CURLIN EXITS CLASSIC WIN IN FINE SHAPE

GI Breeders' Cup Classic winner **Curlin** (Smart Strike) exited Saturday's victory in good shape and a decision on the likely Horse of the Year's future is likely to be

made in the following days. "It's just a whole new set of questions," said the three-year-old's trainer Steve Asmussen. "Our focus has been the Breeders' Cup Classic ever since the Belmont. I think the horse came through with flying colors and put in his best performance yet. He was the best horse [Saturday] that he's been, but everything has to be evaluated from that. It's the first time that we weren't thinking about tomorrow with him. I think everybody needs to step back, enjoy what he's done, and then evaluate it off of that." Classic runner-up **Hard Spun** (Danzig) and GI Ken-

tucky Derby winner **Street Sense** (Street Cry {Ire}), fourth in the Classic, will be shipped to Darley to begin their stud careers next year. "Hard Spun will leave for Darley either Tuesday afternoon or Wednesday morning," trainer Larry Jones confirmed. Reflecting on his charge's final start, Jones said, "It was a good run. We gave it our best and Curlin was just better. Those three horses [Hard Spun, Curlin and Street Sense] have been phenomneal all year. We beat Street Sense as many times as he beat us, and Curlin, out of five times, he got us three and we got him the other two. This may be one of the best crops ever. Hard Spun has been going for 12 months solid, and he never disappointed us." Street Sense was scheduled to ship to Darley last night, according to trainer Carl Nafzger. "Street Sense didn't finish off his race for whatever reason," Nafzger said of his charge's Classic effort. "If he had finished off his race, he'd have been third, but he just didn't finish it off. Curlin and Hard Spun ran top races. I wish [Street Sense] had been third because that would mean we'd have had the 1-2-3 in the Derby, 1-2-3 in the Preakness and 1-2-3 in the Breeders' Cup Classic." GI Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf winner **Lahudood** (Singspiel {Ire}) has also run her last race. "Lahudood will go to Shadwell and be bred next year," confirmed trainer Kiaran McLaughlin. Also retired after his Breeders' Cup victory is Saturday's GI Turf winner **English Channel** (Smart Strike). "I made a deal with this horse that this would be his last race," said owner James Scatuorchio. "We have a deal worked out with a farm in Kentucky, but I promised I wouldn't say anything." **Cont. p2**

ALLEGRETTO ALLEGRO

Cheveley Park Stud's **Allegretto (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) capped an annus mirabilis for the Newmarket-based operation and her sire when flying late to capture France's end-of-season marathon, the G1 Prix Royal-Oak, in race-record time at Longchamp yesterday. Requiring the full length of the Bois de Boulogne track's straight, she was unrelenting in the drive to collar **Macleya (Ger)** (Winged Love {Ire}) nearing the line to claim a deserved first top-level success by a short neck at odds of 26-5. "She's a really gutsy filly and keeps on pulling out more," said winning rider Ryan Moore. "She has already won three Group 2 races, so she really deserved that." **Cont. p3**

ETCHED IN NASHUA

Darley homebred **Etched** (Forestry), a son of GI Breeders' Cup Distaff winner Unbridled Elaine (Unbridled's

Song), rolled to a visually impressive 6 1/2-length victory in yesterday's GIII Nashua S. at Aqueduct. The 1-2 crowd's choice never gave his backers an anxious moment, going to the early lead and sailing clear turning for home en route to the victory. "I had so much horse the whole race," said winning jockey Alan Garcia. "He's a big horse with a real big stride. He liked the mile and I think he wants more distance." **Cont. p6**

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Breeders' Cup Runners Look Ahead (cont. from p1)

Trainer Nick Zito reported that GI Juvenile winner **War Pass** (Cherokee Run) will return to Churchill Downs before heading to Florida to prepare for next year's Triple Crown races. Zito was impressed with his colt's effort, which included an opening six furlongs in 1:09 3/5. "He put an exclamation point on that," Zito said. "If you don't like that, you don't like racing. I don't care what you say, 1:09 is 1:09. I don't care how fast the track is or how wet the track is, you still have to run all the way." Friday's Dirt Mile winner **Corinthian** (Pulpit) now retires to Gainesway Farm, while Filly and Mare Sprint winner **Maryfield** (Elusive Quality) is scheduled to sell at next Sunday's Fasig-Tipton Kentucky Selected Fall Mixed Sale in Lexington. Among Saturday's other runners who ended their racing careers in Saturday's Breeders' Cup are: **My Typhoon (Ire)** (Giant's Causeway) (13th in the Mile), who retires to Live Oak Plantation; **Remarkable News (Ven)** (Chayim) (seventh in the Mile), stud plans to be announced; and **Timarwa (Ire)** (Daylami {Ire}) (6th in the F/M Turf), who will be shipped to Kentucky to be bred in the spring. **Honey Ryder** (Lasting Approval), second in the Filly and Mare Turf, is likely to be retired.

GOMEZ WINS SHOEMAKER AWARD

Garrett Gomez was named the 2007 recipient of the Bill Shoemaker Award, presented annually to the outstanding jockey in the Breeders' Cup as voted by the international media covering the event. The 35-year-old rider, who captured two races Saturday, has now won the award twice after winning two races in the 2005 Breeders' Cup. He rode Indian Blessing to victory in the GI Juvenile Fillies and Midnight Lute in the GI Sprint.

Unraced as a juvenile, Turfrose stepped up from early season conditions wins at this track and Milan to hit the board in the G3 Premio Regina Elena (Italian 1000 Guineas) back here May 13 before doing so again in the G3 Premio Mario Incisa on her return to Milan's San Siro next time May 27. She ran fourth in the G2 Oaks d'Italia back at Milan June 17, dropped to seventh in the G3 Prix de Psyche at Deauville July 31 before returning to the Normandy track to finish second in the Aug. 16 Listed Prix de Lieurey and claimed a first stakes badge in the Listed Premio Archidamia over course and distance last time Sept. 30. Positioned behind the front rank in fifth from the bell here, Turfrose began a forward move under encouragement once into the stretch. Successful in last year's G2 Lancashire Oaks, the diminutive Allegretto has proved her worth this term with victories in the G2 Henry II S. at Sandown May 29 and G2 Goodwood Cup Aug. 2. Runner-up to Peeping Fawn in the G1 Yorkshire Oaks Aug. 22, she was far from disgraced when third to Septimus (Ire) in the G2 Doncaster Cup last time Sept. 14 and was all heart to claim a career high in this meeting highlight. Allegretto was reserved off the pace in ninth for much of the contest as Lord du Sud (Fr) (Linamix {Fr}) assumed his customary front-running role. Making continued headway under pressure once turning for home, she reeled in her rivals one by one on the outside and would not be denied under Ryan Moore's power drive to oust Macleya in the final strides. Posting a new record for the race, Allegretto's winning time was only half a second off the track record. "They went a decent pace, which was good as she needs to switch off and she loves passing horses," explained Moore. "She is sometimes idle, but picked up well today and she loved the good ground because she doesn't want it too fast or too soft." Looking to become the first horse to capture the both Tenno Sho titles--Spring and Autumn--since T.M Opera O accomplished the feat in 2000, Meisho Samson showed little rust returning from a four-month break to easily defeat 48-1 longshot Agnes Ark. Breaking from the rail, the four-year-old colt was eased off the leaders under Yutaka Take. He was part of a line of horses that fanned wide for the stretch run, but left the rest fighting for minor placings with a smart burst of acceleration. The victory pushed Meisho Samson's career earnings to \$7,835,391.

Court Vision, who closed to miss by just a half-length in his six-furlong debut at Turfway Sept. 7, graduated by 1 3/4 lengths on the stretch-out to 1 1/16 miles at Keeneland Oct. 6. Well-beaten in the early going, the dark bay colt had only one horse beaten after six furlongs, but powered into contention with a dramatic seven-wide move in the final furlong, overtaking Halo Najib in the final strides with a determined effort. "The horse ran a super race," said Kenny McCarthy, assistant to trainer Bill Mott. "It was a bit of a test today, because after two starts on the Polytrack we weren't sure how he would take the dirt in his face." Winning jockey Julien Leparoux added, "I was very frustrated at the start. But he came running. The trip was good because we saved ground the whole way. They came back to me, and he had a good kick." Court Vision is out of Weekend Storm, a full sister to Classic winner Summer Squall and a half to champion A.P. Indy. He is a full brother to Kipling, the sire of GI Breeders' Cup Mile winner Kip Deville. Of runner-up Halo Najib, jockey Mark Guidry said, "He ran real hard. He just got a little tired, I think. He was a little antsy in the post parade and broke a little sharper than anticipated. But he ran a good race--he just got run down. My hat's off to the winners." The five-year-old Fishy Advice achieved his first
graded success as he took to the rain-softened course
at Aqueduct yesterday like a, well, fishy to water. The
bay had come across similar conditions when he won
the Laurel Turf Cup in his seasonal finale last Novem-
ber. He opened up 2007 with a victory in a stakes at
Monmouth in June, but was unplaced in three graded
events since, most recently running a good fourth in
the GIII Cliffhanger S. at The Meadowlands Sept. 21.
Here, Fishy Advice launched his rally from well back,
hooked a game Thorn Song a furlong out and was
going away late. "He's learned to settle a lot better this
year," said winning trainer David Donk. "He ran a de-
cent race last time and he's done well since. Coming off
the turn, I knew he had a lot to do, but he has come
from way back before and won."

Etched became a ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ with an authoritative six-furlong debut win at Belmont Sept. 29. The colt, sent off the 7-5 favorite that day, rated just off the pace, inhaled the pacesetters down the backstretch, carried an eight-length advantage into the lane and reported home a 6 3/4-length winner. On the lead early this time around, the strapping chestnut set fractions of :24.20 and :48.01. He was eight lengths in front after three-quarters in 1:12.60 and sailed under the wire much the best. "At the quarter pole I was just looking for horses, but no one could keep up with him," explained winning rider Alan Garcia. Etched also impressed trainer Kiaran McLaughlin. "He's a very nice horse and he trains very well," McLaughlin said. "The nice thing is that his attitude has gotten a little better since his first race. He's been a little more manageable. He's a very talented colt. I liked to see the half-mile in :48 because all of his breezes have been in less than :48, so I knew he had plenty of horse. Elusive Lady, a non-threatening sixth in her debut at Saratoga Aug. 26, chased the pacesetter from second and gamely overtook that rival late to break her maiden by 3/4-lengths racing 6 1/2 furlongs at Belmont Sept. 29. Finding herself on the front end here, the gray filly cut out fractions of :23.54, :47.72 and 1:13.26 before opening up down the lane for a confident score. CHURCHILL HORSES NEGATIVE FOR EHV

Tests performed on 35 horses stabled at a quarantined Churchill Downs barn have returned no trace of Equine Herpesvirus. Barn 47 has been under quarantine since a sophomore trained by David Carroll tested positive last Thursday. The infected horse has been moved to a Lexington equine hospital. "The test results reaffirmed our suspicion that the infected horse carried a low level of the infection in his body and that made him a lesser risk to transmit the virus to other horses," said Rusty Ford, equine programs manager for Kentucky State Veterinarian Dr. Robert Stout. "We remain optimistic that the presence of the virus in that barn was caught very early, which would be good news for our efforts to contain the virus to the infected horse and this barn."
