### THIS ONE'S FOR THE GIRLS

Two years ago, Calvin Borel appeared to be on his way to taking the GI Preakness S. aboard Street Sense (Street Cry {Ire}). But over his right shoulder, he caught a glimpse of his good friend Robby Albarado carrying the gold and burgundy colors of Jess Jackson's Stonestreet Stables, and Curlin (Smart Strike) was along in time to derail Borel's Triple Crown dreams. When GI Kentucky Oaks heroine **Rachel Alexandra** (Medaglia d'Oro) was acquired privately in a deal rumored to be in the ballpark of \$10 million, there was

some question as to whether Borel, whose relationship with the filly dated back to her last five starts--all victorious--would retain the mount for the Preakness. After all, Albarado and Asmussen teamed to win an additional half-dozen Grade/Group 1 events from the Jersey Shore to the deserts of Dubai, while Borel had struck out in 12 rare mounts for Asmussen. Nonetheless, Borel, it was ultimately decided, knew Rachel Alexandra the best and it was announced he would be in the saddle for the Preakness. The rest, as they say, is history. Rachel Alexandra, the first filly to go favored in the Preakness since Kentucky Derby winner Winning Colors (19-10) in 1988, did what that filly could not do, leading virtually every step of the way to become the first female winner of the Classic since Nellie Morse back in 1924.

### GOLDIKOVA RETURNS AT LONGCHAMP

Last year's GI Breeders' Cup Mile heroine **Goldikova** (Ire) (Anabaa) makes her return in the G1 Prix d'Ispahan going an extended nine furlongs at Longchamp today. The four-year-old filly reserves her best for this venue, and put in her finest domestic efforts here last term.

Runner-up to Zarkava (Ire) (Zamindar) in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches in May, she accounted for Darjina (Fr) (Zamindar) and the subsequently disqualified Paco Boy (Ire) (Desert Style {Ire}) in the G1 Prix du Moulin in September, as she prepared for her subse-

quent dazzling display at Santa Anita. She stayed the 1 5/16-mile-trip of the G1 Prix de Diane well enough when third at Chantilly in June, and should find this trip within her comfort zone. "This has been her target for some time and the filly is in great shape," trainer Freddy Head, who partnered Riverman (Never Bend), Carwhite (Ire) (Caro), Baillamont (Blushing Groom {Fr}) and Miesque (Nureyev) to success in this race, told the *Racing Post*.

**Rachel Rousing From the Start...**

Reasoning that his Medaglia d'Oro filly bred from his talented homebred Lotta Kim (Roar) would not bring the money he thought she should, Dolphus Morrison instead decided to hang onto his filly and race her. A maiden winner at second asking, she returned on 15 days' rest to post a runner-up effort in the Gill Debutante S., but was sidelined thereafter with an injury. She made a splashy return to action, taking a Keeneland allowance with supreme ease Oct. 17, but, back just 15 days later, was blocked for a run and settled for a runner-up effort in the Nov. 1

Gill Pocahontas S. at Churchill Downs. She accomplished what her dam could not, scoring by 4 3/4

lengths in the Gill Golden Rod S. Nov. 29 and earning the highest two-turn figure for a juvenile filly in 2008. That she failed to earn so much as a spot on the Eclipse ballot will go down as a tremendous oversight, as she picked up at three where she left off at two.

A convincing eight-length winner of Oaklawn's Martha Washington S. Feb. 15, her 1 1/2-length margin of success in the Gill Fair Grounds Oaks Mar. 14 belied the ease and dominance with which she accomplished it. Morrison and trainer Hal Wiggins decided to give their filly one more prep for the GI Kentucky Oaks, sending her back to Oaklawn for the Apr. 5 Gill Fantasy S. A dime on the dollar seemed generous, as she waltzed home 8 3/4 lengths to the good. The Oaks itself proved to be another tour-de-force. Allowed to stalk the pace, Rachel Alexandra pulled Borel to the front as they approached the stretch and, while never being asked to run, drew off to win by a historic 20 1/4 lengths.

Since the deal to purchase Rachel Alexandra came together rather quickly, the intent seemed clear. While Morrison vowed in the Oaks winner's circle that he would not entertain the idea of trying the boys in the Preakness or beyond, the Stonestreet team were focused on the trip to Baltimore. A five-furlong breeze May 10 in :48 2/5 was followed by the official green light for the Preakness. The naysayers thought her front-running style in a field more packed with speed than even the Kentucky Derby, the competition and the quick turnaround could be the filly's undoing. Those who backed other Preakness runners would be delighted that their favorite would start at inflated odds in the second leg of the Triple Crown. In the end, there would be plenty of torn tickets. **Cont. p3**

**A History-Making Performance...**

The start of the Preakness was delayed momentarily by **Big Drama** (Montbrook), who reared and threw jockey John Velazquez. Reloaded without incident, the Florida invader jumped well from the inside gate, while Rachel Alexandra broke a bit to her outside, but recovered and ranged up outside Big Drama, who raced a bit off the fence, and the duo raced through an opening quarter mile in a sharp :23.13. **Friesan Fire** (A.P. Indy), looking to atone for his 18th-place effort as the Derby

favorite, was close up, as was **Pioneerof the Nile** (Empire Maker), the runner-up in the "Run for the Roses," who seemed to be struggling as they raced around the first turn. **Mine That Bird** (Birdstone), the Derby upsetter, was predictably last of 13 as Rachel Alexandra continued, ears pricked, through a contested opening half-

mile in :46.71. A half-length separated the front-runners, but the filly began to open some daylight as they approached the far turn, while the back markers Mine That Bird and **Flying Private** (Fusaichi Pegasus) were beginning to launch their rallies in earnest. Asked to lengthen away from her male rivals as they turned into the stretch, Rachel Alexandra quickly opened up and was four lengths clear into the final furlong. In the meantime, Mine That Bird, stymied for a fraction of a second before knifing between the weakening Pioneerof the Nile and **General Quarters** (Sky Mesa), launched a game rally while four lanes off the inside and was getting to Rachel Alexandra, but the wire loomed and the Oaks winner, in receipt of five pounds all around, held on for the victory. **Musket Man** (Yonaguska) came from the second half of the field to be third in another honest-as-the-day-is-long performance, while Flying Private got through inside to round out the superfecta.

**Looks Can Be Deceiving...**

To think the winner was possibly not firing on all cylinders is something of an ominous thought, but one issued by her pilot. "She struggled a lot [with the track]," Borel explained. "She's so used to that track at Churchill. She just skips along. She was struggling at the end. I had to get into her a little bit. The first quarter was good, then, we picked it up. The more I asked her the more she struggled. She'd never been hit before." And while stating that turning for home he was 'home free,' Borel added, "I knew [Mine That Bird] was coming. It's going to take a racehorse to beat her. She's the greatest racehorse I've been on in my life. She did not handle the track 110 percent."

**Mine That Bird Validates His Derby Run...**

Many were willing to dismiss Mine That Bird's Derby success as a one-off performance, but those critics were silenced by a barnstorming run which fell just one length shy at the finish. "I'm thrilled to death with the race my little horse ran," said trainer Bennie "Chip" Woolley, who seemed to enjoy the Preakness experience a great deal more than the Derby. "Everything was going according to Hoyle, until the turn when he was fanned a little wide. I thought we had a chance at the eighth-pole. But you have to give that filly credit. She's a great one. The Belmont is next for us."

**And As For Rachel?...**

Connections are inclined to wait a few days before making a decision on the Belmont for Rachel Alexandra. "We'll look at that," said Jess Jackson, referring to the third leg of the Triple Crown. "I'd love to race in New York. The Belmont is always a consideration for a champion. It will depend on her. The horse always tells you whether they're ready. She may be coming out more tired than I know. The Belmont will be determined by her and how she rebounds from this race. That said, she'll run against the boys again somewhere." **VIRTUAL REALITY**

Cheveley Park Stud has come to have a stranglehold on Newbury's G1 Juddmonte Lockinge S., and it was **Virtual (GB)** (Pivotal {GB}) who made it win number seven for David and Patricia Thompson's operation as he nosed out **Alexandros (GB)** (Kingmambo) yesterday. Off the back of a third in the Apr. 25 G2 Sandown Mile, the homebred raced close to the early pace set by **Twice Over (GB)** (Observatory) and required every bit of the mile to grind his way past that rival and the eventual runner-up to win at 6-1. "I thought [Alexandros] had got me, but my lad stuck his head out again," jockey Jimmy Fortune said. "After the line, he was a head in front of me. He needed his run the last day and the soft ground was in our favor."

A slow-burner at three, Virtual was a staggering 14-1 when winning his first handicap over a mile at Doncaster in September but made progress afterwards when registering a brace of wins in the Listed Prix le Fabuleux at Maisons-Laffitte in October and Listed Ben Marshall S. at Newmarket the following month. He was racing on good ground when a length third behind Paco Boy (Ire) (Desert Style {Ire}) in receipt of six pounds from that rival at Sandown, but the heavy downpour that preceded this contest threatened to swing matters

more his way. Along with the timing of that rainburst, luck in running may also have played its part as Frankie Dettori lost his whip on Alexandros after that rival had gained the edge over the long-time leader Twice Over in the final 50 yards. Jimmy Fortune added, "We didn't have much of a plan

other than to go forward and luckily there was plenty of pace, so we kicked on three out, and he's done it like a real game horse. Paco Boy gave us six pounds and a good beating at Sandown, so we had a fair bit to turn around but this horse was probably only eighty percent there and the ground was faster. The track probably suited him here as well as the soft ground and everything has gone his way today. He's got that high cruising speed and although he has a turn of foot, he is more of a galloper and a step up in trip will suit him. They all came to have a crack and he's probably outstayed them." Connections are looking at the G1 Eclipse S. at Sandown July 4, while Alexandros is likely to be aimed at the G3 Diomed S. at Epsom June 5.

Scenic Shot got up in the shadow of the wire to nip pacesetting Sir Slick and held off Racing to Win to prevail in a thrilling finish. "He has done it great," said trainer Len Morton, deputizing for his son, trainer Dan Mortan. "If ever a horse should have been able to win a Group 1, this guy deserved it. We are really thrilled for him. He has been a very consistent horse wherever he has gone. He has been placed in Group 1s, he has won his Group 2s and 3s, like here last year, so he is just one of those really honest and great little horses to work with." Scenic Shot, purchased for A\$36,000 at the 2004 Magic Millions Perth Yearling Sale, has now won 12 of 47 starts with earnings over A\$1.48 million. "This Group 1 has been a long time coming," winning jockey Shane Scriven told *Sky Channel*. "There have been plenty of seconds and I thought I would return when I rode my next one. But bugger that--this is too much fun."

Seattle Smooth has now won five of six starts on conventional dirt, her lone loss coming when she ran third in the slop at Pimlico in the GII Black-Eyed Susan S. a year ago. Trained at that time by Julio Canani, the

bay filly ran ninth in her final start for him in the GII San Clemente H. on the Del Mar lawn July 26. She was sent east to Tony Dutrow and promptly aired by 7 1/4 lengths in the Go for Wand S. at Delaware Aug. 30, then capped her sophomore season by defeating champion Proud

Spell (Proud Citizen) in the GII Fitz Dixon Cotillion S. at Philly Park Sept. 20. The Mercedes Stables colorbearer resumed her career Apr. 18 with an ultra impressive 5 3/4-length score in the GII Bed O' Roses H. over seven furlongs at Aqueduct. That effort saw her pounded at the windows this time, but she definitely had to work for it. Seattle Smooth broke from the rail and settled just a couple of lengths off the lead along the fence. Jockey Ramon Dominguez was sitting on a ton of horse turning for home, but was stuck behind a trio of fillies after three-quarters in 1:10.57. Angled to the outside approaching the final furlong, the crowd's choice found another gear and surged late to secure her third graded trophy. "It was a workmanlike effort and she was in a dicey spot at the top of the stretch," said Dutrow. "Since we started on her last fall, our goal was to try and win a Grade I with her and the 'Big Sandy' [Belmont Park] is where the Grade Is are. The next race is the [GI] Ogden Phipps H. 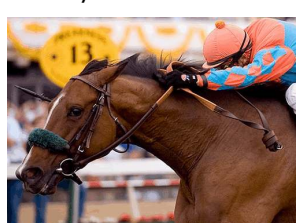

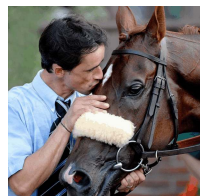


