DALVINA DASHES TO LONG ISLAND WIN

One week after the GIII Long Island H. was postponed due to high winds, **Dalvina (GB)** (Grand Lodge) found the trans-Atlantic commute of little consequence

as she powered from the back of the pack to win her U.S. debut by 3 1/2-lengths over **Barancella (Fr)** (Acatenango {Ger}). Campaigned in Europe by Marina and Andrew Stone and trainer Edward Dunlop, the chestnut was originally slated to be transferred to the barn of Graham Motion follow-

ing the 1 1/2-mile test, however, those plans may have been put on hold following her impressive performance. "After she won like that, I am sure [Ed] Dunlop will be keen to have her back," explained Dunlop's assistant, Robin Trevor-Jones. "She's too nice a filly to lose; we would not like to lose her. She's a Group 2 or Group 3 filly in England and she should improve from three to four. After the way she won, I am sure that the owner and the trainer will talk about what is going to happen with her." Winner of her first two starts, including the 10-furlong Listed Pretty Polly S. at Newmarket in May, the three-year-old was a well-beaten 11th over the soft turf in the G1 English Oaks June 1. Third in the June 21 G2 Ribblesdale S. at Royal Ascot, Dalvina came home fifth in the G1 Yorkshire Oaks Aug. 22 before finishing only two lengths behind the winner in her latest in the Curragh's G2 Blandford S. Sept. 14. *cont. p3*

TALLY ONE FOR LANTERN HILL

Picking the right day to sell a horse can be tricky for consignors. Sell too early, and your horse may get overlooked; too late, and the money might be gone. Latern Hill's Suzi Shoemaker played the balancing-act game to perfection during yesterday's seventh session of the Keeneland November Sale, and was rewarded with the day's highest-priced lot. The Latern Hill-consigned **Tally Ho Dixie** (Dixieland Band), just the fourth horse into the ring yesterday as hip 2192, made \$285,000 after Taylor Made Sales Agency, as agent, won the battle for the five-year-old mare. "That was my philosophy, to be the jewel on the day," Shoemaker said afterward. "It's always a concern though. The money is generally there when you get to this point in the sale, if you have the right product. It's a calculated move, like a poker game. But I think she was a stand-out. I think she probably had about 50 shows; a lot of people were looking at her, and she's just a really pretty mare." *cont. p5*

GOLD RUSH

Supplemented for €15,000, 21-10 chance **Full of Gold (Fr)** (Gold Away {Ire}) rewarded connections' faith with a dominant display in the rain to scoop Europe's final pattern race of the year, the G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud, on the western outskirts of Paris yesterday. Owner Alec Head's red silks had fared no better than third--with Marshall (Fr) in 2002--since the race was upgraded to Group 1 status in 1980, but that minor statistic was consigned to history as the chestnut homebred scooted clear in the closing stages to easily defeat **Hannouma (Ire)** (Anabaa) by two lengths. "It is a great moment for me as I had not won a Group 1 race since Rouvres (Fr) won the [2002] Prix Jean Prat in my colors and Dedication (Fr) won the Prix de la Foret a few months later in my wife's colors," said Head. *cont. p2*

GOMEZ SETS RECORD OF 71 STAKES VICTORIES

Jockey Garrett Gomez recorded his 71st stakes victory of the year at Hollywood Park yesterday, breaking the record established by Jerry Bailey during the 2003 season. The 35-year-old, who tied Bailey's record with a win on Hucking Hot in the Audrey Skirball-Kenis S. Saturday, set the mark aboard two-year-old filly Spring Awakening in the Mocassin S. "Until I tied it yesterday, it really hadn't sunk in," Gomez said of the record. "This is the guy [agent Ron Anderson] that did it right here. I just pointed 'em in the right direction." *cont. p5 (atw)*

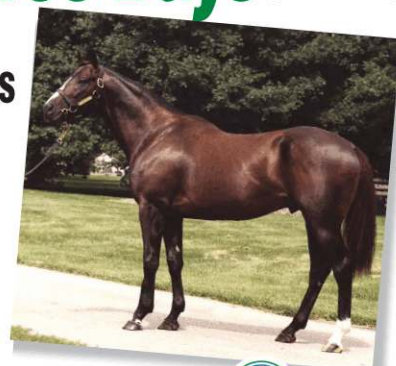

Full of Gold improved on a first-out fourth at Longchamp Sept. 9 to run second in a mile maiden over this track Sept. 28. Tearing up a similar contest here Oct. 25, connections decided to supplement for this and the colt did not disappoint with further proof as a leading contender for next year's Classics. Away quickly, Full of Gold settled just behind pacesetter New Zealand (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) and lost little ground when shuffled back to third at halfway. Pushed along off the home turn, he quickened to the fore a furlong out and drew clear late to post an impressive score. "He is a lovely horse who is big and already quite mature for a two-year-old," said trainer Criquette Head-Maarek. "He stays well, but also has natural speed and he'll be entered in all Classics next year. Of course, he is now finished for the season." Head-Maarek, who had already recorded two victories in the contest--with Poliglote (GB) in 1994 and Special Quest (Fr) in 1997--also saddled third placegetter Putney Bridge. "My other horse also ran a very good race and I'm lucky to have some nice two-year-olds in my stable this season," she added. "We hope 2008 will be a vintage year." 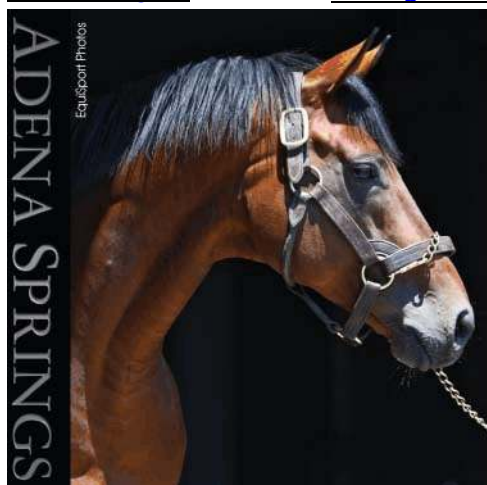

Off a step slowly in yesterday Long Island, Dalvina was settled at the back of the pack in eighth while an overly-eager Miracle Moment (Chester House) carved out modest opening splits of :25.78 and :51.57. With the latter done after a mile in 1:42.03, My Rachel opened up by daylight and looked like she would carry her momentum all the way home. However, the late-running duo of Dalvina and Barancella closed with determination, overtaking that tiring rival in the final sixteenth. Dalvina offered the greatest flourish late, striding clear to post her first victory in six months, while Barancella fought gamely to complete the exacta. My Rachel held on for third. Even-money favorite Royal Highness (Ger) (Monsun {Ger}) was close up early, but faded to be sixth. "At the quarter-pole, when I put her in the clear, she took off," explained winning jockey Cornelio Velasquez. "She is a very, very nice filly. Today, the grass was very soft, very chewed up. Fair Breeze closed 2006 with victory in the Listed Prix Solitude at Fontainebleau, her third straight stakes score, and returned to France to finish fifth in the G3 Prix Allez France at Chantilly on seasonal bow May 2. She garnered further prizemoney in four subsequent Group 3 events before posting a career high when just failing to catch Turfrose (Ger) in the G1 Premio Lydia Tesio at Rome last time Oct. 28. Restrained in fifth after breaking smartly here, she made progress to lead into the straight and maintained control thereafter, despite veering right at the eighth pole, to claim a first pattern win at the expense of stable companion Scatina. With this victory, Fair Breeze becomes the third group winner for her sire Silvano (Ger).

Whistlin' Dixie...

Tally Ho Dixie was selected as a yearling by Randy Trimble, who bought her for \$85,000 on behalf of Richard Otto at the 2003 Keeneland September Sale. The dark bay proved a solid runner for Otto, registering four wins, three seconds and four thirds in 16 starts while earning \$103,920. She concluded her career with an allowance win sprinting over Arlington Park's sod in June of 2006 before being retired to the breeding shed and mated to Grand Slam. "Mr. Otto bred her to Grand Slam because he thought that was a good cross--the same one that produced Limehouse," explained Shoemaker, who admitted that Otto had some reservations selling the mare. "He put her in the sale not really wanting to sell her," she said. "He wanted to get the first foal out of her, and would have been just fine taking her home, but I think everything really worked out." She added of the price, "It was significantly higher than the reserve. She's a nice mare, so we expected six figures, but not necessarily that." In addition to being by a hot broodmare sire in Dixieland Band, Tally Ho Dixie boasts a strong female family. Her winning dam, Tally Ho Annie (Capote), is a half-sister to Starrer, a dual Grade I winner of \$1,043,033; and Steller Jayne, a three-time Grade I winner of \$1,534,964. "And those mares all being bred to nice stallions now, so the family is really poised to explode," added Shoemaker.

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Strong Sabbath at Keeneland...

With the average rising 19.3 percent and the median up 14.3 percent over last year's corresponding session, Keeneland's Sunday session yesterday proved popular with the buyers. "Today did have a lot better feel to it than yesterday," admitted Keeneland's Director of Sales Geoffrey Russell. "Bidding was very strong from start to finish, with a good cross section of domestic and a very wide range of international buyers from all four corners of the world. It was an excellent session." For the session, 257 horses sold for \$13,819,200. The average was \$53,771 and the median was \$40,000. Through seven sessions, Keeneland has sold 1,629 horses for a gross of \$302,303,900. The average is up 10 percent to \$185,576, while the median remained constant at \$87,000. With 68 RNAs Sunday, the not-sold percentage was 20.9, making the cumulative percentage of RNAs at the sale 22.7. The sale continues its 15-day run today, with a session beginning at 10 a.m.

Patience Pays Off for Alastar...

Sand Pebbles is a mare who is very familiar with the sales ring at Keeneland. The 10-year-old daughter of Sadler's Wells, who hails from the immediate family of Seattle Slew, was visiting it for the fifth time yesterday, and realized her highest bid yet when she was knocked down to Jennifer McCutchen/Russell L. Reineman Stable for \$240,000. Sand Pebbles had previously RNA'd for \$225,000 and \$180,000 at the 2004 November Sale and 2005 January Sale, respectively, before being

knocked down to Alastar Thoroughbreds for \$90,000 at the 2005 November Sale. She wasn't carrying a foal at the time, but she was when she was offered up again at this event last year, when she was led out of the pavilion unsold at \$105,000 while pregnant to Afleet Alex. Alastar's decision to hold on to Sand Pebbles paid dividends yesterday when the mare, now in foal to Johar, brought more than twice what she RNA'd for last year. The Afleet Alex foal--a filly--she was carrying followed her into the ring yesterday, and elicited a bid of \$67,000 from James M. Connors. Dapple Stud consigned Sand Pebbles for Alastar, and for Dapple chief Mike Akers, the difference in interest from 2006 to 2007 had less to do with a bullish market and more to do with the Afleet Alex filly. "I think having the baby at her side, and showing the quality of foal she's capable of producing, was the huge difference," said Akers. "I've got mares at home that are average size, correct and well-balanced, but not flashy mares, and if you can show the marketplace the product they're producing, I think it can make a big difference." Still, Akers admitted to being pleasantly surprised by the price. "We had some Europeans that were interested, and we were in the fortunate position where she brought more money than we expected," he said. Sand Pebbles was produced by a half-sister to the great Triple Crown winner Seattle Slew and is herself a full to English Group 2 winner Desert Secret (Ire).

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Bourne Identified as Profitable Mare...

Despite her name, Bourne Royal, in fact, wasn't. the then-nine-year-old mare was a modestly bred daughter of Exbourne who closed out her racing career with three off-the-board finishes in \$2,500 claiming races at Charles Town in West Virginia in 2000.

Still, Nancy Terhune was familiar with the gray, if only because Terhune had purchased her second foal, an Ops Smile colt named Bourne Silver, for \$6,500 at the 2003 Fasig-Tipton Midlantic yearling sale. Bourne Silver was a big, good-looking horse who looked very promising before colicking and dying before ever being able to show what he could do on the track.

But Terhune remembered him when his half-sister, a Deputed Testimony filly out of Bourne Royal, was put the Midlantic Sale in October of 2005. She bought the filly for \$4,000 and named her Bourne Testimony. And now, three months after Terhune bought that filly, Bourne Royal herself was being offered up, at the Fasig-Tipton Midlantic December Mixed Sale.

Terhune was in South Carolina, so she got on the phone, did her bidding via AT&T, and landed Bourne Royal for just \$1,100 without ever actually laying eyes on the mare.

"She was empty at the time, so I figured I'd be able to get her real cheap, and at the price, I figured why not take a chance?" explained Terhune.

Terhune sent her new purchase to the young Storm Cat stallion Van Nistelrooy and shipped her to West Virginia to drop the foal. This spring, Bourne Royal produced a handsome dark bay colt.

When Van Nistelrooy's first crop hit the ground running, Terhune decided to enter the colt in the November sale, and yesterday was rewarded when that colt realized \$185,000 on ML Bloodstock's winning bid. It was the second-highest price for a weanling on the day. The Feb. 12 foal was consigned by Drew Nardiello's Chesapeake Farm.

"Everything just panned out," Terhune said yesterday, on the phone from South Carolina, where she breaks and trains yearlings and two-year-olds. "Van Nistelrooy got really hot, this colt was really good-looking, and we got a little bit lucky."

Terhune operates the Nancy Terhune Training Stable on what used to be Sandy DuBose's farm in Camden. She currently has six mares and actively participates in the West Virginia breeding program. Her brother-in-law, Jeff Runco, is a leading trainer at Charles Town.

Folks around Keeneland remember Terhune from her days of training at the track in the 1980s and early '90s, and, for a while at least, Terhune could boast a place in Keeneland lore. In 1985, Terhune sent out Emriea to a spectacular \$243.00 mutuel upset in a Keeneland allowance race, at the time the biggest payout in the track's history. The record was surpassed in 1989 when Rip Dabbs paid \$255.40.

Terhune eventually tired of the cold winters of Kentucky and Maryland, where she also trained, and moved to South Carolina in 1997 to work at Dubose's operation. The two worked out an agreement for Terhune to gradually buy into the farm, a goal for Terhune that was ultimately realized last year.

Danger: Kids at Work...

Following in the footsteps of their parents, a troupe of Taylor children are dabbling in the bloodstock trade. Yesterday, the septet, with Frank Taylor handling the bidding duties, secured hip 2400, a filly from the first crop of Grade I winner Forest Danger, for \$200,000. Taylor signed the ticket as 4T Stable, which plans to pinhook the colt back to next year's F-T July Sale. "He was just awesome," Taylor said. "He looks a lot like the very good Forest Dangers." Winner of the 2005 GI Carter H. for trainer Todd Pletcher and owners Aaron and Marie Jones, Forest Danger stands at Taylor Made Farm. The six-year-old 's weanlings have been well-received at the November sale, with individuals selling for \$250,000, \$190,000, and \$110,000. "His offspring have been outstanding; they've got great necks and shoulders and they're very athletic," said Taylor. He's outdoing himself and I think he's got a great shot to make it." 4T Stable's new purchase isn't its first. The group pinhooked a number of weanlings over the past few years. 4T is comprised of Frank Taylor's Katey, Joseph, Frankie and Gracie, Ben Taylor's Brooks, and Duncan Taylor's Marshall and Danny.
