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SIMPLY 'D' BEST

Paul Pompa Jr's **D' Funnybone** (D'wildcat) was heavily backed at 2-5 in yesterday's GII Futurity S. at Belmont Park following a runaway victory in the GII Saratoga Special S. Aug. 20, and lived up to the billing with a good-looking 4 3/4-length tally over **Discreetly Mine** (Mineshaft). "I was very impressed," trainer Rick Dutrow Jr offered. "He had to show up on this track going a little further and deal with some tough customers, and he showed up the right way."

And if the conditioner had his way? "I'd rather run him here [in the GI Champagne Oct. 10] and then just stop on him for the year," Dutrow revealed. "I'm not crazy about California and the [synthetic surface], but there's a lot of excitement that goes with [the Breeders' Cup] and how can you turn it down?" **Cont. p2**

MOREAU OF THE SAME AT SEPTEMBER

Numbers remained down during the fifth session of the Keeneland September Sale in Lexington, but there were some bright spots in the depressed market, especially in the arena of weanling-to-yearling pinhooks, which accounted for the top five horses sold. That included the session topper, a colt by Bernstein who was purchased by bloodstock agent Mike Ryan for \$475,000. It was a feel-good pinhooking coup for the small Ocala-based operation Moreau Bloodstock International, the nom de course of husband-and-wife team of Xavier and Sharon Moreau.

The Moreaus, along with partners Jean-Philippe Truchement and Irwin and France Weiner, purchased the colt for just \$55,000 last year at Keeneland November and offered him here under the Moreau Bloodstock banner.

While Ryan's spending helped propel Saturday's session, figures were still off significantly from 2008. The average of \$77,477 was off 29.3 percent, while the median of \$60,000 was down 33.3 percent. The RNA rate was 33.5 percent; last year's was 21.1 percent. The gross of \$18,439,500 was down significantly from last year's \$30,677,000. **Cont. p11**

Away alertly, D' Funnybone was settled in third through a :22.63 opening quarter. With Edgar Prado aboard, he tugged his way to challenge for the lead on the turn for home, took over shortly thereafter and turned it into a romp in the stretch. "He ran the way we expected," Prado said. "He was training great in the morning and he was very happy. He broke super and I rode with a lot of confidence today. I know what he's capable of, so I let the other two horses go and sat and waited. I was looking for him to see a target and he was very comfortable there. I think there's room to improve, because once he took the lead, he started goofing around a little bit." Prado thinks his charge should be able to stretch out in distance. "Today he gave me a better feeling [about his ability to go further] than last time," he confirmed. "Last time I thought he was going to be limited, but today he really opened up and I didn't even have to hit him. I think he's getting better with races and rating well. He's moving the right way." D' Funnybone, a first out maiden winner at Calder in May, was purchased privately by Pompa following a second-place finish in the Frank Gomez Memorial S. July 11. One race after stablemate Discreetly Mine (Mineshaft) settled for second in the GII Futurity S., Awesome Maria did him one better with this authoritative score. The grey filly missed by a half-length when unveiled at Saratoga July 30, but turned a seven-furlong maiden into a procession Aug. 21, skipping through the Spa slop to score by 8 1/4 lengths. The second choice was in the thick of things from the start as odds-on Worstcasescenario (Forbidden Apple) backed away from a speed duel, and wound up pressing 46-1 Southern Truth (Yes It's True) through a :22.57 opening quarter. Awesome Maria began to shake loose entering the stretch and powered clear from her rivals in the final furlong to a decisive success. "I think she'll be better going longer," asserted winning trainer Stanley Hough. "She's kind of got one pace to her, but, fortunately, it's a pretty good pace." Hough added, "If everything is right, I'm leaning toward [running her] in the [GI] Frizette [at Belmont Oct. 10]." Worstcasescenario stopped badly in the lane. According to *Daily Racing Form*, jockey Alan Garcia told trainer Rick Violette that the favorite "took a funny step going into the turn." Awesome Maria is the first foal from Discreetly Awesome, an unraced daughter of Pretty Discreet, who captured the GI Alabama S. for the Robshams in 1995. Pretty Discreet went on to produce the swift Discreet Cat (Forestry), as well as the aforementioned Discreetly Mine. 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JUST LIKE A FINE WINE

At the age of six, Marc Keller's **Bribon** is enjoying a career year. The chestnut, a very good and troubled third in last term's GI Hill 'N' Dale Cigar Mile H., enters riding a three-race winning streak, including tallies in the GIII Westchester S. Apr. 29 and the prestigious GI Shadwell Metropolitan H. May 25. Bribon, who began his career overseas on grass, returned to the spinach at Saratoga with an eye-catching optional claiming tally Aug. 9. "This summer, there was a lapse where there were

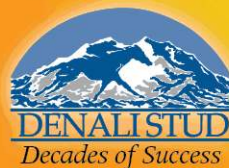
no races for him," trainer Robert Ribauda told *Daily Racing Form*. "So we tried him on the grass at Saratoga to see how he'd compete, and he stepped up and ran big against some quality horses. He came close to the track record, and his numbers were good. This race really suits him. It's his best distance, and it's a one-turn mile. It's got all the things that he likes. He's doing fine. He's the kind of horse you don't have to do a lot with. The fresher he is, the better he is." Five-year-old mare **Ventura** used a second-place finish behind **Rahy's Attorney** in this race last year as a launching pad to a tour-de-force in the Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint. The dark makes her first start since losing a close one to Informed Decision (Monarchos) in the GI Vinery Madison S. at Keeneland Apr. 9.



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Rahy's Attorney posted triple-digit Beyers while annexing the GII King Edward H. June 27 and the GII Nijinsky S. July 26. He cuts back in distance following a disappointing sixth-place finish in the GII Sky Classic S. Aug. 23.

Earning ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ status on the second of his two wins at Newmarket last time July 9, Awzaan took this hike in class in his stride with a fluent success. Given a break after his emphatic five-length success in a six-furlong conditions event at the July meeting, the homebred traveled strongly under restraint off the less-than-demanding pace set here by Quarrel. The bay closed readily on the front-runners to lead approaching the eighth pole and settled the issue instantly before being kept up to his work to record a comfortable success. "He's a lovely, compact horse to ride, and he has great manners and a hell of a turn of foot," jockey Richard Hills said. "The pace wasn't over-strong, and I didn't want to get caught out, as he'd only had two runs. That owner-breeder's Racing Manager Angus Gold added, "He made himself look a good horse at Newmarket, but he's not overly-big, so I wasn't sure he was going to make the necessary progression to the next level. He's done it in some style and, although we have tried to win the G1 Middle Park S. [at Newmarket Oct. 2] twice before with winners of this race and failed, this horse has had a break. Sheikh Hamdan told [trainer] Mark Johnston to give him that after Richard Hills said he was buzzy at the start at Newmarket and he's put on a lot of weight--Mark was worried he'd put too much on--and behaved impeccably today. He hasn't put a foot wrong, so hopefully Sheikh Hamdan will let us have a go at the Middle Park--it's the obvious race on paper."

Given his cue in the stretch, the Melnyk homebred gained a commanding lead and held the rallying second- and third-place finishers safe. With the victory Bridgetown earns an automatic berth in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf on at Santa Anita Nov. 7. "I still had a lot of horse," Landry said. "He could be a serious horse." Just As Well is in career form at age six, stepping up to take the GIII Arlington H. July 11 before finishing a best-of-the-rest second to Gio Ponti (Tale of the Cat) in the GI Arlington Million Aug. 8. The bay will attempt 12 furlongs for the first time for owner/trainer Jonathan Sheppard. "I'm looking forward to running him at a mile and a half," Sheppard told *Daily Racing Form*. "In his first races last year he was too eager early--he was going to run himself into the ground. He's learned to switch himself off, and settle early." **Marshfield** edged last year's Northern Dancer hero **Champs Elysees** and **Medjool** last out in the 11-furlong GII Sky Classic S. over this course Aug. 23. Fourth by 3/4 of a length in the 2008 renewal of this contest, **Marsh Side** prevailed at 29-1 in the GI Canadian International, but hasn't had his picture taken in four subsequent appearances. He ran second in Gio Ponti's GI Manhattan H. score at Belmont June. 6, but wound up a tired sixth in the GI Man O' War H. over the same course July 11.

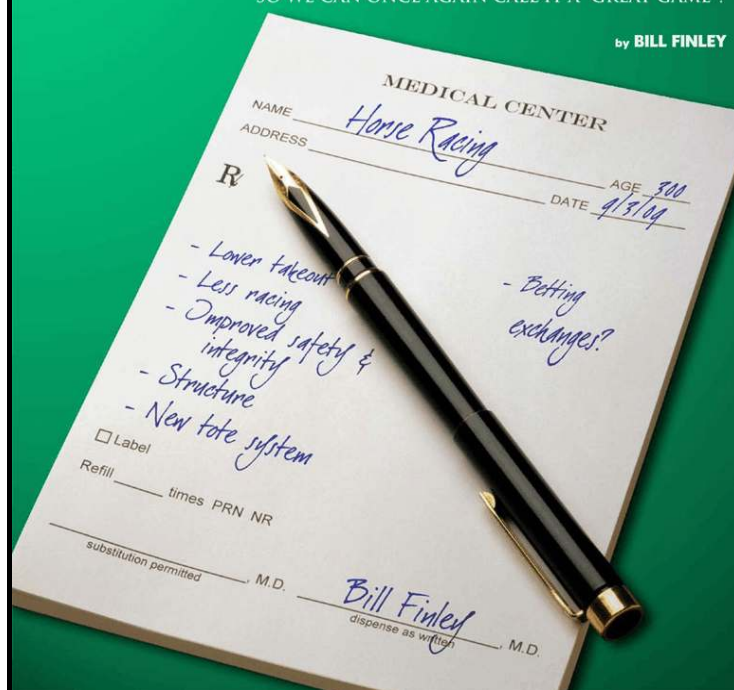

Forever Together finished third in this event last year, but three Grade I wins south of the border--capped by success in the Breeders' Cup F/M Turf--were enough to secure an Eclipse Award. The grey put in her usual fast finish to successfully defend her title in the GI Diana S. last out at Saratoga Aug. 1, and figures to be in the mix at the wire once more here. **Points of Grace** posted a 13-1 upset in the GII Dance Smartly S. over this course and distance July 11, and returns to Canada after finishing fifth in the GI Beverly D. S. at Arlington Aug. 8. "She came back home and has been aiming for this race since then," trainer Malcolm Pierce told *Daily Racing Form*. Pierce will also saddle **Much Obligated**. Heroine of the American 1000 Guineas at Arlington in May 2008, the bay filly tailed off after finishing second by a neck in the GIII Boiling Springs S. the following month. But the Pin Oak homebred is perfect in two starts this year, capturing a seven-furlong allowance over this course June 5 before adding a local off-the-turf affair July 24. "It's time for her to step up, and try a little stiffer company," Pierce continued.

Xavier Moreau was all smiles after watching hip 1544, the Bernstein colt he'd bought for \$55,000 as a weanling, resell for \$475,000. In Moreau's eyes, though, the colt had always had the makings of a star.

"I loved him as a weanling," said Moreau. "I got him on the last day at [Keeneland] November. I was very lucky that a lot of people had gone home. One thing that really

attracted me to him was that I loved the mare, who had followed him

into the ring. She was a big, beautiful mare. In fact, I almost bought the mare [Life Happened, sold to Machmer Hall for \$4,500]."

This spring, Moreau received a vote of confidence in his charge from the Keeneland inspection team.

"Keeneland just loved him when they came and looked at him," he said. "Tom Thornbury said he was one of the best Bernsteins he's seen. It was very encouraging."

And while Moreau was confident he was coming to September with a good prospect, he admitted the colt far exceeded his expectations.

"We came in here thinking \$150,000, maybe \$200,000," said Moreau. "But then we had so much interest. This horse had 23 scopes and so much vet work, and everybody loved him. He was as good as gold."

Born in Paris, France and raised in the south of France, Moreau has been working with horses all his life.

"My family bred and raced Thoroughbreds, we did Arabians, we showed some horses and did jumpers. We did a little bit of everything," he said.

The Moreau family moved to the U.S. about 30 years ago, settling in the outskirts of Houston, Texas.

While it sounds like culture shock defined, Moreau says he took to his new environs with aplomb.

"I loved it," he said, before adding proudly, "I became a U.S. citizen in 1985."

Thirteen years ago, he and wife Sharon moved again, this time to Ocala, Florida, and established the 80-acre Moreau Bloodstock International there. Like many, Moreau has felt the effects of the slumping economy.

"We used to have 100 mares on the farm a few years ago, but now we're down to 35, 40," he said.

That has led to a bit of a shift in focus for Moreau.

"Last year, we decided to pinhook three horses," he explained. "I've bred for years, but with the market the way it is, we decided to pinhook some. It's so much easier to buy than to make them now. To make a horse exactly the way the market wants them is extremely difficult. When I went to Keeneland last November and January, I looked at 150 foals, and only half a dozen were good for me. That means I'd have to breed 180 mares to get six foals that I liked."

Moreau, who sold the third-highest yearling at this year's OBS August Sale, brought just two horses up to September. His second is a Congrats--Show Legs colt that sells as [hip 4532](#). Also making the trip was Moreau's daughter Natalie.

"She has handled the Bernstein colt the entire sale," said Moreau with some admiration. "He's pretty tough."

The Apr. 27-foaled dark bay had previously been purchased by Diagonal Bloodstock for \$140,000 as a Keeneland November weanling. From the second crop of his dual Classic-winning sire, the colt was produced by Swift Princess

The sale of the Afleet Alex--Swift Princess colt ([hip 1287](#)) for \$350,000 meant that, for the second time in as many years, consignor Gerry Dilger of Dromoland Farm notched a big score with a son of the Gainesway stallion. At the last September Sale, Dromoland sold Dublin, by Afleet Alex, to Robert Baker and William Mack for \$525,000. The colt recently showed he was worth every penny of that price tag, winning the GI Hopeful S. for trainer D. Wayne Lukas. Dublin was co-bred by Dilger, along with Peter Blum.

"He was a big, grand horse," Dilger said of hip 1287. "He's a rangy horse like Dublin, though Dublin was a bit stronger at this stage. But this horse was well-grown and I liked him very much. He sold very well, so I was very pleased."

Given his recent success with Afleet Alex, it's no stranger that Dilger is a fan of the young stallion, but he said his admiration goes further back. "I've always liked him because he was such a great race horse," he said. --LM

Avani, a three-parts sister to Grade II winner Jade Flush (Jade Hunter) and SW Tenga (Mr. Prospector), dam of GISW Startac (Theatrical {Ire}).

In keeping with the theme of the day, the colt was another weanling-to-yearling pinhook from the Woods Edge consignment. The dark bay was purchased by Twin Peaks Racing for \$150,000 last year at Keeneland November.

Asked if it gives her any confidence buying a weanling pinhook that had already been gone over by several astute horseman, Siegel said, "No. When you see a pinhook price, it gives you more of an idea of what the seller's thinking, price-wise, if they like them. But it doesn't make me feel more comfortable knowing that someone else had already liked and bought the horse. In some cases, if it's a certain amount, it's enough to take me off a horse."

Jay Em Ess is in the midst of a solid year, care of its star Rail Trip (Jump Start), the GI Hollywood Gold Cup winner who goes next in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic.

"We're going straight to the big one," confirmed Siegel. "As far as I know, he's doing fine." --LM

Out of the Woods, into the Fire...

Pinhooked horses were in high demand yesterday at Keeneland, with seven of the eight top prices on the day coming for horses that had previously sold as either weanlings or as short yearlings in January. Three of the top eight yearlings had something else in common, too: they all hailed from the red-hot consignment of Peter O'Callaghan's Woods Edge Farm.

In total, 10 Woods Edge horses found new homes yesterday, with nine of the 10 bringing more than their weanling prices--some considerably more--a remarkable statistic given the current economic climate.

"We've had a great day. I certainly can't complain," the Irish-bred O'Callaghan said during a break in the action. "We had a nice group of horses that were very highly thought of. There was a lot of veterinary action on them, and they sold accordingly."

O'Callaghan said the vast majority of his horses were purchased as weanlings by the O'Callaghan family, while a few had outside partners, as well. He estimates they bought 25 weanlings to pinhook.

Asked what he typically shops for in a pinhooking prospect, he replied, "We like a nice athletic horse with some scope by nice stallions, like most people do. When you're buying foals, it's not easy. There's a lot of people doing it, and it's hard to get the ones you want. You keep following them in the ring and hope you land a few. But you don't always get the horses you want."

Woods Edge's Saturday consignment included the day's co-second-highest-priced horse, the Stormy Atlantic--Underworld colt ([hip 1310](#)), who went to Mike Ryan for \$350,000.

"He was a very nice, very simple horse," said O'Callaghan. "He was always lovely, and was a very good mover and had a great head. He's out of an Unbridled's Song mare, and seems to have a good mix from both stallions. And people have a lot of respect for Stormy Atlantic."

O'Callaghan and company now have a few days to enjoy their success before getting back to selling Thursday.

"We have a nice Malibu Moon filly and a nice Limehouse filly that should do well," he said.

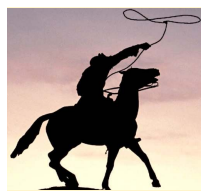

Jambalaya Exits Win in Good Order...

Jambalaya (Langfuhr), winner of the 2007 GI Arlington Million, is doing well after returning from a two-year layoff to win a Woodbine allowance Friday. "That win yesterday was so exiting--it was like a fairy tale," said the seven-year-old's trainer Catherine Day Phillips. "He seemed to come out of the race in fine order, so we'll wait a few days, see how he does next week and, if he looks well, we'll start to make future plans for him." The \$2,500 KEESEP yearling, who also won the 2007 GI Gulfstream Breeders' Cup Turf S., edged The Tin Man (Affirmed) by 3/4 of a length in that year's Million before he was sent to the sidelines. "He came out of the Arlington Million with a big bone bruise in [his] right front fetlock," Day Phillips said. "And when he got the all-clear from that, he pulled a gluteal muscle behind. And when he came back from that last Winter at Gulfstream and was about ready to start, he went lame on his left front. At that point, we sent him to the farm in Florida with the intention of retiring him, but when I went to visit him a few months later, he was all dappled out, so we decided to see how he responded to training."

CONDEMNED (Speightstown)

It was the perfect weather for spending an afternoon at Belmont Park as Condemned sailed to victory in his second start, but Hidden Brook Farm's Jack Brothers, at Keeneland for the September Sale, had to settle for watching the race on television. Still, he was pleased with what he saw.

"It looked like he had a smooth trip this time and leveled out nicely," Brothers said.

A better trip, indeed. Held in high regard by his connections, the chestnut colt was well-bet when he was unveiled at Saratoga Aug. 26, going postward as the 7-2 third choice. He broke awkwardly, but recovered to battle for the lead through splits of :21.36 and :45.25.

That took its toll on him, however, and he packed it in down the stretch to wind up last of 10 as Wildcat Nation (Yes It's True), a half-brother to GISW Visionaire (Grand Slam), rolled on by to win the five-furlong contest in :58.26 ([video](#)).

"He was breaking from the rail, first time out, and he stumbled at the start before getting rushed into contention," Brothers explained. "He got hooked up in a speed duel--they went :21 and one."

Facing a field of firsters yesterday, Condemned was sent off as the 9-5 chalk by the bettors, and made it look as though the track was giving money away. He got away far more smoothly this time under Javier Castellano, and the race was pretty much over from the first call. Paul Pompa Jr.'s colorbearer was in front comfortably while setting a :22.05 and :45.09 pace, opened up significantly in midstretch and was hand-ridden through the final furlong.

"Todd [Pletcher] has been high on him from the start," Brothers said. "This time he benefitted from that experience. Todd said that he galloped out well."

Condemned is a son of the fast Pent Up Kiss (Pentelicus), who bankrolled \$368,463 while capturing four black-type events for New Farm. Bred to fellow New Farm stars Forest Wildcat and Delaware Township, the Florida-bred mare produced five winners from her first six foals, including the black-type placed Town Council (Delaware Township), and had a colt by Speightstown in 2006. That chestnut sold for \$300,000 to Gulf Coast Farms at KEESEP in 2007, and paired up wins at Belmont this year before finishing sixth in the GII Amsterdam S. Aug. 3. Condemned himself made \$350,000 at Keeneland a year ago, with Hidden Brook signing the ticket on Pompa's behalf.

"He's typical of what we're trying to buy," Brothers offered. "We think eventually he'll be a two-turn horse. The pedigree says all speed, but he doesn't fit that physical mold."

New Farm put Pent Up Kiss on the block when she was carrying Condemned, but took her home after she RNA'd for \$75,000 at KEENOV in 2007. She has since produced two more colts by the 2004 champion sprinter Speightstown, and the elder of those two RNA'd on a bid of \$50,000 late during yesterday's session at Keeneland. The chestnut was bred back to Delaware Township.--MK

Godolphin's Fateh Field DQ'd From Allowance Win:

Daily Racing Form is reporting that Godolphin's **Fateh Field** (Distorted Humor) has been disqualified from a Belmont allowance victory Sept. 17 due to the fact that the four-year-old had been placed on the veterinarian's list at Presque Isle Downs. The bay had finished second by a head in a Sept. 12 allowance at the Erie, Pennsylvania, track. Carmine Donofrio, a New York State Racing and Wagering Board steward, told *DRF* that both the horse's connections and the Belmont Park racing office were not unaware that Fateh Field had been on the vet's list at Presque Isle. He been entered to run in the Sept. 17 race a day after his Presque Isle appearance. Horses that have been cited on the vet's list must work out in front of a licensed veterinarian prior to being cleared to race. Dr. Helena Carroll, the track veterinarian at Presque Isle, did not confirm that Fateh Field had been placed on the vet's list, according to *DRF*, but told the publication that horses on the vet's list would not be permitted to race for at least seven days. Presque Isle steward Bill Keen did, however, tell *DRF* that the Godolphin runner was indeed on the vet's list. Fateh Field has now been removed from the vet's list by a New York state veterinarian, and will be permitted to race this Wednesday in Belmont's eighth race, a seven-furlong allowance/optional claimer on the turf. As a result of his disqualification from last Thursday's race, Kinsman Stable's Evolutionist (El Prado {Ire}) has been declared the winner and will be awarded the \$27,000 purse money.

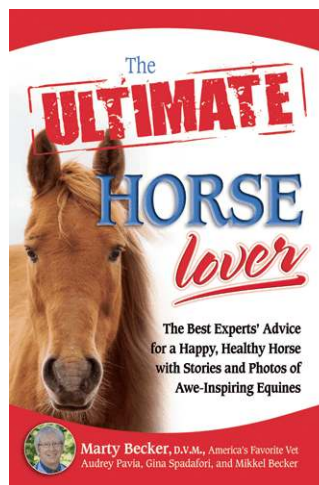
