mar. 24. He annexed Tampa's Dayton Andrews Dodge Sophomore Turf S. Apr. 7, but failed to get his picture taken in four subsequent efforts, including a close fifth in the GIII Kent Breeders' Cup S. at Delaware Sept. 1 and a fourth-place finish in Calder's Needles S. last out Sept. 22. Favored to get back on track here, he was settled in eighth through fractions of :24.01, :48.85 and 1:13.32, began to rally on the turn for home and ran away and hid from 'em in the stretch. "This is the first time he's gotten a good, clean trip in his last three or four starts," trainer David Vivian said. "He's the best horse I've ever trained. Leonnatus Anteas, crowned Canada's champion two-year-old colt in 2006 following victories in the Vandal S., Cup and Saucer S. and Coronation S., kicked off this season with a close-up second in an \$80,000 optional claimer over seven furlongs at Woodbine June 3. Back for a second attempt at those conditions, the chestnut scored over that course and trip Aug. 5 before finishing fifth in the GIII Play the

King S. Aug. 25. Fourth when stretched out for the nine-furlong GII Super Derby at Louisiana Downs Sept. 22, the Ontario-bred was installed the second betting choice in this competitive field. Content to stalk the pace in fourth through early splits of :23.79, :47.55 and 1:11.19, the sophomore closed four wide on the final turn to take command and drew away to take his first at this level. "He bounced back well," said trainer Kevin Attard. "If I thought the ship [to Louisiana] had taken something out of him, I don't think I would have run him. He was a true professional."

Yes He's The Man took the Naked Greed S. at Calder and the Select S. at Monmouth back-to-back during the spring of 2006, but hadn't visited the winner's circle since. Third in the Gilded Time S. that June, he was off the board in his next two appearances, going to the shelf after a seventh-place effort in the Eillo S. in August. The dark bay made his belated return at Calder in the July 7 Turf Sprint S.--which actually came off the grass--and finished sixth. He showed some improvement to be third in an allowance test here Aug. 5, and filled the same spot in the Major Moran S. Aug. 26. Showing renewed energy in his latest, Yes He's The Man set the pace in a Calder allowance going seven furlongs Sept. 14 before weakening late to be second, and he was let go at long odds trying

graded stakes company and a route this time. Jockey Julio Garcia sent the colt right to the front once again and the pair were allowed to gallop along through a half in :48.31 and six panels in 1:12.85, then pulled away late for the surprising score. "His sire says sprinter, but on the distaff side he's got Wild Again, which says long," trainer and co-owner David Braddy said. "This opens up a whole new world for him in the future."

Criminologist posted allowance wins over the Gulfstream turf Mar. 7 and Keeneland grass Apr. 27, but could only manage a sixth-place finish in the Foresta S. at Belmont June 9. Given some time off following her stakes debut, she resurfaced to post a pair of victories at Saratoga--an Aug. 9 \$75,000 optional claimer and the Aug. 29 Perfect Sting S. Seeking the hat trick here, she waited patiently in second as Beautiful Daniele set an uncontested lead. With John Velazquez in the irons, the gray crept closer to the leader through six furlongs in 1:16.55 and quickened impressively in the stretch to draw away to an easy victory. "When Johnny asked her, it was over with," trainer Shug McGaughey said. "I am very pleased with the way she has come along. 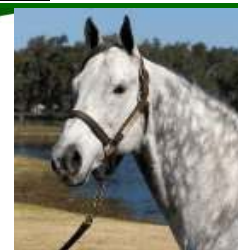

Youbet and Breeders' Cup Locked in Dispute:

Breeders' Cup Ltd. and Youbet.com remain locked in a dispute over a simulcasting contract that may jeopardize the account wagering outlet's ability to simulcast the championship day, the *Daily Racing Form* reported yesterday. According to Breeders' Cup President Greg Avioli, Youbet failed to pay Breeders' Cup a portion of fees generated from last year's event at Churchill Downs, and will not be allowed to sign a contract until those fees are paid. Youbet countered that signal rates are capped at 3.5 percent for wagers made by California bettors, and has asked the California Horse Racing Board for its help in interpreting a part of California racing law. "There is absolutely nothing in the law that says that," Avioli told *DRF*. "It's as if someone said that they interpreted a 55-mile-per-hour speed limit as meaning that they were able to go 90 miles per hour." Lonny Powell, a vice president of Youbet, told *DRF* Friday that he believed Youbet and Breeders' Cup would eventually reach an agreement. He acknowledged that Youbet had paid Breeders' Cup a host fee higher than 3.5 percent in the past, but brought up the issue last year because of the company's concerns that a higher host fee would violate California's racing law. Breeders' Cup charges all simulcasting outlets 50 percent of the net revenue from wagering, a rate that fluctuates based on the takeout of the host track, but is typically approximately 10 percent of handle. This year's Breeders' Cup is scheduled for Oct. 26-27 at Monmouth.

MCCARTNEY PRIMED FOR DEWHURST TEST

Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum's G2 Champagne S. hero **McCartney (Ger)** (In the Wings {GB}) was the subject of an upbeat bulletin ahead of Saturday's G1 Darley Dewhurst S. at Newmarket. A 2 1/2-length winner at Doncaster Sept. 15, the Mark Johnston-trained colt is on target for the £250,000 seven-furlong clash. "McCartney is very well and ready to go," his trainer said yesterday. "I don't see any reason why the Dewhurst shouldn't suit him. He has shown a lot of speed--hence the decision to stay at seven furlongs. The horse should handle any ground, but you always prefer to see good fast ground." Among his potential opponents are Stonerside Stables' G3 Solario S. winner **Raven's Pass** (Elusive Quality), who is due to work over six furlongs of the Rowley Mile this morning, as well as Godolphin's G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere scorer **Rio de la Plata** (Rahy) and Jim Bolger and Sheikh Mohammed's G1 National S. scorer **New Approach (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}). Despite initial indications that New Approach was finished for the term, the unbeaten colt could run Saturday. "He is more likely than not to run in the Dewhurst, as a lot of people would be disappointed if he didn't go there," Bolger told the *Racing Post*. Newmarket's Director of Racing Michael Prosser is relishing the renewal. "It looks like it's going to be a sensational contest, better than we could possibly have dreamed of," Prosser said. "I'll be giving a going report and full weather update [Sunday], but at the moment it looks like we could get rain on Tuesday before it dries up for the remainder of the week. If that forecast is right, one would expect good ground for Champions' Day, when we'll be racing on the stands' side strip of ground, not used since May. If we don't get all the rain they're predicting for Tuesday, it could be on the quicker side of good, but either way the track will be in fantastic shape."
