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## HIB HIB HOORAY!

Still a maiden entering yesterday's G1 Meon Valley Stud Fillies' Mile at Ascot, Mohammed Al Nabouda's **Hibaayeb (GB)** (Singspiel {Ire}) had to survive a stewards' inquiry to lose that tag and provide trainer Clive Brittain with a third renewal. Stepping out of the shadows 15 days ago

when runner-up in the G2 May Hill S. at Doncaster, the progressive bay had failed to convince the punters and started at 8-1 here. In the catbird seat early under Neil Callan, she found a seam up the rail to lead with a furlong remaining, and, despite carrying **Lady Darshaan (Ire)**

(High Chaparral {Ire})--who also received a smack with Callan's whip--left in the final 50 yards, was allowed to keep her hard-earned 3/4-length success. "She has never stopped improving, and the G1 Epsom Oaks is probably on the cards," commented Brittain. **Cont. p2**

## RIP TIDE

Carried to post on a wave of support by the Ascot crowd, 8-13 favorite **Rip Van Winkle (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) repaid the faithful with a bristling performance to double his Group 1 tally in Saturday's G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at the Berkshire track. Beset by foot problems in recent months, the Ballydoyle trainee backed up success in July's G1 Sussex S. at Goodwood with a decisive 1 1/4-length victory from **★ "TDN Rising Star" ★ Zacinto (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) and will now point to the G1 Breeders' Cup Classic at Santa Anita. "He's getting there now, and we're finding out how to ride him," said jockey Johnny Murtagh. "I'm not going to take back what I said before--he's one of the best I've ridden." Indicating future plans in the aftermath of success, trainer Aidan O'Brien added, "I'm really looking forward to the Breeders' Cup Classic. He cruises and he stays, and he has it all there. Let's hope he gets a smooth run to the next [race] day." **Cont. p2-3**

## GALLANT INDEED

**Indian Blessing** (Indian Charlie), first or second in 14 of her first 15 career starts, was the definition of gritty in the GII Gallant Bloom H. at Belmont yesterday. The two-time champion had sophomore **Sara Louise** (Malibu Moon) at her throat when she grabbed a short lead at the top of the lane. The two battled through the final furlong and hit the wire as a team, but it was Indian Blessing who got the nod. **Cont. p4**

Hibaayeb began her racing career with a third behind Eolith (GB) (Pastoral Pursuits {GB}) and Pollenator (Ire) (Motivator {GB}) in a seven-furlong maiden at Newmarket Aug. 8 before finishing a neck runner-up to Creese (GB) (Halling) in a maiden over that same trip at Folkestone 15 days later. She was 40-1 when tackling the May Hill, but outran those odds by reeling in the hot favorite Seta (GB) (Pivotal {GB}) in the closing stages before old rival Pollenator rushed by near the line. Perfectly placed against the rail tracking the pace set by Sent From Heaven (Ire) (Footstepsinthesand {GB}) here, she was gifted a rail run by that wandering rival and duly seized the advantage with a furlong remaining. That was where her troubles started, as her erratic path across Lady Darshaan and Richard Hughes caused connections a few anxious moments before the result was confirmed. "She impressed me a lot in the May Hill where they went no pace, and after ending up in front, she ran around a bit, giving the other horse a chance to come and beat her," jockey Neil Callan said. "Today, I got a nice tow and was always pretty confident, but after getting a lovely run

up the inside, she quickened away and then pricked her ears and shied away into the other horse." For conditioner Clive Brittain, the result was the ultimate justification of his belief in Hibaayeb. He said, "I've been absolutely delighted with her since her third piece of work, when I began to see some light, and I have gradually brought her along. I took her to Folkestone, where she got mugged on the line and then she was mugged again in the May Hill. She is still only a bit of a frame, so I'll let her develop." Lady Darshaan's conditioner Stan Moore commented, "Richard [Hughes] said she was hit across the head by the whip and that stopped her dead in her tracks when she was getting into her stride to win the race. It's just unfortunate, but I had said before the race if she was in the first four it would be a big run. She's a really tough filly, as she was a bit keen to the start. We traveled her with a pony in her box today because she has her quirks." Godolphin's Long Lashes (Rock Hard Ten), the 5-2 favorite, never threatened to land a serious blow before finishing eighth. Rip Van Winkle lined up in the May 2 G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket on his seasonal return, and he closed strongly up the Rowley Mile hill to finish fourth behind champion-elect Sea the Stars (Ire) (Cape Cross {Ire}). Johnny Murtagh kept the faith from a Ballydoyle team of six and posted another fourth in the June 6 G1 Epsom Derby before improving two spots in the July 4 G1 Eclipse S. at Sandown, his third sighting of John Oxx's stable star. The jockey was ultimately vindicated with victory in Goodwood's G1 Sussex S. July 29, despite an 11th hour injury scare, and his evaluation was spot on once more with a brave triumph in this. Murtagh was keen to have his mount front and center from flagfall, but was afforded the luxury of a target as Aqlaam (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}) won the battle for early supremacy. Rip Van Winkle maintained the tempo when taking over into the straight, but looked vulnerable as Zacinto loomed large running to the final furlong. However, he would not be denied and found abundant reserves under forceful urging from the saddle, edging further ahead as the line approached. **Cont. p3**

"He's not easy to train, but, thankfully, the last two weeks went well," said Murtagh. "We went hard all the way and I felt them coming to me, but he came out on top in a very good race." Elaborating on Rip Van Winkle's fractured training regime, trainer Aidan O'Brien added, "He got a very bad infection in all four of his heels in the spring and it went down into his feet. Our team of vets has done a marvellous job to keep him right, but he's had a very interrupted preparation since Goodwood. After the Sussex he was very sore and very lame, but for the last few weeks he's had a good run at it. He's an unbelievable horse and Johnny gave him a great ride. We didn't put in a pacemaker because we would have had to have a Group 1 sprinter to lead him, and we didn't have one of those. It was lovely the way it happened today. He has class, he has speed, he's brave and he stays. He's got it all."

**Placegetters are Breeders' Cup Possibles too...**

While maintaining grace in defeat, connections of both placegetters indicated Santa Anita's Breeders' Cup meet as a possible destination for Zacinto and Delegator. Of the former, Juddmonte's Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe told *PA Sport*, "At one stage we got upsides the winner, and one thing is for sure, we have earned a bit of respect today. There are a couple of options, including the [G1] Champion S. [at Newmarket Oct. 17] and one of the mile races at the Breeders' Cup, but our immediate thought after this is to go to Newmarket." Of the latter, Godolphin's Racing Manager Simon Crisford added, "He fell a bit short today, but we were beaten by two better horses on the day. My feeling is we will still go for the [GI] Breeders' Cup Mile with him. He will be running against those good horses and we know there will be no hiding place in California." She earned the Eclipse after taking the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, but Indian Blessing has raced exclusively in sprints since running second in the one-mile GI Acorn S. last June. Romping to easy wins in the GI Prioress S., GI Test S. and in last year's Gallant Bloom, the Earnhardt homebred was second to Ventura (Chester House) in the Breeders' Cup F/M Sprint, then signed off on the season with a success in the GI La Brea S. and was honored as the champion distaff sprinter. Indian Blessing was off to the Middle East for her 2009 opener in the Mar. 28 G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen, finishing a noble second, and was looking for her first win of the year after a fourth in the June 14 Desert Stormer H. at Hollywood and a second on a sloppy Saratoga strip in the Aug. 29 GI Ballerina S. Taken in hand early, she was on top after a half in :45.15 and fought off favored Sara Louise down the lane for the score. Furthest Land, claimed for \$35,000 out of a NW2L race at Belmont last fall, rewarded his new connections with three consecutive allowance victories on turf. Fourth in the Feb. 21 Tampa Bay S. over the spinach, the gelding annexed a Keeneland optional claimer by 2 1/4 lengths Apr. 5 in his synthetic debut. He beat one home to finish eighth in the GI Woodford Reserve Turf Classic on the Kentucky Derby undercard, and defeated three opponents to take an-off-the-turf renewal of the Golden Bear S. in the slop at Indiana Downs June 10 before running fourth in the non-black-type Claiming Crown Jewel July 25 at Canterbury last time. Kept in the clear in fifth, he launched a challenge for the lead at the top of the stretch. Garrett Gomez went to a drive, and the gelding made an inexorable run to remain undefeated over the all-weather and give his rider a sweep of the three graded stakes on the card. Switching back to the synthetic after three disappointing turf efforts, Indescribable turned it around as the crowd's second choice. The chestnut capped off her 2008 campaign with a win in the Nov. 15 GIII Cardinal H. over a yielding Churchill lawn, and resurfaced with a victory in the Apr. 17 GIII Doubledogdare S. on the Keeneland all-weather. Third as the 4-5 chalk in the May 23 GIII Arlington Matron H., she then moved to the grass, running eighth as the 7-5 favorite in the June 20 GIII All Along S. at Colonial Downs. Indescribable was off the board in the Aug. 1 GI Diana S. and the Sept. 4 Voodoo Dancer S. at Saratoga, and connections opted to get her back on the Poly. Content to track the pace from fourth, she closed from the outside on the turn. The homebred sustained her rally in the stretch, getting to the front at the eighth pole and drawing clear. Joshua Tree started off with a battling win in a seven-furlong maiden at Gowran Park Aug. 5, and was sent off at 6-5 when second in a mile nursery at Listowel 11 days prior to this race. Despite starting as Ballydoyle's second string on jockey bookings here



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behind the eventually luckless Mikhail Glinka (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}), the bay took a major leap forward with a clear-cut success. Settled in rear early by Colm O'Donoghue, he was swung wide on the turn into the straight and unleashed a surge which took

him to the front with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining. Crossing the eventual third Vale of York shortly after, he was kept up to his work to hold the staying Waseet and was allowed to keep the race by the stewards despite his minor infringement. "He learned a lot from Listowel, where the line came a bit quick for him, but had been coming forward with every run and Colm gave him a lovely ride here," trainer Aidan O'Brien commented. "He's a good-moving horse who came home very well--he's had three runs now so we won't be in a hurry with him and we'll see how he comes out of it." El Brujo provided Canadian shippers with a second straight renewal of this event, which has been a productive prep for the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint. Not quite as brilliant as last year's winner, Fatal Bullet (Red Bullet)--who went on the finish second in the Sprint--El Brujo has cut out a fine reputation of his own as a sprinter back home at Woodbine. He returned from a November layoff to take the Apr. 11 Achievement S. and the May 2 Queenston S. around one turn before finishing ninth as the chalk in the nine-furlong Plate Trial S. May 31. Last of 13 in the Queen's Plate June 21, the gelding was most recently runner-up in a valuable Woodbine six-furlong allowance Aug. 12. Fozzy added, "We think Gibraltar Blue is quite a smart filly, and she did it quite well at Fairyhouse. She got shuffled back early on, but got there and won with her ears pricked, so she'll go there with every chance as well." Richard Hannon is always to be respected in these races and, after recording a double in the Million and Fillies' Million 12 months ago, relies on the Weatherbys Insurance 2YO S. third **Lucky General** and the July 25 G3 Princess Margaret S. runner-up **Full Mandate**. "[Lucky General] has only won a couple of minor races at Windsor, but he is as tough as teak and ran a terrific race to finish third from a bad draw in the big Sales race at Doncaster," Hannon commented. "[Full Mandate's] best runs have been when she has been up there forcing the pace, but I'll tell Mick [Kinane] to make plenty of use of her, and she would be quite happy bowling along."

**ARC POSSIBLE FOR DAR RE MI** Connections of **Dar Re Mi (GB)** (Singspiel {Ire}) announced that they could still head to Sunday's G1 Qatar Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe despite the rejection of their appeal against her disqualification in the G1 Prix Vermeille. Just 24 hours after learning that France-Galop would not be reversing the decision of the Longchamp stewards to demote her from first to fifth in that Sept. 13 contest, owner/breeder Madeleine Lloyd Webber said, "The appeal and the Arc are two issues and we cannot connect the two, as we have to do whatever is right for the filly. If the filly is fit and well and if John Gosden thinks she should run, she will run and take her chance and it will be the right thing for the filly's career. Dar Re Mi worked very well this morning and she is going to have her last bit of work on Tuesday. The Arc is a world-class race in its own right; you have to forget about where it is being held. We would be delighted if something would change or if there was some modernisation of the racing rules as a result of this. I hope that Dar Re Mi might be a catalyst for change in the future."



## Racing Round-Up

### IEAH Buys Diamondrella...

The *Daily Racing Form* reports that IEAH Stables has purchased GISW **Diamondrella (GB)** (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}--Tap Your Feet, by Dixieland Band) from Castletop Stable for an undisclosed amount. IEAH acquired 70 percent of the five-year-old mare, while the company's co-president, Michael Iavarone, bought the other 30 percent for himself. A \$185,000 KEESEP yearling, the bay has raced exclusively in the U.S., and reeled off four consecutive victories to close out her 2008 campaign. Diamondrella opened 2009 with her fifth straight in Keeneland's Giant's Causeway S. Apr. 18, and made it six in a row in the GI Just a Game S. at Belmont June 6, where she bested champion Forever Together (Belong to Me) by 1 3/4 lengths. Switched to synthetic for the Sept. 12 GIII Presque Isle Downs Masters S., she didn't appear to take to the surface, finishing sixth. The British-bred will remain in trainer Angel Penna Jr.'s barn, and will likely make her next appearance in the GI First Lady S. on the turf at Keeneland Oct. 10. Looking ahead, Iavarone indicated that three Breeders' Cup races are under consideration--the GI F/M Sprint, GI Mile or the Turf Sprint. "Any one of those three races have to be kept on the radar screen," Iavarone told *DRF*. "Anything can happen with any horse and change the complexion of any race. Right now, the two-turn mile at Keeneland is an interesting target. How she runs there will dictate a lot. If she relishes the two-turn mile, it does put the Breeders' Cup Mile on the top of the list." He added that the mare will be bred to Big Brown at the conclusion of her racing career.

### Sidney's Candy to Miss Norfolk...

Sore shins will prevent ☆ **"TDN Rising Star" ☆ Sidney's Candy** (Candy Ride {Arg}) from starting in Oak Tree's Oct. 4 GI Norfolk S., *Daily Racing Form* reports. Trainer John Sadler will instead point the chestnut towards the two-year-old series at the Hollywood Park fall meeting. Second by a head on debut at Del Mar July 25, the Craig family homebred established a 5 1/2-furlong track record of 1:02.71 when he powered clear to graduate by four lengths at the seaside oval Aug. 22.

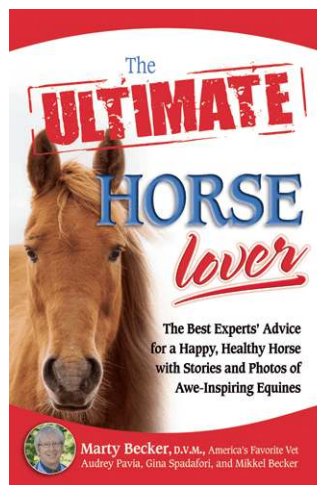

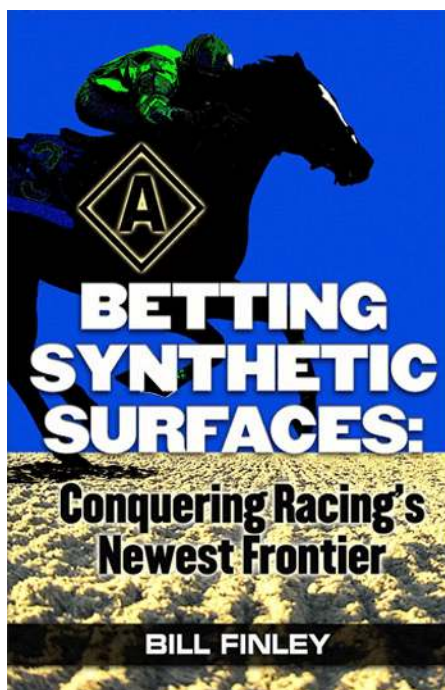

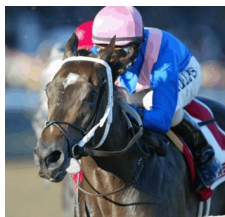

**September 27, 1894...****Aqueduct Racetrack** opened its doors. The building was torn down in 1955 and the new Aqueduct was reopened September 14, 1959.

**September 27, 1947...****Armed**, then the world's leading money-winning Thoroughbred, met 1946 Triple Crown winner **Assault** in the first \$100,000 winner-take-all match race, held at Belmont Park. Armed won easily over a less-than 100 percent Assault.

**September 28, 1960...**Forty years after Man o'War won the Lawrence Realization by 100 lengths in the record time of 2:40 4/5, **Kelso** equaled his time in the same event.

**September 28, 1983...**Atlantic City Racecourse and The Meadowlands became the first U.S. tracks to engage in simulcasting.

**September 28, 1996...**Jockey **Dave Gall** became only the fourth rider to win 7,000 races, piloting A. J. Onray to victory at Fairmount Park.

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
