WELCOME TO FANTASY ISLAND

The back of jockey Alex Solis's silks pretty much said it all. "Winner." For the second straight time, David Bienstock, Paul Mandabach and Chuck Winner's **Magical Fantasy** (Diesis {GB}) crossed the line first, and yesterday landed the second Grade I race of her career when she accounted for **Visit (GB)** (Oasis Dream {GB}) and **Diamond Diva (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) in the Gamely S. at Hollywood Park. The 42-1 upsetter in last year's

GI Del Mar Oaks, the chestnut filly, though winless at Hollywood, had displayed a liking for the course, missing by a nose in last year's GIII Senorita S. and going a close fourth in the GI Matriarch S., both over an insufficient one mile. Tried on the synthetic for the first two starts of

this season, **Magical Fantasy** acquitted herself well against **Life Is Sweet (Storm Cat)**, missing by 3/4 of a length when second in the GII La Canada S. Feb. 15 and fourth in the GI Santa Margarita H. Mar. 14. Back on her preferred surface for her latest, she benefitted from an inside trip and found the line a nose better than **Black Mamba (NZ)** (Black Minnaloushe) in the GII Santa Barbara H. in Arcadia Apr. 18. Held up towards the back of this field as a generous betting proposition, **Magical Fantasy** was switched out four wide for the drive and rallied under urging to be up late. "She's such a professional, you can do anything you want with her," Solis commented. "She's really game and she's getting better and better. I was surprised to see her pay \$14, she just beat the same kind. I was afraid of **Black Mamba** coming late, but I never saw her."

The decision to keep Rutherienne in training at age five continues to pay dividends, as the homebred eclipsed the \$1-million mark in career earnings with this much-the-best success. Winner of the GI Del Mar Oaks in 2007, the dark bay was up to take the GII Jenny Wiley S. in her four-year-old debut last April, then proceeded to post no fewer than six consecutive third-place finishes, running behind champion Forever Together (Belong to Me) in the GI Diana S. in July and the GI First Lady S. in October. She rounded out the triple, this time as the favorite, in the GIII My Charmer H. at Calder Dec. 6, and returned from a winter's rest to be runner-up to Forever Together in this year's running of the Jenny Wiley Apr. 11. Handier than is her custom as they went only a moderate pace up front, Rutherienne remained right at the heels of the leaders, but in need of room into the stretch. The gap finally came two off the fence approaching the eighth pole, and Rutherienne punched through and was moving away late. "On paper, there wasn't too much speed in the race," said winning rider Alan Garcia. "My filly was comfortable where she was. I wanted to be patient until the top of the stretch. It's a long stretch and the last quarter, I was looking for room. Then it opened up a little bit and I had a small opening. I wanted to take advantage. She went in there and she kept on going."

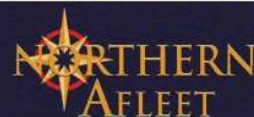

A maiden winner on the turf at Aqueduct in November, Gozzip Girl opened 2009 with a third in a grass allowance at Gulfstream Jan. 15. The dark bay came back to win the Feb. 15 Coconut Grove S. and Mar. 15 GIII Herecomesthebride S. on the Hallandale course, then switched to the Keeneland Poly and just missed, running second by a neck in the Apr. 4 GI Ashland S. Returning to the spinach here, she was sent right to the front, cruised through six panels in 1:15.78 on the rain-softened lawn and held longshot Warm Shower at bay in the final furlong. "She was the best horse in the field and she got it done," jockey Kent Desormeaux said. The winner will be pointed for the July 5 GI American Oaks going 10 panels at Hollywood. A debut second going six panels at the Fair Grounds Dec. 18, Hightap graduated by 9 1/4 lengths when tried around two turns Jan. 17. Ninth to Conduit (Ire) (Dalakhani {Ire}) in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Turf Oct. 25, Spring House was fourth over in the Dec. 6 GIII Native Diver H. over the Hollywood Cushion Track and filled the same spot in the GII San Marcos S. back on the grass at Santa Anita Jan. 19. The veteran bounced back with a half-length victory in the GII San Luis Obispo H. Feb. 22, but followed with a dull fifth as the favorite in the Mar. 21 GII San Luis Rey H. The dark bay was a 5-1 chance in the GII San Juan Capistrano H. over 14 grassy furlongs, but he could not quite catch the free-running Midships (Mizzen Mast) and settled for the place. Heavily favored in his first visit to Northern California, Spring House was rated along in the second half of the field as they went no kind of pace up front. Snugly at the fence and enjoying the run of the race as they approached the final bend, the gelding got through on the turn, responded when set down for the drive and was going away at the wire.

Returned to this main track for his latest at this track May 10, the dark bay came from just off a swift pace to post a two-length allowance score over Vicarian (Vicar) and employed similar tactics to secure back-to-back victories for the first time in his career. Three deep on the track as Garifine (Belong to Me) cut out the fractions in advance of Semaphore Man, Bold Start was asked for his best by Robby Albarado turning for home, reeled in Semaphore Man at the furlong grounds and pulled clear. "He deserves it," commented winning trainer Ken McPeek. "He's been so solid for so long. It seems like he was always knocking on the door, but hadn't quite gotten over it. Main Aim, a smart prospect early last term, looked group class as he quickened clear to land a decent six-furlong handicap by seven lengths at Newbury on his seasonal bow last time May 16. Proving the point here, the homebred raced freely in second through the opening stages before taking over at the quarter pole and scoring in straightforward fashion. "He has come and proved the class he is, and that is always a relief," the owner/breeder's Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe told *PA Sport*. "He showed speed, then settled well and, although he idled a little bit, he has gone on and done it very well. He is in the [June 20] G1 Golden Jubilee S. at Royal Ascot, but he is also in the G1 Sussex S. [at Goodwood July 29], so there are possibly mile races to consider too. 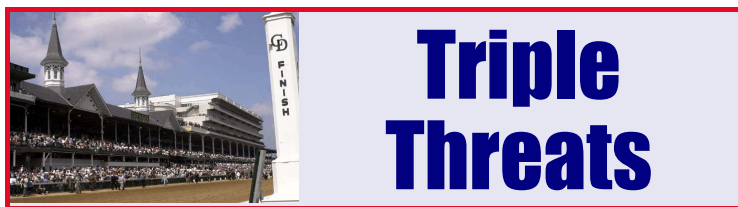

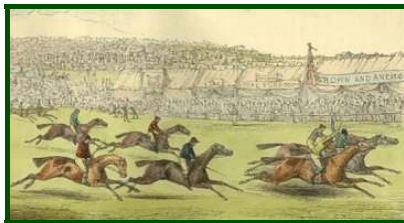

Again and Beauty Swerve Oaks; Dozen Remain...

Leading Irish contenders **Again (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) and **Beauty o'Gwaun (Ire)** (Rainbow Quest) were high-profile scratches from Friday's G1 Investec Oaks as the six-day entries were announced yesterday. While trainer David Wachman had previously suggested that the Epsom Classic may come too soon for Again following her success in last Sunday's G1 Irish 1000 Guineas, John Oxx had been considering a tilt at the prize with Neil Jones's G3 Blue Wind S. winner Beauty o'Gwaun. He explained the late decision to *Racing Post*, "Having spoken with Beauty o'Gwaun's owner/breeder Neil Jones last night, we have decided against running the filly in the Oaks. We were always a bit concerned about her lack of experience. She has had only the two races, winning both of them, but she was still quite green when she won the Blue Wind S. at Naas this month. Her recent work didn't send out the right signals that she had come on enough since the Naas race to be able to overcome her inexperience at Epsom. We've decided to wait a bit longer before running her again." Of the 12 remaining, Lady Bamford's G3 Musidora S. heroine **Sariska (GB)** (Pivotal {GB}) looks set to start favorite. Her trainer Michael Bell commented, "She needs a bit of graft, as she eats and sleeps very well, and we just need to keep her fresh and well. We don't know whether she handles this track, but we know she goes left-handed, as she went around York, and I would hope she will." George Strawbridge's 2008 champion **Rainbow View** (Dynaformer), Khalid Abdullah's Listed Lingfield Oaks Trial scorer **Midday (GB)** (Oasis Dream {GB}) and Anne Marie O'Brien's Listed Cheshire Oaks winner **Perfect Truth (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) are other notables remaining.

He added, "Aidan has got six horses for the Derby, with **Age of Aquarius (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}), **Black Bear Island (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), **Masterofthehorse (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), **Rip Van Winkle(Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}), **Fame and Glory (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}) and **Golden Sword (GB)** (High Chaparral {Ire}) all running. **Freemantle (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}) is a probable non-runner, and **Johann Zoffany (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}) probably doesn't run. Those two are both possibles for Royal Ascot. **Malibu Bay** (El Prado {Ire}) definitely doesn't run, and he goes for the French Derby. Along with him in the French Derby are **Westphalia (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) and **Drumbeat (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}), and **Set Sail (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) is a possible for France. There has been no decision on who is going to ride what yet, because the horses will work again next week, and the ground and other factors will come into play."

Why do you want to serve on the Breeders' Cup Board?

We can do this by increasing the value, not the cost, of a stallion and/or foal's nomination. My successful terms as President of the NYTB, where I was victorious in battles with the New York



State Legislature over VLT splits, combined with my background in business and my education make me an excellent candidate. I have worked exclusively in our industry. I am located in Kentucky, and I travel to almost every major auction. I have met many breeders and stallion owners, here in Kentucky and across the country. If elected, this is the constituency I will serve. I will try to use the Breeders' Cup to make breeding more financially rewarding.

A company needs to focus on customers. The Breeders' Cup's customers are the breeders who pay the nominations. To increase the number of nominations (revenue), we need to increase the value that the nominator receives for each stallion/foal nominated. We must continue to strive for a series of races that Breeders' Cup nominees can benefit from, further benefiting their nominators and broadening the impact of the Breeders' Cup on our industry.

Increased nominations will provide for a better bottom line, allowing the Breeders' Cup to spend more money attracting sponsorships and advertising races. If done effectively and in a consistent manner, these efforts will multiply, and increased handle and TV ratings will result. We only have four or five "Big Days" left in American racing. We must exert maximum effort to improve the revenue streams that feed the Breeders' Cup or face the consequences of drastic losses to purses, marketing opportunities and sponsorships.

TRO Denied; Theriot Suspension Begins:

An Illinois judge denied jockey Jamie Theriot a temporary restraining order seeking to delay the rider's 30-day suspension, and the rider appeared set to begin serving his days yesterday. In a ruling handed down this past Monday by Arlington Park stewards, Theriot was cited for having bumped Born to Be (A.P. Indy) while riding Sky Mom (Maria's Mon) in the GIII Arlington Matron S. Born to Be clipped heels and fell, seriously injuring jockey Rene Douglas, who remains at least temporarily paralyzed in a Chicago hospital. Born to Be's injuries proved catastrophic. Theriot had previously stated that he did not want to have to appeal the suspension, but did so when he and his legal counsel deemed the penalty excessive. Temporary restraining orders are often granted to jockeys, who are then allowed to continue riding up to the point where the appeal is approved or denied. However, Theriot's appeal would not be heard by the Illinois Racing Board for at least a couple of weeks and it would take additional time for the Board to issue their ruling. Suspended riders are often permitted to ride in stakes races, but Illinois suspensions in excess of 10 days do not carry that exception. Theriot will not return to the saddle until June 29.

Breeders' Cup Releases 2008 Annual Report:

Breeders' Cup Ltd. yesterday sent out its 2008 annual report to Breeders' Cup nominators. The consolidated financial statements for the years ending Dec. 31, 2007 and Dec. 31, 2008 were audited by the independent firm of Crowe Horwarth LLP of Louisville, Kentucky. In a letter that accompanied the report, President and CEO Greg Avioli noted that Breeders' Cup will distribute \$30.5 million in purses in 2009--\$25.5 million for the World Thoroughbred Championship purses, and \$5 million for the Breeders' Cup stakes program. As a result, the organization will have an operating deficit for 2009. "This deficit is largely driven by projected declines in nominations levels and Championships host site fees," Avioli said in the letter. "While the decision to operate at such a large deficit was not made lightly, the consensus of Board Members and Trustees was that a targeted one-time use of the organization's reserves was warranted to fund the shortfall and show support for our nominators and the broader industry in this period of unprecedented economic turmoil." **For the complete report, click [here](#).**
