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### LOOKIN TO GET LUCKY AT PIMLICO

He hasn't been living up to his name. Eclipse champion **Lookin At Lucky** (Smart Strike) was sent off the 4-5 chalk in the GI Santa Anita Derby, but bounced off the rail at the 5/16 pole and could do no better than third, six lengths behind Sidney's Candy (Candy Ride {Arg}). The bay was bet down to 6-1 favoritism to rebound in the May 1 GI Kentucky Derby, but once again was roughed up while racing along the inside during the opening exchanges of the race. Some would have called it a day, but **Lookin At Lucky** was able to close some ground to be sixth, seven lengths adrift of **Super Saver** (Maria's Mon). Can he shake off the hex to give trainer Bob Baffert a fifth win in the GI Preakness S.? Looking to change his luck, Baffert took Garrett Gomez off the colt, giving Martin Garcia his first Preakness mount. "I wanted to try to just change our mojo a little bit," Baffert explained. "Our mojo just wasn't working. It was just something different. If I'm going to come here, I want to do something different. He's been in trouble; we've had bad luck three times in a row. That's the only reason I did it." **Cont. p2**

### NO SANTA ANITA LEASE FOR OAK TREE?

MI Developments yesterday announced it was ending its current contract with Oak Tree Racing Association. Oak Tree, a non-profit association, has held a lease at Santa Anita in Arcadia, California, since 1969. While Oak Tree officials believed they would have a deal going forward at least until 2016, MID's Chief Executive Dennis Mills said that was not the case. "They've talked about coming out in June and renegotiating a new lease," Oak Tree's Executive Vice President Sherwood Chillingworth told *Daily Racing Form*. "They are telling us it will be very equitable, but until we see it, we don't know." Mills would not discuss the potential for a new contract. "It's totally inappropriate to talk about those things at this period of time," he told *DRF*. "I'm sure they've got ideas on their own. We're not going to talk about specifics at this moment, because we think it's important for all of us to come up with a comprehensive plan that is doable, and we hope that we can accomplish that by the middle of June." He added, "This is not personal with Oak Tree. The whole model needs review. Let's start with a clean slate and figure out how to make things work." The two entities will meet next week to discuss the future; if Oak Tree cannot negotiate a new contract with MID, it could hold its meet at another California track, possibly Hollywood Park. "We've got the dates," Chillingworth told *DRF*.

For those who haven't been to Pimlico, the barn that houses the Preakness runners doesn't sit on the backstretch, but instead is behind the grandstand, along with a second stakes barn for the weekend's other graded events. That set-up makes for a concentration of high-quality animals that's pretty impressive.

The runners kept the schedules they established a day earlier. Todd Pletcher's pair of **Super Saver** (Maria's Mon) and **Aikenite** (Yes It's True) headed to the track around 6:30 a.m., while trainer Bob Baffert's **Lookin At Lucky** (Smart Strike) waited until just after the 8:15 a.m. renovation break to go out.

Baffert, rocking out the ostrich-skin boots, was joined by several colleagues, including Lookin At Lucky's co-owner Mike Pegram. Asked just after watching 'Lucky' jog 1 3/8 miles if he was beginning to get nervous, Pegram smiled and said, "Me? Nahhhh."

Baffert kept the group amused by relating the story of when Silver Charm stopped suddenly and dropped rider Larry Damore on the clubhouse turn at Pimlico one pre-Preakness morning. "He didn't even know he was loose; he was just jogging around out there," Baffert said. "I told a reporter the rider's name was Larry DaMoron."

Joining the Lookin At Lucky team was Pegram's friend Mike Tice, former coach of the Minnesota Vikings and current offensive line coach for the Chicago Bears. At 6'7" and 250 pounds, Tice is roughly the size of a Winnebago. At one point yesterday, a security guard, trying to determine who belonged where, asked Tice if he was part of the group. "I am the group," Tice replied.

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## Preview

### Triple Threat?

Immediately after guiding **Super Saver** (Maria's Mon) to victory in the GI Kentucky Derby two weeks ago, jockey Calvin Borel went on national TV and guaranteed a Triple Crown victory. He was sounding just as confident on the eve of the second leg of the Crown. "I think this colt is starting to peak at the right time, and it's a big, big plus," Borel said. "He worked so good Monday morning, you wouldn't imagine." He backed off a little to remark, "I'd love to win the Triple Crown, but if it happens, it happens. If it doesn't, it doesn't. But the colt is coming into the race super good." Super Saver, forwardly placed in his first six starts, did rate a little farther back in fourth in the Derby. But he could be on the front end today. "It's going to be a totally opposite race, I think," Borel said. "It won't have the speed in it, like it did in the Derby. If somebody wants to go, I think I can let him go and lay right off of him. If they don't, we'll take it to them."

### New Shooters...

Eight of the last 10 Derby winners have hit the board in the Preakness, and four have won it. Monarchos, the other son of Maria's Mon to wear the blanket of roses, could do no better than sixth in 2001. No less than seven of today's 12 starters will be looking to knock Super Saver off the podium, including Cal-bred **Caracortado** (Cat Dreams). The gelding missed out on a Derby berth through a lack of graded earnings, but his co-owner Donald Balhut took the disappointment in stride. "We would have liked to have had enough points to get there, but it wasn't to be," said Blahut. "We're really not devastated by it. I think this is the race we fit better in of the three races. I think if we have some racing luck, we'll be all right." Caracortado won his first five races, including the GII Robert B. Lewis S. He was fourth in the Apr. 3 GI Santa Anita Derby last time out.

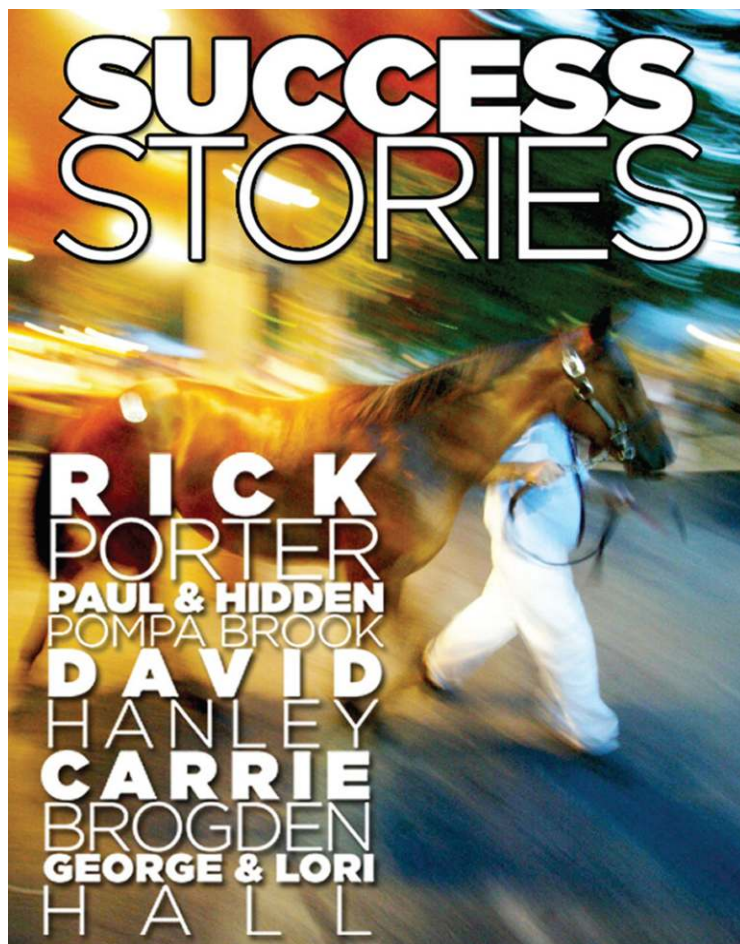

Unraced as a juvenile, Manifest debuted with a second at Newmarket's July course July 8, and broke through back there a month later. He ran third in the Listed Noel Murless S. at his local Rowley Mile track in his only other sophomore outing Oct. 1, and came back this term to run a commendable second to Harbinger (GB) (Dansili {GB}) in the G3 John Porter S. at Newbury Apr. 17. Positioned in second for most of this stamina test, he was urged to the front with three furlongs remaining and powered clear under a final-quarter drive to record a career high by daylight. "He ran a hell of a race in the John Porter, he's improved since then and he did that very well," said jockey Tom Queally. "He stays well, he wasn't stopping there and, once he reaches top gear, he's something to be reckoned with." Manifest earned ante-post quotes of 8-1 for the June 17 G1 Gold Cup at Royal Ascot in the wake of this win. "I love Cup horses, and he just could make up into a really nice one," trainer Henry Cecil said. "He looks as if he stays and he could stay the Gold Cup trip, but it's entirely up to the Prince [Khalid Abdullah] whether he'd like to run him in it or not. "Just because this track has been favoring speed today, I said, 'Jockey [Jose Lezcano], let's give her a little incentive early on. **SKIP AWAY DEAD** Skip Away (Skip Trial--Ingot Way, by Diplomat Way), a four-time Eclipse Award winner and Horse of the Year in 1998, died yesterday of an

apparent heart attack at Hopewell Farm near Midway, Kentucky. The stallion was 17. Bred by Anna Marie Barnhart, he went through the ring at the 1995 OBS February sale and attracted a final bid of \$30,000 from owner Carolyn Hine. But shortly after the sale, it was discovered the grey had a chip in

his knee, and OBS agreed to lower the price to \$22,500, discounting the cost of surgery. His connections opted to skip the surgery, however, and the colt made his first start at Monmouth Park that June. Conditioned by trainer Sonny Hine and easily recognized by his signature red and yellow blinkers and exaggerated knee action, he would go on to win 18 races, including 10 Grade I events, and earn \$9,616,360. "I can't say he's just another horse; he's a bolt of lightning, this guy," Sonny Hine told the *New York Times* just before the colt's retirement. "Who would ever think I'd have the best horse in the world, but it happened."

### Consistent As They Come...

Fourth when sent off at 4-5 as part of an entry in his career opener, Skip Away would hit the board in 34 of his next 37 appearances. The Florida-bred capped off his juvenile campaign with narrow losses in the GII Cowdin S. and GII Remsen S., and was bet down to 4-5 in a Gulfstream allowance test to open his sophomore season. With jockey Jerry Bailey in the saddle, the odds-on chalk was at the back of the five-horse field before they'd gone a half-mile, and was eased down the lane. The Hines pulled Bailey off the horse, replacing him with Shane Sellers, and Skip Away romped by 12 lengths in an allowance test a month later. Third in the GI Florida Derby, he came back to take the GII Blue Grass S. by six lengths, but he put in a rare lackluster effort in the GI Kentucky Derby and ran 12th.

Sellers lost the mount after a second-place finish in the GI Preakness S., and it was Jose Santos who was aboard when the colt finished second in the GI Belmont S. The winner of the GII Ohio Derby and GI Haskell Invitational H. at the Hines's home track on the Jersey Shore, Skip Away then ran third as the 7-5 favorite in the GI Travers S., and Sellers had the mount again. Skip Away captured the GI Woodbine S. and beat Cigar a head in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup. He was named champion three-year-old, but lost out on the Horse of the Year title to Cigar (Palace Music).

With Sellers still in the irons, Skip Away had to settle for minor awards in his first four outings of 1997 before garnering a head score in the GIII Mass 'Cap. He made it two in a row in the GII Suburban H., but was beaten again in his next three tries, and Jerry Bailey was given another chance. The two combined to take the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup by 6 1/2 lengths, but Bailey opted to ride Behrens in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic. Mike Smith made a cameo, piloting Skip Away to a six-length tally as Behrens finished seventh. But the Classic victory was not enough to sway the voters. Favorite Trick was named Horse of the Year, while Skip Away picked up the Eclipse for top older horse.

Bailey would ride Skip Away in every one of his nine starts in 1998. The two reeled off wins in the GI Donn H., GI Gulfstream Park H., GI Pimlico Special, GIII Mass 'Cap, GI Hollywood Gold Cup, GII Philip H. Iselin H. and GI Woodward S. He tailed off at the end of the season, running third in the Jockey Club Gold Cup and sixth in the Breeders' Cup Classic, but finally earned that elusive Horse of the Year crown.

When Sonny Hine was elected to the Hall of Fame posthumously in 2003, Carolyn Hine told the *New York Times*, "He once asked me after Skippy became Horse of the Year who I loved more, him or the horse. When I didn't answer right away, he asked me what was taking so long. I told him that it was a dead heat." When asked who he would choose, superstar Cigar or Skip Away, Bailey told the *New York Times*, "It's like having two kids. Which one do you love most? Either one in themselves would be just great, but to be blessed to ride two great horses like that--it's indescribable."

### Hard to Replicate...

Skip Away retired to stud at Rick Trontz's Hopewell Farm in 1999, and has nine crops to race. His 21 stakes winners include graded winners Skipaslew, Sister Swank and Skip Code, and Panamanian champion Sanky Panky. His progeny have earned more than \$19 million. Skip Away, who had just 29 named foals from his 2007 crop, and has 21 two-year-olds this season, stood for a fee of \$10,000 in 2010. Trontz, who indicated that Skip Away had suffered from a heart condition for several years, told *Daily Racing Form*, "He was just a super horse and he seemed to get pretty nice racehorses. He was a sound, sound horse. I'm sure he hardly got any medication. You just don't see those kind of horses anymore. It's all about speed these days. His horses did well on all surfaces: they were great on the turf, all-weather, and dirt, they ran short and they ran long."

**BLIND LUCK TO HOLLYWOOD OAKS** Immediately following her victory in the GI Kentucky Oaks Apr. 30, trainer Jerry Hollendorfer indicated that the victorious **Blind Luck** (Pollard's Vision) had earned a

She was back on the worktab yesterday morning, breezing five-eighths of a mile in :59.80 and, instead of receiving some rest and relaxation, she will go back to work in the GII Hollywood Oaks June 6. "It's not really that quick back; it's five weeks since the Oaks," said Hollendorfer, who was winning his third renewal of the "Run for the Lilies." "It's better to run at home rather than to ship again, and that's

why we'd like to stay on the West Coast for this race." Hollendorfer said he and his fellow owners gave some consideration to a run in the GI Belmont S. June 5, but ultimately opted for something softer. "We had put that on our list of races to look at, but I didn't think that made much sense right now," the conditioner commented.

### Tapitsfly Back in Action...

Frank Jones Jr.'s homebred **Tapitsfly** (Tapit), last seen annexing the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf at Oak Tree Nov. 6, has rejoined the Dale Romans barn in Churchill Downs. She posted one workout following her Breeders' Cup heroics in late December at Gulfstream, then hit the sidelines. "We had a chip taken out of her ankle," said Romans, who saddles a pair in today's GI Preakness S. "She's back and looks better than ever, and we'll start breezing her when we get back from Maryland." Romans added that he hopes to have Tapitsfly back in the entries by the end of the Churchill meeting.

### Pellegrini Hero Targeting Arc...

G1 Carlos Pellegrini hero **Interaction** (Arg) (Easing Along) arrived without incident at Pascal Bary's Chantilly stable earlier this month, and is now preparing for a European campaign leading to his anticipated start in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe in October. The Southern Hemisphere three-year-old landed South America's signature event last December, stamping himself South America's leading sophomore. He then spent four months acclimating to the change of hemisphere at J.J. Pletcher's training facility in Ocala, Florida, before heading to France. Interaction made a good first impression upon his arrival. "He is a magnificent horse with a great appearance, and he has already been out on the sand at Chantilly," Bary told *Racing Post*. "He is quite a funny individual, because he is very curious, but very calm and sure of himself." He added, "We haven't decided when he will make his debut in France, but the one purpose of him being with me is to win the Arc de Triomphe." Bary landed the G1 Dubai World Cup in March with former South American-trained Gloria De Campeao (Brz) (Impression {Arg}). Favored to be honored with the Carlos Pellegrini Award as Argentina's 2009 Horse of the Year and champion three-year-old male, Interaction was campaigned in Argentina by Jorge Cardemil's Haras Futuro and partner Fernando Fantini. He won five of nine starts in Argentina, including the G1 Gran Premio Jockey Club, the second leg of Argentina's Triple Crown, and the Pellegrini over older horses. As a two-year-old, he captured the G1 Gran Premio Raul y Raul E. Chevalier. Interaction will race in France for new owner Jose Cerillo's Haras Pozo de Luna and for Fantini.

Beaten 1 1/4 lengths by Makfi (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}) a fortnight ago, he puts that form to the test here, and trainer Richard Hannon is hoping that the likely easier underfoot conditions will help his cause from the inside post. "People have underrated Dick Turpin," Hannon said. "I told anyone who would listen before the Greenham that he could be the fly in the ointment, and he not only won that trial, but went on to run a blinder to finish second in our Guineas. Ryan [Moore] said that he did everything right at Newmarket, but there will be a bit more juice in the ground at Longchamp and that will be right up his street. He is a serious horse, and I hope and think that he'll go very close."

Bolstering a strong overseas challenge is the unexposed **Aldovrandi (Ire)** (Cape Cross {Ire}), who impressed when winning a mile conditions race at Kempton Apr. 3. "He's working well, we think he's a nice horse, but now he has to prove that he's ready for the big step up," trainer Marco Botti told *PA Sport* yesterday. "The ground should be fine, and we'll see if he's good enough or not. I think he has improved from the way he has been working--all the signs are positive. He's a straightforward horse, and I don't think he will show any inexperience. At Kempton, he showed a good turn of foot and travelled really well, so hopefully, he'll be fine."

Those apparently unfavored by a wide draw include ☆ **"TDN Rising Star" ☆ Lope de Vega (Ire)** (Shamardal), who sports the colors of Gestut Ammerland and represents Andre Fabre, bidding for his fifth win in this Classic. He was beaten a half length and a short head by His Highness The Aga Khan's pair **Rajsaman (Fr)** (Linamix {Fr}) and **Siyouni (Fr)** (Pivotal {GB}) when third in the main trial at this venue, the Apr. 25 G3 Prix de Fontainebleau.

Khalid Abdullah's **Special Duty (GB)** (Hennessy) will bid for a rare Classic double after connections gave the green light yesterday, and she will exit from stall 10 on the wide outside. Last year's G1 Cheveley Park S. winner, who was recently awarded the G1 1000 Guineas on the demotion of Jacqueline Quest (Ire) (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}), was reported ready for the test by trainer Criquette Head-Maarek, who is looking for a sixth edition. She pulled off the 1000 Poulisches double with Ravinella (Mr. Prospector) in 1988. "I did the Guineas double with Ravinella and they are quite similar, both honest horses of small size with a big heart and are big fighters," Head-Maarek told *PA Sport*. "This filly showed plenty of battling qualities at Newmarket, and I hope she can do so again. She's fine, she looks well and she looks fresh. She seems to have taken the race at Newmarket very well. We are drawn 10 out of 10 on Sunday. That's not the best draw, because the mile start at Longchamp is very close to the turn. That won't be an excuse. If she's well enough, she has a good chance."

Juddmonte will also be represented by the Andre Fabre-trained **Full Steam (GB)** (Oasis Dream {GB}), who took a conditions event over a mile at Chantilly last time Apr. 27, and will bid to provide her trainer with a third renewal. The operation's **Deluxe** (Storm Cat), a daughter of the great Hasili (Ire) (Kahyasi {Ire}), was scratched and will head to the same venue's G1 Prix Saint-Alary a week later.

**Paco Boy** faces a straightforward task here, and a reproduction of his latest impressive 3 1/4-length success in the Apr. 24 G2 Sandown Mile should be enough to banish the memory of his flop 12 months ago. Sent off the 11-8 favorite in the latest renewal of this race, he was only fourth, but had reportedly suffered a last-minute setback. His previous track form is red-hot, with three wins from three starts at this venue culminating in the G2 Hungerford S. in August 2008. After that breakthrough moment, he annexed that season's G1 Prix de la Foret and last year's G1 Queen Anne S.

"Paco Boy has been a real star for us, and I honestly think that he is better than ever this season," trainer Richard Hannon commented. "Forget last year's Lockinge. He started favourite and finished a disappointing fourth behind Virtual. However, we were not happy with him on the morning of the race and were in two minds whether to run. He did not fire as he can, but he came back with an infected hoof, and it must have affected his performance. This time around, everything has gone smoothly, and he deserves to be a hot favourite." **"TDN Rising Star" Zacinto** is closely linked with the favorite on a line through Rip Van Winkle (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}), who had beaten Paco Boy in the G1 Sussex S. at Goodwood in July. Ballydoyle's star was only 1 1/4 lengths in front of Khalid Abdullah's homebred Zacinto in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot in September, but, after a disappointing effort in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile, Zacinto has questions to answer in his seasonal bow. Last year's G3 Jersey S. winner **Ouqba** returns for the first time since finishing runner-up after a troubled trip in the seven-furlong G2 Challenge S. at Newmarket on Champions' Day. "He's a smashing little horse and, while I'm not saying he'll be good enough to beat Paco Boy, I think he's been underestimated a bit," said Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's Racing Manager Angus Gold. "He was unlucky to be beaten at Newmarket, and [trainer] Barry [Hills] has been thrilled with him all spring."

## Letters TO THE EDITOR

The following statement was submitted for publication in the *TDN* by the Executive Board of the Kentucky Association of Equine Practitioners:

"Two Summit Meetings between Equine Industry leaders and the AAEP Public Sale and Auction Task Force were held in July and October of 2009 to discuss the use of radiographic reports and on-site medications at public auctions. Following these meetings, the KAEP hosted a panel discussion of veterinary leaders to discuss the use of radiographic reports at public auction. The members of the KAEP voted unanimously to approve a position against the use of radiographic reports on the sales grounds. The KAEP position statement has been distributed to key industry groups: Keeneland, Faisg-Tipton, the Consignors and Breeders Association, the Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association and the Kentucky Thoroughbred Association. The main objective is to improve the integrity of the sales process by promoting proper use of the repository and the veterinary resources available to those parties buying and selling horses at public auction. The statement is being released now to allow adequate time for discussion and to inform and educate buyers prior to the busy sale season."

### USE OF RADIOGRAPHIC REPORTS FROM VETERINARIANS AT PUBLIC AUCTIONS OF HORSES *Statement from the Kentucky Association of Equine Practitioners, Mar. 16, 2010*

The KAEP would like to commend and support the work done over the past year by the AAEP Public Sale and Auction Task Force with regards to the use of radiographic reports at public auction. Through careful and thorough deliberation and discussion, the AAEP Public Sale and Auction Task Force generated the Guidelines For Purchase Examinations at Public Auction ([http://www.aaep.org/purchase\\_exams.htm](http://www.aaep.org/purchase_exams.htm)). These guidelines consist of six key points to consider when examining horses for both the buyer and seller at public auction and were formally approved by the AAEP Executive Board in 2009.

The KAEP would like to state that we are in agreement with and support the AAEP's Guidelines for Purchase Examinations at Public Auction.

The KAEP recommends all parties involved with the sale of horses at public auctions work to improve the integrity of the business for current and prospective buyers of horses.

The KAEP will begin this process in three ways:

- 1) A Position Statement will be issued from the Kentucky Association of Equine Practitioners on the use of radiographic reports at public auctions. The KAEP strongly believes the use of veterinary radiographic reports by the seller as a marketing tool is a detrimental practice. Radiographic reports are a required component of a patient's medical record. The KAEP recommends the use of these reports at Public Auctions be discontinued immediately. These reports create a natural conflict of interest between the veterinarian and the seller, are easily misinterpreted, are easily manipulated, and are not created to be and should not be used as a marketing tool.
- 2) The KAEP recommends prospective buyers establish a Veterinary-client-patient-relationship with a knowledgeable veterinarian when evaluating horses endoscopically or radiographically. A veterinarian retained to represent the buyer can consider the buyer's personal goals and level of risk when evaluating horses endoscopically or radiographically.
- 3) The KAEP will make available to all members client education materials that can be posted and distributed at public auctions. The brochures will inform the prospective buyers of the risk of third-party radiographic reports, stress the importance of a veterinary-client-patient-relationship and direct buyers to seek advice from licensed veterinarians.

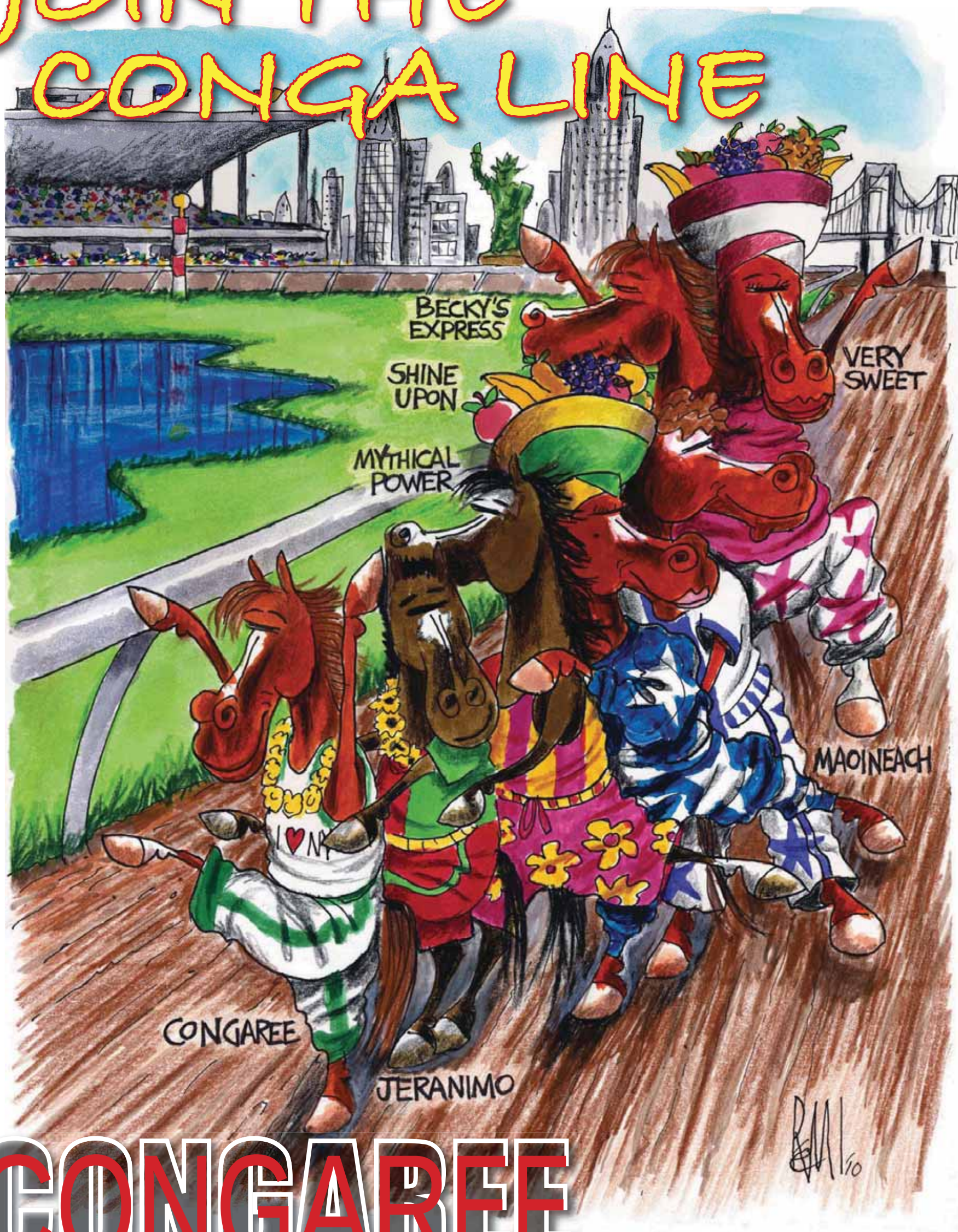
