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"SUPER" MAN: ANOTHER DERBY FOR BOREL

Somebody up there likes him. While Eclipse winner and favorite **Lookin At Lucky** (Smart Strike) was getting hammered into the fence before they'd even gone a quarter mile, and GI Florida Derby winner **Ice Box** (Pul-

pit) looked like he was trying to fight his way through an NFL backfield down the lane, Calvin Borel once again rode a golden rail to victory in the GI Kentucky Derby. Piloting WinStar Farm homebred **Super Saver** (Maria's Mon), Borel settled off a fast early pace, steered around the fading front-runner **Conveyance** (Indian Charlie) and set sail for home. Ice Box finally broke free in the final sixteenth and came flying through the mud, but it was too late. Super Saver hit the line 2 1/2 lengths to the good, giving Borel his third Derby win in the last four years. It was a

first victory in the Classic for trainer Todd Pletcher, and a first for Kenny Troutt and Bill Casner's WinStar operation. Borel wants to give them even more. Moments after dismounting from the Derby winner, he declared the colt would sweep the Triple Crown. "I'm going all the way this year," he said. "I have to." Cont. p2

MAK ONE

Rejected by Shadwell as a two-year-old, **Makfi (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}) made an unlikely hero yesterday when eclipsing his rivals to cause a 33-1 upset in Newmarket's G1 2000 Guineas. Despite his unbeaten record--extended in the G3 Prix Djebel last time Apr. 8--and the ambitious nature of this tilt by the Mikel Delzangles stable, the bargain Tattersalls horse-in-training purchase crept in under the radar as a weight of money and expectation

crushed the price of **St Nicholas Abbey (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) down to evens. With Ballydoyle's latest great hope looking one-paced in sixth, it was left to the sole French raider to upstage the Richard Hannon duo of **Dick Turpin (Ire)** (Arakan) and **Canford Cliffs (Ire)** (Tagula {Ire}), and he virtually silence the crowd. Settled towards the rear of the pack early, the bay travelled smoothly under Christophe-Patrice Lemaire and after collaring Dick Turpin with 100 yards remaining, asserted for a 1 1/4-length success. "He lacked experience before the race, but had won very well last time and had improved," Lemaire said. "He travelled well all the way and kicked like a top-class horse." Cont. p4

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A Winning Combination...

Bill Casner has been a fan of racing since the age of nine. "The first Kentucky Derby I saw was in 1957," he recalled. "That was Needles. I watched it on a small TV, and the vision is still etched in my mind." What was it like, some 53 years later, to be standing on the podium, celebrating a Derby winner of his own? "It's almost a surreal moment," he said. "It's unbelievable."

Casner, who put himself through college by galloping horses, and later trained as well, got to know Kenny Troutt the same year that Secretariat swept the Triple Crown. "We met when we were 25 years old in Nebraska at the old Ak-Sar-Ben," Casner said. "We've been friends and business partners ever since."

Troutt, a native of Illinois, founded a communications company, while Texan Casner was the owner of a

heavy equipment company. They were involved in racing in the '70s, but got out of the game for nearly 20 years before joining the Prestonwood partnership that campaigned 1998 GI Belmont S. winner and Kentucky Derby runner-up Victory Gallop. In early 2000, Troutt and Casner purchased the 1,450-acre Prestonwood property near Versailles, Kentucky, and renamed it WinStar. Just three years later, they were represented by the WinStar-bred Kentucky Derby winner Funny Cide. Now their familiar white and green silks have been carried to victory on the first Saturday in May as well.

"It's such a great feeling, having everybody together for this," Troutt said. "My family is here, everybody's family is here. I just want to thank everyone--Todd [Pletcher], [WinStar President and CEO] Doug [Cauthen], [WinStar Vice President and Racing Manager] Elliott [Walden]. Thank you!"

Doug Cauthen, whose brother Steve guided Affirmed to Triple Crown success in 1978, was also awed by the experience. "It's a dream come true," Cauthen said. "When Steve won, I was 15, and I figured by the time I was 18 or 19 I'd train a Derby winner. I learned it takes a lot longer. I got involved on the managerial side, and it's such a blessing to have this opportunity."

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Getting the "Mon"key Off His Back...

It was a rollercoaster week for Todd Pletcher, who had to withdraw ante-post favorite Eskendereya (Giant's Causeway) Sunday, but cast aside his winless streak in the Derby yesterday. Churchill's John Asher introduced the trainer at the post-Derby press conference and told the trainer that this was his opportunity to let loose and show his emotions. "Thanks very much. I feel terrific," Pletcher said evenly. A few seconds passed before Asher retorted, "Really? That's it?!"

Pletcher did pin his emotions on his sleeve in his next response, when he explained why winning the Derby at this point in time meant so much to him.

"The win, obviously, is important to me," he said. "But the one thing I wanted to do is win it while my parents were still here. My mom said that this was the best day of her life."

He added, "I'm sure it will sink in in a day or two. Obviously, it's a race I've thought about winning my entire life. Now that it's happened, you just don't know what to feel or say. I wish I could wax poetically up here, but it's all just soaking in."

As for the race itself, the future Hall of Famer remarked, "Calvin was in a beautiful spot the whole way. The only thing I told him was, 'Ride him like you own him, and don't forget about the lead change. That was it. He's an instinctive rider.'"

Super Saver was briefly in the shadow of Kentucky Derby longshot Discreetly Mine (Mineshaft), finishing second behind his stable-mate in his career opener at Saratoga last August. Stretched to a mile over a sloppy Belmont strip Sept. 11, he romped by seven lengths, then was fourth behind another "Run for the Roses" outsider in Homeboy Kris (Roman Ruler) in the Oct. 10 GI Champagne S.

The colt capped the year with a five-length score in the Nov. 28 GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. at Churchill, but took some time to come to hand this season. "We were sort of playing catch-up early in the year in February, and we went to the Tampa Bay Derby knowing that we weren't quite where we wanted to be," Todd Pletcher explained. "But that race moved us forward a little bit, and the Arkansas Derby put him right on." Third, beaten just a half-length, in the Mar. 13 GIII Tampa Bay Derby, Super Saver came back to be second by a neck in the Apr. 10 GI Arkansas Derby. He only improved from there. "For whatever reason--I wish I could tell you exactly what we did to make it happen--since the Arkansas Derby, this horse has just gotten better and better and better," Pletcher said. 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Super Savings...

WinStar purchased Super Saver, in utero, for just \$160,000 at the 2006 Keeneland November Sale. "Doug and Elliott picked the mare out," Bill Casner said. "It all starts from there." The blue-blooded bay is descended from a royal Phipps family, with GISW Dance Number (Northern Dancer) as his third dam, and the solid producer and GSW Get Lucky as his second dam. He is out of a full sister to the dam of WinStar's Bluegrass Cat (Storm Cat), who was runner-up in 2006 Kentucky Derby. Supercharger has a two-year-old colt named Brethren (Distorted Humor), a yearling filly by Awesome Again, and an April. 11 colt by Medaglia d'Oro.

Not So Lucky...

Lookin At Lucky's race was pretty much over when he was bumped hard in the run to the first turn. "I quit watching him after the first bump," said trainer Bob Baffert. "He was done. I wish [rider Garrett Gomez] would have pulled him up. That's horse racing. You have good luck and bad luck, and I've been lucky to win this race and other guys have had bad luck." Added Gomez, "I got bumped two or three times. That's what I worried about going in. He wasn't real willing to help me the first sixteenth of mile and take some of it. After the first one, he wasn't willing to take too much." The bay came on for sixth.

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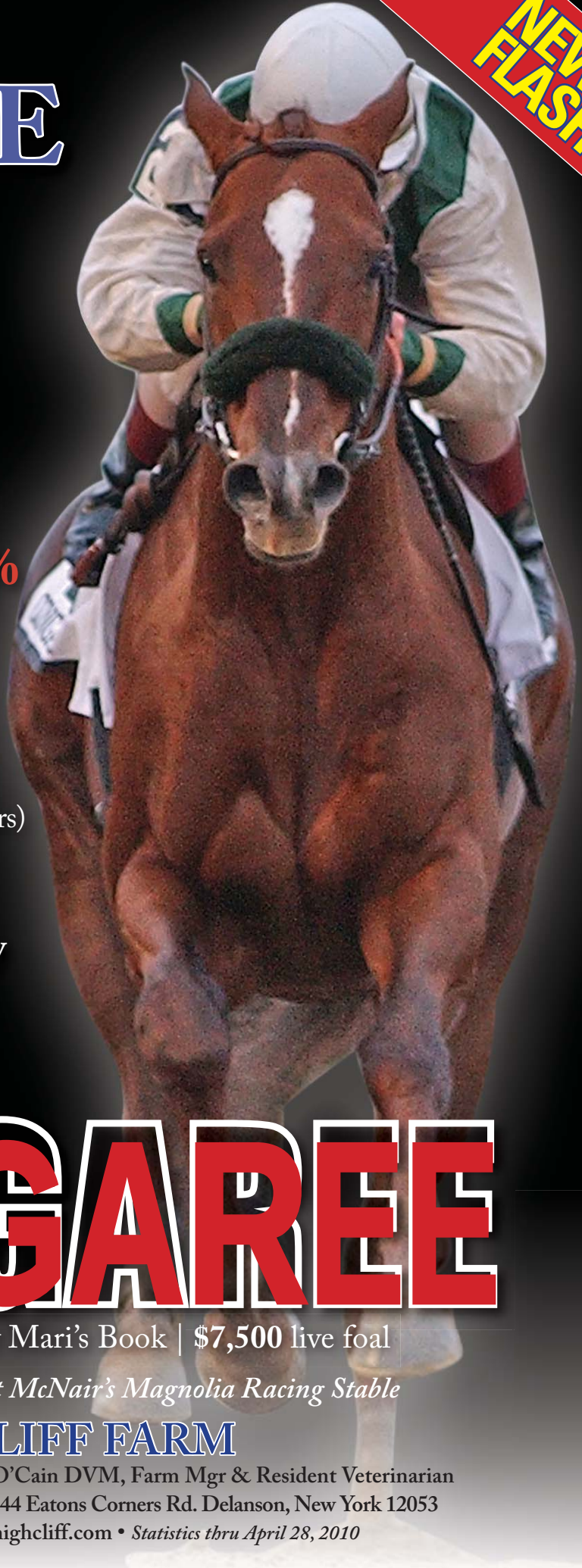

Little could have been expected of Makfi when he was purchased for just 26,000 guineas, and his debut came inauspiciously over seven furlongs at Fontainebleau in late November. His easy success over very soft ground there was a solid start, and when he pulled three lengths clear of decent types in the Djebel at Maisons-Laffitte last time, it was clear he had turned an important corner. Able to travel comfortably while tracking the hot favorite off the modest early tempo, Makfi glided through rivals with a half mile remaining. After squeezing between St Nicholas Abbey and Al Zir (Medaglia d'Oro) heading down into the "dip," he gathered in Dick Turpin on the uphill climb to the line. "He had only run on soft ground, but I saw no reason why he would not go on this faster surface," Mikel Delzangles said. "Although he didn't show much in the mornings, we thought he was above-average before the Djebel and he has proved that now. He is a very quiet horse, but can quicken and we might wait for the G1 St James's Palace S. [at Royal Ascot June 15] now. The G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains [at Longchamp May 16] is only two weeks away and he has only run three times, so it might come too soon." Makfi's Paris-based owner Mathieu Offenstadt, who has just seven horses in training, said, "For a small owner like me, it's hard to buy yearlings, so we went to Newmarket Sales, and I wanted to buy a Dubawi. I hoped he might win a maiden, but this is really just a dream."

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Aidan O'Brien was not completely downhearted afterwards and was in his usual analytical mood when considering the reasons for St Nicholas Abbey's reversal. "We would have been delighted to have seen a stronger-run race for him," the Ballydoyle conditioner said. "Johnny [Murtagh] said they did a hack canter for the first half and ideally our horse would have liked an evenly-run mile, as we were using this as a stepping stone to Epsom. That is not taking anything away from the winner or any other horse in the race, but we didn't put anything in to go an even, building pace in front and Johnny said they sprinted and he started staying on again at the end. He was working so well and his times were as good as any of the milers that we've had, so we decided to let him take his chance in the Guineas but we weren't winding him up for a mile. We were thinking of the rest of the year and although he is a horse with natural speed, we didn't want to light him up too much. We are happy with the horse." He couldn't get the job done for owner/trainer Tom McCarthy in the 135th running of the GI Kentucky Derby, finishing a troubled 10th last year, but General Quarters was on top of his game for this event. The grey had tried the turf just once before, finishing eighth in an allowance test on the Churchill spinach in November of 2008. He earned his way into Kentucky Derby consideration with a second in the Pasco S. and a win in the GIII Sam F. Davis S. at Tampa, and sealed the deal with a 14-1 score in the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. The four-year-old failed to land a blow in his two Triple Crown race tries, however, and went to the shelf after finishing ninth in the GI Preakness S. There was some suspicion he had turned into a perennial bridesmaid after four straight second-place finishes at Fair Grounds on his return, but General Quarters shed that sobriquet with a game effort here. He entered this test after filling out the exacta in an optional claimer Dec. 26, the Louisiana H. Jan. 23, the GIII Mineshaft H. Feb. 20 and the GII New Orleans H. Mar. 27. McCarthy decided Derby Day 2010 was the time to try his hard-knocking horse on the grass once again and, undaunted by the rain and the soggy footing, he came through this time. Breaking from post two and second through the opening quarter, the 8-1 shot was snugged back to sit fourth down the backside. Jockey Rafael Bejarano gave him the signal as they raced around the bend, and General Quarters responded. California horses have little experience with sloppy surfaces, but that didn't stop Mona de Momma from running down the speed to earn her first Grade I victory. The bay filly had demonstrated ability on the slick Churchill strip in the morning, working a bullet six panels in 1:14 3/5 in the slop Apr. 23, and she ran back to that trial here. Twice a winner at Del Mar last summer, the OBSMAR graduate made it three out of four with an allowance tally at Oak Tree in October. She was off the board in her next three appearances, but rebounded to post a rallying success at 10-1 in the Apr. 4 GIII Las Flores H. An 8-1 chance this time, Mona de Momma was well back early as Warbling (Unbridled's Song) powered her way through an opening half-mile in a rapid :44.38. The crowd's choice still had the advantage when they hit the lane, but she tired as jockey Joel Rosario got the winner geared up on the far outside. He got her to switch to her right lead as they neared the eighth pole, and outgamed fellow closer Pretty Prolific to get to the wire on top. "I'm always looking to be outside with her; I don't want to get stopped in traffic and all that," Rosario said. "The whole way I wanted to stay outside." Trainer John Sadler confirmed, "I told him to come wide. This race was tailor-made for Joel." Sadler added, "The filly has got a wonderful broodmare pedigree, loaded with stakes winners. 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Hot Mama...

The second Grade I winner from the first crop of her sire, 2004 champion sprinter Speightstown (Gone West), Mona De Momma made herself a valuable broodmare prospect for owner Michael Talla with this off-the-pace victory against a solid group. The bay filly was purchased by Eisaman Equine for \$100,000 at FTKOCT in 2007 before being resold to Mayberry Farm the following spring for \$335,000 at OBSMAR. She is out of Society Gal (Linkage), whose younger brother Mr. Greeley (Gone West) was a solid sprinter before going on to a successful stud career. Another of Society Gal's siblings was SW Majestic Legend (His Majesty), whose champion grandson Street Sense (Street Cry {Ire}) had a career moment on the first Saturday in May. Society Gal produced an El Corredor colt in 2009 and was bred back to Pure Prize.

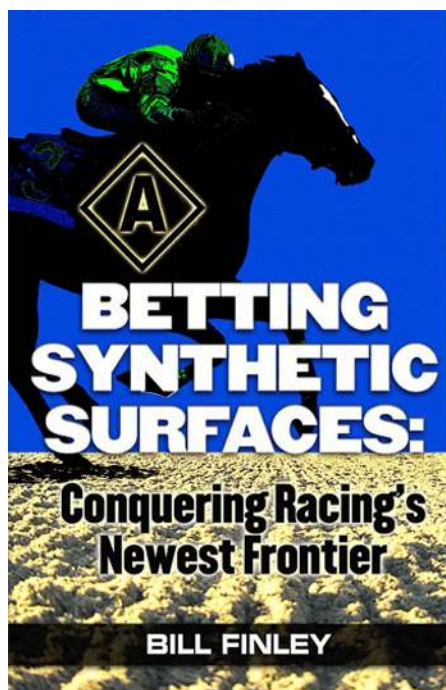

Pletcher said, "We handled soft ground at Tampa last time out, so we were optimistic that she'd handle it today, though this is softer than she ran on before. She's just a filly who's finding herself and getting good. She's getting better and better with every race. We'll probably run her in the [GI] Just A Game at Belmont on Belmont Day." He added, "My father bought her originally for himself for \$50,000 after she was third in the [GIII] Arlington-Washington Lassie. Wayne Patterson contacted him and they bought a majority interest. 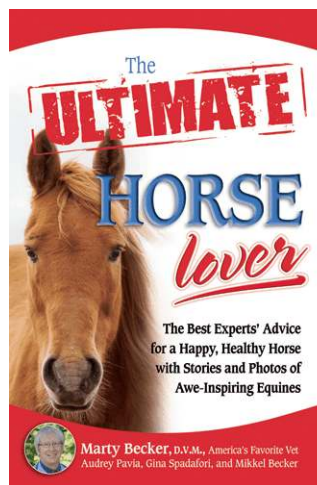

Three of racing's biggest names conjoin ahead of today's G1 Stanjames.com 1000 Guineas at Newmarket, when the hopes of the Leigh Family, Luca Cumani and Kieren Fallon are carried by ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ **Seta (GB)** (Pivotal {GB}). Hugely impressive when routing maiden rivals by eight lengths on the July Course here in August, the striking chestnut was only third at 4-7 in Doncaster's G2 May Hill S. when

last seen the following month. While that reversal dented confidence, the recent vibes surrounding the relative of Gossamer (GB) (Sadler's Wells)--who was the unplaced favorite for the Leigh-Cumani axis back in 2002--suggest she can feature prominently in

this renewal. With a forecast for plentiful overnight rain, her comeback jockey will be happy but her conditioner was quick to dismiss the idea that the homebred needs cut underfoot. "She's been ticking over nicely since her last piece of work and everything has gone smoothly," Cumani said. "Anyone who has read the comments made by Kieren Fallon regarding his reservations about underfoot conditions might be under the impression that the softer the ground for Seta the better, but that's far from the case. Ideally, we'd like the ground on Sunday to be good, no worse and certainly not soft and then she will have every chance to show everyone that she is as good as we think she is. Whatever Kieren might have said this week, we'll make sure he goes to post in a positive mindset."

It's In the Air...

Five years after Motivator (GB) provided the Royal Ascot Racing Club with one of those fairytale moments when winning the Epsom Derby, his first-crop daughter **Pollenator (Ire)** offers a potential revisiting of the dream. While Seta was backed as if defeat was out of the question in the May Hill, the late rush of the Richard Hannon-trained chestnut put that rival firmly in her place. "We were all very excited by the gallop that Pollenator produced against good horses at Herridge on Wednesday and she has really started to blossom this past week," Hannon commented. "After Doncaster, we were all talking more Oaks than Guineas and her pedigree suggests that she will stay further, but she has done so well through the winter that she deserves her place in this field. This mile is probably sharp enough for her now, but we know that she is not short of speed and she looks absolutely terrific, so she must have a great shot of finishing in the frame."

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Hibaayeb (GB) (Singspiel {Ire}), who split Pollenator and Seta in the May Hill, underlined that form when subsequently beating **Lady Darshaan (Ire)** (High Chaparral {Ire}) by 3/4 of a length in Ascot's Fillies' Mile in September. Switched from Clive Brittain's yard to Godolphin, that operation's Racing Manager Simon Crisford is more hopeful than confident about the middle-distance prospect. "She's been going well and has been building up to this race nicely," he said. "We are expecting a nice run, but think she will be better over a longer trip than a mile. The Fillies' Mile she won last year wasn't the best race, so she has a bit to find but she is in the mix and if she can get a piece of it that would be fantastic."

Show Off...

Jaber Abdullah and Mick Channon were denied a clear run and probable Guineas glory when the eventual close fifth Nahoodh (Ire) (Clodovil {Ire}) was stuck in traffic in this event two years ago. The fates had also conspired against the duo when the unbeaten Queen's Logic (Ire) (Grand Lodge) failed to make the gig in 2002, but in **Music Show (Ire)** (Noverre) they have a real opportunity to bury the hoodoo. Successful twice over seven furlongs of this track in the G2 Rockfel S. in October and G3 Nell Gwyn S.--in which she carried a penalty--the bay is coming into this test on an upward curve.

"All I want is no excuses," Mick Channon said. "We've had trouble in running in the Guineas before, it does happen on the Rowley Mile despite the width of the track, but that's out of my hands. As long as she gets a run, she'll hopefully be there at the finish. If we get beaten by a better filly on the day, fair play to them, but she's top class--I have no doubt about that." Barry Hills sent Ghanaati (Giant's Causeway) to success in 2009; he relies on **Sent From Heaven (Ire)** (Footstepsinthesand {GB}) this time.

Successful in the G3 Prestige S. at Goodwood in August, she was fourth in the Fillies' Mile the next month and her conditioner said, "She is a tough filly who you can place anywhere in a race, which should makes Michael [Hills]'s life a bit easier." Aidan O'Brien sends across the Mar. 21 G3 Park Express S. runner-up **Devoted to You (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}), while Andrew Balding saddles a live outsider in George Strawbridge's **Pipette (GB)** (Pivotal {GB}), who looked smart when winning a mile conditions event at Kempton last time Apr. 3.
