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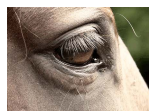

Park, *Daily Racing Form* reports. Trainer David Fawkes was at first unsure where Duke of Mischief would make his next start after winning an off-the-turf renewal of the Jan. 10 GIII Fort Lauderdale S., but was able to make a decision after the four-year-old impressed with a 1:00 five-furlong move on the

Gulfstream main track Saturday. "I was very happy with the way he went," Fawkes told *DRF*. "He needed a sharp drill like that, and he obviously likes the race-track." The Fort Lauderdale, contested over a one-turn mile at Gulfstream, was Duke of Mischief's biggest victory to date. **Quality Road** (Elusive Quality), winner of last year's GI Florida Derby over the Donn's course and distance, turned in a :49 4/5 four-furlong breeze at Palm Meadows Sunday and enters the race off an easy score in the GIII Hal's Hope S. Jan. 3 last time out. Also probable for Saturday's featured event are **Delightful Kiss** (Kissin Kris), **Dry Martini** (Slew Gin Fizz) and **Hel-sinki** (Distorted Humor), while **Friesan Fire** (A.P. Indy), **Le Grand Cru** (Dynaformer), **Timber Reserve** (Forest Camp) and **You and I Forever** (A.P. Indy) are possible, according to *DRF*. The trade daily also reported **Kiss the Kid** (Lemon Drop Kid) and **Mambo Meister** (King Cugat) could start in either the Donn or Saturday's GI Gulfstream Park Turf S.



PEDIGREE INSIGHTS

THE KING OF JAPAN

Naming a young colt after a famous figure often seems to pay handsome dividends. Currently on the American Triple Crown trail is Winslow Homer, named after the celebrated American painter; Coolmore has had a long line of Group 1 winners named in honor of the likes of George Washington, Dylan Thomas, Yeats, Galileo, Horatio Nelson, Alfred Nobel, Beethoven, Mozart, Stravinsky and Jan Vermeer.

A lofty name was also assigned to a half-brother by Kingmambo to The Deputy, winner of the Santa Anita Derby in 2000. This Japanese-foaled colt was named after King Kamehameha, who had "The Great" added to his name after he unified the Hawaiian Islands more than 200 years ago.

The equine King Kamehameha also developed into a dominant force, as I reported in this column in the spring of 2004:

"Having recorded his fourth win in his first five starts when he took the G3-Jpn Mainichi Hai over a mile and a quarter in March, King Kamehameha was very impressive in taking the G1-Jpn NHK Mile Cup in very fast time two days ago. He came home five lengths ahead of Cosmo Sunbeam, with Meisho Bowler nearly two lengths further back in third. Bearing in mind that Cosmo Sunbeam had topped last year's Japanese two-year-old Classifications, with Meisho Bowler in second position, it probably isn't too fanciful to wonder whether King Kamehameha will follow in the footsteps of El Condor Pasa, another Kingmambo colt who won the NHK Mile in 1998. This colt was one of the first to highlight the tremendous progress being made by the Japanese Thoroughbred, thanks to his victories in the Japan Cup and Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud and his outstanding second to Montjeu in the Arc."

Whereas El Condor Pasa missed the Japanese Derby, King Kamehameha was in the line-up for the Tokyo Yushun three weeks after his NHK Mile victory, and he coped well with the extra distance, taking the Classic by a length and a half from Heart's Cry. Heart's Cry later became one of the few horses ever to beat the Japanese superstar Deep Impact and performed very well internationally. King Kamehameha again had Heart's Cry behind him when he won the G2-Jpn Kobe Shimbun Hai, but unfortunately a bowed tendon in November forced his retirement.

The compilers of the World Rankings for 2004 probably did him few favors in placing him on 117, the same mark as another Japanese colt, Cosmo Bulk, and the American colt Lion Heart. Timeform took a kinder view of his form, rating him 125, three pounds superior to Cosmo Bulk and only one pound below the top older horse Zenno Rob Roy, winner of the 2004 Japan Cup.

King Kamehameha duly landed the title of champion three-year-old colt, by which time he had caused quite a stir in the Japanese breeding industry. With a record of seven wins from eight starts and a highly fashionable American stallion as his sire, the colt was syndicated for ¥2.1 billion--approximately \$19 million--to stand at Shadai Stallion Station. His initial fee was set at ¥6 million, or roughly \$55,000. The syndication deal was the largest ever for a Japanese-trained horse, but was made to look small fry two years later when Deep Impact was valued at ¥5.1 billion, or approximately \$42.7 million.

Inevitably, a very large book of mares headed King Kamehameha's way in his first season at Shadai, and he is credited with a first crop of 186 foals. Equally inevitably, his first produce attracted some huge prices at the sales. His 29 foals that sold in July 2005 averaged over \$500,000, with the average receiving a considerable boost from the record-breaking ¥600 million (\$5,254,800) paid for his daughter out of Sunday Silence's top-notch daughter To the Victory.

Expectations, therefore, could hardly have been higher when King Kamehameha's first runners reached the track in 2008. He duly became Japan's leading sire of two-year-olds, thanks partly to his son Fifth Petal, who was beaten only a head in the prestigious Asahi Hai Futurity.

To be honest, I was more impressed with the start made by Neo Universe, winner of the 2003 Japanese Derby, and this impression was strengthened when two

of Neo Universe's first-crop sons went on to take the equivalents to the 2000 Guineas and the Derby. King Kamehameha's first three-year-olds were comparatively quiet, the notable exception being the smart dirt performer Golden Ticket. It could be worth mentioning that he had four sons considered worthy of inclusion on the classifications for three-year-old dirt runners, compared to only two in the turf category.

I have warned in this column often enough about the dangers of jumping to conclusions about stallions, and there are signs that King Kamehameha's second crop is going to make a much bigger impact than its predecessor.

The son of Kingmambo again topped Japan's list of two-year-old sires in 2009, with help from 90 starters from a crop of 185, but more relevant is the fact that two of them--the colt Rose Kingdom and the filly Apapane--were among the Japanese divisional champions published in the *TDN* of Jan. 26. The Japanese classifications support these awards, with Rose Kingdom topping the colts (by a margin of three pounds from the Giant's Causeway colt Eishin Apollon) and Apapane the fillies.

Top weight on the two-year-old classifications is normally 112, but the compilers awarded Rose Kingdom 114, on the strength of a perfect record in three starts. His final victory was gained by more than a length in the Asahi Hai Futurity in December. There's every reason to expect this colt to be even more effective at three. King Kamehameha was rated no higher than 100 at two, after winning both his starts, and the colt's dam Rosebud is a Classic performer by the great Sunday Silence.

Rosebud was beaten only a neck in the 2001 Japanese Oaks over a mile and a half, and later was beaten just a nose by To the Victory in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II Commemorative Cup. Rosebud's brother Rosenkreuz also stayed well--well enough to finish third to Deep Impact in the Japanese St Leger--and their close relative Rosado was another accomplished and durable performer.

Rose Kingdom's fifth dam is Riverqueen, an outstanding three-year-old in France in 1969, when she won the French 1000 Guineas and Prix Saint-Alary before beating the males in the Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud. With so many high-class middle-distance performers in his pedigree, there must be every chance that Rose Kingdom will continue to dominate his generation this year--and hopefully help justify the hype that surrounded King Kamehameha at the start of his stallion career.

Runaway winner of Paumonok S. at Aqueduct

Wall Street Wonder's stock is quickly on the rise since moving to dirt this winter at Aqueduct.

Minus a fifth-place finish after a stumbling start in Calder's GII Carry Back S. last July, the dark bay was campaigned exclusively on turf and synthetic surfaces. Under the care of Bob Baffert on the West Coast in 2009, Wall Street Wonder placed a close fourth in the GII San Vicente S., and added a trio of third-place finishes in grassy stakes in the spring. Kept in the Empire State following his trip to Miami, Wall Street Wonder was third in the Solomon Northup S. at the Spa Aug. 20, then ran third and fourth in a pair of turf sprints at Belmont Sept. 17 and Oct. 11. Given time to regroup, he was officially transferred to the husband-and-wife team of John and Tonja Terranova--who oversee Baffert's New York runners--and pointed to the inner track meet.

Making his return in a Dec. 12 allowance contest (video), Wall Street Wonder pressed the early leaders from third and tugged his way to reach even terms on the far turn. With an extremely confident John Velazquez aboard, the Florida-bred took over from next-out winner Rereadthefootnotes (Read the Footnotes) while under a hand ride in deep stretch and had a two-length advantage at the wire. Backed as the 5-2 second-choice to make it two straight in the Paumonok S. Jan. 23 (video), the son of Kisses and Hugs (Kissin Kris) broke like a shot beneath Channing Hill and outsprinted heavily favored Driven by Success (Precise End) through a snappy opening quarter of :22 3/5. Carrying the colors of Nita Connelly's Stetson Stables, he began to shake loose from last term's GI Carter H. and GI Shadwell Metropolitan H. third-place finisher on the turn for home, and opened daylight in the stretch, stopping the clock for a meeting-best 1:09 2/5 for six furlongs. Wall Street Wonder earned a gaudy Beyer Speed Figure of 109 in the eye-catching 8 1/2-length victory.

"We told the jockey that he runs best when he has something to run at, but when the horse broke so well, the jockey did the right thing and just went for it," said Nita's husband John Connelly, who flew in from Kentucky to watch the race. "The horse came out of the race well--it didn't take much out of him. It was pretty impressive. The horse is a real character too. He's become a real handful around the stable, and it's come exactly at the same time as his substantial improvement as a racehorse. I think that Roberto is popping up in him."

Nita Connelly watched the race from the couple's California home. "I was so thrilled," she said. "He just took off. It was fantastic. We're very proud of him."

As for what's next for Wall Street Wonder, John Connelly offered, "I'm not one of those foolish, ego-driven owners that tries to tell the trainer what to do. One thought is the [GIII] Toboggan [H., Mar. 6]. If the trainer decides to go there, I think this performance will scare some horses off. It looks like it would be a good race for him leading up to the [GI] Carter [H., Apr. 3]. Those are just my thoughts; it's completely the trainer's decision. I think right now he's in the right place in New York, and Tonja is doing a great job with him. Bob [Baffert] is still providing oversight as our primary trainer as well."

Wall Street Wonder, from the first crop of the unraced City Place (Storm Cat--Glitter Woman), fetched \$325,000 from the Connellys at the 2008 Barretts March sale after breezing an eighth in :10 1/5 (video).

"Kim Lloyd [vice president of sales] at Barretts had him rated as the best conformed horse at the sale," Connelly recalled. "Things are funny in the horse business. I was more interested in a filly by Empire Maker [Empressive Lady, GSP], but she didn't vet, so we got off her, and he was the one we settled on."

When asked what's appealing about two-year-old in training sales, the 63-year-old replied,

"One thing I like is watching the breezes on DVD. I get to freeze frame and do special measurements on what I think are the quality horses. Then I narrow it down and bring in Baffert at that point. It's a real team effort when it comes to the two-year-old sales--we've had some good luck at them. At the yearling sales, I defer completely to Baffert, because he's the best."

Nita Connelly, 64, is the sole proprietor of Stetson Land and Cattle, a family-owned ranch located in Northern California dating back to the late 1800s. John and Nita Connelly were involved with quarter horses before entering the Thoroughbred scene in 2004.

Cry and Catch Me (Street Cry {Ire}), heroine of the 2007 GI Oak Leaf Breeders' Cup S., was purchased privately by the Stetson outfit following her debut. Retired after a pair of starts last year, she is currently booked to Medaglia d'Oro for the 2010 breeding season. Their current racing stable consists of a handful of runners, including the well-bred four-year-old maiden Spun Silver (Grand Slam), who is a half-sister to GISWs El Corredor (Mr. Greeley) and Roman Ruler (Fusaichi Pegasus). She is owned in partnership with John Sikura. --S.S.

GILL TO LIQUIDATE RACING STABLE Michael Gill, North America's leading Thoroughbred owner in 2009 by earnings and races won, plans to sell off his racing stock following an ongoing controversy at Penn National Race Course, *Daily Racing Form* reports. Jockeys at the Grantville, Pennsylvania, racetrack have now twice refused to ride in races where Gill has horses entered. Six horses owned by Gill have broken down at that venue since Oct. 1, while nine were pulled up, eased or went lame, according to figures published by the *DRF*. Although the jockey boycott might play havoc with Wednesday's card, Gill plans to race the four horses he has entered for that night before he liquidates his operation. "I don't know what is going to happen Wednesday night," Gill told the trade daily. "All I know is I'm running, even if I have to ride the horses." Jockeys refused to ride the remainder of the Jan. 23 card after a horse owned by Gill broke down not far past the wire following the fifth race, and only reversed their stance after Gill's lone remaining entrant was scratched. Gill's horses were barred from competing the last four race nights, but were allowed to be entered for Wednesday. Gill, who primarily deals with claiming stock, reduced his operation to about 20 horses after receiving the 2005 Eclipse Award for outstanding owner, but had become much more active again in 2009.

HOTEP (c, 3, [A.P. Given the rest of the season off, the bay tired in the late stages to be fourth most recently over this track and trip Jan. 3. Sent off the 4-5 choice in this second attempt on the dirt, the Canadian-bred settled in fifth through opening splits of :24.73, :49.22 and 1:14.37. Ready to roll approaching the turn, Hotep drew clear in the stretch to triumph by 3 1/4 lengths over Down With Dixie (Purge). "[The GII Louisiana Derby Mar. 27] is definitely a possibility," said Mark Frostad. "We'll just have to see how he goes. He's got two starts in him now this year and he looks great. The [GIII Risen Star S.] is too soon [Feb. 20]. I might well look for a race for him somewhere." Pletcher Looks to Continue Hot Streak at Big A with Three Day Rush:

Trainer Todd Pletcher, who has won with 10 of his 25 starters at Aqueduct since New Year's Day, will look to remain hot over the inner track when he sends out **Three Day Rush** (Harlan's Holiday) in Saturday's Whirlaway S. at the Big A. Winner of the restricted NATC Futurity S. in September, the Starlight Partners representative set the pace and dug in to deny stable-mate Mission Impazible (Unbridled's Song) by a head in a six-furlong entry-level allowance at Gulfstream Jan. 9 in his lone start as a sophomore. The Whirlaway, set to be contested at 1 1/16 miles, will be the dark bay's first start around two turns. "We're not a hundred percent he wants to go that far, but the basic idea that Jack Wolf and I talked about is let's go ahead and answer the question now instead of later," Pletcher told *Daily Racing Form*. "If he does handle the two turns, then we got a lot of options. If he doesn't, then we can back up and focus on the shorter races." The Whirlaway will also provide a distance test for **Eightyfiveinafifty** (Forest Camp), who romped by 17 1/4 lengths in a six-furlong maiden event over the inner Jan. 9.

Larry Bortstein:

Veteran turf writer Larry Bortstein died early Sunday morning after suffering a pulmonary embolism Jan. 23. The native of New York was 67. Bortstein, who had covered horse racing for the *Orange County Register* for the past 17 years and contributed to the California Thoroughbred Breeders' Association's *California Thoroughbred* magazine, never regained consciousness after he was transported to Arcadia Methodist Hospital. "He was a consummate pro," said former *L.A. Herald-Examiner* sports writer and current Santa Anita publicity staffer Jack Disney. "Larry was very passionate about racing and the people in it. He was always for the underdog and he had a broad network of sources. Larry overcame a lot. He was sight-impaired and had to depend on other people to transport him to the track, or to whatever sports venue he may be covering, be it a high school game or a major league baseball game. He was good-hearted and he was extremely conscientious. He'll be missed." Bortstein, who had a passion for singing, is survived by his wife, Pat; a son, Steven; a daughter, Christy; and grandson, Jeff. Memorial services are pending.

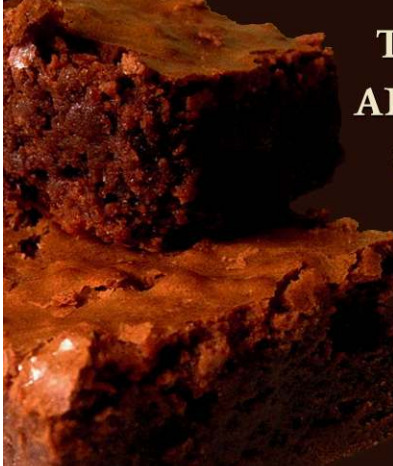

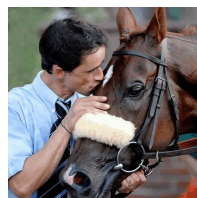
