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SUPER SAVER DRILLS THREE FURLONGS

GI Kentucky Derby winner **Super Saver** (Maria's Mon) tuned up for Saturday's GI Preakness S. with a three-furlong work at Churchill Downs yesterday. The

WinStar homebred covered the distance in :36.60 with jockey Calvin Borel in the irons. He galloped out a half-mile in :49.20 and five-eighths in 1:02. It was the fifth fastest of 29 at the distance. "I was very pleased with the work," reported trainer Todd Pletcher. "We are very encouraged by what

we've seen since the Derby from him. Everything is good." Borel concurred with that assessment. "It was real good--just what we wanted," Borel said. "He switched leads on key--we've been working on that a little bit. It was perfect. You couldn't ask for better, I don't think." Super Saver is scheduled to ship to Baltimore Wednesday.

Pletcher also sent out GII Louisiana Derby winner **Mission Impazible** (Unbridled's Song) to work yesterday at Churchill. Twin Creeks Racing Stable's colt, ninth in the Derby, went three furlongs in :36.40--third fastest on the day, but connections have decided not to run in the Preakness. Pletcher will also saddle Dogwood Stables' **Aikenite** (Yes It's True) in the Preakness.

A Little Warm Out of Preakness...

Edward Evans' homebred **A Little Warm** (Stormin Fever) was declared out of Saturday's Preakness after working at Delaware Park Monday. "He worked fine, but he just didn't scope out good," said Chris Baker, manager of Evans' Spring Hill Farm. "We're going to have to withdrawn him from consideration from the Preakness. We just have to get him well and hopefully he'll be able to get back to racing in 30 days or so."

Garcia Gets Lucky...

Juvenile champion **Lookin At Lucky** (Smart Strike) has been confirmed for Saturday's Preakness and will be ridden by Martin Garcia. Garcia replaces Garrett Gomez,

who will ride Dublin (Afleet Alex) in the race. The colt's status for the Preakness had been undecided, but trainer Bob Baffert said yesterday the colt will run barring any unforeseen circumstances. "I'm planning on it unless I see something between now and getting on the plane," Baffert said. "I've been watching him, looking for any little sign of not wanting to come. He's been training well here,

he's moving well and is his old self. He deserves another chance at it." Lookin At Lucky, who will not have a work between the Derby and Preakness, is expected to ship to Pimlico Wednesday.

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Gomez Works Dublin, Albarado Takes Out Ike...

Dublin (Afleet Alex) worked a half-mile in company yesterday at Churchill in :48.40. New rider Garrett Gomez was aboard for the drill, which was the 15th fastest of 69 at the distance. He completed the work in fractions of :13, :25 and :37, and galloped out five furlongs in 1:01. "I liked what I felt under me," Gomez. "He was very responsive. [Trainer] Wayne [Lukas] wanted a good easy half and didn't want much of a gallop-out. He wanted solid :12s." Lukas added, "It was a very good work. Garrett liked it. He's enthused and that's all that matters." Lukas will also saddle **Northern Giant** (Giant's Causeway), most recently ninth in the Apr. 10 GI Arkansas Derby, in the Preakness. The Westrock Stables' colorbearer went three furlongs in :36.40.

Also getting acquainted to a new rider, **Hurricane Ike** (Graeme Hall) went seven furlongs in 1:25.80 with Robby Albarado aboard. Albarado is replacing Calvin Borel on the Ike and Dawn Thrash runner. "I thought it went well," Albarado said. "He hit the ground nice and I think I am in good shape."

Behkabad broke through at La Teste de Buch in his first go July 7 before doubling up in a Deauville conditions event Aug. 5, and closed his juvenile campaign with a victory in the Sept. 19 G3 Prix des Chenes at Longchamp. He returned this term to run third to No Risk At All in the Listed Prix Omnium II at Saint-Cloud last time Apr. 1. The colt gained revenge on that rival, but only after his chances was compromised when jockey Christophe Soumillon lost his whip when challenging in the closing stages. Setting the tone under a tight hold after one furlong, Behkabad was shaken up with 350 meters remaining and came under increased urging in the closing stages to hold the wide bid of No Risk At All. "The going was not in Behkabad's favor last time and he probably needed the run, too," commented racing manager Georges Rimaud. "He found himself in front today, but that was not a problem as he's a very straightforward horse. We shall discuss his future with His Highness [The Aga Khan] and [trainer] Jean-Claude Rouget, but, all being well, he will most probably run in the [G1] Prix du Jockey Club [June 6], and we do not anticipate any problem with him staying the trip." Behkabad looks set to once again renew rivalry with the runner-up, whose trainer Jean-Paul Gallorini added, "No Risk At All is better on softer ground, and it was not so easy to make up so much ground on that going today. His jockey lost his whip, which didn't help in the closing stages, but we're not at all disappointed. We will come back here for the Prix du Jockey Club." **Click for the**

RACHEL WORKS AT CHURCHILL

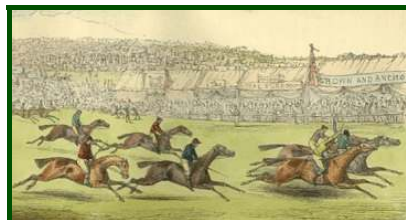

The four-year-old filly went four furlongs in :50. With jockey Shaun Bridgmohan up, she completed the work in fractions of :13, :25.60 and :38.60 and galloped out five furlongs in 1:05.60. "It was an easy first work back," trainer Steve Asmussen reported. "It's a nice cool morning and everything is ideal today. It's another step in the process." Asmussen said no race had been picked out for Rachel Alexandra's next start.

'Mine' Oaks Bid Doubtful...

Aidan O'Brien yesterday all but ruled Roisin Henry and Susan Magnier's **You'll Be Mine** (Kingmambo) out of the June 4 G1 Epsom Oaks after revealing that she was running out of time due to the setback that ruled her out of the May 2 G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket. Outlining plans for his Epsom hopefuls, the Balldyole conditioner said, "You'll Be Mine had a knock, so had to miss the Guineas at Newmarket. She is in good form, but she's not guaranteed to go for the Oaks. **Dance On By** (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) ran respectably when there was no pace on in the Listed Cheshire Oaks, while [Cork maiden winner] **Awe Inspiring** (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) is another that might go to Epsom. **Cabaret** (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) is going to the G3 Musidora S. [at York] and we're very happy with her, while Dylan Thomas's three-parts sister **Remember When** (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) finished third [in the Listed Victor McCalmont Memorial S.] at Gowran, and she's another possible for the Oaks."

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O'Brien Retains Faith in St Nick...

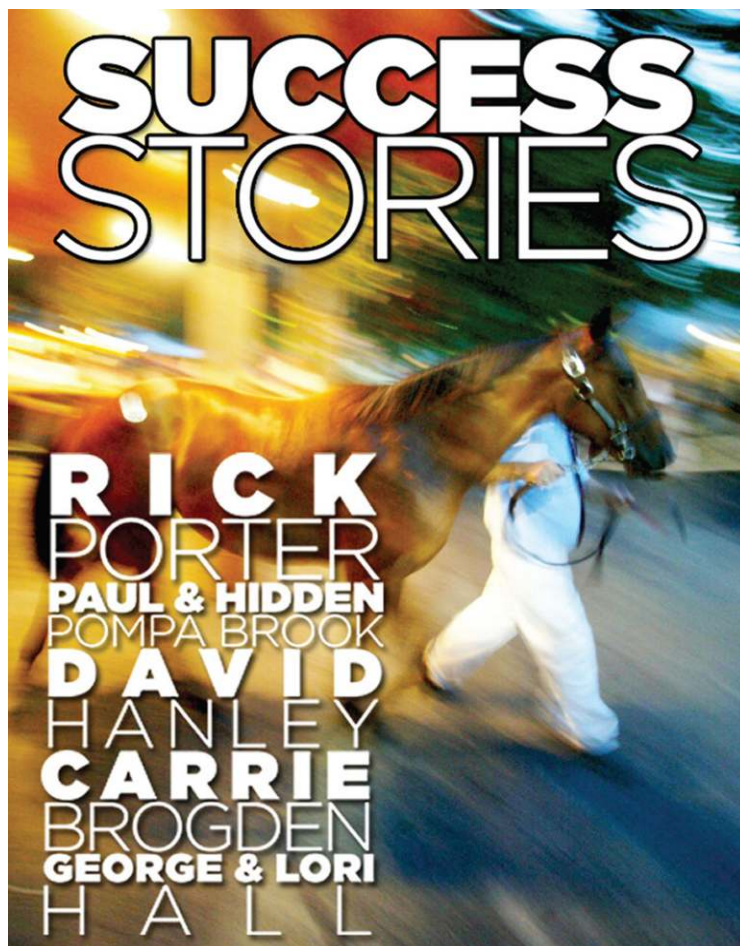
Aidan O'Brien underlined his belief in **St Nicholas Abbey (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) ahead of the June 5 G1 Epsom Derby. Despite the failure of Derrick Smith, Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor's champion juvenile to justify even-money favoritism when sixth in the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket May 1, his Ballydoyle conditioner is confident he can rebound from that effort.

"He was ready to run a hard mile that day, but maybe it wasn't a hard mile and, if the pace had been fast and strong, his class would have come out," O'Brien explained. "Before that, his times at home had been as good, if not better, than all the good milers we've had, and he was doing it on the bridle. We didn't ask him a lot at home, and maybe we were too easy on him. He has to step up from the Guineas to the Derby, but I think it's in there. He was always the number one candidate for Epsom, and nothing has changed. He's one of those horses that comes along very few times, but I don't want to hype him. I'd rather he does the talking and shows you what he can do. He had last week off and his work will start this week again and get more serious each week in the run up to the Derby. I'd have no worry about the track at Epsom--he was always a well-balanced horse."

Johnny Murtagh looks set to maintain his partnership with last year's G1 Racing Post Trophy winner and added, "I was disappointed immediately after the Guineas, but watching the race again, it was a good run. It was slowly run, and I was very happy with the way St Nicholas Abbey stayed on to the line. It was his first run of the season, and that's just putting all ours right mentally this year. When St Nicholas Abbey won the Racing Post last season, I thought he was potentially one of the best I'd ridden, and he could be right up there with the best if everything goes OK in the Derby. He's got the speed, the stamina and he's got everything you need for the race. It would take a huge performance from one of our other horses to get me to change my mind about what I ride in the Derby."

O'Brien also revealed that Thursday's G2 Dante S. hopeful **Cape Blanco (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) was on course for York after his slight setback, while he gave the lowdown on some of the other Derby contenders.

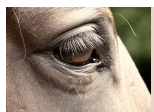
"**Mikhail Glinka (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) had a foot bruise that delayed him and has held him up, so we will just have to see how he is in the next few weeks," O'Brien added. "We were delighted with **Midas Touch (GB)** (Galileo {Ire})'s win on Sunday [in the G2 Derrinstown Stud Derby Trial S.], and he has eaten up and come out of the race very well today. We have to decide with **Viscount Nelson** (Giant's Causeway), whether to go for the Dante with a view to going to Epsom, or whether to go to the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas [at The Curragh May 22]. **Fencing Master (GB)** (Oratorio {Ire}) looks like he could get farther than a mile, and he might go for the Irish Guineas."

If any stallion was good enough to shake off the effects of advancing age, one would have thought it would be the marvellous Sadler's Wells. With 14 sires' championships to his name, including 13 consecutive titles between 1992 and 2004, this fertile stallion was surely going to be immune to the diminishing success that often affects veteran stallions.

Over the years, we have become accustomed to thinking of Sadler's Wells as a most reliable source of Group 1 winners. Every one of his first 18 crops produced at least one winner at the top level, and there were three or more Group 1 winners in 15 of them. His career-best figure of eight came with his 1999 crop, which featured High Chaparral, Islington and Gossamer. He was still in excellent form with his 2003 crop, conceived when he was 21 years old. As many as five of the 133 foals in that crop achieved Group 1-winner status, with the dual Oaks winner Alexandrova leading the way from such as Septimus (Irish St Leger) and Ask (Coronation Cup).

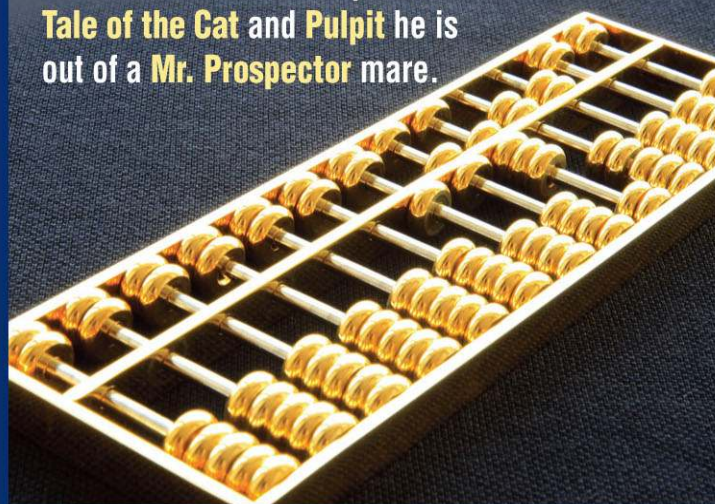

Since then, though, it has been a somewhat different story. None of the 112 foals in his 2004 crop has so far triumphed in a Group 1, and only one of the 126 foals in his 2005 collection has done so (the Fillies' Mile winner Listen). Of the 105 foals in his 2006, one has won a Group 2 and another three have scored at Group 3 level. That said, five members of this crop were good

enough to be placed in such important races as the Epsom Derby, Fillies' Mile, French 1000 Guineas, Irish Oaks, Yorkshire Oaks and Secretariat S., so a Group 1 win may yet be around the corner.

Although Sadler's Wells's 2007 crop--conceived when he was 25--is smaller than many of its predecessors, it still numbers more than 70. It has been comparatively quiet up until now, but last week saw his gelded son Icon Dream fail by only a head to land one of Britain's Derby Trials, the G3 Chester Vase (won by a colt by Sadler's Wells's son Beat Hollow).

Then, two days later, Sadler's Wells's son Bullet Train underlined his Classic potential with a very encouraging victory in Lingfield's G3 Derby Trial. I think Bullet Train's victory made him the 164th group/graded winner to represent Sadler's Wells on the flat, and the rate at which this youngster appears to be improving suggests that he could one day become his sire's 74th Group 1 winner.

Before I take a look at Bullet Train's pedigree, I need to try to explain the apparent decline in Sadler's Wells's results at the highest level.

I am reluctant to accept that it has anything to do with Sadler's Wells's actual age. Mr. Prospector--a similarly extraordinary stallion--was 26 years old when his Kentucky Derby winner Fusaichi Pegasus was conceived, and 27 when he sired the Grade I winners Aldebaran, Dancethruthedawn and Full of Wonder.

I have become increasingly convinced that these veteran stallions often become a victim of their own success. From 2001, Sadler's Wells faced increasing competition, on his own doorstep, from three of his most accomplished sons. Montjeu joined the Coolmore team in 2001, Galileo in 2002 and High Chaparral in 2004. While these sons were unproven, they represented a highly enticing alternative to their aging sire, especially as they were available for a fraction of the hefty fee that Sadler's Wells had earned. Of course, there was also fierce competition from Danehill for the best mares at Coolmore at the start of the decade.

It is also essential to remember that Sadler's Wells has developed into the dominant force among the broodmare sires in Britain and Ireland, to the extent that he has topped the table in each of the last five years.

Of course, the mares that put him there were disqualified from visiting him before his retirement, as were the numerous good mares that either have a son of Sadler's Wells as their sire or a Sadler's Wells mare as their dam.

Many of Sadler's Wells's daughters visited Danehill, producing a total of 84 foals. No fewer than 10 of these became stakes winners, with the Group 1 winners Peeping Fawn and Horatio Nelson leading the way. Sons of Danehill have now become popular choices for daughters of Sadler's Wells, with this combination producing 250 foals aged three or more. Dansili and Oratorio have both sired Group 1 winners from them, and there are likely to be plenty more, even if Danehill's sons have yet to match their father's impressive 12 percent stakes winners with daughters of Sadler's Wells.

Perhaps because Sadler's Wells was born five years before Danehill, there have been fewer instances of daughters of Danehill visiting Sadler's Wells. Indeed, Bullet Train is one of only 15 foals bred this way, and he's the first to win a group race. Fergus McIver, another of the 15, was second to the future Irish Derby winner Fame and Glory in last year's G3 Ballysax S.

Mating daughters of Danehill to Sadler's Wells created 2x4 inbreeding to Northern Dancer, and it is possible that breeders preferred to send them to Sadler's Wells's sons. This combination is responsible for nearly 200 foals aged three or up. Galileo's contribution to this total includes the champion two-year-old Teofilo, the Derby Italiano winner Cima de Triomphe and the Classic-placed fillies Cuis Ghaire and Gile na Greine. High Chaparral is also shaping up well, with the Group 3 winners Above Average and Noll Wallop among his first 14 foals out of Danehill mares.

There was another compelling reason for sending Bullet Train's dam, Kind, to Sadler's Wells in her first season. Kind is a half-sister to Sadler's Wells's top-class son Powerscourt. This quirky horse was extremely good at his best, as might be guessed from his total earnings of nearly \$2 million. His earnings would have been considerably higher had he not been demoted from first to fourth after a controversial ride in the 2004 Arlington Million. He defeated Kitten's Joy in the following year's Arlington Million, his other Group 1 success having come in the 2004 Tattersalls' Gold Cup. Powerscourt is now based in Turkey, after starting his stallion career in Kentucky, and it is possible that his Group 1-winning daughter Termagant will make his sale look regrettable.

Bullet Train's dam Kind was a very different performer from Powerscourt. As a listed winner over five and six furlongs, she clearly inherited speed from her sire rather than stamina from her dam, the G3 Lancashire Oaks winner Rainbow Lake. **Cont. p8**

Despite his dam's speed, Bullet Train is clearly not going to have any problems with the distance of the Derby--a race that has provided Sadler's Wells's sons with two victories, seven seconds and three thirds. Three grandsons have also won the race in recent years, these grandsons significantly being by Montjeu (two) and Galileo.

Bullet Train's third dam Rockfest was a successful staying two-year-old who went on to be second in the Lingfield Oaks Trial, and his fourth dam Rock Garden was a half-sister to Glen Strae, a very smart winner of six of his seven juvenile starts.

His fifth dam, Nasira was a three-parts sister to Zabara, winner of the 1000 Guineas, and to Rustam, a high-class two-year-old. This family also produced the Classic winners Don't Forget Me and Desert King, plus the top miler Maroof. Kind looks well placed to add significantly to the family fortunes, as Bullet Train is followed by two impressive sons of Galileo and a colt foal by Oasis Dream.

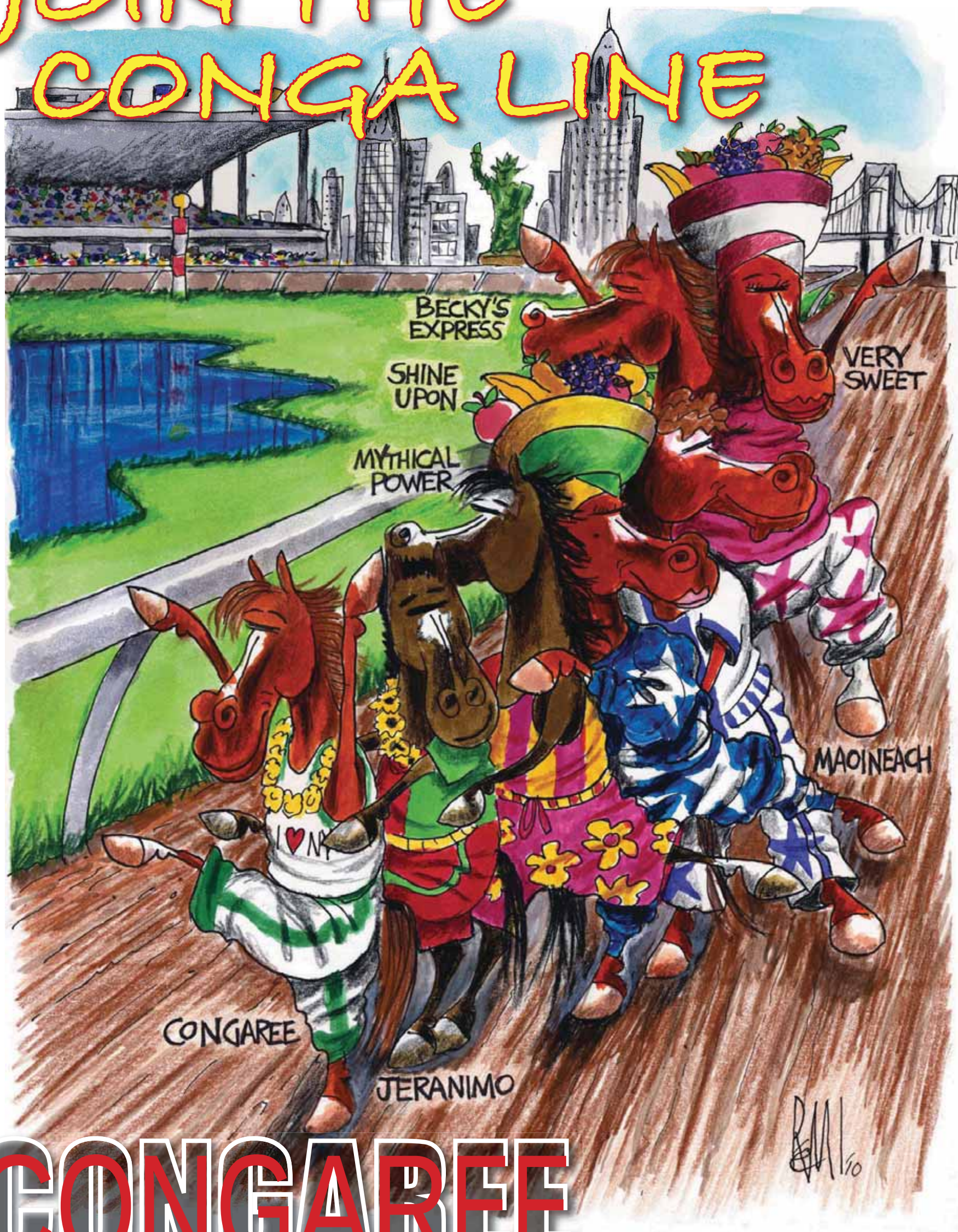
