PLETCHER TROUPE DRILLS AT BELMONT

Trainer Todd Pletcher was well represented on the worktab at Belmont Sunday when 12 Breeders' Cup hopefuls took to the track for their final serious works. Leading the fray at 6:50 a.m. was **Unbridled Belle** (Broken Vow), who worked in company on the training track, completing five furlongs in 1:01.28. Covering the same distance following the break, **Lawyer Ron** (Langfuhr) went in 1:01.26; **Any Given Saturday** (Distorted Humor) in 1:02.12; **Indian Vale** (A.P. Indy) in 1:01.69 and **Octave** (Unbridled's Song) completed the task in 1:00.67. "Lawyer Ron got on the bridle early, but was manageable," explained Pletcher. "He is a very good work horse. If you allowed him to, he would go extra fast." Pletcher added, "Any Given Saturday was aggressive, but that's him." **Panty Raid** (Include), who is cross-entered in the Distaff and Filly & Mare Turf, covered a half mile in :49.10. At 9:00 a.m., Pletcher sent out members of his turf team, led by last year's three-year-old champion filly **Wait A While** (Maria's Mon), who worked five furlongs in 1:04.11; and **English Channel** (Smart Strike), who negotiated the distance in 1:03.55 with Angel Cordero Jr. up. Working in company with Mile hopeful **Host (Chi)** (Hussonet), **Honey Ryder** (Lasting Approval), pre-entered in the Filly & Mare Turf, worked five furlongs in 1:03.41, while **The Leopard** (Storm Cat), accompanied by stablemate The Green Monkey, covered four panels in :50.64. The juvenile was ridden by Edgar Prado, who is on the mend from a broken ankle suffered at Saratoga Sept. 1. **Icy Atlantic** (Stormy Atlantic) rounded out the works with a four-furlong move--around the 'dogs' on the inner turf--in :50.71. Pletcher indicated that his runners will ship to Monmouth Oct. 23.

SILVER LINING IN INTERNATIONAL

Still swinging for the fences at the ripe old age of seven, **Cloudy's Knight** (Lord Avie) came from off the pace to nose out favored **Ask (GB)** (Sadler's Wells) in Sunday's GI Canadian International S. at Woodbine. Let go at generous 18-1 odds in search of his first Grade I victory, the gelding kept the early leaders in his sights through opening splits of :25.18, :50.89 and 1:15.60. Ready to make his move turning for home, the chestnut charged to the front midstretch and dug in late to hold off Ask. "It just set up perfectly," said winning rider Ramsey Zimmerman. "He broke exactly how I would have wanted him too. He was going to stalk a half length off the speed horses that were crawling." *Cont. p5*

MAJESTIC WARRIOR OUT OF JUVENILE

GI Hopeful S. winner **Majestic Warrior** (A.P. Indy) will be forced to miss the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile after suffering an injury to his left front foot, *Daily Racing Form* reports. "He has some hoof wall separation," trainer Bill Mott told *DRF*. "It's underneath the hoof wall. I'm 95-percent confident this is what we were looking for, and he did enough [during a three-furlong work] that we were able to discover it." Mott added, "It's similar to a quarter crack, except it's in the toe instead of the heel. I'm sure this was very uncomfortable for him. We were able to cut it out and clean it up. We've already got a protective shoe on him." Majestic Warrior was coming off a disappointing sixth-place finish in the Oct. 6 GI Champagne S. at Belmont. While he is out of Breeders' Cup contention, the colt could run again this year. "He could very well be back in training in a few days," Mott said. "He might even be able to make a race like the Remsen [GII, Nov. 24, Aqueduct] or the Kentucky Jockey Club [GII, Nov. 24, Churchill Downs] at the end of next month, depending on when he gets back to the track and we can test it. But we don't have enough time to test it for a race on Saturday." The two-year-old has won two of his three starts to date for earnings of \$195,200.

over Belmont Park's main track Sunday. The four-year-old was ridden by jockey Garrett Gomez. "His work this morning was fast, and probably a little faster than we expected, but we are taking it as a positive sign," said Rick Mettee, assistant to trainer Saeed bin Suroor. "The track was extraordinarily fast, from what I gather from talking to the clockers, and he was well within himself." The attractive bay finished third in his

most recent start in the GI Vosburgh S. Sept. 30.

VIOLETTE READIES FOR MONMOUTH

Trainer Rick Violette Jr. continued his march to Monmouth Park, sending out his team for their final major preps heading into this week's Breeders' Cup. **Dream Rush** (Wild Rush), who will contest the inaugural Filly & Mare Sprint Friday, worked four furlongs in :47.96, while Juvenile Fillies aspirant **Phantom Income** (Montbrook) covered the same distance in a bullet :47.61. **High Finance** (Talk Is Money), set to run in the Dirt Mile, completed the task in :48.65, and **Globalization** (Touch Gold), pre-entered in the Juvenile, went in 1:00.23. "Every work was better than the other," said Violette. "Even Globalization, who tends to be on the lazy side in the mornings, worked well. Dream Rush was in hand, and High Finance was just a maintenance work because we laid into him pretty good in his last few works."

BAFFERT TRIO PREP AT SANTA ANITA

Conditioner Bob Baffert sent out a trio of Breeders' Cup hopefuls to their final serious works yesterday morning at Santa Anita. GI Sprint candidate **Midnight Lute** (Real Quiet) flaunted his speed with a blistering five-furlong drill in :57 3/5, which came in company with barnmate Wanna Runner (:58 2/5). The GI Forego S. winner registered the second-fastest work of 17 at the distance. Also breezing five panels was the GI Oak Leaf S. heroine **Cry and Catch Me** (Street Cry {Ire}) and GI Lady's Secret BC S. winner **Tough Tiz's Sis** (Tiznow). The former, who enters the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies with two wins in three lifetime starts, stopped the clock in :58 2/5. Tough Tiz's Sis, who will tackle the GI Distaff, went in :59 2/5. "Everything went as planned," said Baffert. "I just have to keep them alive now." Baffert added that the trio are scheduled to fly to New Jersey early this morning.

TRANSDUCTION GOLD PRIMED FOR TURF

The plan was for **Transduction Gold** (Formal Gold) to go out for a routine fast gallop at Keeneland Sunday, according to trainer John Glenney. The four-year-old appeared to have something else on his mind. "I wanted long fast gallops; we planned to go :14s all around, but he's his own horse and he spotted another horse in front and went after him," explained Glenney. "He looked great though, and was hardly blowing when I met up with him and his rider afterward. He looks like he didn't even work, so I guess he's ready." The GIII Sycamore S. winner, a candidate for the BC Turf, was clocked going five furlongs in 1:01.60. He is expected to ship to Monmouth Oct. 24.

Well supported in her U.S. bow, the Pennsylvania-bred settled in a tracking position

in the early going, closed steadily on the front rank approaching the stretch and was all out to best Sealy Hill by a half length at the wire. "At the top of the straight, I pulled her out to go," said Johnny Murtagh. "The acceleration wasn't immediate. [Sealy Hill] kind of quickened up and maybe got a length on me. But she's very brave, she's very tough. When I asked her for everything, she gave it to me." Heros Reward opened the season with a second in an abbreviated turf allowance at Gulfstream Park Jan. 20, then reeled off four straight wins. The dark bay gelding started the streak with back-to-back scores in starter allowance company at Gulfstream Feb. 17 and Mar. 29, added an optional-claiming victory at Pimlico Apr. 28 and capped it off with a one-length tally in the Baltimore City Turf Sprint on the Preakness undercard. Runner-up behind Smart Enough in the June 24 GIII Highlander S. at Woodbine, he hit the gate in the Aug. 11 Turf Sprint Championship H. at Calder and had to settle for fifth. The Maryland-bred chased Smart Enough under the wire once again in the Sept. 3 Turf Monster H. at Philly Park and was coming off yet another second-place performance in an optional claimer at Laurel Sept. 27. Dragging jockey Javier Castellano up to go head and head with nemesis Smart Enough through an opening half in :44.98, Heros Reward took over at the top of the stretch, but ducked from the right-handed whip inside the eighth pole. Castellano straightened him away, and the winner had just enough left to hold on to the wire. "Smart Enough is a fantastic horse and we knew it would take a lot to beat him," trainer Dale Capuano said. "We broke well. Javier had him right there and running easy. I was a little surprised he was that close. When I saw the first quarter in :22.23, I wasn't as concerned. That's not all that fast for these horses. He responded well and we got lucky." But nothing is forever and it is time to move on and look for fresh challenges. Going freelance will make me much more available and, besides committing myself more to Richard Hannon and Brian Meehan, who have always been so supportive, I will hopefully be able to spread myself more. Prince Khalid and I had a lot of luck together and apart from Oasis Dream and Nebraska Tornado, there was no more special memory than helping Henry Cecil celebrate his first Group 1 winner for more than six years when riding Passage of Time to victory in the Criterion de Saint-Cloud last November. It was also always so satisfying getting to know the Juddmonte families and riding the brothers and sisters and sons and daughters of horses that I had ridden to victory in the past and, while we will be going our separate ways from next year, I wish the Juddmonte team all the best for the future and still hope to ride for them on occasions."

INCOMPASS IN FOCUS

By Lucas Marquardt

Much has changed in racing over the last decade. Slots-infused purses, for example, have given trainers more options when it comes time to find a spot for a particular runner, while those same inflated purses have encouraged increased activity at the claim box at tracks like Charles Town and Delaware Park. Better and more efficient travel means trainers can pick and choose which stakes events suit their horses best, whether at Belmont Park across the country at Santa Anita, while owners like Maggi Moss and syndicates like West Point Thoroughbreds have dozens of horses spread out over several tracks in different states.

All of that means a whole lot of extra work when it comes to keeping track of a stable.

Technology, too, has changed a great deal in recent years, and many companies are employing the computer and internet to make things easier for busy horsemen and women. One such company is InCompass, a wholly owned subsidiary of The Jockey Club that is based in Lexington, Kentucky. Since 2001, when it was launched, InCompass has worked on programming and software development to, according to its website, "achieve operational efficiencies, reduce costs and increase revenue" for tracks across the country.

InCompass has also aimed to make technology work for horsemen. Three years ago, it rolled out InCompass Financial Services (IFS), a system that allows horsemen to view bookkeeper statements from member tracks online (IFS Brings the Bookkeeper to You! is the company's slogan). At any time of day, members can log on and check account balances, claim activity, etc., at the various tracks where they compete. What's more, members can view consolidated statements, if they choose.

Have accounts at Pimlico, Santa Anita and Keeneland? No problem. Instead of remembering three different IDs and passwords for those tracks, InCompass has consolidated the data from each and, after signing in with a universal ID, members are provided one simplified statement in a standardized format.

"It's really a great service for horsemen," said Brad Kimbrell, InCompass' vice president of sales.

Kimbrell added, "Another thing members can do on the site is print out tax forms if they need to for their accounting."

Thus far, InCompass has over 40 tracks and associations signed up for the service (*listed below*).

Maybe the best part about Financial Services is its price: it's free to horsemen. The service is offered courtesy of racetracks and various horsemen's associations.

IFS Funds Transfer...

In April, IFS launched a new product that makes doing business even easier. Called IFS Funds Transfer, the service allows customers to not only check their bookkeepers' statements online, but to move funds electronically from one member track account to another.

Each night, InCompass collects the fund requests it received that day and facilitates the transfers. The next day, the funds are in place.

"If an owner wins a race at Keeneland and wants to move some of that money to Santa Anita to claim a horse the next day, he can do that easily online," explained Kimbrell. "It saves the hassle of having to wire money or send a certified check or overnight mail."

Members can also use Funds Transfer to move money from their track accounts to their personal or business bank accounts.

The cost of the service is \$7.50 per transaction.

Unfortunately, because of state regulations, InCompass' Funds Transfer service isn't currently available in all states. InCompass is unable to offer the service in New Jersey, Pennsylvania or Florida, but Kimbrell hopes that will soon change.

"We're currently talking to a banking partner and we've come up with a solution, but we have to make sure it's the right solution," he said. "But we're hoping to offer the service in those states sometime next year."

When all is said and done, the goal of InCompass Financial Services and Funds Transfer is to simplify tasks so owners and trainers can focus on what's really important: getting their horses into the winner's circle.

The suspension was automatically reduced from 30 to 15 days after Contessa waived his right to appeal. The suspension begins today and runs through Monday, Nov. 5. Wild Vicar will be declared unplaced in the July 20 race and purse money will be redistributed. Wild Vicar more recently won a \$16,000 claimer at Belmont Oct. 17 for Contessa and Winning Move.
