

CLAIM TO FAME

Halted no fewer than three times in 2007, **Dearest Trickski** (Proudest Romeo) ran her rivals off their feet yesterday in the GI La Brea S. at Santa Anita. It was the Florida-bred's eighth trip to the winner's circle in 12 outings over the course of the year, and marked her stakes debut. "[Trainer] John [Sadler] told me to just let this filly do her thing, to just leave her alone," said winning rider

NEW YORK RACING BACK IN LIMBO

Two days after a deal was reached to keep racing in New York going into the new year, it was announced that a state committee would not give its approval. On Thursday, the New York Racing Association, State Attorney General's office and Non-Profit Racing Association Oversight Board came to an agreement that would keep NYRA operating on a temporary basis, until at least Jan. 23, while a permanent deal was hammered out between Gov. Eliot Spitzer and legislative leaders. That deal required final approval by the New York State Racing and Wagering Board, but, at a special session held Saturday morning in Schenectady, the Racing and Wagering Board said it did not have the authority to issue NYRA a temporary license. The Racing and Wagering Board said the authority instead lies with the Oversight Board. "They should have called us and asked us and we wouldn't have had a meeting today," Dan Hogan, chairman of the Racing and Wagering Board, told the *Albany Times Union*. NYRA's franchise to run Aqueduct, Belmont and Saratoga expires tomorrow. It wasn't immediately clear what the next step in the process would be, or whether there would be racing at Aqueduct on Tuesday, New Year's Day.

THE TIN MAN RECOVERY CONTINUES

Ralph and Aury Todd's **The Tin Man** (Affirmed), who sustained a fractured knee when coming out of surgery in October, is almost ready to be sent to a farm, according to *Daily Racing Form*. The nine-year-old is now being walked several times a day as he continues his rehabilitation at trainer Richard Mandella's Santa Anita barn. Winner of the GI Shoemaker BC Mile in his 2007 opener, the bay ran second in each of his next three outings, including the GI Arlington Million in August and the GI Clement L. Hirsch Memorial Turf Championship Oct. 6 in what would be his career finale. The venerable gelding's record stands at 31-13-8-2 with earnings of \$3,663,780.



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THE OAKLAWN CONNECTION CONTINUES

Closer attention should be paid to maiden claimers for fillies at Oaklawn this winter. Last year's La Brea heroine, **Downthedustyroad**, hailed from the Arkansas oval, and **Dearest Trickski** debuted victoriously for a \$20,000 tag at Oaklawn Jan. 25. Fifth at the \$25,000 level Feb. 17, the granddaughter of Proud Truth was claimed for \$12,500 from breeders Dr. K.K. and Vilasini Jayaraman next out Mar. 23. Dropped in for \$10,000 at Lone Star Apr. 29, she scored by eight lengths and was haltered once again. It was the first of three straight victories at the Texas track for Dearest Trickski, and she shipped to Del Mar during the summer. Claimed for \$32,000 by Tom Mankiewicz and trainer John Sadler out of a second-place finish Aug. 4, the bay drilled \$50,000 foes by 7 1/4 lengths Sept. 1 and added an optional-claiming success by a nose at Bay Meadows Oct. 12. Her streak continued in a Hollywood allowance Nov. 18, when she scored by 5 3/4 lengths under a hand ride and, fittingly, had **Downthedustyroad** back in third. Michael Baze had been aboard for that score, but he opted for graded winner **Sindy With an S** (Broken Vow) in this feature. Hall of Famer Mike Smith proved an able substitute.

The third choice in her stakes debut, Dearest Trickski broke alertly and soon had the lead while chased by **Unspoken Word** (Catienus), setting a pace of :22.52 and :44.53. She cornered for home smartly and had enough in reserve to take her first black-type event. "She's been great on the synthetics," Sadler commented. "Some [horses] don't like the synthetics, so you hope you have some that really will move up on it, and she's been

that horse." Sadler added that he scratched **Dawn After Dawn** (Successful Appeal) after the filly tied up yesterday morning, according to *Daily Racing Form*. He hopes to have the filly back in action for the GII El Encino S. Jan. 13.

Ruthienne, whose career began quietly enough over

this course last fall, put her head down gamely to post her eighth victory in 10 starts. After taking Calder's Cherokee Frolic S. last December, the Payson homebred was out of action for four months, returning to finish fourth in the Appalachian S. at Keeneland Apr. 22. She then rattled off an impressive five-race sequence, beginning

with the Sugar Plum Time S. at Belmont May 12. A dead-heat winner of the GIII Sands Point S. June 2, she was put up to first in the GIII Boiling Springs S. June 30 and took the GII Lake George S. July 27 on her own. The neatly made filly then shipped to California to take the GI Del Mar Oaks Aug. 18, but her streak came to an end in the GI Garden City BC S. Sept. 8 at Belmont, where she finished 10th, beaten 5 1/2 lengths. Given some time to regroup, Ruthienne settled into stride in the early stages of this contest and reached contention on the far turn. She made her move between horses and summoned her old class to make it to the wire a neck in front of the inseparable Pretoria Light and Sweet Ransom to her inside and out. "She's a very good filly, and I didn't really have her at 100 percent for this race, but she was able to overcome that," said Christophe Clement, saddling his second graded winner of the day. Bayou's Lassie closed out 2006 with a victory in the GIII Frances A. Genter S., and gave her connections an early New Year present once again. Turned over to Christophe Clement following a fourth in the Sunshine Millions F/M Turf in January, the dark bay didn't go postward again until Sept. 15, when she finished sixth in the GIII Noble Damsel H. at Belmont. She missed by a half-length to Annabill (Outflanker) in the Elmer Heubeck Distaff H. over track and trip Nov. 10, then came up 3/4 of a length short to J'ray in the GIII My Charmer H. on the Calder lawn Dec. 1. Breaking from the inside here, she clipped heels with Annabill on the first turn, but recovered quickly and skimmed the rail. The homebred kicked into gear turning for home and bested pacesetter Amazing Speed late. "She is a very nice filly and obviously can run on turf or dirt," said Clement. City Attraction slugged it out in deep stretch for his first added-money score. Second in three straight outings last spring, the dark bay broke through in an optional claimer at Saratoga Aug. 13 and added a win at the next level Sept. 19 at Belmont. He didn't face the starter again until Thanksgiving, when he ran third by a half-length in the Fall Highweight H., a neck behind Joey P. The four-year-old pressed Debussy through splits of :22.61 and :45.95, but appeared to be losing ground between rivals in the lane. Responding to Mike Luzzi's urging, he surged again and forged to the front as the wire approached. "We played the track today," said Luzzi, noting the speedy nature of the inner track. "We were a little aggressive out of there. They told me if he gets into a fight, that he'll fight for you. I just followed orders and he was right." Favored Joey P. recovered after stumbling badly at the start to stalk the pace, but couldn't sustain his momentum late and settled for second.

CHARM THE GIANT RETIRED Graded stakes winner **Charm the Giant (Ire)** (Giant's Causeway--Olympic Charmer, by Olympio) has been retired from racing, *Daily Racing Form* reports. Breeding plans have not been finalized, but trainer Ron McAnally told *DRF* that he hoped to breed the soon-to-be six-year-old to champion Bernardini. McAnally trained the bay for his wife, owner/breeder Deborah McAnally. A daughter of multiple graded stakes winner Olympic Charmer, Charm the Giant won all three of her outings at three in 2005. She was sidelined for eight months, and visited the winner's circle just once in six starts in 2006, but turned things around this season. Third in Santa Anita's Tuzla H. Jan. 24, she annexed the Hillsborough H. at Bay Meadows Mar. 24 before adding the GIII Wilshire H. at Hollywood Apr. 25. After finishing sixth in the GI Gamely BC S. May 28, Charm the Giant was on hiatus for another six months, but returned with a sharp three-length tally Nov. 28 in the Intercontinental H. at Hollywood in what would be her final career outing. She heads to the breeding shed with a record of 15-7-3-1 and earnings of \$336,309.

Allowed to settle in second as Angelic Aura (Concerto) showed the way for the opening mile, Nite Light took over shortly thereafter and ran away to post a dominating score. "The horse is really getting a lot of confidence and coming into his own," assistant trainer Seth Benzel said. "He gets out there and he just strides along comfortably which is why he's so good at these distances. Right now, it looks like we're going to try to find our best path to the Breeders' Cup Dirt Marathon."

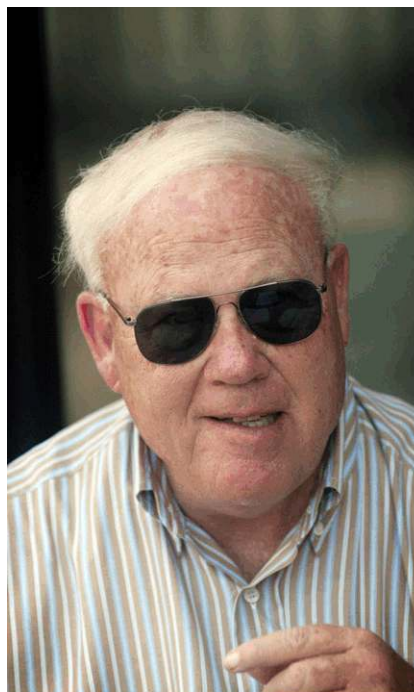

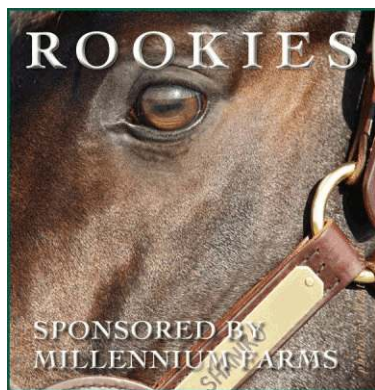

LORENZO BROGI RETIRES

Italian trainer Lorenzo Brogi has announced his retirement following the sixth-place finish of **Vol de Nuit** (GB) (Linamix {Fr}) in Friday's Listed Gran Premio UNIRE at Naples. Brogi has trained for most of the major Italian stables, a list which includes Carlo d'Alessio's Scuderia Cieffedi, the Palmieri family's Razza Spineta, AJB Stable and Sergio Scarpellini's Allevamento La Nuova Sbarra. His most recent champion was the dual G1 Premio Presidente della Repubblica hero **Distant Way** (Distant View) and he has garnered most of Italy's major prizes apart from the G1 Derby Italiano. "I would have won the Derby Italiano with Vol de Nuit as he was a different class, but he got injured before the race," claimed the veteran handler. Brogi's picturesque stables near the Ciampino training track in Rome will be taken over by son Fabio and nephew Simone, but he will not disappear from the scene altogether, as he is set to act in an advisory role. The horses of La Nuova Sbarra will be transferred to rookie trainer Giorgio Pucciatti who, until recently, acted as Brogi's head man. "It's a great challenge for me," commented Pucciatti. "Mr. Brogi and the Botti brothers have been my two main training bases and, having spent two years with the Bottis at the Siba training center near Brescia, I decided to come back to Rome with Mr. Brogi. To now go on my own with La Nuova Sbarra is a great opportunity."

ROYAL ACADEMY DONE SHUTTTLING The popular and successful dual-hemisphere stallion **Royal Academy** (Nijinsky II) will spend the rest of his career in Australia after officials at Coolmore Stud decided to permanently remove the 21-year-old from shuttle duties. "He will be covering mares next year," Coolmore's Michael Kirwan confirmed to *Australian Associated Press*. "Hopefully he still has a few more years ahead of him. We decided he has done enough travelling and will allow him to enjoy the more suitable conditions here." The 3/4-brother to Storm Cat was originally retired to stud in Ireland in 1991 and shuttled to Australia for the first time in 1994. He was the leading first-season sire in 1997-1998 and later covered mares in Brazil, where he was champion sire in 2005 and 2006. Royal Academy is the sire of 1,045 winners worldwide, including G1 Breeders' Cup Mile hero Val Royal (Fr), Sleepytime (Ire), Ali-Royal (Ire), Hong Kong Horse of the Year Bullish Luck, Bel Esprit (Aus) and Kenwood Melody (Aus). His best performers in 2007 include Oprah Winney, Molengao (Brz), Serious Speed (Aus) and Danzon.

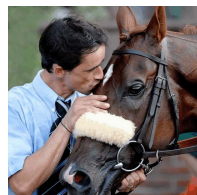
