SHINING THROUGH

Blessed by a dry spell in the lead-up to yesterday's G1 Tattersalls Millions Irish Champion S., **Sea the Stars (Ire)** (Cape Cross {Ire}) graced Leopardstown and handled everything that Ballydoyle could throw at him to emerge as the ultimately comfortable victor. Aidan O'Brien has been seeking a way to lower the colors of Christopher Tsui's homebred all term, but the prospect of that occurring appears even slimmer after the goliath of the modern scene readily dismissed two of County Tipperary's big guns here. After allowing **Mastercraftsman (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) and **Fame and Glory (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}) first run off fast fractions, Mick Kinane shook the reins, and Sea the Stars duly clipped their wings with a furlong remaining. The whip was waved, but not applied, in the closing stages, and there was a 2 1/2-length margin back to Fame and Glory and Johnny Murtagh at the line. "He has improved through the year and took his last race better than any other so far," commented the steely nerved Kinane, who has guided the burgeoning legend through his career tests. "He was at his heaviest at the scales today and is maturing and getting better--he has a fantastic constitution and is sound of mind and body. It's phenomenal how easy he can travel, no matter how fast they are going, and that's the key." Cont. p3-4

Alexandra the Great...

Rachel Alexandra entered the starting gate with a bulls-eye on her back following a brilliant seven-for-seven campaign, which included a record-breaking victory in the GI Kentucky Oaks as well as historic wins against the boys in the GI Preakness S., and GI Haskell Invitational S. last time Aug. 2. Away in good order, the bay narrowly led the field into the clubhouse turn through a suicidal opening quarter in :22 4/5, with GI Belmont S. winner Da' Tara (Tiznow) pressing from the inside and Past the Point (Indian Charlie) tracking in third. Under pressure through a half-mile in :46 2/5, Calvin Borel had Rachel Alexandra in hand at the top of the stretch as the gray Macho Again began to uncork a rally from the back. Borel began to get busy on Rachel with several left and right back-handers when Bullsbay took a run at the lead in the stretch. Quickly disposing of the GI Whitney H. winner, Rachel Alexandra embraced the next challenge of Macho Again, and gave it everything she had to just hang on. Asmussen and Jackson Double-Up...

Two-time Horse of the Year Curlin (Smart Strike) delivered for Jess Jackson and Steve Asmussen in last year's GI Woodward S., and the dynamic duo were in the winner's circle again yesterday following Rachel Alexandra's heroics. "I can't say enough about the race she put in today under the circumstances," Asmussen offered. "It means so much to me and everyone involved with her. For Jess [Jackson] and Barbara [Banke] to allow us the opportunity to run her in these races, I can't say enough. She came through today like a true champion. At :22 and change, I started worrying. I worried until they put her number up. I can't say how proud of her I am. Her performance--under the pressure that she always is, stepping up and raising her game--was tremendous today. She didn't lope along on the lead or anything. She's a spectacular athlete." On taking on unbeaten champion Zenyatta (Street Cry {Ire}), Jackson added, "I can't predict. It depends on both horses coming out and what both camps would be willing to do. I've indicated Rachel's had a full race year already. It might be that they get together, but I can't predict that."

Sea the Stars will always have a good-ground proviso attached wherever he goes, but it would have been harsh fate had his home fans been denied a chance to celebrate him in the flesh for a second time. They had been within hours of enjoying his presence on The Curragh before the seemingly unending rain canceled out any chance of him participating in the G1 Irish Derby in late June. By that time, the son of the great matriarch Urban Sea had already established his own niche in history by completing the lauded 2000 Guineas-Epsom Derby double, and it was back to England for his next outings in Sandown's G1 Eclipse and York's G1 Juddmonte International. Ireland has been plagued by constant drenchings all summer, and when Leopardstown received another dose early in the week it appeared odds-against that Sea the Stars would make the homecoming. Thankfully, a welcome break in the gloom arrived in time for him to line up, and the usual market support in the face of tough opposition told its own story about the state of the ground. Traveling with all his usual fluency off the high pace carved out by the Ballydoyle grafters, he had dead aim on Mastercraftsman as that rival took over before the quarter pole and Mick Kinane was comfortable enough to allow Johnny Murtagh to sweep wide to gain first jump on Fame and Glory. As the latter swept to the front two out, Sea the Stars was instantly in his slipstream and, a furlong later, had rolled by en route to another dominant display. "Mastercraftsman started to show distress signals as we got halfway round the bend and I decided not to take it up at that stage, so Johnny [Murtagh] took first run, and I was happy to let him do that," Kinane added. "I was able to get a breather and he won very snug. He said, 'a couple of lengths will do' when I asked him to go away today. I haven't ridden a horse that can do what he does at any distance, so he's top of the tree." **Cont. p4**

Trainer John Oxx commented, "In the week, it looked very doubtful but on Wednesday evening I was pleasantly surprised how well it had taken the rain, and so there was no great difficulty in the decision to run. To win five Group Ones in five months, with one performance better than the last, is hard and he's one of these landmark horses who come along every 25 or 30 years that we will always remember. He has a phenomenal temperament and is the nearest living thing you will get to a machine. He does everything the same way all the time--he devours his food and loves his work, which he has to do as he gets above himself and too fresh without it. We have to keep him going and it remains to be seen how long he can keep putting up these performances. The G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe [at Longchamp Oct. 4] is the next one on the agenda, with the usual boring statement about the weather and ground, so we'll have to see." Aidan O'Brien said of the vanquished, "We are delighted and Fame and Glory's next run will be in the Arc all being well, while Mastercraftsman will drop back to a mile. Sea the Stars is a marvelous horse and I've never seen anything like him--it was a privilege to be here and it was a great race." Sea the Stars also earned a guaranteed place in the \$3 million GI Emirates Airline Breeders' Cup Turf at Santa Anita Nov. 7, but Oxx is looking at the Pro-Ride option over that event. "It's a hell of an ask to keep going that long for a horse that had a Guineas preparation in May, and I'd think it would be the Classic rather than the Turf that we would think about--but it's such a long way off that we're not talking about it now." He hadn't visited the winner's circle since taking the GIII Northern Dancer S. at Churchill Downs in June of 2008, but Pyro was back on top of his game yesterday. Runner-up in the GII Jim Dandy S. and GII Indiana Derby, the Godolphin colorbearer also was third in the GI Travers S. over this track, but connections opted to turn him back to sprint distances this season. The move paid big dividends, as the colt earned his first Grade I score here. The dark bay ran sixth after a slow break in the Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile at Santa Anita in October, then went to the bench. He made his return after a nine-month layoff in the July 29 James Marvin S. at the Spa, and closed from last to be second. At the tail end of the field again in the Forego, Pyro rode the rail into the stretch while still well back, eased out for running room and charged from out of the pack. He outfinished Kodiak Kowboy in the final yards for the narrow score. As for what's next, assistant trainer Rick Mettee said, "The Breeders' Cup being on synthetic changes the game completely. A narrow winner of the grassy GI Woodford Reserve Turf Classic S. on Derby day, the seven-year-old placed a troubled third in the GI Stephen Foster H. June 13 before returning to grass with a disappointing fifth in the GI Arlington Million last time Aug. 8. "He loved the surface at Santa Anita, in an exceptional way," trainer Helen Pitts told *Daily Racing Form*. "It looks like the speed is inside of me. He can sit off it. I like being on the outside. It allows Julien [Leparoux] to see where he wants to place him." ★ **"TDN Rising Star"** ★ **Colonel John**, last year's GI Santa Anita Derby and GI Travers S. hero, kicked off his four-year-old season in style, annexing the Wickerr S. over the Del Mar spinach July 31.

At the end of last term, it was almost inconceivable that Rainbow View would take until September to find the winner's spot again, but, after a string of defeats, the champion juvenile filly of 2008 finally hit the target again here. Rounding off her two-year-old campaign with a success in the G1 Fillies' Mile at Ascot, the homebred was only fifth as the 8-11 favorite for the G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket May 3. Fourth in the June 5 G1 Epsom Oaks, third in the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot June 19 and fourth again in the G1 Falmouth S. back at Newmarket July 8, the diminutive bay was threatening to become exposed after a latest second to Midday (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}) in the Aug. 1 G1 Nassau S. at Goodwood.

Keeping the faith dropped back to a mile here, her followers sent her off a warm favorite fitted with sheepskin cheekpieces for the first time, and she traveled keenly in her new headgear stalking the early pace. Delivering her customary potent turn of acceleration after the final turn, she grabbed the lead approaching the furlong pole and soon put her seal on the contest as Heaven Sent chased in vain. "She's just been slow to come to herself--her work has been fine, but she hasn't been greatly interested in racing," trainer John Gosden said. "With another filly I used to train called Ryafan, it took her until this time of year to come right, and she went and won three Group 1s, so I think it's a matter of being patient and not giving up. It is a hormonal thing, and the spring and early summer can be a difficult thing for three-year-old fillies, but there is no doubt she is more composed in herself. She tried to bite me when I saddled her, showing a coltish side, and she's probably back to her best now." Jockey Jimmy Fortune added, "She's been dossing in her races all year, so we tried something different with the cheekpieces and they made her concentrate today. She got down and went about her business, and the nice thing about her is she handles most ground." Gosden revealed that Rainbow View could be California-bound eventually. "The G1 Prix de l'Opera [at Longchamp Oct. 4] is the obvious next target, and then possibly the G1 E.P. Taylor S. But looking further on, there is the Breeders' Cup in November, and there are a number of races she could go for. There's the Filly and Mare Turf, although our Dar Re Mi (GB) (Singspiel {Ire}) has earned a place in that after her Pretty Polly win, but she could also run on the main track; after all, someone has got to take on Zenyatta (Street Cry {Ire})." Regal Parade bagged valuable prizes in last term's Buckingham Palace H. at Royal Ascot and Ayr Gold Cup H., and came back this term to run sixth in a Kempton conditions event Mar. 28. Following up with a second in the Apr. 25 Listed Leicestershire S., he claimed a May 30 York conditions before finishing ninth in the June 20 G1 Golden Jubilee S. at Royal Ascot in his only prior attempt at the highest level. He improved to hit the board in the July 28 G2 Betfair Cup at Goodwood and the Aug. 15 G2 Hungerford S. at Newbury, and continued his rise up the sprinting ranks by causing a minor upset to register a career high in this.

Racing in rear from the outset, the eventual winner sliced through the pack into contention approaching the final eighth and was ridden out late to deny G1 July Cup heroine Fleeting Spirit nearing the line. "I've been waiting a long time to get a first Group 1 winner and I'm thankful to the owners for letting me ride him," said jockey Adrian Nicholls. "The horse has done a lot for me, he's improving all the time and my old man [trainer David Nicholls] is a legend with these sort of horses. All I have to do is sit and point them." The jockey's father, David, reciprocated the praise and added, "Regal Parade's a lovely horse and Adrian gave him a great ride. We were supposed to make the running, but we changed our plans. He tries really hard, he's an easy horse to train and doesn't give us any trouble. I'm not sure where we'll go with him next." Citing the soft turf as a factor in Fleeting Spirit's undoing, trainer Jeremy Nosedá told *PA Sport*, "A poor preparation on the soft ground has not helped her. She travelled well and if we met again on faster ground, I think it might be a different story. The [G1] Prix de l'Abbaye [at Longchamp Oct. 4] is under consideration, but it will depend on the ground. She's better on fast ground and the Breeders' Cup is still at the back of my mind." Echoing the Newmarket conditioner's comments, jockey Kieren Fallon suggested the conditions may have also compromised the chance of third placed High Standing, and added, "High Standing's run a good race, but the ground was softer than he really likes. He traveled nicely, but, when I asked him for an effort, he didn't pick up like he would on good ground. 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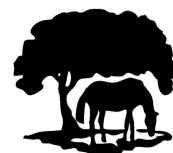

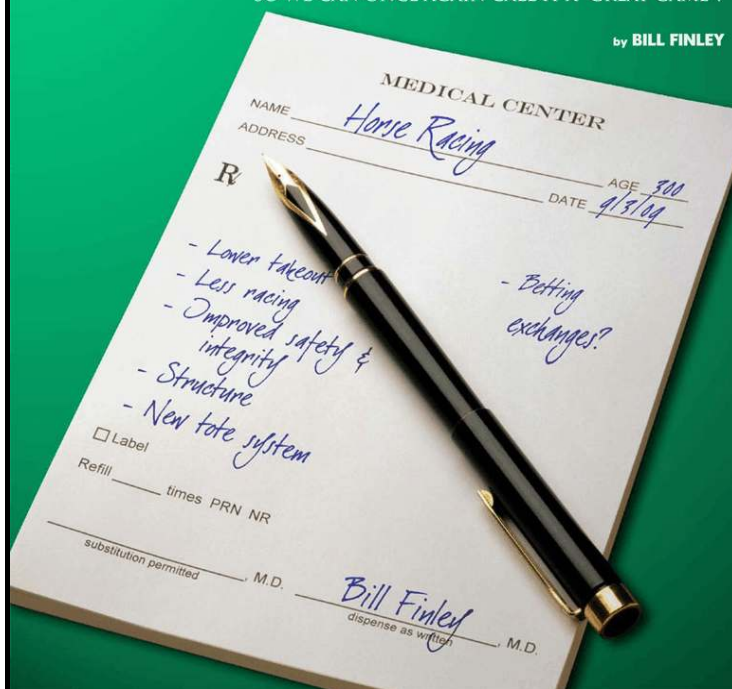

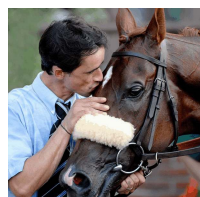

Racing Round-Up

Flashing to Presque Isle...

GI Test S. winner **Flashing** (A.P. Indy) will make her next appearance in the \$400,000 GIII Presque Isle Downs Master S. Sept. 12, *Daily Racing Form* reports. Godolphin's three-year-old filly, five-for-seven lifetime, will try a synthetic track for the first time in the six-furlong Masters. "[Trainer Saeed bin Suroor] thought, if she did run well in the Presque Isle race, you'd at least entertain the idea of taking her out to Santa Anita for the seventh-eighths race [Breeders' Cup F/M Sprint]," assistant trainer Rick Mettee told *DRF*. "Now that she's a Grade I winner, she's likely to go off to the breeding shed after this year." Flashing worked five-eighths in 1:01 over the all-weather at Sheikh Mohammed's Greentree Training Center Friday. In addition to the Test, the chestnut won the GIII Nassau County S. and was third in the GI Mother Goose S. Another Godolphin runner, G2 UAE Derby hero **Regal Ransom** (Distorted Humor), is also expected to hit the road for his next start. Out of action since finishing eighth in the May 2 GI Kentucky Derby, the colt is being pointed for the Sept. 19 GII Super Derby at Louisiana Downs. The sophomore had been considered for the Oct. 11 GII Jerome S., but Godolphin has three other candidates for the one-mile test. "He's a nice horse to train up to the Jerome, but we've got Girolamo [A.P. Indy] for that, we've got Vineyard Haven [Lido Palace {Chi}] for that, we could possibly have Midshipman [Unbridled's Song] for that," Mettee added. "Somebody's got to go on the road; he's the most likely candidate." Girolamo came back after a 10-month layoff to take a Saratoga allowance Aug. 9, while Vineyard Haven was DQ'd from first in the Aug. 29 GI King's Bishop S. last time out. Eclipse winner Midshipman has not been out since taking the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile S. last October.

Well Armed Getting R&R...

WinStar's **Well Armed** (Tiznow), hero of the G1 Dubai World Cup in March, is recuperating from surgery at Bill Casner's farm in Flower Mound, Texas. The six-year-old gelding had a bone chip in his ankle that required removal, but is expected to make it back to the races at some point. "He's doing very well, swimming every day and healing nicely," Casner said. "He should be back to racing next year, maybe as early as Dubai, but that's pushing it a lot." Well Armed, who has earned over \$5 million to date, finished eighth in the GII San Diego H. at Del Mar Aug. 2 in his lone start following his Dubai exploits.

The daughter of Lando (Ger) was purchased by trainer Mirce Rulec, and is a half-sister to the 2006 G2 Maurice-Lacroix Trophy winner Global Dream (Ger) (Seattle Dancer). She also hails from the family of this term's G1 Irish Derby victor Fame and Glory (GB) (Montjeu {GB}), who chased home Sea the Stars (Ire) (Cape Cross {Ire}) in yesterday's G1 Tattersalls Millions Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown. That price was matched less than three hours later when Gestut Hof Vesterberg's Hip 229 also went the way of Jurgen Albrecht, again acting for R & B International. The February-foaled colt, already named Sanogo (Ger), is a half-brother to the 2005 G2 Mehl-Mulhens-Rennen (German 2000 Guineas) hero Santiago (Ger) (Highest Honor {Fr}), who also garnered the 2007 G2 Premio Ribot. Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's Shadwell Estate Company was also active, and laid out €150,000 for Hip 117, a March-foaled Tertullian colt consigned by Ronald Rauscher. That price was equalled by Rupert Plersch, owner of last week's G2 Goldene Peitsche winner War Artist (Aus) (Orpen), for Stiftung Gestut Fahrhof's Hip 260, an April-foaled Konigstiger colt. He is out of Germany's Champion Stayer of 1999, Win For Us (Ger) (Surumu {Ger}), who garnered the G2 Deutsches St Leger in her banner year, and is herself a daughter of Germany's Champion Juvenile Filly of 1993 Wild Romance (Ger) (Alkalde {Ger}). "The top end of the market was there, but the middle market went completely amiss," commented BBAG's Managing Director Carola Ortlieb. In contention when struck into behind, the four-year-old was pulled up before the winning post, and trainer Luca Cumani later reported to the *Racing Post*, "It's very sad--he got struck into on his off-hind leg, and such was the severity of the injury that sadly the vet had no alternative but to humanely destroy him." Successful in the 2007 G2 Beresford S. at The Curragh, Curtain Call was fifth in the G1 Irish Derby back at that venue last term and had returned there to capture the G3 Mooresbridge S. in May. In total, he won three of his 14 starts and over £200,000 in prizemoney.

FIRE CLAIMS LIFE OF RIDERS Racing was yesterday coming to terms with the death of two apprentice jockeys in a fire on Saturday morning. While they are yet to be named, the two riders were understood to be based at a Northern-based yard and were trapped in an apartment block in Norton, near the racing centre of Malton. Two other apprentices were injured, and local police later announced that a man had been arrested as part of an investigation into a possible arson attack. Kempton, Wolverhampton and Thirsk racecourses staged a period of silence yesterday, while jockeys at those meetings and at Stratford wore black armbands as a mark of respect. Jockey Dale Gibson told *PA Sport*, "The whole weighing room is numb," while trainer Richard Fahey added, "It's an absolute tragedy--we're all shocked." North Yorkshire Police later revealed that it was possible there might be further casualties, due to the inability to enter the building at present.

FALLON OFF THE MARK Kieren Fallon rode his first winner since returning to race-riding in Britain after over three years without a licence when partnering Our Kes (Ire) (Revoque {Ire}) in the extended mile-and-a-half handicap at Wolverhampton. His steering of the 7-2 favorite to a 3/4-length success on the Polytrack during the evening meeting came hours after the six-time champion jockey had ridden High Standing (High Yield) into third place in the G1 Haydock Sprint Cup. "I had some good rides, but at least now I can relax and ride proper races," Fallon told *PA Sport*. "It is a confidence thing--if you are not riding winners and have not done for the last couple of years, then you don't have the confidence, but hopefully it will build from here. I have said all along that even with all the homework and training you do, there is only one thing that can get you race-fit, and that is race-riding."
