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AN ARTIE PARTY AT KEENELAND

An attractive and athletic weanling filly from the second crop of GI Breeders' Cup Mile hero Artie Schiller (El Prado {Ire}) elicited a final bid of \$90,000 from the Bare Stable to top Wednesday's ninth session of the

Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale in Lexington. Consigned as hip [3286](#), the February foal was bred and consigned by Elise W. Kendall from the stakes-winning mare Love a Ruckus (Bold Ruckus), who won a total of four times

and bankrolled \$226,410. It was just the second live foal produced by the 12-year-old mare from her seven years at stud. Bred to Skywalker in 2002, she dropped a colt the following February, and, named Shadow Rush, he went on to post eight wins and earnings of \$118,924. She aborted to Lear Fan in 2004, and bad luck struck again the following year when her Silver Charm colt died as a foal. Barren to Vindication in 2006, she aborted foals by Stormy Atlantic and Medalist in 2007 and 2008, respectively, but her Artie Schiller proved most popular.

Stallion Prospect Abraaj Sells for \$75K...

Sent through the ring in the final few minutes of bidding Wednesday, hip [3296](#), the six-year-old stallion prospect **Abraaj** (Carson City) was knocked down to Rob McDonald for \$75,000. The bay, consigned by Shadwell Farm, was a solid performer for Sheikh Hamdan's operation, winning five times from 13 career appearances while missing the top three just twice. Third by a half-length to champion Benny the Bull (Lucky Lionel) in the 2008 GII True North H. at Belmont Park, he made his final start a winning one, drawing off to score by 2 1/2 lengths as the favorite in the GII A. G. Vanderbilt H. at Saratoga. A full brother to GSW Leelanau, Abraaj ended his career with earnings of \$338,050.

It's No Secret...

Hip [3002](#), the six-year-old Secret Brook (Montbrook), proved most popular of the broodmares on offer Wednesday, selling to Polo Green Stable, agent, for \$70,000. Consigned by Hill 'n' Dale Sales Agency, agent, the chestnut, a half-sister to three stakes performers including MSW Special Report (Notebook), was offered in foal to Seeking the Dia (Storm Cat), who stood his first year at stud at Hill 'n' Dale in 2009 for a fee of \$10,000. The sale, which continues through this Sunday, resumes this morning with a session beginning at 10 a.m. Full results are available at www.keeneland.com.

GOLDIKOVA LIKELY TO STAY IN TRAINING

Gerard Wertheimer has given a firm indication that the dual GI Breeders' Cup Mile heroine **Goldikova (Ire)** (Anabaa) will return for a 2010 campaign. Speaking at the 2009 Cartier Awards on Tuesday night, at which the seven-time Group 1 winner landed the Champion Older Horse title, her owner/breeder commented, "We could run her in her fourth year, because we are first and foremost breeders and owners, and Goldikova has proved to us that we made the right decision. No firm decision has been made, but it is looking more likely that she will stay in training. I will know for sure in about 10 days."

Mint Lane Retired...

Pinebloom Stable's Headley Bell has announced the retirement of **Mint Lane** (Maria's Mon--Sister Girl, by Conquistador Cielo), winner of the 2008 GII Dwyer S. A \$270,000 Keeneland September yearling purchase, the bay took an Aqueduct allowance by over eight lengths in March 2008 prior to missing by a head in the Federico Tesio S. the following month. He set the pace in the GII Peter Pan S. before finishing a solid second behind Casino Drive (Mineshaft). He injured his hind ankle in the GII Jim Dandy S. and was off over a year before returning to make a pair of starts this past September. A half-brother to GISP Sister for Gold (Hold for Gold) whose fourth dam is champion Kamar (Key to the Mint), Mint Lane retires with a record of 12-4-2-1 and earnings of \$299,312. His future plans as a stallion prospect are being considered.

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Controversial Late Scratch at Churchill...

Grand Forks (Quiet American), a 12-year-old mare entered to make her first start since placing third in a \$32,000 claimer at Del Mar in 2000, was scratched in the paddock by the stewards at Churchill Downs yesterday. The heroine of the 2000 Arizona Oaks at Turf Paradise was entered by owner/trainer Kathleen Costello for a \$5,000 tag Wednesday. "I can't afford to bring her down here and not run her," a tearful Costello told *Daily Racing Form*. Rick Trontz, who haltered Grand Forks in her most recent start nine years ago, gave Costello the mare after she proved futile in the breeding shed, but strictly for the purposes as a pleasure horse, according to *DRF*. The 27-year-old Costello is a former employee of Trontz's Hopewell Farm. Chief steward John Veitch said, "We decided to err on the side of caution and to protect the animal and the betting public. It was a tough call. We've told Ms. Costello that we would be willing to work with her but that we need more information about the health and well-being of the horse."

Penn National Makes Vegas Inroads:

According to a report in Wednesday's *Wall Street Journal* and as reported by the *Harness Tracks of America* newsletter, Penn National Gaming has offered \$50 million for the bankrupt Fountainebleau Casino and Resort Hotel project in Las Vegas. It would mark the company's first foray into the gaming capital of America. According to the HTA newsletter, Penn National has agreed to provide debtor-in-possession financing and purchase the as-yet unfinished property as a stalking-horse bidder. Penn National would reportedly provide an additional \$51.5 million credit through Feb. 9. Penn National Gaming operates 19 casinos and horse racing facilities in 14 states.

Churchill to Add 50-Cent Wagers:

Officials at Churchill Downs have announced that the track will experiment with 50-cent minimum Pick 3s and trifectas beginning with today's live racing program and continuing through the end of the meet Nov. 28. The wagering public reacted positively when the Pick 4 wager was reduced to a 50-cent minimum this past spring. "With the experimental reduction of the minimum wager on Pick 3 and trifecta races from \$1 to 50 cents, we hope to provide a little 'economic stimulus' for racing fans," said Churchill Downs President Kevin Flanery. "The 50-cent minimum Pick 4 wager has been popular with our on-track patrons and simulcast players. The lower minimum bets on the Pick 3's and trifectas should provide fans of every skill level with a greater opportunity to win and enjoy Churchill Downs races with smiles on their faces."



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Mr. Nightlinger Retired to JEH Oklahoma:

Mr. Nightlinger (Indian Charlie--Timely Quarrel, by Time for a Change), one of the elite turf sprinters in the United States, has been retired from racing and will stand the 2010 breeding season at the Oklahoma division of JEH Stallion Station in Wynnewood. GOFFS NOVEMBER FOAL SALE DAY THREE HIP HAPPENINGS

TRADE PICKS UP AT GOFFS After a low-key opening session, which witnessed a 42 percent clearance rate, the second day of the Goffs November Foal Sale saw the action turned up a notch yesterday. With 64 percent sold and the average and median at a healthy €10,784 and €8,000 respectively, the latest renewal looks to be holding its own at present. Topping proceedings was a colt from the first crop of the top-class sprinter Amadeus Wolf (GB) who sold to Peter Doyle Bloodstock for €60,000. From Gary Swift Sales, hip [382](#) is from one of The Queen's finest families and his dam is a half to the 2004 G1 Dubai Duty Free dead-heater Right Approach (GB) (Machiavellian).

Ross Doyle commented, "I've bought him for Pier House Stud to be resold next autumn. He's a very nice sort with plenty of size about him which you would like. Also he's by a sire whose first foals this week have been a good bunch."

Two fillies shared top billing when selling for €42,000 apiece. Hip [321](#) is by Medicean (GB), who has been in demand this autumn and the offering from Ballybin Stud from the family of Northern Afleet and Tap to Music was knocked down to Keith Harte Bloodstock.

"I've bought her for a client to be reoffered next year," Harte explained. "She's a lovely filly with a nice temperament and is very typical of the sire."

The other top-priced filly hails from the first crop of Heliostatic (Ire) and hip [407](#) from the draft of JK Thoroughbreds out of the listed winner Midris (Ire) (Namid {GB}) was also snapped up by Peter Doyle Bloodstock. Paul McCarthy paid €37,000 for Foxford Stud's hip [419](#), another Amadeus Wolf colt whose page includes the 1998 G1 National S. scorer Mus-If (GB) (Lahib), while Holy Roman Emperor (Ire) was responsible for one of the best-bred colts of the session. From Commene Stud, hip [241](#) is a half-brother to the 2005 G2 Mill Reef S. winner Cool Creek (Ire) (Desert Style {Ire}) and was secured by Glenvale Stud for €35,000.

"I think the sire has an excellent chance of making it and if he does this horse will hopefully be a very saleable yearling next autumn," Glenvale's Ciaran Conroy commented. "He's a half-brother to a Mill Reef winner and I was actually under bidder on his half-brother here last year."

Catridge Farm Stud paid €34,000 for Osberstown Stud's hip [343](#), a daughter of Oratorio (Ire) whose dam is a half to the 2002 G2 Cherry Hinton S. winner Spinola (Fr) (Spinning World). David Powell, who owns Catridge, said, "She's a very nice filly and we'll bring her home and see how she progresses before deciding whether to reoffer her or keep her to race."
