It seems that there is little will in the gods to upset the course that **Sea the Stars (Ire)** (Cape Cross {Ire}) is charting during his golden season, and all is in order again ahead of the G1 Qatar Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. Wherever Christopher Tsui's "colt for the ages" has

traveled this year, the fortunes have favored him, and an unusually dry lead-up to today's Longchamp feature appears the icing on the cake. Even superstition is on his side, with his rider Michael Kinane entering the race in the knowledge that he was victorious in 1989 and 1999. "Hopefully, every 10 years it comes around," Kinane quipped at Dundalk Friday eve-

ning before assuming his customary steely persona. "Things have been going well, and his preparation has been great," he added. "We have a nice draw, so hopefully things will work out nicely." After an unprecedented run of success through the G1 2000 Guineas, G1 Epsom Derby, G1 Coral-Eclipse S., G1 Juddmonte International S. and, most recently, the Sept. 5 Irish Champion S., the John Oxx trainee has assumed the aura of greatness. He bids to emulate the feat of his legendary dam Urban Sea (Miswaki) 16 years ago. "He has a big head and a great opinion of himself now," Kinane remarked. "He knows he's a superstar, but behaves himself impeccably and is easy to train and handle. We just need that little bit of luck now, but I couldn't have asked for a better preparation." **Cont. p7-10**

"It means a lot to win the three races in New York," trainer Tim Ice offered. "It's been 20 years since a three-year-old won the Belmont S, the Travers and the Jockey Club Gold Cup. I think it puts him in an elite group and he should be named [champion] three-year-old colt." **Gio Ponti** (Tale of the Cat) was upset by **Interpatation** (Langfuhr) in the G1 Joe Hirsch Turf Classic, while **Music Note** (A.P. Summer Bird became the first three-year-old since the exalted Easy Goer (Alydar) in 1989 to sweep the GI Belmont S., GI Travers. S. and GI Jockey Club Gold Cup, and in all likelihood, earned himself an Eclipse Award in the process. After his surprising win in the Belmont June 6, the Jayaramans' homebred finished an honorable second in the GI Haskell Invitational S. famously won by Rachel Alexandra (Medaglia d'Oro) at Monmouth Aug. 2. He stretched back to 10 panels for the Shadwell Travers Aug. 29 and splashed home an authoritative winner. Favored in his first try against older horses, Summer Bird settled into a spot on the outside while keeping tabs on the leaders. Quality Road took over heading into the home turn, and jockey Kent Desormeaux urged Summer Bird along to stay within striking distance. The plan worked like a charm. The chestnut edged ever closer to Quality Road in front of the stands and, under a hand ride from Desormeaux, forged ahead approaching the wire. "When Summer Bird took the lead, I was very confident that no one was going to get in front of him," said winning trainer Tim Ice. "Summer Bird was hanging a little bit on him; Kent said it was easier than it looked." Ice added, "The goal is the [GI] Breeders' Cup [Classic, Nov. 7]. We'll take a couple of days and see how he is."

Despite trying 12 furlongs for the first time--and in a bog at that--divisional leader Gio Ponti seemed to be on his way to a fifth straight Grade I victory at the stretch call here. Not so fast, said Interpatation. Third in the 2007 renewal and a distant runner-up to Grand Couturier last year, the seven-year-old was coming off a fourth in the PTHA President's Cup at Philly Park Sept. 19. He showed the way through trotting-horse splits of 1:22.20--for six furlongs--and a mile in 1:48.79. Three-year-old Al Khali (Medaglia d'Oro) threw in the towel at that point, and Gio Ponti ranged up on the outside looking to secure his Breeders' Cup credentials. The favorite looked to be going right by, but began to ease up once he made the lead, and the veteran on his inside proved resurgent to have his picture taken for the first time in just over two years. "I was waiting for him one day to pick his head up and do it right," said winning trainer Bobby Barbara. "He did it right, on the perfect day. This horse made \$700,000 the hard way, and now he's over a million in one day! I don't know what's next for him." As for Gio Ponti, trainer Christophe Clement offered, "Second best in that one, but I thought he ran a very good race--he really tried. Pure Clan, third in last term's GI Kentucky Oaks, was switched back to grass last summer, reeling off wins in the GIII Regret S. at Churchill and the GI American Oaks Invitational S. at Hollywood before placing second in the GI Garden City Breeders' Cup S. over the Belmont spinach in September. The chestnut failed to land a blow against horses when crossing the wire 10th--then moved up to ninth via the stewards--in the GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf at Oak Tree, the only off-the-board finish in her stellar 15-start career. Kicking off her four-year-old campaign in the June 6 GIII Early Times Mint Julep H. at Churchill, she rallied to finish second, beaten a neck, then went one better in Arlington's GIII Modesty H. July 11. She entered this off a third-place finish as the 3-2 chalk in the GI Beverly D. S. Aug. 8. With Julien Leparoux in the irons, Pure Clan saved ground in fifth as Leamington (Pleasant Tap) set easy early fractions of :26.81 and :53.81 over the boggy going. Given her cue on the turn for home, the 2007 GIII Pocahontas S. heroine rallied in tandem with Moneycantbuymelove (Ire) (Pivotal {GB}), and came with a sustained run to grab the lead in deep stretch as the rain came down in buckets. "She ran a great race," trainer Bob Holthus said. "She showed more speed today than normal. She was in the race all the way. Julien had confidence. It's always good to get Grade I's." Favored Dynaforce (Dynaformer) reportedly lost a shoe on the far turn before fading to finish fifth. Varenar was introduced by Alain de Royer-Dupre at this track last September, and got off the mark on his third attempt at Compiègne the following month. After winning two of his next three conditions starts, the homebred was pitched into the G3 Prix de la Porte Maillot over this track and trip June 22, and acquitted himself with credit to be second. Fourth in the G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest at Deauville Aug. 9, he found only Proviso (GB) (Dansili {GB}) a neck too strong in the G3 Prix du Pin back over this course and distance on his latest outing Sept. 6. Varenar, drawn alongside Goldikova here, was restrained from the gate by Stephane Pasquier as the market leader raced close to the fierce early pace before assuming command at halfway. Goldikova stretched her lead in early stretch, while Varenar still languished in the main group, but she paid for her early exploits. Sweet Hearth took over in the final 100 yards, then Varenar came charging with a wide sweep that denied his barn mate in the shade of the post. "This result is not a surprise to me, as he has never had suitable racing circumstances--he needs a fast pace so that he can relax and come from behind," de Royer-Dupre commented. "Stephane [Pasquier] gave him a beautiful ride, and we'll see later on where he goes." Varenar was catalogued to sell at yesterday evening's Arqana Arc Sale, but was withdrawn. Just minutes after the reversal of Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa) in France, Sahpresa provided more surprises when getting the better of G1 1000 Guineas heroine Ghanaati. Starting out with a win in a mile conditions event at Maisons-Laffitte last July, the filly recorded a black-type success in her third outing in Saint-Cloud's Listed Prix Coronation that September. Subsequently fourth in the G3 Darley S. here on Champions' Day, the bay got off the mark on her sophomore bow in Longchamp's Listed Prix de Montretout May 7. She was runner-up in the G3 Prix du Chemin de Fer du Nord at Chantilly June 14, then tackled Goldikova in Deauville's G1 Prix Rothschild on her next start and was a respectable fourth in that Aug. 2 highlight. Sahpresa filled the runner's-up spot again in the G3 Prix Quincey back at that venue four weeks later. Breaking well under Ted Durcan here, the homebred was restrained off the

strong pace set by Spacious. Sahpresa moved closer approaching the downhill sweep into the dip. Ghanaati edged ahead under Richard Hills, but it was Sahpresa who had the final say, quickening by the favorite

before the furlong pole and comfortably holding her rally in the run to the line. "They went hard early on, and she traveled lovely and quickened up nicely," Durcan said. "At this time of year, you can get strange results in these mares' races, and luckily it went our way." Trainer Rodolphe Collet added, "This is the second time she has been to Newmarket, and we came for the good ground. Today she showed she is a top-class filly, and she has a strictly American pedigree, so good ground is much better than soft. I don't ever want to run her on heavy." Collet continued, "Ted followed exactly what I said, as eight furlongs here is the maximum for her. Last year, she did well in the Darley S. against older horses, but showed that a mile is her trip on that occasion. She will probably stay in training at five, so we will keep her fresh for then and maybe come back to England for Ascot."

Music Note punched her return ticket to the GI Breeders' Cup Ladies Classic nee Distaff with this professional score. Runner-up in the balloting for Eclipse Award honors in 2008, the bay faltered in her seasonal bow, finishing a lackluster fifth in the GI Ogden Phipps H. June 13. Her team worked with some of her lingering small issues, and a new-and-improved Music Note surfaced in the seven-furlong GI Ballerina S. in the Saratoga slop Aug. 29. Facing divisional heavyweights Indian Blessing (Indian Charlie) and Informed Decision (Monarchos) that day, the four-year-old blew by them with authority, and was bet accordingly by the wagering public here. However, 2007 Beldame heroine Unbridled Belle, with blinkers off, resurrected her earlier form and looked very dangerous as she bowled through :47.99 and 1:11.66. Jockey Rajiv Maragh asked Music Note for a bit more in the lane and the favorite obliged, putting away her foe in the final furlong. "I was a little concerned about how well Unbridled Belle was traveling," admitted assistant trainer Rick Mettee. His boss, Saeed bin Suroor, added, "I was waiting for [Maragh] to take her outside. When he did, I was happy. We'll take her to the Breeders' Cup. Nine furlongs will suit her."

Back in April, Kodiak Kowboy ran down Fabulous Strike to secure his first top-level score in the GI Carter H. at Aqueduct, and it was deja vu all over again as he surprised the gallant veteran in the shadow of the wire. Kodiak Kowboy had been guided by Steve Asmussen during his juvenile campaign, when he earned Sovereign Award honors in Canada for his exploits. He was turned over to Larry Jones midway through his sophomore season, and captured the GII Amsterdam S. at Saratoga in his first start for that trainer. A close third in last year's Vosburgh, the bay captured the GIII Sport Page H. Oct. 25 before closing out 2008 with a fifth in the GI Hill 'n' Dale Cigar Mile Nov. 29. He began his four-year-old season with a second in the Duncan F. Kenner S. at Fair Grounds Mar. 14. He bounced after the Carter to finish seventh as the chalk in the GII Churchill Downs H. May 2, but came back to post a four-length success in the Donald Levine Memorial H. at Philly Park June 27. Third in Fabulous Strike's GII Alfred G. Vanderbilt H. Aug. 9 at the Spa, Kodiak Kowboy came here off a half-length second to Pyro (Pulpit) in the GI Forego S. at the same track Sept. 5. He returned to Asmussen's barn in the interim, and assumed his customary spot well off the pace set by Go Go Shoot (Songandaprayer) and Fabulous Strike. The latter seemed to be home free in midstretch, but Kodiak Kowboy came running and finished up strongly in the slop for his second Grade I win of the year. "I was on him when he won the [GII] Saratoga Special [in 2007]," said winning rider Shaun Bridgmohan. "He was a pro even back then. When he was transferred to Steve Asmussen's barn, I was excited because I knew I had a shot at getting back on him. Today, when I hit him left-handed, he really dug in gamely." not for the considerable presence of Sea the Stars. That colossus proved his nemesis in both the G1 Epsom Derby and G1 Irish Champion S. either side of an emphatic five-length success in the June 28 G1 Irish Derby at The Curragh. On that occasion, Derrick Smith, Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor's great hope had what was an ideal scenario of a strongly run mile and a half on ground easier than good. Of the last six three-year-old colts to collect

this prize, four had contested the Kildare Classic, including his sire Montjeu and that luminary's son Hurricane Run (Ire). Despite not being able to tax Sea the Stars at Epsom and Leopardstown, the Ballydoyle camp have not hesitated in taking him on, with all guns blazing so far this season, and Aidan O'Brien offered his thoughts at Friday's draw ceremony. "[Fame and Glory] had a big long break after the Irish Derby, and we were sorry the clash with Sea the Stars didn't materialise in that race," O'Brien commented. "He then had two months off before the Irish Champion S., and he was only just ready to start back. We were delighted with him, because when you see a horse that gets a mile and a half like him, yet can quicken up as he did in the Champion S., then you'd have to be really happy and looking forward to his next run."

Cavalry to the Rescue?...

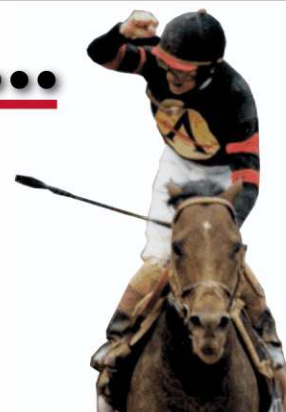
Andre Fabre has won the Arc six times since Trempolino (Sharpen Up {GB}) opened the score back in 1987. Chantilly's longstanding icon has made no secret of the regard he has for Sea the Stars, but if the favorite flops, he has a live contender in **Cavalryman (GB)** (Halling). Already a course-and-distance Group 1 winner, Godolphin France's progressive colt followed a defeat of Age of Aquarius (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) and subsequent G1 St Leger hero Mastery (GB) (Sulamani {Ire}) in the July 14 Grand Prix de Paris with a prep win in the G2 Prix Niel here Sept. 13. Only workmanlike in besting His Highness The Aga Khan's **Beheshtam (Fr)** (Peintre Celebre) by a half-length on that occasion, he bids to become the ninth colt to use that prep as a springboard to glory here since 1996. "Cavalryman hasn't got a great draw [in 19], but, hopefully, over a mile and a half, it will not play against him too much," Godolphin's Racing Manager Simon Crisford commented. "Andre has been happy with his progress leading into the race, and I don't think the good going will be a problem--he has form on all types of ground."

The State of Play...

Eric Libaud warned 12 months ago that **Vision d'Etat (Fr)** (Chichicastenango {Fr}) was more of a long-term project ahead of his first try at this race and, in the event, the 2008 G1 Prix du Jockey-Club hero was not disgraced when fifth after a troubled trip. His trainer and part-owner's prediction has been proved correct so far this term after the grey mastered the G1 Prix Ganay at this track Apr. 26 and G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot June 17. He enjoyed a stress-free prep when second to Spanish Moon (El Prado {Ire}) in the G2 Prix Foy over course and distance Sept. 13, and Libaud commented, "The ground at Ascot was good when Vision d'Etat won the Prince of Wales's S. in June, but a bit of rain would help. All I ask for is genuinely good-to-soft ground, so that everybody can give their best." He added, "Vision d'Etat came back a bit sore from his last prep race, but he's completely recovered now. He's bounced back and looks at least as good as he was before Ascot." **Arc preview cont. p9**

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Re-Visiting the Scene of the Crime...

The decision by the Longchamp stewards to disqualify **Dar Re Mi (GB)** (Singspiel {Ire}) from first to fifth in the Sept. 13 G1 Prix Vermeille over this course and distance has become one of the talking points of the season. Many argue that the Lloyd-Webbers' four-year-old was the clear-cut winner on the day, and that she should have been allowed to keep the race her dam Darara (Ire) (Top Ville {Ire}) plundered in 1986. Politics aside, she is still the winner of two Group 1 races, the June 27 Pretty Polly S. and Aug. 20 Yorkshire Oaks, in which she lowered the colors of Sariska (GB) (Pivotal {GB}). Her trainer John Gosden was concentrating on the positive aspects, saying, "She is fine and in good form. We will just have to see what happens, and Jimmy [Fortune] will ride as he finds it. I am happy she will jump and use her stride, which she enjoys doing. She is capable of coming from off the pace and she is capable of making her own running--she has done it all. She is versatile on any ground. She is taking on the colts, and we have to be realistic that we have previously been racing in fillies' Group 1s."

Lemaire Misses Out on Five-Timer...

Christophe Lemaire, who was forced to the sidelines with a broken collarbone after a fall at Saint-Cloud Friday, missed out on five winning rides on the opening day of Longchamp's two-day Arc meet yesterday. Lemaire could only watch as **Manighar (Fr)** (Linamix {Fr}) in the G2 Prix de Chaudenay, **Daryakana (Fr)** (Selkirk) in the G2 Prix de Royallieu, **Tamazirte (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) in the G2 Prix Daniel Wildenstein, **Pipedreamer (GB)** (Selkirk) in the G2 Prix Dollar and handicap scorer **Roatan (GB)** (Daylami {Ire}) all won in the hands of substitute riders. Tamazirte was guided to victory by Christophe Soumillon, who made a surprise early return to the saddle, having fractured his elbow in a fall at Nancy Sept. 9, and the Belgian is slated to replace Lemaire aboard the hitherto unbeaten **Stacelita (Fr)** (Monsun {Ger}) in today's main event. That filly's trainer Jean-Claude Rouget said yesterday, "We are pleased to have Christophe on Stacelita, and feel that he will suit her well."

Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe

The progeny of Urban Sea, who died earlier this year at the age of 20, have landed many of the world's most prestigious prizes, but none have emulated their mother by winning the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. That could change today when Sea the Stars (Ire) (Cape Cross {Ire}) goes postward in Europe's richest turf race as the heavy favorite.

Although she remains one of the most influential broodmares in modern history, the story of Urban Sea had humble origins. French breeder Michel Henochsberg needed only approximately \$55,000 to acquire her dam Allegretta (GB) (Lombard {Ger}) ([catalogue-style pedigree](#)), who was in foal to Irish Castle, at the 1984 KEENOV sale.

"I wanted to buy [Allegretta] because she was quite a good performer," said Henochsberg, the former chairman of the French and European Breeders' Associations. "She was second in the [G3] Oaks Trial S. at Lingfield. She ran in the Oaks, but she was quite nervous--she was on her toes--and she didn't perform well. She was sold to the United States, but she didn't do much there, and they put her in the sale in foal to Irish Castle."

It wasn't just Allegretta's racetrack performance that caught Henochsberg's attention.

"She was out of a fantastic German family that was not fashionable at the time," he said. "I knew the main bloodlines in Europe, including those in smaller countries like Italy and Germany. This mare was coming from the 'A' family, where the mares' names start with the letter 'A.' It's the blood of the stud Gestut Schlenderhan."

Her first three foals were unremarkable, with handicap horse Irish Allegre (Irish River {Fr}) being the best of the lot. That all changed when Henochsberg decided to send Allegretta to a son of Mr. Prospector.

"[Irish Allegre] was a decent horse, but he was not brilliant," he said. "The entire German family consisted of stayers, and I wanted some Mr. Prospector blood. At that time, he represented speed, at least for Europeans. Miswaki was a good performer in France, and he was a winner at seven furlongs." **Cont. p10**

"[Miswaki] was starting to become quite highly regarded in the United States, as he was standing for \$40,000 at Walmac Farm. Miswaki was not a big horse. Allegretta was a big mare--workmanlike."

Getting a season to Miswaki wasn't easy, but Henochsberg was able to obtain one from then bloodstock agent [now TDN Publisher] Barry Weisbord. The resulting foal was a chestnut filly.

"[Urban Sea] had a good structure and a good frame," Henochsberg recalled. "She was not unfurnished, but she was not the most pleasant yearling. She was a very good walker and a good athlete."

Like all other horses bred by Henochsberg at the time, she was sold at auction.

Henochsberg set a reserve of FF280,000 (about \$50,000) when he offered her at the Deauville yearling sale, and she sold for that exact price.

"One bid less, and I would have kept her," he noted.

Henochsberg admitted Urban Sea's racing success surprised him, as she took the 1993 G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe en route to being named France's highweight older mare at 11-14 furlongs.

"As a two-year-old, [Urban Sea] was nothing much," he said. "As a three-year-old, she was a good group winner. At four, she became a champ. She was always very useful, but she improved. She had a big, big heart. She didn't really have the structure to be a champion, but she wanted to win."

Henochsberg, having missed the chance to campaign Urban Sea, attempted to buy an interest in her as a broodmare prospect.

"I had become friends with her current owner, Mrs. Tsui," he said. "I proposed we make a partnership, breeding her on a foal share to Nureyev, who was one of the most expensive stallions in the U.S."

"We were very close to completing this deal, but she changed her mind."

While fate worked against Henochsberg with Urban Sea, luck was on his side when he tried to sell Allegretta's sixth foal, Allez Les Trois (Riverman). She failed to meet her reserve of FF550,000, and she would go on to win the G3 Prix de Flore and finish third in the GIII Saratoga Breeders' Cup H. As a broodmare, Allez Les Trois produced the 2001 G1 Prix du Jockey Club winner Anabaa Blue (GB) (Anabaa). Turbaine (Trepolino), also out of Allegretta, produced MGSW Tertullian (Miswaki) and GSW Terek (Ger) (Irish River {Fr}).

Allegretta saved one of her best runners for her later years when, in 1997, she foaled the eventual G1 English 2000 Guineas winner King's Best (Kingmambo). Pensioned after coming up barren in 2000 and 2001, Allegretta died in 2005 at the age of 27. Despite having passed on, Allegretta's impact on the breed has been guaranteed by Urban Sea, whose son by Sadler's Wells, Galileo (Ire), has established himself as one of the finest young stallions in the world. Her son Black Sam Bellamy (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) plies his trade in Germany. Stud plans for Sea the Stars have yet to be determined.

Henochsberg, a professor of economics at the University of Paris, credits Urban Sea for Sea the Stars' brilliance.

"Sea the Stars looks like a typical Cape Cross or Green Desert," he said. "He's very handsome colt with a lot of power, but obviously there is something inside that comes from Urban Sea. This mixture seems to be something great. I hope I'll have another filly like her, but it's very doubtful. I'm hoping he'll win [the Arc], just like his mother did." -J.F.

Daryakana capped a memorable afternoon for His Highness The Aga Khan and Alain de Royer-Dupre by completing their group-race treble, following the exploits of the G2 Prix Chaudenay winner Manighar (Fr) (Linamix {Fr}) and G1 Prix de la Foret scorer Varenar (Fr) (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}). Unbeaten in three prior starts, the homebred produced dramatic acceleration to come from last to first in a matter of strides on debut at Clairefontaine July 9, at Deauville Aug. 4 and in the Listed Prix des Tourelles at Chantilly last time Sept. 2. Those exaggerated tactics were employed again here by Gerald Mosse, who was enjoying one of his finest days since returning from Hong Kong. Still detached in early stretch, Mosse allowed all rivals first run before steering the chestnut wide for her surge passing the quarter pole. Chopping down Peinture Rare passing the furlong marker, Daryakana swept to a decisive success to provide her renowned owner-breeder with a sixth renewal, and her conditioner with a fourth. "She is a lovely filly, and the way she quickened was impressive," the Aga Khan's Manager Georges Rimaud commented. "We will keep her in training next year and decide in a few days whether she runs again this year or not. "When she relaxes, she can quicken, and Christophe gave her a beautiful ride. I will discuss plans with her owners, and she is not certain to run again this year, but, hopefully, she will stay in training."

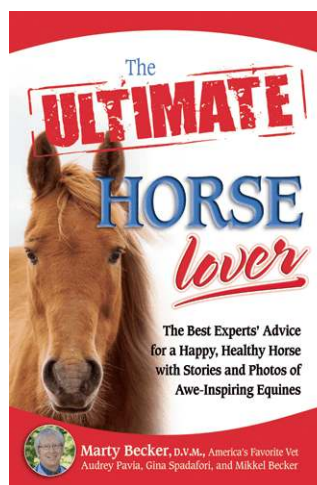

His only experience of this venue came when winning the 2007 Petit Couvert and he enjoyed his foray to Chantilly when annexing the May 31 G2 Prix du Gros-Chene. Fourth in the Nunthorpe last time, rider Adrian Nicholls is hoping for a leap forward. "He's in good form and great heart," he commented.

Yeats says goodbye here and bids to cap an iconic career with a first victory in this "French Gold Cup" in which he was third in 2007 and fifth last year. Were it not for a subsequent win in the G1 Prix Royal-Oak in late October, it would have been easy to dismiss Longchamp as the bogey track for the King of Ascot. His performance when recording a heralded fourth G1 Gold Cup at the Royal meeting June 18 might have been a career-high, but he was far from his imperious best in The Curragh's soft ground when trailing in last in the Sept. 12 G1 Irish St Leger last time. "Yeats is old and wise now, and when the ground is heavy he just minds himself--if he wasn't like that, he wouldn't have been around so long," Aidan O'Brien explained. "He's in good form and the better ground will suit him, but it will be his last run, so hopefully he'll come back safe. It's been a privilege to have had him and we'll never have another." The Irish Leger fell to **Alandi**, whose attitude could not be faulted as he outgamed Clowance (GB) (Montjeu {Ire}) by a half length in what became a war of attrition. He is crying out for marathon trips on that evidence and Mick Kinane commented, "I think the step up in distance will help him enormously and we are hoping he can be a bit more adaptable ground-wise when going a trip. We want to see how he is on a fast surface with Gold Cups in mind for next year. We just had a little hold-up with a quarter crack after the Irish Leger and he missed a bit of work, but was very fit so it isn't an issue and he seems fine."

As a half-brother to this year's multiple-graded-stakes-winning three-year-old Kensei (Mr. Greeley), the bay shapes up as a colt who will thrive with added distance. "He is a very mature two-year-old that takes everything in stride," remarked regular rider Garrett Gomez. **Dave in Dixie**, a \$310,000 KEEAPR purchase, earned big speed figures for his victorious debut at Del Mar, where he came from off the pace to succeed by 3 1/4 lengths Aug. 29 ([video](#)). 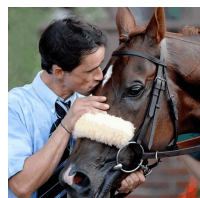
