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CHAMPS 'TRIOMPHEES' IN INTERNATIONAL

Making the final start of his career before retiring to his owner's Banstead Manor Stud, **Champs Elysees (GB)** (Danehill) had two beaten into the Woodbine stretch, but closed with resolute strides to nail **Jukebox Jury (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) and win the GI Pattison Canadian International S. at Woodbine. Third to **Marsh Side** (Gone West) in the C\$2-million event last year, the Juddmonte homebred was bothered by that rival in defense of his title in the GI Northern Dancer S. in his most recent start Sept. 20, and crossed the line fourth before being promoted to third. **Cont. p3**

LAHALEEB UPSETS E. P. TAYLOR

European raider **Lahaleeb (Ire)** (Redback {GB}) was completely ignored by the Woodbine faithful going off at 44-1 in yesterday's GI E. P. Taylor S., but looked like the odds-on favorite in deep stretch, powering clear to a decisive victory. Placed in sixth by jockey William Buick, the bay was swung out for racing room in the stretch, and exploded on the outside to gain the lead before veering to the inside en route to a 1 3/4-length tally over the 2-1 choice, G1 Matron S. victress **Rainbow View** (Dynaformer). With the victory, Lahaleeb earned an automatic spot in the starting gate for the GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf at Santa Anita Nov. 6. "The Breeders' Cup would be a lovely thing, but we do think she needs a little bit of a cut in the ground, which is why we came here really," trainer Mick Channon revealed. "So, we are not too sure really; it's a question of one race at a time." **Cont. p3**

ONE TWO, CHA CHA CHA

Nelson McMakin's **Hot Cha Cha** (Cactus Ridge), last seen annexing Arlington's GIII Pucker Up S. Sept. 7, slipped through an opening along the inside on the turn for home after stalking the early leaders and opened daylight in the stretch to score by an impressive 4 1/2 lengths over **Shared Account** (Pleasantly Perfect) in the GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup at Keeneland Saturday. "I pulled the trigger a little sooner than I wanted to, but if I didn't, the hole would've closed and I'd have never got through," said jockey James Graham after riding his first Grade I winner. "When I did get through, she exploded all the way to the wire." Regarding Hot Cha Cha's next start, trainer Phil Sims said, "We don't know. We'll sit back and look and see, just hash it over." **Gozzip Girl** (Dynaformer), favored at 3-5, weakened to finish third after keeping pacesetter Shared Account company on the front end. "She was in perfect position down the backside," trainer Tom Albertrani said of the GI American Oaks heroine. "[Jockey] Kent [Desormeaux] said when he pushed the button to go on, she just didn't have her closing kick." **Cont. p4**

TWICE AS NICE

Runner-up to the mightily impressive New Approach (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in last year's G1 Emirates Airline Champion S., **Twice Over (GB)** (Observatory) returned to Newmarket to go one better yesterday at inflated odds of 14-1. Khalid Abdullah's homebred had encountered trouble when second 12 months ago, and that was the closest he had come to winning at this level so far. Dropped in class for his warm-up, the four-year-old took Goodwood's Listed Foundation S. in his stride Sept. 23, and stepped up to register a third renewal of this prize for his veteran trainer Henry Cecil. Never far from the searing pace, the bay was asked to take the initiative by Tom Queally before the quarter pole, and stayed on up the rising ground to deny **Mawatheeq** (Danzig). There was an unsuccessful objection lodged by jockey Richard Hills aboard the runner-up. "He deserved it, as he's had so many near-misses, and we'd got his confidence back up in his last couple of runs," Queally said of the half-length winner. "I knew Henry [Cecil] could see it in his work in the mornings, as he was quite bullish coming into this race, even though he was an outsider." **Cont. p2**

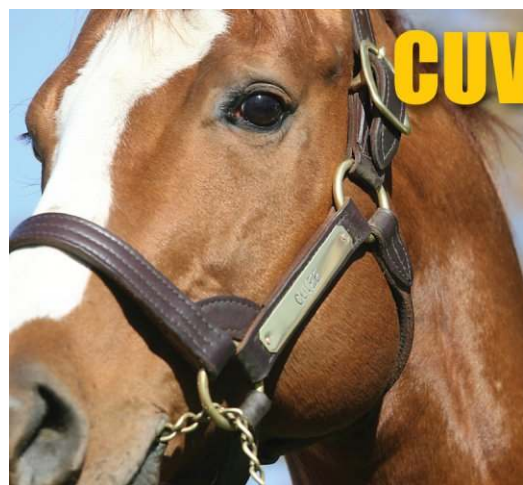
Twice Over sprang to prominence when winning a maiden and conditions event here at two, and returned to this track to upset Raven's Pass (Elusive Quality) on his sophomore bow in the G3 Craven S. last April.

Excitement turned to anti-climax; his limitations were exposed when only third in the G2 Dante S. the next month, but he regained some luster when filling the same spot in the G1 St James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot in June and winning the G2 Prix Eugene Adam at Maisons-Laffitte the following month. Rested after finishing seventh in the G2 Prix Guillaume d'Ornano at Deauville in August, he was back on track in the Champion to bring his three-year-old campaign to a close.

On his three tries at the highest level this term, he was a close third in the May 16 G1 Lockinge S. at Newbury and fourth in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot June 17, but flopped when down the field in the G1 Coral Eclipse S. at Sandown July 4. Revived by a break, he returned to winning ways in a conditions event at Doncaster Sept. 9 and doubled up in the Foundation, after which connections had waited before committing to a repeat bid here. After an initial shove to gain a prominent position, Twice Over enjoyed mostly plain sailing, and the only concern for Queally was keeping him straight after taking the race by the scruff of the neck at the quarter pole. As Mawatheeque attempted to come between the eventual winner and Pipedreamer (GB) (Selkirk), the gap narrowed, and by the time that rival was freed Twice Over had flown.

"It's been a long road back for him and those couple of minor wins gave him a perk-up, which made the difference," Queally said. "I thought it might be a little bit quick today, but he's a lovely horse who is game, and he had a little bit more." Cecil revealed that connections may consider a tilt at the Breeders' Cup, adding, "He's always been a decent horse who has just missed, and I was worried about the ground, but there was no jar today. I nearly ran him in the G3 Darley S. yesterday, but time is running out so we decided to have a go. I think the Prince enjoys him, so I think there's a very good chance he will stay in training next year. I'm sure we'll get an invitation to the GI Breeders' Cup Classic, and we'll see whether we go there or not, but he could even go to Dubai for one of those big races."

Mawatheeque's trainer Marcus Tregoning told *PA Sport*, "It's a frustrating day, as I thought he'd win. My feeling is that he's best over a mile and a half, and he ran here before and got unbalanced. He definitely stays in training." **Fame and Glory** (Montjeu {Ire}) was sent off the 6-4 favorite, but could not land a serious blow and trailed in sixth, while the dual Oaks heroine **Sariska (GB)** hindered her chances with a tardy start and plugged on into third late. **Click for the [Racing Post chart](#), the [brisnet.com PPs](#) or the [free brisnet.com catalogue-style pedigree](#). Champs Elysees was based at Woodbine this summer, finishing third in the GII Nijinsky S. on soft ground July 26, then was a half-length second to Marchfield (A.P. Indy) in the GII Sky Classic S. Aug. 23 prior to his eventful stretch run in the Northern Dancer. Rated off the pace as Marsh Side tried to make all in his repeat attempt, Champs Elysees took to the outside and away from trouble and was able to run down Jukebox Jury, who was in receipt of seven pounds from the winner. "To go out on such a huge win like this is obviously a huge boost to his stallion career as well," Juddmonte's Garrett O'Rourke said. "He has been a tremendous servant. Ballydoyle brought four to yesterday's G1 Jumeirah Dewhurst S., but it was the lesser-fancied Oratorio (Ire) pair **Beethoven (Ire)** and **Fencing Master (GB)** who led the way for a memorable exacta for the sire and stable. Ballydoyle's **Steinbeck (Ire)** (Footstepsinthesand {GB}) was also fourth. Highly tried all term, Beethoven had managed third placings in the July 12 G3 Anglesey S. and Sept. 12 G1 Vincent O'Brien National S. at The Curragh, but was only sixth in the G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagadere at Longchamp 13 days prior to this test. Punters ignored the potential pointer of a first-time visor and the booking of British champion jockey Ryan Moore and paid the price as the 33-1 shot rallied from just off the pace to overhaul Fencing Master and Colm O'Donoghue in the final 25 yards for a neck success. "Progressive, progressive, progressive," is how Aidan O'Brien summed up the winner. "His form figures didn't look like it, but he's been getting better and better with every run, just like his dad."

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Off the mark in maiden company at Leopardstown Aug. 6, he was only two lengths off Kingsfort (War Chant) when third in that track's National S. Following a fourth in the Goffs Million Sprint back there Sept. 27 and a latest sixth on Arc day, the headgear was called for. Positioned close to the early pace set by Johnny Murtagh and Steinbeck, who held the call against the stand's rail, he looked to be treading water passing the quarter pole, but Moore kept applying the pressure. Responding when switched outside, he rallied to cut down Xtension and Fencing Master in the center of the track as Steinbeck waned against the fence. "His record isn't great, but he had the visor on for the first time and to be fair to him, he traveled very well, picked up nicely and fought hard in the end," Moore said. "It is a bit of a surprise and I thought he was my worst ride today, but it just shows the strength Ballydoyle have in the juvenile department and what a hard choice Johnny [Murtagh] has." O'Brien added, "He's very tough and, during the week, Joseph [O'Brien] said there was loads in there and to put a visor on to sharpen him up a little bit. I'm delighted with Steinbeck, as Johnny said he would have liked to have got a lead, but he jumped and that natural quickness he has meant he couldn't be backed out. He got a bit tired, but we're over the moon with him."

O'Brien continued, "It's possible he could go for the Breeders' Cup--either the Turf or the race on the [Pro-Ride]. The advantage he has is his experience. We also have **Alfred Nobel (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}), who is probably going for the Juvenile." Godolphin's **Buzzword (GB)** (Pivotal {GB}), who was fifth, is also being taken to Santa Anita, according to trainer Saeed bin Suroor, who said, "We were very pleased with his run today, he ran a very solid race and was beaten by better horses on the day. We are going to aim him for the Breeders' Cup for one of the Juvenile races, but have not decided which one." Brought round the field to lead after the first call, he was asked to set a moderate gallop. Jockey Richard Hills wound the pace up from the half-mile pole and asked his mount to kick on two furlongs from home. The partnership would not be denied, and held on gamely as the pack closed in the final eighth. The victory gave veteran trainer John Dunlop his 250th win at Newmarket. "My first winner here was a horse called Tamino in the Palace House S., and that was my first ever winner also, but I hate to say that was back in 1966," Dunlop told *PA Sport*. "Akmal started very humbly, but he has gone on and on. That's the end of him for this year, and we'll have to look at an ambitious Cup campaign next year." An inspired ride by quietly confident jockey Brad Rawiller enabled reigning Melbourne Cup victor Viewed to return for a decisive Caulfield Cup score from stablemate Roman Emperor. The win provided trainer Bart Cummings with his seventh Caulfield Cup, as Viewed became only the third horse ever to win a Melbourne Cup and return the following season to win the Caulfield Cup. Jumping from barrier 13, Viewed was guided over to the fence by Rawiller and sat quietly in last as the field passed the post the first time. From the 800-meter pole, Rawiller deftly crept through gaps in the field, and Viewed rapidly made ground to burst clear. Connections now have their sights set squarely on the repeat attempt at Flemington Nov. 3. "I was confident all week, not so much of winning, but just that the horse was spot on for this race," Rawiller said. "To win a Caulfield Cup is one thing, but to win for the greatest legend in racing ever is another." He added, "It was imperative he settled, going toward the Melbourne Cup. If he had been forced to go forward with his big weight, I don't think he could have won, and I was a bit worried when the race slowed to a crawl down the back." Viewed returned from a five-month spell close-up fourth in the G2 Memsie S. at this track Aug. 29. He was unplaced in the G1 Underwood S. Sept. 19 and in the G1 Turnbull S. Oct. 3 ahead of this assignment. International challengers Kirklees (Ire) (Jade Robbery) and Cima de Triomphe (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) drifted slightly in betting before finishing seventh and 13th, respectively.

MIDDAY HEADS JUDDMONTE BC TEAM

Khalid Abdullah's G1 Nassau S. heroine **Midday (GB)** (Oasis Dream {GB}) was yesterday reported on course for her tilt at the GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf by trainer Henry Cecil. Third in the G1 Prix de l'Opera at Longchamp on Arc day, the three-year-old will spearhead a strong team of challengers from Britain to run under the Juddmonte banner. "She's in very good shape, and I think she just needed her last run and got tired, as I gave her a rest after the Nassau," Cecil said. "**Father Time (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) will also go there [for the Marathon]." A potential new member of the Santa Anita squad came in yesterday's G1 Emirates Airlines Champion S. winner **Twice Over (GB)** (Observatory), who could be Classic-bound (*see the race report*). Juddmonte's Racing Manager Lord Grimthorpe said, "We hadn't been looking at the Breeders' Cup [for Twice Over] before today, but he has come back and won this race very well, so the Classic would be under consideration. The question mark is that the race is on a surface that he's never raced on. At the moment, we are likely to take **Zacinto (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) to the GI TVG Breeders' Cup Mile, Midday for the Emirates Airline Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf and **Spanish Moon** (El Prado {Ire}) for the GI Emirates Airline Breeders' Cup Turf. Father Time may go for the Marathon, and **Famous Name (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) could run in the Dirt Mile. Then we have **Ventura** (Chester House) and **Proviso (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) who are in America already."

Summer Bird Works at Santa Anita...

Stretching out for the first time since his victory in the Oct. 3 GI Jockey Club Gold Cup at Belmont Park, **Summer Bird** (Birdstone) breezed five furlongs in an easy 1:02 at Santa Anita yesterday morning. Jockey Alonso Quinonez was aboard. "I got him in 1:01.96, and he finished the last eighth of a mile in :11 1/5, so we got out of it what we

wanted," said trainer Tim Ice. "We'll see how he comes back. It looked to me like he handled it fine. He started off a little slow and then picked it up down the lane, which is what we wanted." The three-year-old is scheduled for a more serious workout Oct. 25. "Kent [Desormeaux] will be in to work him, and we'll try to see if we can't get a work set up in between the races," Ice said. Summer Bird will bid for his third straight Grade I score in the Nov. 7 Breeders' Cup Classic.

Trainer Saeed bin Suroor commented, "Schiaparelli got a little tired last time out at The Curragh, and the ground may have been a bit too soft for him. He has done very well since then, and he is in good form at the moment. I think that dropping back down to a mile and a half will suit him." **Voila Ici** has enjoyed a profitable campaign so far, winning the G3 Premio Carlo d'Alessio at the Capannelle May 9 before finishing third in the G1 Gran Premio di Milano over this track and trip June 14. Two more successes in the G1 Prix Maurice de Nieuil at Longchamp July 14 and G3 Premio Federico Tesio here last time Sept. 20 bode well for his chances of keeping the prize at home. **Halicarnassus** took Veliefendi's Bosphorus Cup Sept. 3 before finishing fifth in the G3 Arc Trial at Newbury 15 days later. "If the horse we all know turns up, he must have a great chance of being in the shake-up," trainer Mick Channon said. "The ground will be perfect for him out there and, while the quality horses have stayed in, we've got to have a go."
