CURLIN WEATHERS THE STORM

Conditions for the 24th running of the Breeders' Cup World Championships at Monmouth Park were far from ideal. Rain squalls punctuated the afternoon, the main track was a sea of slop, and riders coming from off the pace on the turf were bathed in mud as well. But the clouds parted as the horses headed to the paddock for yesterday's \$5-million GI Breeders' Cup Classic, and the sun was shining as **Curlin** (Smart Strike) powered past **Hard Spun** (Danzig) en route

to what will certainly be a Horse of the Year-worthy performance. "It was truly awesome," said jockey Robby Albarado, who had managed just one third-place finish in 10 prior Breeders' Cup attempts. "Everything went perfectly, starting with all the speed up front. It unfolded just the way we wanted, but it also takes a hell of a horse to get this done. Curlin was there for us every step of the way." **BC Classic cont. p2**

A WORLD OF CHAMPIONS

Voting for the Eclipse Awards has not even started, but it is likely that all but one category were decided in Breeders' Cup races. The two-year-old races were particularly formful--**War Pass** (Cherokee Run) took the GI Juvenile as the 2-1 favorite, and **Indian Blessing** (Indian Charlie), heroine of the GI Juvenile Fillies, was the shortest-priced winner on the day at 8-5. **Midnight Lute** (Real Quiet) was the 5-2 crowd's choice in the GI Sprint and, after adding that victory to his GI

Forego S. success, he will be nearer to even-money to be crowned champion. Also earning themselves considerable points towards year-end honors were GI Turf hero **English Channel** (Smart Strike), GI F/M Turf winner **Lahudood (GB)** (Singspiel {Ire}), GI Distaff victress **Ginger Punch** (Awesome Again) and GI Classic champ **Curlin** (Smart Strike). Only sidelined Rags to Riches is expected to garner an Eclipse without a Breeders' Cup score. Despite the ugly weather, the turnout for the first-ever two-day Breeders' Cup was solid. There were 27,803 on hand at Monmouth Park Friday, and 41,781 at the track yesterday. "We are encouraged with the results of the inaugural two-day format at the 24th Breeders' Cup World Championships at Monmouth Park, and want to congratulate the breeders, owners, trainers and riders who competed over the two days of our championships," said Breeders' Cup President and CEO Greg Avioli. "We also want to thank our hosts--Governor Corzine, the state of New Jersey and the New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority--for their efforts. The weekend combined stunning athletic performances and solid business results. Despite the weather, Friday's business exceeded our expectations. The severe weather and resulting track conditions, though, clearly affected overall wagering handle. We believe the results of this year, while preliminary, show the merits of expanding to two days, and we look forward to the 25th Breeders' Cup World Championships next year at Oak Tree at Santa Anita."

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YEAR-END HONORS ON THE LINE

The Eclipse Award for top three-year-old--in addition to the title of Horse of the Year--were at stake in the Breeders' Cup Classic. GI Kentucky Derby and GI Travers S. winner **Street Sense** (Street Cry {Ire}) had the edge, but **Curlin** was on his heels after taking his measure in the GI Preakness S., and outgaming four-year-old **Lawyer Ron** (Langfuhr) in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup. If he could have turned the tables and added a Classic score to his GI Whitney H. and

GI Woodward S. wins, Lawyer Ron would have earned himself the championship, and **Hard Spun** was also in with a chance after taking the GI King's Bishop S. and beating Street Sense in the GI Kentucky Cup Classic. A Horse for the Course?

Many thought Monmouth's tight turns and wet track would prove Curlin's undoing, but that was not the case. The head-turning chestnut settled outside Street Sense as Hard Spun, followed closely by Lawyer Ron, **Diamond Stripes** (Notebook), **Any Given Saturday** (Distorted Humor) and **George Washington (Ire)** (Danehill), splashed through a half in :45.85 and six panels in 1:10.67. The chase team gave it up one by one and Curlin and Street Sense made their moves. The Kentucky Derby winner was able to ride the rail around the turn and Curlin had to make his way through an opening between tiring rivals, but there was no doubt who loomed the larger threat. Curlin was in high gear as he collared Hard Spun at the top of the lane, and he galloped away to an eye-catching victory. It was the first Breeders' Cup success for trainer Steve Asmussen, who was off the board in six prior tries. "It's incredible," Asmussen said. "It's all about Curlin--he's the one who did it." Curlin won easily, but there were anxious moments for his conditioner. "[The track] was a huge concern; I was extremely nervous about it. But Robby gave him the chance. He got him on his feet. First time by the stands, he was carrying Robby nicely, and he ran extremely well from there. He is incredible."

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Word on the Street

Street Sense got the trip he wanted, but didn't have the gas he needed in the stretch. The dark bay flat-tened out in the final drive and finished fourth. "We just got outrun today," jockey Calvin Borel said. "Curlin ran a beautiful race. At the quarter-pole, I thought I would go with him, but he just kicked away. I couldn't have had a better trip--he tried hard with me. Curlin is the genuine article and I just couldn't go with him." The Jim Tafel homebred was carrying on a tradition--four previous BC Juvenile winners had tried to come back to take the Classic the following year and three--Macho Uno, Fly So Free and Chief's Crown--were fourth. The 1989 Juvenile hero Rhythm was eighth in the 1990 Classic.

Tragedy for Ballydoyle

MG1SW George Washington, who returned to training after an unsuccessful stint in the breeding shed, was looking to improve on a sixth-place finish in the 2006 Classic. The four-year-old never looked comfortable while chasing Hard Spun early. He dropped back on the far turn and broke down in the stretch. "George Washington sustained an open fracture of the cannon bone in the right front fetlock joint and disarticulated the joint at the same time, and had both sesamoids broken," said Dr. C. Wayne McIlwraith. The colt had to be euthanized.



HOMETOWN HERO

Score one for the home team. Owner Jim Scatuorchio hangs his hat in Rumson, New Jersey, just a 10-minute drive from Monmouth Park, and he

celebrated in his own backyard after cheering **English Channel** (Smart Strike) to a dominating seven-length victory in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf yesterday afternoon. "I don't know if you can script it any better," said Scatuorchio, who

retired from a Wall Street firm in 1998. "That's the stuff you dream about. Knowing the race was going to be at Monmouth, we always had it in the back of our minds how excited we would be to get him [to the Breeders' Cup], but people forget sometimes how difficult it is to get a horse to these races. It's quite an accomplishment."

Crossing the Hudson...

English Channel had been to Monmouth twice before, winning the GI United Nations S. in 2006 and again in 2007. He came into the Breeders' Cup off an impressive 2 1/4-length tally in the GI Turf Classic Invitational S. at Belmont Park. But the five-year-old had been beaten in two previous Breeders' Cup tries, finishing fifth in the Turf in 2005 and third in the race last year. There was also a question mark as to how he would handle the rain-soaked turf course at Monmouth. The handicappers had faith, however, sending English Channel off as the 3-1 second choice, and he rewarded their loyalty. Always eager in his races, English Channel broke well and was hard held by jockey John Velazquez as chased 29-1 **Fri Guy** (Theatrical {Ire}) and 25-1 **Shamdinan (Fr)** (Dr Fong) through a half in :53.20. He edged closer down the backstretch, forged to the front as they raced out of the turn and simply ran away from the field to win as much the best. Shamdinan held off the 2006 Breeders' Cup Turf hero Red Rocks to be second. "We got the perfect trip," Velazquez said. "Our plan was to save ground and wait as long as possible before we made our move. Everything was perfect." Added trainer Todd Pletcher, "He delivered big-time today. I was concerned [about the course condition]. Obviously, it was extremely soft, but he ran an unbelievable race."

No Luck for the Irish

Irish invader **Dylan Thomas (Ire)** (Danehill), the 9-10 chalk, became the sixth winner of the prestigious G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe to disappoint on Breeders' Cup day--in fact, no Arc winner has been able to win the Turf. The four-year-old angled outside in the stretch, but had little to offer in the final drive and finished fifth. "Take nothing away from Dylan Thomas, but I always thought [English Channel] was a champion," said Jim Scatuorchio. "We couldn't beat [Dylan Thomas] in France...but he was on my home court today." English Channel gave Scatuorchio his first Breeders' Cup win. He completed the mile and a half over the soft turf in 2:36.96, but that is not the slowest time in the race's history. Northern Spur (Ire) needed 2:42.07 to get the job done on the bog at Belmont Park in 1995.

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KNOCKOUT PUNCH

It looked like her Eclipse Award chances might have been compromised after a third-place finish in the Sept. 30 GI Beldame S., but **Ginger Punch** (Awesome Again) rebounded with a gallant winning effort in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff. The four-year-old filly joined **Hystericalady** (Distorted Humor) as they raced around the far turn and the two were heads apart all the way down the lane. They bumped hard at the eighth pole before Ginger Punch edged ahead to earn the victory. "This filly has come a long way," said Chad Brown, assistant to trainer Bobby Frankel. "Bobby never lost confidence in her. I'm so happy for the filly--she's a real tough filly. She's always been a fighter."

Adding Spice to the Distaff

Sent off at odds no higher 6-5 in her last four starts, Ginger Punch looked well on her way to a championship after taking the July 8 GII First Flight H., July 28 GI Go for Wand H. and Sept. 8 GI Ruffian H. The Stronach home-bred was head-and-head for the lead at the eighth pole in the Beldame, weakening late to finish behind **Unbridled Belle** (Broken Vow) and **Indian Vale** (A.P. Indy). But her Hall of Fame trainer

was not the only one keeping the faith. The chestnut was sent off the second choice in the Distaff, with Unbridled Belle the 6-1 third choice and Indian Vale off at 8-1. Rafael Bejarano settled Ginger Punch just behind the leaders down the backstretch. He hustled her up the rail on the final bend to get on even terms with Hystericalady, and the battle was joined. Ginger Punch had the call at the quarter pole, but her rival was back in front while causing the contact at the eighth pole. The interference was to no avail--Ginger Punch pinned her ears and was a neck in front at the wire. "In the stretch, we got squeezed by [Hystericalady], but I always knew she would come back," Bejarano said.

Kip Deville (Kipling) had to be supplemented to line up for yesterday's GI Breeders' Cup Mile, but backed the confidence of his owners with a big performance. Away sharply from the seven hole, he was taken back by Cornelio Velasquez to settle just behind the leaders. Awaiting racing room on the turn for home, Kip Deville was swung off the rail, split horses to take the lead in deep stretch and drew clear to win impressively. "I couldn't be more excited," trainer Rick Dutrow, Jr. said. "I knew he was doing very good going into this race. My only concern was him liking the track. I was under the impression that he was going to get a good trip. We just couldn't be happier."

Solid Foundation for Private Purchase...

Kip Deville caught the attention of the New York-based IEAH Stables following a victory in the Grand Prairie Turf Challenge S. in April 2006, and they purchased the Oklahoma-bred privately. The strapping gray led by as many as 15 lengths in his first start sporting IEAH's red, white and blue silks, but tired late to finish second to Showing Up in the Colonial Turf Cup S. He showed the ability to rate when annexing Keeneland's Bryan Station S. last October, and kicked off a three-race winning streak with Santa Anita's GIII Sir Beaufort S. last December. Kip Deville reached a career high when posting a neck victory in the GI Frank E. Kilroe Mile H. Mar. 3, and followed with a game decision over Showing Up in the GII Maker's Mark Mile S. Apr. 13. Favored at 7-5 in the GI Shoemaker Breeders' Cup Mile S. May 28, he finished sixth by two lengths. Wheeled back on short rest for the GII Californian S. over the Hollywood Cushion June 2, he reported home eighth, and was given some time off. The IEAH colorbearer completed the trifecta in Monmouth Park's Oceanport S. Aug. 5, and entered the Mile off a strong second to Shakespeare in the GI Woodbine Mile S. Sept. 16.

Excellent Effort From Favorite...

Excellent Art (GB) (Pivotal {GB}), backed as the 2-1 lukewarm favorite, rallied from far back to earn the runner-up slot. "He's a good or fast ground horse," trainer Aidan O'Brien commented. "He was drawn very badly [post 12], but he ran a great race. Johnny [Murtagh] gave him a very good ride. He was drawn outside, so he had to let the race unfold, but he was closing, closing, closing at the end. There might be a race for him in Hong Kong or Japan." 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MIDNIGHT MADNESS

"Oh my god." Those were the sentiments of trainer Bob Baffert after **Midnight Lute** (Real Quiet), who normally does his best work from on or near the pace, was bothered at the break and forced to race at the back of the pack. Roughly sixty-nine seconds later, his mood had changed dramatically, after the imposing dark bay colt unleashed a barnstorming stretch run to win the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint by a record-setting 4 3/4

lengths. "What a horse!" the silver-haired trainer said. "It was an incredible run he made. He's the best one I've ever led over here to the Breeders' Cup."

Sprint, Route, Sprint...

Midnight Lute made the first five starts of his career around one turn, parlaying a Del Mar allowance victory last August into a dominating success in the GIII Perryville S. at Keeneland. He would go on to contest all three legs of Santa Anita's Strub series, beginning with an off-the-pace third in the seven-furlong GI Malibu S. Dec. 26. He gave an excellent account of himself in a pair of starts around two turns, finishing a nose second to Awesome Gem in the GII San Fernando Breeders' Cup S. Jan. 13 and fourth as the favorite in the GII Strub S. Feb. 3. Returned to the site of his career best, Midnight Lute was no better than fourth in the GII Commonwealth Breeders' Cup S. Apr. 14, but was later found to have breathing problems. With those issues addressed, Baffert invested plenty of confidence in his colt by bringing him back in the Sept. 1 GI Forego S. at Saratoga. Midnight Lute won it by 2 1/4 lengths with the best Beyer of the year (124) and the lowest figure (-7) ever awarded by Thoro-Graph's Jerry Brown.

Overcoming Adversity...

Steadied after being bumped and pinched back at the break, Midnight Lute raced far back early as **Talent Search** (Catienus), **Commentator** (Distorted Humor) and **Idiot Proof** (Benchmark) exchanged blows through an opening quarter mile of :21.56. Garrett Gomez angled out Midnight Lute midway on the turn and had the colt in high gear as they turned for home, but still had Idiot Proof some six lengths in front of him with just a furlong to run. But in a matter of strides, the Baffert trainee inhaled that one and pulled away to a devastating victory. "I felt really comfortable at the half," Gomez recalled. "I felt that we had a good shot. I made the decision to come around horses and Commentator took us out a little farther than I would have liked, but once I got him clear, he came on." The win was the fourth in Breeders' Cup history for Baffert and the fourth in the last two years for Gomez.

They didn't have to wait long for their second score, as the over-looked, but improving **Lahudood (GB)** (Sing-spiel {Ire}) edged to the front on the final turn and staved off a late bid from **Honey Ryder** (Lasting Approval) to win the GI Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf. The
