THEWAY TO DO IT

For the past two years, Aidan O'Brien has brought his chief older horse to Longchamp for the G1 Prix Ganay



and duly conquered. While **Thewayyouare** (Kingmambo) is a darker prospect than either of Dylan Thomas (Ire) (Danehill) or Duke of Marmalade (Ire) (Danehill), the former Andre Fabre-trained

colt has the material to make an impact here. Successful in the G3 Prix Thomas Bryon and G1 Criterium International as a juvenile, the half to Peeping Fawn (Danehill) is bidding to get back on track after two unplaced efforts in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains here and G1 Prix du Jockey Club at Chantilly last term. "Thewayyouare arrived at Ballydoyle just after Christmas," O'Brien told *PA Sport*. "He was obviously a very good two-year-old when he was with Andre Fabre and then had a few little problems last year. We are happy with him and are hoping that he might come back to his two-year-old form. He is ready for his first start and we are looking forward to Sunday." **Cont. p10**

QUALITY ROAD UPDATE

Trainer Jimmy Jerkens held a teleconference yesterday morning to provide an update on the progress of G1 Kentucky Derby hopeful **Quality Road** (Elusive Quality). The three-year-old jogged at Belmont yesterday morning, and Jerkens was optimistic it would be all systems go for the trip to Churchill. "[After the jog], the crack looked dry and there was no blood seeping from it, so we're planning on patching him [Sunday] morning and galloping him after the second harrow break," the conditioner said, adding, "I'm usually negative about everything by nature, but the way he responded off of the last [quarter crack], and [Ian (McKinlay's)] reassurance, and the fact that he hasn't been sore--weight-bearing sore--on it, I'm pretty confident [he can make the Derby]. He's been sore on that one spot on top of the hairline when you press it, but he still has no soreness whatsoever when he's bearing weight on it, which is a big thing." The second-generation horseman indicated that Sunday's gallop is the biggest test **Quality Road** faces in his quest to make the Derby. "He'll have to get the patch and gallop sound and come out of the gallop sound," Jerkens said. "If he comes out of the gallop sound, I'd be really surprised if he was to work [Monday] and have any problem. [Sunday] is the big day as far as finding out where we're going."

As a G1 Prix de la Foret winner, Paco Boy had obvious strong claims dropping back in grade here but had to overcome the significant drawbacks of a six-pound penalty and the step up to a mile on a track with its renowned testing finish. Brilliant over seven last term, the bay collected Newbury's G3 Greenham S. and G2 Hungerford S. on either side of another impressive score in Goodwood's G2 Lennox S. prior to his career high in Longchamp's

Foret. Beaten but far from disgraced on all attempts at further, he rebounded off an unplaced run in the G1 Dubai Duty Free at Nad Al Sheba Mar. 28 with a more typically consistent performance here. Ridden with supreme confidence by Richard Hughes in behind the early leaders, he took over traveling easily before the eighth pole and was not hard pushed to hold Dream Eater in the run to the line. "It is a very stiff mile here, and he coped with it very well and was impressive," Richard Hannon Jr. said. "We were very keen to take the freshness off him here before the G1 Lockinge S. [at Newbury May 16] and he will take a lot of beating, in that as he was deadly at Newbury last year. Hughesy said he felt he excited him a bit too early here, so he's done well to give six pounds away in probably what was a good race. He's a very exciting horse, is very talented and easy to deal with, and they don't come along very often." Criticism picked up her third U.S. graded score with this determined victory. The Darley homebred was a listed winner and group placed in France, and opened her stateside campaign with a second in the GIII Athenia H. at Belmont last October. She followed up with a win in the Nov. 1 GIII Long Island H. at Aqueduct before getting a short break. The bay returned in the Feb. 22 GIII The Very One H. at Gulfstream, winning by 2 1/2 lengths, but faded to third in the Mar. 22 GIII Orchid H. last time out. Odds-on to get back on track here, Criticism went to the front, was allowed to lead through snailly fractions of :52.03, 1:17.89 and 1:42.11 and was kept busy in the final furlong to post the popular score. The key to her winning today was in the first quarter of a mile," jockey Javier Castellano said. "I knew if I could get her relaxed right out of the gate she would be there at the finish. I just tried to keep her going along as evenly as possible after that, and it went according to our plans." Criticism's primary goal this summer will be the GI Diana S. at Saratoga in August.

The chestnut capped off 2008 with a second-place finish in an optional claimer on the spinach at Santa Anita Dec. 27, and opened 2009 by filling out the exacta in a similar event that was moved to the Pro-Ride Feb. 13. Beaten just two lengths when sixth as a 48-1 shot in the Mar. 7 GI Frank E. Kilroe Mile H., he was 18-1 in the Apr. 4 GII Arcadia H., but just missed, rallying to run 3/4 of a length behind Dixie Chatter (Dixie Union). Mr Napper Tandy used those late-charging tactics to their full advantage this time. Hull earned ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ status with his 4 1/4-length maiden tally at Fair Grounds Feb. 7, and underlined that call with a 7 3/4-length optional-claiming win at Turfway Apr. 2. Mr. Fantasy, a half to the ill-fated Tin Cup Chalice (Crusader Sword), kicked off his career with a 10 1/2-length romp in a New York-bred maiden test at the Big A Dec. 28. The West Point colorbearer came back to take a restricted allowance by 8 1/2 lengths Feb. 1, and earned a shot in the Mar. 7 GIII Gotham S. Wesley drew post 12 in this event and hadn't hit the board in his past five starts, but that didn't worry the crowd. month, the homebred suffered from an infection after his subsequent Curragh effort and had to prove his ability remained intact following his absence from the major finales of 2008. Dropped out early by Ryan Moore, the chestnut had allowed Pipedreamer a formidable start before the quarter pole but found the gears that saw him go so close in two Classics to wear down that rival in the shade of the post. "I didn't want him to have too rough a time of it, so I was a bit out of my ground at the three and when Jimmy [Fortune] kicked I was surprised how well Pipedreamer picked up and he caught me out. I was trying to be clever, as I didn't want to commit my horse too soon and he nicked a couple of lengths but mine really wants it and put his head down. He hadn't down that much work and the boss left plenty to work on, so with any luck he'll be winning some good races this year."

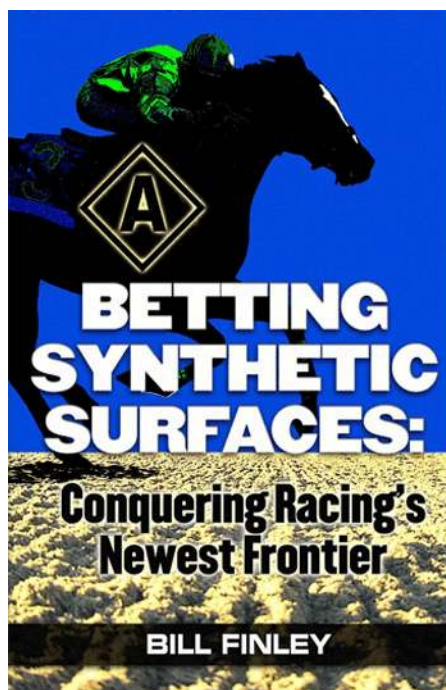

Trainer Charles Laird told *sahorseracing.com*, "I'm very proud of this horse; we set him up for this race a long time ago. He threw a curve ball by winning a Group 1 last time, and he still won."

Proven over a mile in graduation plate and handicap company, the chestnut was a major disappointment when last in the G2 Gauteng Guineas Feb. 28, and fared little better when seventh in the Pinnacle S. over seven furlongs Mar. 14. A tiring eighth after having the run of things early in the G1 SA Classic over 1 1/8 miles a fortnight later, the homebred had stamina doubts to quell in this test. Restrained behind the leading group, he was cut loose with a quarter mile remaining and, after storming clear, was kept up to his work as Magical closed all too late.

A Stoute Chance...

Sir Michael Stoute has yet to win this prestigious prize and saddles an intriguing contender in Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's **Tajaaweed** (Dynaformer). Successful on his seasonal bow in 2008 in the G3 Dee S. at Chester, the imposing bay was only eighth in the G1 Epsom Derby and fifth in the G2 York S. when last seen in July. The owner's Racing Manager Angus Gold is hopeful he can make up for lost time here. "He is a great big horse, but still quite weak and took a bit of time to mature," he told *PA Sport*. "We went down the Derby route,

which didn't quite work out. It's a big ask first time out, but a good starting point for the year."

Win-Win Situation?

Another British-trained hopeful is Teruya Yoshida's acquisition **Cima de Triomphe (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}), who has failed to add to his tally in the G1 Derby Italiano last May. Seventh in the G1 Grand Prix de Paris here in July, he was a respectable ninth in the venue's feature G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe in October, with the top-class Meisho Samson (Jpn) (Opera House {GB}), Kamsin (Ger) (Samum {Ger}) and Papal Bull (GB) (Montjeu {Ire}) behind. His major disappointment came when trailing on his final start in the G1 Premio Roma back in Rome the following month, and Luca Cumani, who brought Falbrav (Ire) here to be third in 2003, is hoping he can turn over a new leaf. "He's a very straightforward horse, a very good looking horse," the master of Bedford House Stables said. "He has been training well and he is ready for his first start of the year. He seems to have sufficient speed to make me think that he will be effective over a mile and a quarter." Elie Lellouche, who collected this with Vert Amande (Fr) (Kenmare {Fr}) in 1993, Helissio (Fr) (Fairy King) in 1997 and Aquarelliste (Fr) (Danehill) in 2002, saddles Ecurie Wildenstein's **Loup Breton (Ire)** (Anabaa). Having beaten Spirit One (Fr) (Anabaa Blue {GB}) in the G2 Prix d'Harcourt at this track 12 months ago, the homebred spent much of the remainder of the 2008 season playing second fiddle to the top runners. Only fourth in the latest renewal of the d'Harcourt last time Apr. 5, he has improvement to find to figure here.

Champions Mile cont.

Twelve months ago, local hero **Viva Pataca** came into the QE II Cup off a runner-up effort as the betting favorite in the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic and was sent off the even-money chalk to annex this important event on the Hong Kong racing calendar. But it was **Archipenko**, from the internationally successful of trainer Mike de Kock, who stole the show at 15-1. The two are back for the rematch this afternoon, with the notable difference that Viva Pataca was not travelled this winter and instead remained at home for a local preparation. A troubled fourth in the G1 Hong Kong Cup Dec. 13, the veteran came from 11th to grab third behind Good Ba Ba in the 1600-meter Stewards Cup Jan. 24, then successfully defended in the Hong Kong Gold Cup Feb. 22, though he made hard work of it in besting **Packing Winner** by a neck. He enters off a third in the Chairman's Trophy over an insufficient 1600 meters Apr. 5 and is set for a top effort from a tricky draw. Whereas Archipenko prepped with a third in the G1 Dubai Duty Free S. last season, he could manage only a sixth to the front-running Gladiatus (Silic {Fr}) this year. The five-year-old should go better here over a more comfortable distance. **Niconero** was a good fourth in the Duty Free and carries the hopes of trainer David Hayes, who recorded 458 winners during a 10-year stint in Hong Kong from 1995 to 2005.

Trainer Saeed bin Suroor got just what he wanted when sending out **Regal Ransom** (Distorted Humor) and **Desert Party** (Street Cry {Ire}) for their final GI Kentucky Derby preps at Churchill yesterday. "They both worked nicely this morning," trainer bin Suroor said. "They are really in good form here, and that is a good sign. They will walk tomorrow, jog Monday and then gallop up to the race. They both may go to the gate and paddock one time next week." He added, "They are fit and ready to go. There will be no excuses for our horses."

Dunkirk Gets Final Work at Palm Meadows...

GI Florida Derby runner-up **Dunkirk** (Unbridled's Song) was on the work tab at Palm Meadows yesterday morning, with clockers catching the grey going five panels in 1:01.05. "I was very, very pleased with the work," trainer Todd Pletcher said. "I caught him in splits of :12 4/5, :24 4/5, :36 4/5 and 1:01, and I had him galloping out in 1:14 2/5. It was a very good move for him." Pletcher believes the colt has a serious chance of breaking

the trainer's 0-for-21 streak in the first leg of the Triple Crown. "We couldn't be more pleased with the way things have gone as he's come up to this race," Pletcher said. "Everything has fallen into place. Every one of his works has taken place when we wanted it to, and they have all come off the way we hoped. He's coming up to the race right and we're feeling very good about him. We couldn't be happier."

Clockers Keeping Busy At Churchill...

In addition to Godolphin's two Derby runners, three other "Run for the Roses" candidates had their last major workouts at Churchill Downs yesterday morning. GI Arkansas Derby hero **Papa Clem** (Smart Strike) went seven furlongs in 1:29.20 after cutting out splits of :24.80, :49.60, 1:02.40 and 1:15.40. The move didn't come together quite the way trainer Gary Stute had hoped. "The main goal was just to get him tired," Stute remarked. "He broke off kind of fast and got a little 'late.'" Stute said the dark bay could blow out a quarter mile a day or two before the Derby "if he's biting and kicking." **Musket Man** (Yonaguska) had an eventful trip around the oval as he worked five furlongs in 1:01.60. Jockey Eibar Coa was in the irons. "A horse crossed in front of him when he broke off," trainer Derek Ryan said, "and that got him a little excited. Then, near the eighth pole, some guy going the wrong way of the track ducked over toward the rail. A little excitement, but no big deal. Nothing happened." He continued, "It was a good work, just what we wanted. I didn't want him to do too much a week before the race." Just how far Musket Man might want to go has been the subject of debate, but the colt had no trouble handling nine furlongs when taking the GI Illinois Derby last time out, and his Irish-born conditioner is confident a mile and a quarter is within his scope as well. "I've been hearing about his distance limitations since October," Ryan offered. "So far he's handled every track and every distance." Ryan is familiar on the Jersey circuit, as is trainer Kelly Breen, who will send out his first Derby starter when **West Side Bernie** (Bernstein) takes to the gate on the first Saturday in May. The runner-up in the GI Wood Memorial S., West Side Bernie worked a half in :48.20 under jockey Stewart Elliott, who guided Smarty Jones to victory in the 2004 Kentucky Derby. "I told 'Stew' to go in :48, so it was just what I wanted," Breen said. "Better a fifth slower than a second too fast. The track has been kind of dull, so I think that was a very good work. And 'Stew' told me that he had a lot of horse left when he passed the wire. I was happy he stayed well within himself today, instead of leaving his race on the track. He got something out of the work without knocking himself out. The time was as close to the plan as you can get, so I'm happy."

TDN Quote du Jour

Jimmy Jerkens, regarding the possibility that foot problems run in Quality Road's family:

"I had a three-quarter sister to him, last year...and we had a horrible time with her. We were forever patching up quarter cracks--matter of fact, there got to be a point where we didn't really think it was worth going on anymore and she's a broodmare now, so it certainly looks like it could be hereditary."

Surgery for Fitz Just Right...

West Point Thoroughbreds' **Fitz Just Right** (Seattle Fitz {Arg}) came out of a five-furlong drill Friday with a chip in her right front ankle; she had been a contender for the GI Kentucky Oaks May 1 at Churchill Downs. "When she came back, she was not 100 percent," said trainer Kiaran McLaughlin. "We x-rayed the ankle and discovered the chip. She will get some time off. She is going to the Woodford Clinic in Versailles with Dr. [William] Baker." Winner of the Darley OBS Championship S. Feb. 16, the bay filly was most recently second in the GIII Bourbonette Oaks at Turfway Mar. 21.



Classic Corner

FRONTIERES YORK-BOUND Sir Robert Ogden's **Sans Frontieres (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) will put his Derby credentials on the line in York's G2 Dante S., trainer Jeremy Nosedo announced yesterday. Runner-up to Delegator (GB) (Dansili {GB}) in the Apr. 16 G3 Craven S. at Newmarket, the chestnut will step up to 10 furlongs for the May 14 trial, which is expected to attract **Crowded House (GB)** (Rainbow Quest), the Tattersalls 3YO Trophy winner **Nehaam (GB)** (Nayef), Godolphin's **Kite Wood (Ire)** (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) and the inevitable Ballydoyle presence. "He has taken his race at Newmarket very well and I am happy with him," his trainer commented. "For what was only the second run of his life, we were delighted with the level of his performance. He will be suited by the step up to a mile and a quarter and, although it is shaping up, as usual, to be the premier and most competitive Derby trial--with Crowded House and Kite Wood scheduled to run--it's a race that will tell us where we stand and also what his future program is likely to be."

Lording It at Ripon...

Connections of **Lord Shanakill** (Speightstown) expressed their satisfaction yesterday with the G2 Mill Reef S. winner's racecourse gallop at Ripon ahead of Saturday's G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket. Mark Gittins's colt, runner-up in the G1 Dewhurst S. at that track in October, was partnered by Darren Williams and, after following two companions, got narrowly on top at the finish. "We were very happy with the work, it all went to plan," trainer Karl Burke told *PA Sport*. "He didn't really handle the undulations, but it can be a bit of a hit-or-miss track for some horses. It was good to get the gallop into him. We could have come and done it quietly tomorrow but we wanted to get as much out of it as possible, let him see the crowds and put that edge on him. I'm delighted with him though and he might just have another blow before Newmarket." Burke also confirmed that regular rider Jim Crowley would retain the mount for the mile Classic. "He won on him and was second on him in the Dewhurst last year and after a discussion with the owners, we felt it was the right thing to do."

JUSTENUFFHUMOR (c, 4, [Distorted Humor](#)--Justenuffheart {MSW & GSP, \$373,229}, by Broad Brush) didn't do much in his Oct. 23 debut on Keeneland's Polytrack, fading to ninth in a seven-furlong maiden, but has been unstoppable since returning on grass this season. After graduating in a one-mile maiden at Gulfstream Jan. 14 ([video](#)), the regally bred colt came from way out of it to take an allowance at that track Mar. 28 ([video](#)) and was the second choice here. The 5-2 second choice tucked into a ground-saving fifth from his rail post, then drew closer on the far turn. When a hole opened up on the fence, Eddie Castro sent him through and the bay shifted gears nicely for a smart 3 1/4-length score over Radical Sabbatical (Harlan's Holiday). The \$550,000 KEESEP yearling is a half-brother to Lewis Michael (Rahy), MGSW, \$811,714; and Dreaming of Anna (Rahy), Ch. 2yo Filly, GISW, \$2,024,550.
