THE OTHER BIRD IS THE WORD

All eyes were on **Mine That Bird** (Birdstone) as he swept to the front at the top of the stretch in the 141st running of the GI Belmont S., and it seemed the little

gelding would follow his sire into the Belmont history books. But it was another from Birdstone's first crop that found himself in the winner's circle. **Summer Bird** (Birdstone) did as his father had done just five years ago, grinding past the betting and sentimental choice in the final yards to take the third leg of the Triple Crown. It was

sweet vindication for jockey Kent Desormeaux, erasing the memory of his aborted Triple Crown bid on Big Brown last year; and sweet celebration for rookie trainer Tim Ice, who turned 35 yesterday. **Cont. p2**

Mine That Bird Gets the Bronze...

Mine That Bird, obviously leg weary in the waning yards, could not stave off the re-rallying pacesetter **Dunkirk** (Unbridled's Song), who battled back from the inside to get second. But the bay once again demonstrated that his shock victory in the GI Kentucky Derby hero was far from a fluke. The 6-5 chalk, he was not as agreeable to rating off the slower fractions on the speedy Belmont surface, and jockey Calvin Borel opted to give him his head earlier than planned. Mine That Bird closed the gap on the turn and drove to the front as they straightened for home, but the move had cost him, and he had no answer when first Summer Bird and then the determined Dunkirk came at him in the final sixteenth. "I had to let him go a little down the backside--he was fighting me a little bit," Borel explained. "He had the lead at the sixteenth pole and I thought we were home free, but [Summer Bird] just galloped past. He's a little tired, but he ran his race."

PLAIN SAILING

Ending the 20-year spell of waiting since Nashwan completed the heralded 2000 Guineas-Derby double, **★ "TDN Rising Star" ★ Sea the Stars (Ire)** (Cape

Cross {Ire}) made the task look straightforward as he emerged from yesterday's G1 Epsom Derby with his reputation skyward. Christopher Tsui's homebred, a half to the 2001 Blue Riband hero Galileo (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), had doubts surrounding his stamina, but was allowed to start as the second favorite. He made 11-4 look big when traveling with ease

and rolling to the front approaching the furlong marker. All fears about staying power were quashed there as he carried veteran jockey Mick Kinane to a comfortable 1 3/4-length success from the 9-4 pick **Fame and Glory (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}), who led home a Ballydoyle blanket for the placings. John Oxx, who saddled Sinndar (Ire) (Grand Lodge) to an Epsom Derby score in 2000, remarked on Sea the Stars's Classic double. "You daren't dream that it might happen when you see that some great horses didn't quite pull it off," Oxx said. "Sinndar was a dream, but there was more expectation this time, and [Sea the Stars] has never let us down." **Cont. p3**

Summer Bird was making just the fifth start of his career in the Belmont, but had shown promise in his first four outings. Fourth after a wide trip in his debut at Oaklawn Mar. 1, the rangy chestnut--the polar opposite of his compact crop mate Mine That Bird--came back to break his maiden by 2 1/4 lengths over Luv Gov (Ten Most Wanted) 18 days later. The Jayaraman homebred earned a chance in the Apr. 11 GI Arkansas Derby with that victory, and outran his 26-1 odds to be third, just 1 1/4 lengths behind Papa Clem (Smart Strike) and Old Fashioned (Unbridled's Song). That effort gave him just enough earnings to sneak into the field for the May 2 GI Kentucky Derby. Off at 43-1, Summer Bird closed from 16th to be sixth, beaten 13 lengths. Trainer Tim Ice never considered a run at the GI Preakness S., instead pointing for the Belmont. "This has been the goal," Ice said before the race, and the final jewel in the Triple Crown proved attainable. Sporting blinkers for the first time, Summer Bird found himself caught in traffic for nearly 10 furlongs of the Belmont. The colt was steadied on the first turn and again while tucked in at the fence on the backstretch. He was shuffled back at the half-mile pole, finding himself in ninth, but Kent Desormeaux maneuvered his mount to the outside on the far turn and the race was on. The lightly campaigned three-year-old dug in from the far outside and fought his way past the leaders to win going away. "All I could hear was my hollering, I couldn't hear anybody else," Ice said. "It was surreal to see the red cap, blue blinkers coming the outside--it was just a thrilling, exciting finish." The Battle of Dunkirk...

Looking to regain his reputation after a lackluster 11th-place finish in the Kentucky Derby, Dunkirk surprised just about everybody by shooting straight to the front. The grey cut out fractions of :23.41, :47.13, 1:12.43 and 1:37.86. He was caught by Mine That Bird as they rolled out of the turn, but stayed on resolutely and surged Dunkirk Leads On The First Turn *Horsephotos* past that rival



nearing the wire to get second. "He battled every step of the way," said John Velazquez. "I couldn't believe I was on the lead early. There was no pace. The way he broke, he was already there on the lead, so I didn't want to hold him back." Velazquez added, "I didn't see Mine That Bird when he came to me, but I got after my horse and he put up a real good fight. He just ran his eyeballs out, but unfortunately, we just got beat." The effort did take its toll. "He was definitely tired when I pulled him up, and he tied up," the rider explained. "I hosed him down, and he seemed to be okay."

Linked together from the early part of this decade with the likes of champion Azamour (Ire) (Night Shift), John Oxx and Mick Kinane have proved a formidable partnership. But it was the arrival of the *beau ideal* Sea the Stars into the yard that proved a turning point for the worldly wise duo and, after wins in a Leopardstown maiden in August and G2 Beresford S. at The Curragh the following month, they could dare to dream again.

Seeing Stars...

Sent off at 8-1 in the G1 2000 Guineas, Sea the Stars outran the speedy favorite Delegator (GB) (Dansili {GB}) in a performance that said Derby, but there were fears that his pedigree, compounded by his free-running style, would fall short. True to form, the bay was at the fore of the main group racing adrift from the Ballydoyle duo Golden Sword (GB) (High Chaparral {Ire}) and Age of Aquarius (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) yesterday. And, despite the enthusiasm he had shown to the bottom of the hill, when Kinane let out some rein in early stretch it was clear that Sea the Stars was far from emptying. Sweeping by Colm O'Donoghue on the pacesetter, he dominated the final furlong as Fame and Glory chased in vain. Masterofthehorse made up an enormous amount of ground from last to nose out Rip Van Winkle (Galileo {Ire}) for third. It was a third renewal for Kinane, and a landmark second on a son of Urban Sea, as he steered Galileo eight years ago. The rider was basking in the moment. "I was going so easily all the way--he traveled almost too good and it was slow-motion for him," said Kinane. "He has a serious cruising speed over any distance and is so quick. We had to really chase him hard to get him to Newmarket, and only a horse with his constitution would have taken what we threw at him." He added, "He's regally bred, with a physique and attitude to be a great horse, and has given me a new lease of life and put a few years back on me." Oxx is one of racing's thinkers and was not being rushed into any decisions about the winner's next target, but the burning question of a pursuit of the Triple Crown--not completed since Nijinsky II in 1970--was the first to be raised. "I'm a believer in the Triple Crown and think it will be won in the next 10 years, but I think the G1 St Leger [at Doncaster Sept. 12] might be a bridge too far for him," Oxx said. "We'll have to think about it, but the obvious race is the G1 Irish Derby [June 28], although he doesn't want soft ground so we'll see how it goes. The G1 Eclipse S. [at Sandown July 4] is an alternative, and the big 1 1/4-mile races like the G1 Juddmonte International S. [at York Aug. 18] and G1 Irish Champion S. [at Leopardstown Sept. 5] will be right up his street." With four of his six runners beaten by no more than two lengths, Aidan O'Brien was largely satisfied, but had a lot to take in. "The winner won well, but all our horses ran well too," O'Brien told *PA Sport*. She floundered down the lane after setting the pace in the May 1 GI Kentucky Oaks, finishing 29 1/4 lengths behind Rachel Alexandra (Medaglia d'Oro) in sixth, but Gabby's Golden Gal kept it together to lead every step here. The bay broke her maiden at Santa Anita when making her second career start Feb. 6, and came back to be second in an allowance test Mar. 5. Shipped to New Mexico at the end of the month, she made her stakes bow in the Mar. 29 Sunland Park Oaks and romped to a front-running 13-length triumph.

The Arnold Zetcher homebred couldn't take the pressure of having Rachel Alexandra breathing down her neck in the Kentucky Oaks, but had things a whole lot easier on the front end here. Gifted fractions of :22.61 and :45.31 on the lightning fast strip at Belmont yesterday, Gabby's Golden Gal turned into the stretch with a three-length advantage and was not threatened as odds-on Justwhistledixie closed ground late. The filly was unable to have her picture taken, however, as she was the victim of heat stroke after the race. Hosed with cool water and treated swiftly by the track vet, she was able to return to the backstretch under her own power. "She's not real big, but she puts everything into it," Zetcher said. "[Trainer Bob Baffert] calls her a little keg of dynamite. This is a good distance for her. When we bred her, we thought Medaglia d'Oro had good potential, and the dam, Gabriellina Giof, was our first winner; she won the 2002 Manhattan Beach H. for us." Taking the overland route, the five-year-old Diamondrella earned a well-deserved first graded victory while defeating the heavily favored Forever Together. The CastleTOP Stable colorbearer entered the Just a Game off a five-race winning skein that began in allowance company last June, ran through victories in the restricted Positive Gal S. and Xtra Heat H. at Belmont last fall, and, in her seasonal debut, was capped with a late-running tally in the 5 1/2-furlong Giant's Causeway S. at Keeneland Apr. 18. The big question in this initial go at the graded level was the distance--she had tried a route just once and all six of her wins had come from five to seven furlongs on grass. Disregarded as a 9-1 shot, Diamondrella was taken back early and caboosed up the backstretch, just behind Forever Together. After Raw Silk (Malibu Moon) took the field through a half in :47.88 and three-quarters in 1:12.35, Forever Together, in behind horses, dove to the rail for racing room, while Diamondrella rallied widest of all and came charging home a confident winner. "The gates opened and she broke sharp," said winning jockey Rajiv Maragh. "I didn't want her to run up early, so I kind of took hold of her right away. The pace slowed down more than I was hoping it would, but she was comfortable being in the back of the pack. And, she's an awesome filly, so once she does that she's going to finish all the time." As for what's next, trainer Angel Penna, Jr., said, "I'll ask Rajiv what he thinks. It's great we might have more on the horizon [than sprints]. The Breeders' Cup is an awfully long way away--we'll look at whatever is next, and take it from there." What is your favorite sport other than horse racing? I'm a football fan, but I love basketball. I played a lot of basketball in the city parks [in Manhattan]. I played with Kareem [Abdul-Jabbar] in the schoolyard when he was called Lew [Alcindor], and our high schools played each other in some brush-up games before the season started.

Who was your idol growing up? I always loved Sandy Koufax. I was a crazy baseball fan as a kid. I'd take three trains from Riverdale in the Bronx with my dad to see the Dodgers play at Ebbets Field, rather than take one bus to see the Yankees.

You grew up in New York, and now live in California. Better city, New York or L.A.? I love to visit New York, but wouldn't want to live there. I've been out here now 27 years or so; I'm as much a native as anybody is. You can't beat the weather on a year-round basis, and I do deeply love Del Mar. From the first time I went there in the early '70s, I fell in love with that area.

What is your favorite food or meal? I'll tell you what I like better than anything. I like to go to New York and have a good corned beef sandwich. Just drop me off at the Carnegie Deli. That would be top of the list.

Perfect day? Last Sunday--that's where I get my juice. Winning a race of any kind is what this is about. Like my mother said, I could've been an accountant. Winning races, there's no charge like it in the world.

What's your favorite vacation spot? I don't have time for vacations. I'm 365--either at the sale or at the barn. I'm real early and hands-on; small outfit. I loved Whittingham and Woody in their old ways; I'm a little old-fashioned. I'm also a little new fashion. I have internet cameras in the barn, and could look at my horses off my laptop. I have remote control cameras that move and cameras that I can turn lights on and talk through. I used to take more vacations than I do now. I don't go out of the zip code except when I go to Hollywood Park to run a horse.

If you could change one thing in the sport, what would it be? I'd stop them from closing all these racetracks down if I were God. I'm looking across town at one of the most unbelievable racetracks in the world--Hollywood Park--and it's soon to be a park.

He showed impressive acceleration in the G2 KRA Guineas at this track last time May 12. In front from his wide post position early here, he was restrained to take a lead by Bernard Fayd'Herbe until unleashed passing the quarter pole. Challenged by Dan de Lago in the center of the track, Big City Life was kept to task to hold on. CHASING THE PRIZE AT CHANTILLY

Today's G1 Prix du Jockey-Club at Chantilly has proved irresistible for His Highness The Aga Khan's **Beheshtam (Fr)** (Peintre Celebre). Trainer Alain de

Royer-Dupre, talking to the *Racing Post*, said of the Listed Prix de l'Avre winner, "Having taken everything into account, we decided to let him take his chance. Both his races have been like training gallops, but he is a horse with a very fine

turn of foot. We haven't got the best of draws, but it is not dramatic. We know he stays well, and he's a very easy individual."

Beheshtam has to get past the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains hero **Silver Frost (Ire)** (Verglas {Ire}) first, and since this Classic was trimmed from a mile and a half, winners of the Poulains have enjoyed more than a fair crack at the whip. Shamardal (Giant's Causeway) proved the point four years ago, and John Cotton's Silver Frost appeared to have won on merit in that May 10 mile Classic, as he had earlier in the G3 Prix de Fontainebleau over the same track and trip Apr. 12.

Having been runner-up in that contest, Michael Tabor, Derrick Smith and Susan Magnier's **Westphalia (Ire)** (Daneshill Dancer {Ire}) was feeling the draft of the winner's slipstream for the second time when fourth, before being promoted to third, in the Poulains. Last year's G2 Champagne S. winner and Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf runner-up looked in need of a step up in trip there, where he suffered an interrupted run and is joined by three stable companions as Aidan O'Brien chases a first renewal.

O'Brien's runners include ☆ **"TDN Rising Star" ☆ Malibu Bay (El Prado {Ire})**, who also suffered a troubled trip when third in the Apr. 24 G3 Sandown Classic Trial; **Drumbeat (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}), who is beginning to look exposed after a third in the May 8 Dee S. at Chester and sixth in the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas at The Curragh 15 days later; and **Set Sail (Ire)** (Daneshill Dancer {Ire}), who was fourth in the Fontainebleau last time. "Westphalia was possibly a bit unlucky in the French Guineas, he didn't get a clear run, but came home really well and looked like he'd get further," O'Brien said. "Malibu Bay ran once last year and won, and then finished third on his first run back in the Classic Trial on the right-handed track at Sandown. Johnny [Murtagh] was very happy with him, but felt he didn't get a run when he needed it and thought there was improvement to come. Drumbeat ran in the Dee S. at Chester, where he was third, beaten half a length, and then ran in the Irish Guineas when the very soft ground may not have been ideal for him, as he's a horse with a lot of speed. We think the mile and a quarter at Chantilly will suit him."

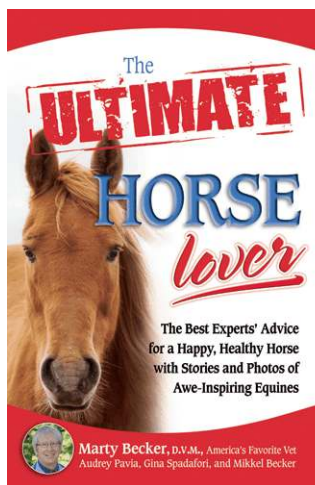

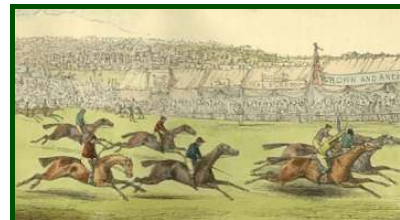

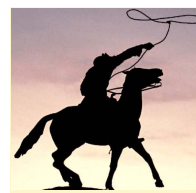
