LA BREA A TAR-RIFIC AFFAIR

The field for today's GI La Brea S. at Santa Anita is anything but the pits, featuring an evenly matched group of sophomore fillies making their final starts versus their own age group. Oak West Farm's **Ashley's**

Kitty (Tale of the Cat), one of just two graded-stakes winners in the field, owns the added distinction of having posted her success going today's distance in the GIII Railbird S. at Hollywood Park in May. Unable to duplicate her form at a distance of ground, the chestnut won a Del Mar allowance Aug. 1 and has been runner-up in a pair of stakes in her last two, including to Jay Em Ess Stable's Theverythoughtof U in the 6 1/2-furlong Pine Tree Lane S. over the local Cushion Track Oct. 20. "I think the distance is

great for her," trainer Ted H. West told *Daily Racing Form*. "We've been targeting this race for several months and she's coming in fresh." The Siegel family won the 1997 running of the La Brea with I Ain't Bluffing, and the stable has a serious shot this time around with **Glorified** (Honour and Glory). Favored at 7-2 on the morning line, the dark bay is the most lightly raced of the 13 runners and is first up since finishing second in the July 2 Honest Lady S. at Hollywood Park. Trainer Ron Ellis, who also conditioned I Ain't Bluffing, is not overly concerned about the time off or his filly's relative inexperience. "We have a lot of faith in our filly," Ellis told *DRF*. "She's only had three races, but she's pretty professional. I've given her plenty of time for this. I haven't rushed her."

NYRA RECEIVES EXTENSION

Live racing in New York has been saved for the time being, as officials from the New York Racing Association yesterday signed an agreement with the state attorney general which will allow racing to continue at Aqueduct Racetrack through Jan. 23, according to published reports. Under the agreement, NYRA will retain all legal rights to Belmont Park, Saratoga Race Course and Aqueduct. The deal averts a shutdown of racing in the Empire State after Dec. 31, when NYRA's franchise to operate the three tracks was set to expire. A long-term extension of the franchise remains in heavy negotiations involving Governor Eliot Spitzer and the leaders of the state legislature, Democrat Sheldon Silver and Republican leader Joseph Bruno, whose staunch opposition to a plan proposed by Spitzer is largely responsible for the failure to reach a long-term agreement to date. Officials at NYRA had threatened to shut down operations absent an agreement, and also stated their distaste for any plan which would hand the operations over to an oversight board created in 2005 by former Governor George Pataki. The New York Senate and House are not in session until Jan. 9, giving ample time for a decision to be reached prior to the expiration of the extension.

Ike and Dawn Thrash's **Dawn After Dawn** (Successful Appeal) is the lone member of the field with Grade I black-type, having run third at 54-1 in Keeneland's Ashland S. in April. Fourth to Rags to Riches in the GI Kentucky Oaks the following month, she most recently returned from a July layoff and made her debut for the John Sadler barn Nov. 30, taking a 6 1/2-furlong allowance at Hollywood over **Swiss Diva** (Swiss Yodeler). Jockey Garrett Gomez has the call; he and Sadler have teamed to win 35 percent of their starts.

The other graded winner in the La Brea is the well-traveled **Sindy With an S** (Broken Vow), who annexed the GIII Safely Kept Breeders' Cup S. at Laurel Park Oct. 6. Third to Ashley's Kitty in the Railbird, the dark bay was most recently fifth in the Miss Woodford S. on the Breeders' Cup undercard Oct. 27, but reportedly struggled with the underfoot conditions. **Look Deep** (Petionville) has missed the frame just once in six starts over synthetic tracks, including a win in the Sept. 21 Cozy Lace S. at Presque Isle Downs. She was a wide fifth in the GII Raven Run S. at Keeneland Oct. 20.

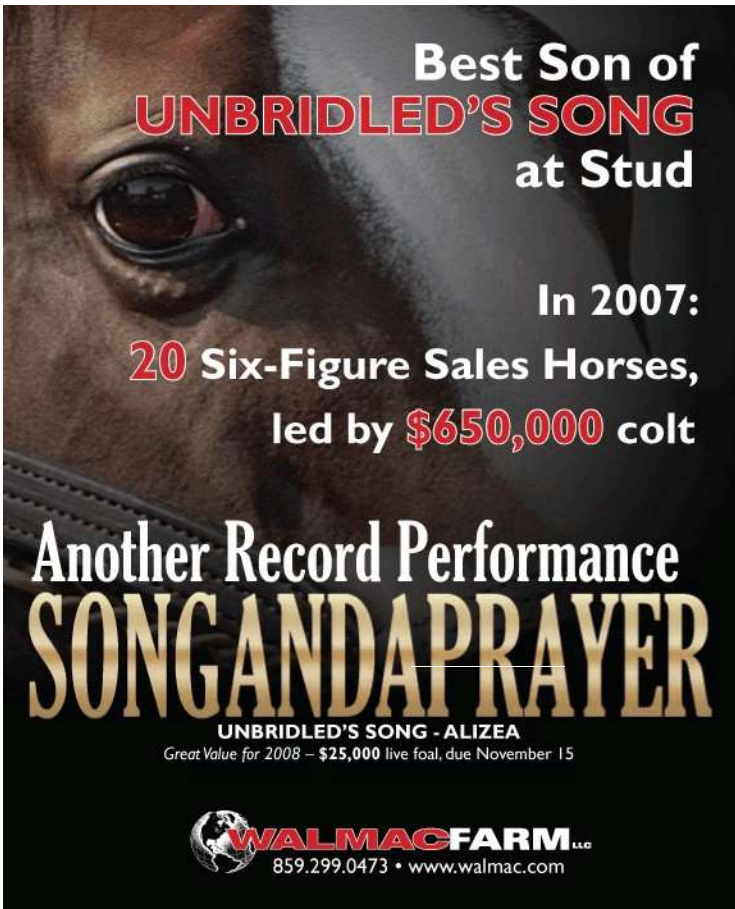
VALENZUELA HAS LICENSE REVOKED According to a release issued by California Horse Racing Board Executive Director Ingrid Fermin, the conditional license issued to jockey Patrick Valenzuela from Nov. 14, 2007 to Dec. 31, 2008 has been terminated. According to the release, terms and conditions of the license included a provision that Valenzuela "abstain from the consumption and/or possession of any alcohol" and "shall not enter any public place where alcohol is the principal commodity for sale or use." The CHRB ruled that the oft-suspended Valenzuela had been found to have "materially violated" that condition and made the decision to terminate his license. "All I know is that he got a DUI a week ago Wednesday, but I don't know the specifics of it," his agent, Tom Knust, commented. "I haven't talked to him about it. We're still very good friends and I want to help him work through this one way or the other. That's not to say he won't ride again, but I just want to help him the best I can."

NYRA Announces Wagering, Television Agreements:

Pending appropriate approvals, the New York Racing Association announced several wagering and television agreements yesterday. NYRA will provide TVG with worldwide video and account wagering rights on the NYRA product on a non-exclusive basis for TVG's television network and interactive wagering platforms. "NYRA has enjoyed an outstanding relationship with TVG over the years and we are thrilled that we can continue to provide our video and wagering products to TVG's growing audience," said Charles Hayward, NYRA President & CEO. "As our goal is to develop a broader distribution for the NYRA product, TVG is obviously the key venue for NYRA. We look forward to continuing our mutually beneficial partnership." This agreement will run through the end of 2008; previously, TVG had exclusive broadcast and account wagering distribution rights to the NYRA product.

NYRA has also reached a content-exchange agreement for 2008 with TrackNet Media Group, permitting TrackNet-affiliated racetracks, simulcast-wagering facilities and account-wagering providers to accept wagers on a non-exclusive basis from NYRA racetracks. Likewise, NYRA's racetracks and account-wagering system will be permitted to accept wagers on a non-exclusive basis on races conducted at all TrackNet-affiliated racetracks. The agreement also allows HorseRacing TV non-exclusive rights to televise races from NYRA tracks.



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"New York offers some of the most dynamic horse racing in the country," said TrackNet Chief Executive Officer Scott Daruty. "Officials with NYRA have demonstrated great foresight and customer focus by embracing an open-content model and making NYRA races available to a wide array of wagering outlets, including TwinSpires.com and XpressBet, and to more than one horse-racing television channel. New York horsemen and racetracks will benefit from this decision, as will wagering customers around the country who enjoy betting on NYRA races and who can now do so through their preferred on-track or off-track wagering platform."

NYRA has also entered into a direct relationship with Youbet.com. Youbet.com currently takes wagers on the NYRA product as a sublicense of TVG, but, under the terms of this new agreement, Youbet.com will be a direct customer of NYRA. "We look forward to this new direct association with Youbet, a major player in the account wagering landscape," said NYRA's Hayward. "We want our racing product to be available to as many racing fans as possible through a variety of platforms, and the Youbet platform is one of the most important in the industry. Youbet's CEO, Gary Sproule, added, "NYRA content has been a cornerstone of our platform for many years, and we're excited to continue our long relationship."

 Donald Dizney's homebred **CANYON DRIVE** ([Aptitude](#)) closed into fast fractions in his debut, rallying from well back to complete the exacta sprinting six panels at Hollywood Dec. 8. He should appreciate the added ground here, but likely will have a much slower pace to run at. **Coast Guard** ([Stormy Atlantic](#)) could find himself alone up front after a pair of solid sprint efforts. He attended a hot pace in his latest (:43 4/5 half), a Hollywood maiden Dec. 1, and still held on for second, 3/4 lengths ahead of **Street Royale** ([Street Cry](#) {Ire}), who was making his debut that day. **Medjool** ([Monarchos](#)) has run with credit in each of his races, finishing third to Colonel John on debut in October before two seconds while routing, his latest coming at Hollywood Nov. 23.  The nicely bred **Decorator** ([Storm Cat](#)) makes her debut for trainer Richard Mandella. She was in utero when Malibu Farm purchased her dam, Words of War, for \$1.95 million at the 2004 KEESEP, and Decorator has been through the ring twice since. She RNA'd for \$675k as a yearling and for \$385k as a juvenile. Decorator--a half to, among others, MGSW E Dubai--has a strong worktab to her credit, though Mandella rarely gets them cranked at first asking. **Royal Humor** ([Distorted Humor](#)), 0 for 7 thus far but on the board in both turf starts, rates a front-running chance. 5:41p TVG **8th-TUP, \$45K, Arizona Juvenile Fillies S., 2yo, f, 61/2f**
 This might appear an odd spot for the undefeated **HIGH RESOLVE** ([Put it Back](#)), until you take into account that she hails from the same connections as Lost in the Fog, who won the male counterpart of this race in 2004. The swift filly, owned by Harry Aleo and trained by Greg Gilchrist, has been in front at every call in each of her three races, including her stakes debut, the Joe O'Farrell Juvenile Fillies S. at Calder Nov. 10. Her other two wins came at Bay Meadows, and so she races in her third state in four starts here. **Nook and Granny** ([Impeachment](#)) is an interesting alternative. The dark bay won her debut at Hollywood as the 4-5 choice May 17, then returned from an absence to run second in a Dec. 5 allowance at that track. [brisnet.com pps](#)

Maryland Million Noms Due Dec. 31:

The last day of the year marks the final opportunity for owners and breeders to nominate horses and/or stallions to the Maryland Million programs. A fee of \$600 is due for yearlings (foals of 2006) which have not previously been nominated, while a fee of \$250 is due to fully nominate weanlings (foals of 2007). While foals can be nominated for life, stallions must be nominated prior to each breeding season in order that the foals conceived in that season are eligible for nomination. The nomination fee for stallions is equal to the advertised stud fee with a minimum of \$500.

Golden Hare Wins 14th Race of 2007:

Golden Hare (Gilded Time) made his 14th trip to the winner's circle of 2007 yesterday at the Fair Grounds, the most by any horse in a calendar year since the nine-year-old gelding Belle's Ruckus won no fewer than 16 races in 1994. Trained by Steve Asmussen, the eight-year-old gelding was claimed for \$3,500 by Scott Blasi, Asmussen's assistant trainer, out of a runner-up finish at Remington Park Aug. 22, 2006. Since being haltered, Golden Hare has won 19 of 22 starts with three seconds and has bankrolled over \$186,000, racing primarily in starter allowance company. He now has a career record of 22 wins from 51 starts. A maiden winner at first asking at Santa Anita in 2002 and a close fourth in that year's GI Malibu S., Golden Hare posted his major victory this year when he took the \$50,000 Claiming Crown Express S. at Ellis Park.

Elvis on the Mend:

Veteran Louisiana-born jockey E. J. Perrodin, seriously injured in a pre-race spill at Fair Grounds on Nov. 23, could return to the saddle sometime during the Louisiana Downs meeting in May as he chases his 3,000th career victory. I'm not in any pain anymore--I take a couple of pills a day for that --but I'm not trying to walk yet." He added, "I've seen the x-rays of my pelvis and they're not good looking," Perrodin added. "I've got a screw in there as long as my hipbone, so my doctors told me not to rush things. I'm going to wait as long as I can before I start up again--I don't want to push it." In a career spanning 33 years, Perrodin has ridden 20,687 mounts with 2,986 trips to the winner's circle, 2,759 seconds, 2,646 thirds. He has \$39,140,169 in purse earnings.
