PROMISE REALIZED

Sometimes horses improve with racing and that seems to be the case with Chasing Dreams Racing's **Noble's Promise** (Cuvee), who won for the third time in the span of 35 days, defeating a deep field in the GI Dixiana Breeders' Futurity at Keeneland yesterday. Second in a 4 1/2-furlong test here Apr. 23, the bay returned from a spell to graduate sprinting over the Ellis turf Sept. 5 and added a comfortable victory in the Dixon Memorial Juvenile on the Presque Isle Tapeta Sept. 26. Stretching out for this contest, Noble's Promise was forwardly placed by Willie Martinez while traveling three wide. A bit deeper on the second turn, he advanced to grab the lead entering the stretch, opened some daylight and was fully extended to hold the late bid of **Aikenite** (Yes It's True).

Some questioned whether Diamondrella could get the job done going two turns, but she silenced her doubters with a last-gasp victory. Four-for-five last season while racing exclusively in turf sprints at Belmont, the bay was a nose winner of the six-furlong Xtra Heat H. in her seasonal finale in October. She opened 2009 with a rallying tally in the Giant's Causeway S. going 5 1/2 panels on the Keeneland lawn, then jumped up the ladder and bested champion Forever Together by 1 3/4 lengths on a yielding Belmont course in the one-mile GI Just a Game S. June 6. Connections took the opportunity to experiment last time, sending the mare to the Sept. 12 GIII Presque Isle Masters S., but the test resulted in a lackluster sixth-place effort. Diamondrella was purchased privately by IEAH after that race, and was back on the weeds here. The field was strung out behind dark horse Hotlantic (Stormy Atlantic) as they raced down the backstretch, with Diamondrella well back in seventh. She still had plenty to do as they came around the bend, but the five-year-old fired her best shot down the lane. Tizaqueena, who took over from the early leader inside the final eighth, raced a bit erratically late, leaving the door open, and Diamondrella drove past in the waning strides. The winner has been catalogued as [hip 73](#) at the Nov. 10 Fasig-Tipton Kentucky Selected November Mixed Sale. IEAH principal Michael Iavarone was unsure where the mare might run next, but trainer Jonathan Sheppard said that Forever Together would defend her title in the GI Breeders' Cup F/M Turf Nov. 6. Trainer Rick Dutrow Jr. has never been shy about talking up his horses, and when he opined that Homeboykris was better than D'Funnybone (D'wildcat)--a fellow Calder purchase who has captured a pair of Grade II events in New York--people stopped to listen, a la the E.F. Hutton commercials of yore. The bay brought \$50,000 as a yearling at KEESEP, but was picked up for just \$11,000 at OBSMAR this year by Brenda Tarbrue. After finishing fourth in his June 27 debut at Calder for trainer Pablo Andrade, the Maryland-bred graduated by 3 1/4 lengths next out at that track July 11 ([video](#)), and agent Nick Sallusto worked out a deal to bring the juvenile to Dutrow's New York barn. Homeboykris broke alertly under Edgar Prado and settled three wide in third as Super Saver (Maria's Mon) led from Discreetly Mine through splits of :22.79 and :45.78. Prado kept Aspire boxed in for a bit, then asked his mount for a bit more in the stretch and Homeboykris responded, forging past Discreetly Mine to earn his first black-type victory. "I was going to be disappointed if we got beat; you know my game,"

Dutrow said. It's uncertain as to whether Homeboykris heads to California for the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile at Santa Anita Nov. 7. Runner-up in the GIII Sham S. on the Santa Anita Pro-Ride in February, Take the Points was a close fourth in the GI Santa Anita Derby Apr. 4, then was last of 13 in the GI Preakness S. May 16. Switched to the turf thereafter, he finished behind Straight Story when fourth in the GII Colonial Turf Cup June 20 and third in the GII Virginia Derby July 18. A maiden winner in three starts as a juvenile, Gitano Hernando opened 2009 with a conditions tally on the grass at Doncaster in March. The chestnut was under consideration for the GI Belmont S. after finishing second by a head in the May 8 G3 Dee S. at Chester, but was lame a few days after that race and had to head to the DL. Making his return in a conditions test on the Wolverhampton all-weather Sept. 17, he came from just off the pace to score by two lengths, and finally boarded that plane for the States. The colt was an 18-1 outsider as he tried his luck in Grade I company for the first time yesterday. Taken in hand to wait just off the leaders into the first turn, the blaze-faced three-year-old was still in hand while in traffic on the backstretch and around the bend. Jockey Kieren Fallon threaded Gitano Hernando through a seam at the top of the lane and the two set sail for home. Colonel John was on his flank as they drove to the wire, but Gitano Hernando would not let him by, hanging on gamely to take it by a head. al Shimaal at Nad al Sheba Mar. 5, then ran second to stable-mate Two Step Salsa (Petionville) in the G2 Godolphin Mile Mar. 29. In his only subsequent appearance, the four-year-old won a six-furlong optional claimer at Saratoga Aug. 17, and is looking to

punch his ticket to the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint Nov. 7. "I was really happy with Gayego when he won at Saratoga, and he has come on for that run," trainer Saeed bin Suroor said on www.godolphin.com. "He has shown that he has the pace for six furlongs and he handles synthetic surfaces." Bin Suroor added, "He is taking a step back up in class, but I couldn't have been happier with his preparation and he looks in great shape at the moment." **Cost of Freedom** captured the 2008 Ancient Title, but was subsequently sidelined due to differing opinions about his well-being. The six-year-old finally made his first start back in Pirate's Bounty H. on Del Mar's closing day and, after holding the lead at the quarter pole, flattened out to finish fourth. "He stumbled, and ended up on a dead rail," trainer John Sadler told *Daily Racing Form*. "Being off a year, it's hard to get a horse ready mentally. I thought I had him fit enough." **Square Eddie** came into last year's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile as the favorite following a big win in Keeneland's GI Lane's End Breeders' Futurity. He ran second that day, and was diagnosed with shin problems following another runner-up effort in the GIII San Rafael S. over this surface Jan. 17. His connections hoped to make the Classics, and the chestnut returned to run third in the GII Coolmore Lexington S. at Keeneland Apr. 18, but his problems resurfaced, and Square Eddie wound up having surgery instead. "He has been training fantastic," trainer Doug O'Neill revealed. "Obviously, we've been excited about him since the first day we brought him over from Europe. The Ancient Title is not our major goal, but we feel he's ready to put in a good effort and, hopefully, it will lead to a big day in the Breeders' Cup Sprint."

Sovereign Stable's **Neglignee** (Northern Afleet), upset winner of the GI Darley Alcibiades S. at Keeneland Friday, will return to her Belmont base Monday to prepare for her next engagement, the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies at Santa Anita Nov. 6. "Neglignee will train in New York as long as she can and take the last flight out to California," said trainer John Terranova. The bay may have a rematch with Alcibiades runner-up **She Be Wild** (Offlee Wild) and fifth-place finisher **Beautician** (Dehere). She Be Wild, the GIII Arlington-Washington heroine, lost her unbeaten record in the Alcibiades. "She didn't get the trip we wanted," said trainer Wayne Catalano. "She didn't settle." He added, "The owners want to go [to the Breeders' Cup]. We'll see what [She Be Wild] says." Beautician got caught in traffic in the \$500,000 race, and was fifth. "We are still going to go," said trainer Ken McPeck, who sent out Noble's Promise (Cuvee) to land yesterday's GI Dixiana Breeders' Futurity. "She just had an unlucky trip--that's racing. She deserves to go."

Fatal Bullet Targeting BC Sprint...

Bear Stables' **Fatal Bullet** (Red Bullet) punched his return ticket to the Nov. 7 GI Breeders' Cup Sprint with a battling score in the GIII Phoenix S. on Keeneland's opening day. Second to Midnight Lute (Real Quiet) last year, the bay was honored as Canada's Horse of the Year and champion sprinter. "I'm very happy with the race," said trainer Reade Baker.
