COLONIAL BATTLE GOES TO HASTINGS

Able to sneak up the inside, **Battle of Hastings (GB)** (Royal Applause {GB}) found the wire a head in front of the troubled **Straight Story** (Giant's Causeway) to secure the \$500,000 GII Colonial Turf Cup yesterday at Colonial Downs. It was the second graded triumph for the British-bred gelding, who captured the GIII Baldwin S. earlier this year at Santa Anita. The Colonial Turf Cup is the first leg of the Grand Slam of Grass, which guarantees \$5 million in purse money and bonuses to any three-year-old who can add victories in the GII Virginia Derby, GI Secretariat S. and GI Emirates Airline Breeders' Cup Turf. **Cont. p6**

ASCOT CONNOISSEUR

It was a case of deja vu in yesterday's G1 Golden Jubilee S. as Richard Green's **Art Connoisseur (Ire)** (Lucky Story) rolled by rivals near Ascot's stand's rail and on to glory, much as he did in last year's G2 Coventry S. at this meeting. He was an 8-1 chance 12 months ago, and was 20-1 this time off a 66-day break since his comeback seventh in the Listed European Free H. at Newmarket. Anchored in rear by Tom Queally off the inevitable strong pace, the bay slipstreamed the field towards the fence to lead with a furlong remaining and held U.S. raider **Cannonball** (Catienus) to score by a neck. "It was clear that he was a sprinter after Newmarket and this had been the target since," trainer Michael Bell said. "I would have been far more confident had he not popped a splint a month ago. He was very sore on it and swam for a fortnight and cantered for a fortnight. He did three bits of work very nicely, but this was a surprise, as I thought he was a boy against men today." **Cont. p2**

Art Connoisseur came into last year's G2 Coventry S. with an unbeaten record to defend and emerged with maximum respect after comfortably defeating subsequent G1 Dewhurst S. one-two Intense Focus (Giant's Causeway) and Lord Shanakill (Speightstown) by 2 1/4 lengths. As a result, he was sent off the even-money favorite for the G1 Phoenix S. at The Curragh in July, but was no match for Mastercraftsman (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) despite finishing in front of the eventual dual Group 1 hero Bushranger (Danetime {Ire}) there. He fractured a cannon bone when down the field on his next start in the G2 Gimcrack S. at Newbury in August, and the European Free was a fact-finding mission with the Guineas in mind. Despite being hampered badly and denied a clear run there, his performance convinced regular jockey Jamie Spencer that sprinting was his forte, and the Classics were passed over. In the absence of his suspended rider, Tom Queally was left with the steering task and he gave a passable impression of Spencer early as he sat chilly off the speed. Allowed enough space for his effort near the rail, he responded with instant acceleration to power past Lesson in Humility before pulling out extra as the U.S. raider charged late. For his jockey, this was compensation for the narrow defeat of his mount Midday (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}) by the Bell team's Sariska (GB) (Pivotal {GB}) in last Friday's G1 Epsom Oaks. "I came in for the ride when Jamie was suspended, but it makes up for Michael beating us in the Oaks," Queally commented. "They went a hell of a gallop and there was a lot of scrimmaging for position, so I gave him time and when he got the split, it was do or die up the rail. I was fortunate I hit the front close to the line, as he idles in his work and only does as much as he has to, but to be fair to him he knuckled down and did it very well."

For Bell, the win was all the more important as he owns a share and had refused to sell earlier. "Richard [Green] and I turned down a lot of money for him after the Coventry and although I was slightly regretting it over the winter, it looks like the right decision."

Just Missing the Target...

Trainer Karl Burke was equally delighted by the run of third-place finisher Lesson in Humility. "When a filly is in form, in the way she has been, there is no telling how much improvement they can make and after that it wouldn't be a surprise if she was able to win a Group 1," Burke said. "She is a tough filly and, physically, there is more improvement to come. She's not in the G1 July Cup [at Newmarket July 10], and I doubt whether she will be supplemented." South African speedball **J J the Jet Plane (SAf)** (Jet Master {SAf}) was far from disgraced in fourth, but could not reward the 5-2 favorite backers. Jockey Kevin Shea offered, "He traveled beautifully for three furlongs, but then there was a mad dash to the line and he didn't pick up like I thought he would, running as if he might want a little bit further."

His G2 Jockey Club S. win was largely written off as a fluke, but the Oppenheimers' **Bronze Cannon** (Lemon Drop Kid) proved that reasoning to be all wrong as he defied a penalty to oust **Campanologist** (Kingmambo) in the closing stages of yesterday's G2 Hardwicke S. Lightning-fast ground was given as the reason for his suddenly-improved form when defeating subsequent G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup hero Casual Conquest (Ire) (Hernando {Fr}) at Newmarket last time May 2, but the homebred proved he is purely a horse on a sharp upwards curve with this battling half-length success. Sent off at 8-1, the bay arrived with a rattle off the furious tempo to cut down 2-1 favorite and Frankie Dettori in the final strides. "They went very quick early and I was happy where we sat, but Frankie wasn't stopping all the way to the line and we just wore him down in the end," jockey Jimmy Fortune said. "He's only small, but his heart is twice the size he is and he gets a mile and a half well. He's very game and is certainly going the right way."

Bronze Cannon beat Doctor Fremantle (GB) (Sadler's Wells) in a handicap at Newmarket's Craven meeting last April, but missed the Epsom Derby and failed to fire when only seventh behind Campanologist in this meeting's G2 King Edward VII S. After only two more outings at three, he returned to be third in both Lingfield's G3 Winter Derby and Kempton's Listed Magnolia S. in the space of a week in late March. His defeat of Casual Conquest in the three-runner renewal of the Jockey Club marred by withdrawals left him with an extra burden to carry here and that had proved too much for the likes of Scorpion (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) and Bollin Eric (GB) (Shaamit {Ire}) in recent years. Settled way off the fast pace set by the tearaway Barshiba (Ire) (Barathea {Ire}), he allowed Campanologist first run in the straight, but kept finding to collar that rival where it mattered. "When he won the Jockey Club, I thought this would be difficult with the three pounds and Frankie was expecting Campanologist to win," trainer John Gosden commented. "He has just shown enormous courage. He missed the Derby due to a little hiccup and got hurt in the King Edward

here last year, but we're happy with where we are at the moment." The runner-up's trainer Saeed bin Suroor said, "The pace was too quick early, but he ran a big, big race. I thought for a second that he was going to win, but we could have done with the winning post being further down the track." Third-place finisher Dansant is Breeders' Cup bound after a commendable effort staying on from the rear. "He had a poor draw and had to come from a long way back, but I was delighted with the way he finished the race," trainer Gerard Butler told *PA Sport*. "He is in a few tasty spots, including the [July 25] G1 King George [VI & Queen Elizabeth S. at Ascot]. I wouldn't mind coming back for that, but the [Nov. 6] Breeders' Cup Marathon [at Santa Anita] is his long-term objective." In the winner's spot three times on day one, Richard Hughes had endured a barren spell until Big Audio registered an upset here. Second in a six-furlong maiden at Doncaster last time May 30, the bay relished the step up in trip and after being restrained early off the fast fractions, was coaxed into contention from rear. Challenging wide inside the final quarter, he grabbed the lead passing the furlong pole and had enough to cling on from the strong-finishing Emperor Claudius. "He jumped quite well, but I thought they were going too quick, so I tried to move up without finding trouble and in the end we were stuck on the outside, which wasn't ideal," Hughes said. "Then he was left alone in front and swerved in the last 100 yards. He's a horse with a future and is pretty raw at this stage."

MURTAGH HOLDS ON Johnny Murtagh was crowned the leading jockey at Royal Ascot for the second consecutive year despite missing the final two days with a suspension. Four wins and a second proved enough to hold off close friend Richard Hughes for the London Clubs International Charity Trophy, which he also won 2001-2002. Barry Hills, who missed the meeting due to suffering from a blood disorder, became leading trainer for the first time in his 40-year career thanks to three wins. His son Charlie told *PA Sport*, "This week has shown us what a great team we have at home. They have kept the horses bang on for the week while dad hasn't been well, and he has never won the title before."

JUST RE-WARD Wesley Ward's ambitious first foray across the Atlantic Ocean has paid handsome dividends this week, and the trainer's Cannonball bettered a sixth-place finish in Tuesday's G1 King's Stand S. to finish runner-up yesterday in the G1 Golden Jubilee S. "I was very excited watching that, and I really wanted to win the race for Mr. Ramsey," Ward told *PA Sport*. "It was a bit unfortunate Johnny [Velazquez] couldn't stay to ride him, but Olivier [Peslier] has done a great job."

Icon Project, hailing from a deep Wimborne family, competed at Royal Ascot a year ago, stepping up from a maiden win to finish fourth in the G2 Ribblesdale S. for trainer Brian Meehan. A close third in the Listed Plantation Stud S. at Newmarket July 19, the bay closed out her European campaign with a seventh in the Listed Prix de Liancourt at Longchamp Sept. 2. She finished fifth in her first outing for Marty Wolfson in a Gulfstream allowance Feb. 20, but rebounded to take a similar contest Apr. 12 and, 13 days later, ran third to Criticism in the GII La Prevoyante H. at Calder. Trying the main track for the first time when persistent rain forced this contest off the turf, Icon Project raced in fourth as favored Criticism showed the way in the slop. The four-year-old ranged up on the outside turning for home and added to her advantage with every stride while being geared down late. "That was impressive," said Wolfson. "She had been training so well up to this race. I told her owner [that] when she first came to this country, she was training so well on dirt I wanted to run her on dirt, but it didn't turn out that way. Now, I'm not sure in which direction we'll go. We'll take some time to figure things out and then decide where she'll go next." Criticism, who boasted four graded wins from her last five starts, earned brownie points for staying on to complete the exacta. "She ran well off her class to be second," offered trainer Tom Albertrani. "I was happy to stay in because you have to try." Unbridled Belle boasted an enviable 6-4-1-1 record at Delaware heading into this one, and chalked up another victory. After airing by 5 3/4 lengths in last year's Obeah, the big mare settled for third in the GII Delaware H. in July, then travelled up to Saratoga to finish third in the GI Personal Ensign S. However, she concluded 2008 with a desultory ninth in the GI Spinster S. on Keeneland's Polytrack Oct. 5, and found herself RNA'ing for \$1.2 million at Fasig-Tipton the following month. After failing to get in foal to A.P. Indy this spring, Unbridled Belle was a non-threatening fifth in the GII Louisville Distaff H. May 1 at Churchill. She returned to the First State earlier this month, and loomed as a tough customer here. The six-year-old assumed command heading into the first turn and steadily built her advantage, splashing home a clear winner. She is scheduled to race through November. We called the vet, and then he got worse so fast it was frightening. We put him on the van and sent him to the Midlantic Clinic in Ringoes. Dr. Patty Doyle worked on him. They had to make an incision, but fortunately they were able to untwist the intestine manually, and they didn't have to resect it. Dr. Doyle said it will take a couple of months for the incision to heal, and then he can go back into training." Perkins added, "The change in him after the surgery was amazing," Perkins said. "By 11 o'clock that night, he was looking for his supper." The popular New Jersey-bred has earned \$973,472 while winning 16 of 35 career starts to date.

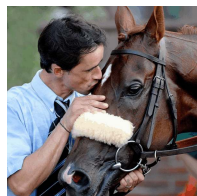
