He saved his finest performance for the world's first-ever \$10-million horse race. **Gloria de Campeao (Brz)** (Impression {Arg}), a 25-1 longshot in the G1 Dubai World Cup at Meydan yesterday, went to the front and cut out the pace. Kicking clear at midstretch, he looked in control, but **Lizard's Desire (SAf)** (Lizard Island {Aus}) and **Allybar (Ire)** (King's Best) came charging in the final yards. When they hit the wire, jockey Ahmed Ajtebi, sandwiched in the middle on Allybar, turned to congratulate Kevin Shea, aboard Lizard's Desire, and Shea pumped his fist as they galloped out. But the two had it wrong--it was Gloria de Campeao who had a nostril in front on the line. "I thought I had won, but as we passed the post, I looked across and [Shea] was celebrating, so I thought I'd keep quiet and wait for the result," said winning jockey Tiago Pereira. **Cont. p2**

Third Time's The Charm...

Gloria de Campeao (Brz) finished eighth behind Curlin (Smart Strike) in the 2008 G1 Dubai World Cup and, as



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a 60-1 shot, was a distant second to Well Armed (Tiznow) last year. The seven-year-old had two more starts in 2009, winning the May 17 G1 Singapore Airlines International Cup by a

neck over Presvis (GB) (Sakhee) at Kranji, but beating just one home in the Aug. 8 GI Arlington Million.

Returning after a 5 1/2-month vacation, he captured the Jan. 28 G3 Maktoum Challenge-Round 1 at 1600 meters. The Brazilian-bred prepped for the World Cup in Round 3 of the G3 Maktoum Challenge going 2000 meters Mar. 4, where he was a neck second to **Red Desire (Jpn)** (Manhattan Cafe {Jpn}).

His success over the Meydan synthetic did nothing to impress the handicappers, but he showed his affinity for the surface once again yesterday. Tiago Pereira hustled his horse away from the gate, and the two sailed along in front, with Allybar looking anxious while rating just off the pace on the rail, and Lizard's Desire sitting near the back of the pack.

Gloria de Campeao was asked for his best when they turned into the stretch, and opened enough daylight that he appeared to have the race in hand. His advantage dwindled to next to nothing in the final strides, but he did get the photo.

Brazilian-based owner Stefan Friberg of Estrela Energia Stables, surrounded by family and freinds, said, "I don't have words for it. It was fabulous. The plan was to go to the front, and he is very tough. He enjoys a fight and he never gives up."

Gloria de Campeao means "Glorious Champion" in Portuguese. "He always tries--he has a heart like that," said trainer Pascal Bary, holding his hands far apart.

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Not Their Night...

No one was more disappointed with the World Cup result than Kevin Shea. Beaten a whisker aboard **Lizard's Desire (SAf)**, but mistakenly thinking he got to the wire first, Shea said, "It's a very bitter pill to swallow, but I've got to swallow it. When I looked up it was just after the line and I was in front and I thought I'd got it. It's hard to take." Two-time Eclipse champion **Gio Ponti** (Tale of the Cat) raced just off the leaders and finished evenly to be fourth. "I had a great trip," jockey Ramon Dominguez offered. "I was very proud of how my horse ran. They were setting a very modest pace in front of me. That really affected my horse. They just didn't come back a whole lot." Favored **Gitano Hernando (GB)** (Hernando {Fr}) was taken back off the pace and had a wall of horses in front of him when they turned for home. He made up some ground to hit the line in sixth. "They went no pace and, consequently, there were traffic problems and everything was blocking up in front of me," jockey Kieren Fallon explained. "If they'd gone faster, the horses would have spread out more, but on a tight track like this, you need some room." **Richard's Kid** (Lemon Drop Kid) finally got untracked late, but could do no better than seventh. "I couldn't get him to quicken," Garrett Gomez said. "It was like he was in quicksand. All of a sudden, the last sixteenth of a mile, he started hitting gears."

It was the Dubai World Cup's version of Arcangues. Al Shemali, the subject of fewer than \$1,000 in bets in the American betting pools, was prominent behind only a steady tempo--which proved the undoing of many of the race's chief protagonists--shifted out past midstretch and stormed home a comfortable winner in the Duty Free. Third, beaten four lengths by Presvis (GB) (Sakhee) in a 10-furlong handicap at the 2009 Carnival, Al Shemali was seventh to the well-regarded Age of Reason (UAE) (Halling) in a 12-furlong affair a week later, then went missing. The chestnut returned from a 378-day absence to fill the fifth spot in a course-and-distance handicap Feb. 11 and came back just eight days later with a neck success going a mile and a quarter on the Tapeta.

That effort earned him a spot in Round 3 of the G2 Maktoum Challenge on Super Thursday Mar. 4, and Al Shemali did not disgrace himself, finishing sixth to a trio of World Cup contenders led by Red Desire (Jpn) (Manhattan Cafe {Jpn}). It was back to the weeds for this, but few believed he'd be anywhere other than at the back of the pack at the end of the day.

Tam Lin (GB) (Selkirk), third to Presvis and Alexandros in the G2 Jebel Hatta S. Mar. 4, displayed his characteristic

speed to lead from the American three-some of Take the Points (Even the Score), The Usual Q T (Unusual Heat) and Courageous Cat (Storm Cat), who had the garden seat one back on the fence. Al Shemali wasn't far from the front,



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while the stormers, including Alexandros (GB) (Kingmambo), Presvis and Good Ba Ba (Lear Fan) were ridden from off the slow pace. Take the Points edged to the front nearing the 200-meter mark, but Al Shemali was eased out, raced to the front and finished full of run as Bankable and Imbongi came from out of the pack to fill the minors. "It was a pleasant surprise, but the stable had been in terrific form and I knew he'd stay," said winning rider Royston Ffrench. "It was the case of getting a clear split and we got it. It's the most prestigious win of my career." As for Presvis, who was hopelessly blocked in the stretch, trainer Luca Cumani chalked it up to racing luck. "It was more like trackwork than a race and at least it didn't take a lot out of him," he commented. A progressive three-year-old, Dar Re Mi captured the G3 Prix Minerve before finishing second to Lush Lashes (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) and champion Zarkava (Ire) (Zamindar) in the G1 Prix Vermeille. She closed out the 2008 season with a third in the G2 Prix Royallieu at Longchamp. She began her four-year-old campaign with a narrow defeat in the G3 Middleton S. last May at York, then broke through at the top level in the G1 Pretty Polly S. at The Curragh June 27.

After upending dual Oaks heroine Sariska (GB) (Pivotal {GB}) in the G1 Yorkshire Oaks Aug. 20, the regally bred bay finished first in the G1 Prix Vermeille at Longchamp Sept. 13, but was controversially disqualified and placed fifth; an appeal by her owners was turned down. She flew across the world to finish a fine third under Frankie Dettori at Santa Anita, and was paired with William Buick for the first time here.

Away alertly from stall 14, the five-year-old crossed over to save some ground in the first flight of runners as Breeders' Cup Turf runner-up Presious Passion (Royal Anthem) did his usual business up front, with Golden Sword (High Chaparral {Ire}) tracking him in second. Buick kept his cool

aboard Dar Re Mi, allowing the mare to draw in closer, and finally angled out and gave her some rein as they straightened into the lane. Spanish Moon had the edge to her inside as they passed the 400-meter marker, but Dar Re Mi summoned up her superior reserves in the final 100 meters. Buena Vista was in behind the winner, but found a seam between her and Deem to get second.

"I told William to get a nice position, but to sit and chill on the bend as it's a long way home, and I'm delighted that he did not panic," said winning trainer John Gosden. "That's his first winner for me and, hopefully, the start of a long relationship." Buick added, "When I saw her earlier this month, it looked as though she had spent the winter in California, not freezing cold England. In the race itself, she just kept getting better and better, and found an extra gear in the stretch."

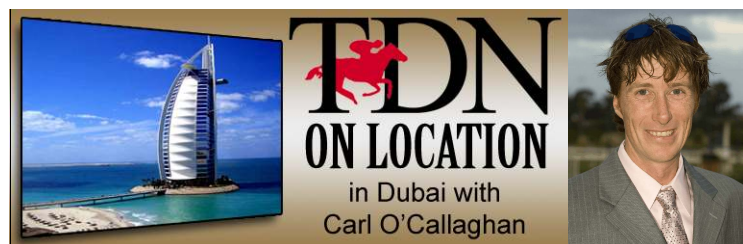

Carl O'Callaghan took Saturday off from his duties as *TDN* correspondent--he was just a little busy. Making his first appearance in Group 1/Grade I company, O'Callaghan sent out Kinsale King in search of a fourth consecutive victory and, with the *TDN* crew cheering nearly as loudly as the trainer himself, watched as the gallant gelding held off favored Rocket Man for a narrow score. The lightly raced Kinsale King was transferred to the O'Callaghan stable after finishing last in an entry-level allowance test at Santa Anita last January. He lit up the tote board at 61-1 in his first start under new management, an optional claimer at Oak Tree Oct. 30, and made it two in a row with a front-running neck score in the Dec. 6 GIII Vernon O. Underwood S. at Hollywood. Still, the bettors were not convinced. He was let go at 9-1 in the Jan. 23 GII Palos Verdes H., but fought it out through a half in :44 4/5 and was still there at the wire, winning by a half-length. The effort earned him a trip to Dubai, chronicled by his conditioner in the *TDN*.

O'Callaghan was confident before the race, and Kinsale King justified that trust in decisive fashion. Jockey Garrett Gomez had a snug hold on the five-year-old as they sat just off leader Laurel Guerreiro (Jpn) (King Halo {Jpn}) down the backstretch. A looming threat on the far outside as they raced out of the bend, Kinsale King struck the front at the top of the lane, opened a little daylight and kept finding more as Rocket Man came at him, taking it by a half-length. "I just wanted to get involved in the race early and, once got he got involved, he travelled well, and in the last 400 meters he stayed on well. It was wonderful," Gomez said. An overjoyed O'Callaghan remarked, "I knew I had it won when I put the saddle on him. I wasn't too worried about who else was in the race, but it was just amazing. Leave it to the Irishman. He's a great horse, has a lot of heart. I don't need to do a whole lot with him. I just give him his eggs and his Guinness, and let him go." He added, "This is what I want to do with my life and, hopefully, this proves that I can train and that it opens up a few more doors for me." It was the 10th win by an American-based horse in the event. The UAE Derby has been the domain of trainers Mike de Kock and Saeed bin Suroor, and so it remained for

yet another year, as the South African saddled the first two home for owner and breeder Sheikh Mohammed bin Khalifa al Maktoum. A debut winner at Clairwood last May, the bay was runner-up to stablemate Solid Choice (Aus) (Redoute's Choice {Aus}) in a June 13 allow-

ance race back at that venue before turning the tables on that rival with a decisive 3 1/4-length success in the G1 Golden Horseshoe S. to conclude his domestic freshman campaign at Greyville July 4.

Having clearly made the cut to join the always-formidable de Kock team at the International Racing Carnival, Musir resurfaced in the UAE 2000 Guineas Trial, a Feb. 4 conditions event over 1400 meters on the Tapeta. Making his first start on the synthetic track, things got off to a rocky start, as he took a few awkward strides out of the inside box, but was able to shift out in upper stretch and got home to best Godolphin's Frozen Power (Ire) (Oasis Dream {GB}) by a neck. The latter was the victim when the two squared off two weeks later in the G3 Guineas, but Musir had no trouble to speak of on that occasion and streaked home to score by 3 1/4 lengths.

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Looking to remain perfect on Tapeta and with Christophe Soumillon, Musir was reserved at the tail of the field as Solid Choice, also in the colors of Sheikh Mohammed bin Khalifa, raced freely on the front end. Mendip was racing in centerfield and traveling well, when disaster struck Timely Jazz (Ire) (Noverre), who broke down, forcing jockey Frankie Dettori to take evasive action to the outside. Rebalanced, the Godolphin runner came three wide at the quarter pole, with Soumillon and Musir following that move and Raihana going equally well. The filly struck the front in upper stretch, but Musir dove down towards the fence and finished willingly for an impressive victory. "I was on a very good horse, and he showed a lot of courage in the straight," said Soumillon, who was involved in a post-race scuffle with jockey Willie Supple, who rode Izaaj (Giant's Causeway) in a fifth-place effort. "He had a lot of weight and was racing over further than he's been before. I was able to sit behind good horses. He had to go through a gap and he did." The winning conditioner expressed at least a little bit of relief after the race. "I wasn't sure that he would stay, to be honest, but Christophe [Soumillon] thought he would, and he was right," said De Kock, saddling his fifth UAE Derby winner. A second-place effort in an open-company optional test Mar. 13 earned him the chance to try his luck in graded company, and he made the most of the opportunity. The Cal-bred kept pacesetter Eagle Poise in his sights down the backside, made his bid as they came into the lane and was all out to get to the line ahead of the late-closing Rendezvous. 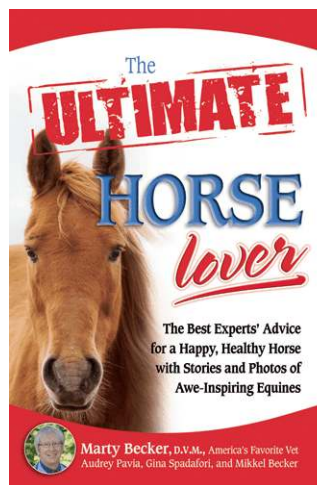

Musir would have won the Guineas and Derby back home. Of all the three-year-olds I've trained for [the UAE Derby], he could be the best of them." De Kock was winning the Derby for the fifth time. Musir is owned and bred by Sheikh Mohammed bin Khalifa al Maktoum, whose Raihana (Aus) (Elusive Quality) was second in the Derby and whose Lizard's Desire (SAf) (Lizard Island {Aus}) just missed in the World Cup. Musir was offered at auction as a yearling, but did not meet his reserve and was bought back.

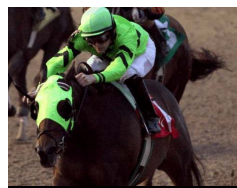

Ky Senate Passes Horse Health Bill:

House Bill 398, which calls for the formation of the Kentucky Equine Health and Welfare Council, was passed by the Kentucky Senate Friday by a unanimous vote of 38-0. The Council will work under the auspices of the state Department of Agriculture, overseeing matters related to the well-being of the horse. "As in the tradition of Kentucky basketball, we want this Commonwealth to be number one in protecting the health and welfare of the horse," said Dr. Frank Dwayne Marcum, DVM, an equine veterinarian from Versailles and president of the Kentucky-based Equine Health and Welfare Alliance Inc. (EHWA). "In this matter, we cannot afford to be number two." The bill was sponsored by Rep. Tom McKee (D), and now heads to the state House, where approval is expected. According to a press release, the Kentucky Equine Health and Welfare Council will be responsible for:

- Undertake research, conduct public hearings, and collect data to determine prevalent equine health and welfare issues.
- Strive to develop regional centers of care for unwanted, abused, neglected, or confiscated equines.
- Create a system of voluntary certification of equine rescue and retirement operations that meet industry-accepted standards for care of equines.
- Research and offer suggestions for statutory changes affecting equine health, welfare, abuse, and neglect issues.
- Assist veterinarians and others in maintaining the health and welfare of equines by identifying and referring to the appropriate authorities critical areas of need.

"We are taking a giant step forward for the equine industry in Kentucky," said McKee, a Harrison County farmer. "The horse is an economic engine and our signature animal. This bill is a step toward improving the health and welfare of the horse."
