PASSAGE TO GLORY

Dr. Ronan Lambe's **Rite of Passage (GB)** (Giant's Causeway), better known as a hurdler of high merit, called on his experience in that sphere to outlast **Age of Aquarius (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) in yesterday's pulsating renewal of the G1 Gold Cup at Royal Ascot. With only

two runs on the flat under his belt culminating in an eight-length success in the Leopardstown November H., the Dermot Weld-trained chestnut was mainly ignored at 20-1 coming off a break since finishing third over hurdles at the famed Cheltenham National Hunt Festival in

March. Always traveling easily close to the early pace, he was moved up by Pat Smullen to take on Age of Aquarius as Johnny Murtagh sent that rival to the front with a half mile remaining. Rite of Passage edged ahead at the furlong marker, stayed committed all the way to the line and had a neck advantage over the game runner-up at the end, shaving over a second of the previous track record in the process. **Cont. p2**

THE ENDURING QUEST

Jacqueline Quest (Ire) (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}), Denied a Classic victory by the Newmarket stewards after finishing first past the post in the G1 1000 Guineas May 2, could write another chapter in the remarkable story of owner Noel Martin today in the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot. Her nose defeat of Special Duty (GB) (Hennessy) at Newmarket represented a huge improvement on her previous seventh in the G3 Nell Gwyn S. at that track Apr. 14, and trainer Henry Cecil--who also saddles the May 14 Listed Michael Seely Memorial S. winner **Chachamaidee (Ire)** (Footstepsinthesand {GB})--thinks there is a lot more to come. "I wasn't very happy with running Jacqueline Quest in the Guineas, as I didn't really have her at her best, so she did very well considering," Cecil explained. "I had been very easy with her, because I was trying to get her to settle and relax, so I needed more time. I was delighted with the way she ran, and [the stewards' decision] was just one of those things. I think she has improved, and is going there with a chance." Cecil added, "It has taken a long time to get Chachamaidee right after she got highly strung and unsettled at two, and she has blossomed since York. They have both done very well, and are coming to themselves." **Cont. p7**

Rite of Passage started late in this discipline, but by the time he scored at first asking at Ballinrobe in September, he had already cut a dash in National Hunt flat races, and had been third in the Cheltenham Festival's Champion Bumper. Following his rout of overmatched rivals in the November H., the chestnut's attentions were switched back to the jumps, and he started favorite for the Neptune Investment Management Novices' Hurdle back at Cheltenham last time Mar. 17. The joker in the pack here, he settled in third while sticking close to Age of Aquarius. The pair entered the straight with Purple Moon on their heels, and it was soon clear that they had it between them. Despite Johnny Murtagh getting a tune out of Ballydoyle's latest high-class stayer, it was Rite of Passage who had that ounce more strength as the duo ensured the time dipped well under the previous best.

"I've always believed in this horse and that he had the potential to win a Gold Cup since I bought him as a yearling," trainer Dermot Weld said. "His great-granddam is Dahlia, who was very famous around this particular racetrack, and I thought if he inherited any of her genes, he would do me."

Among Dahlia's glittering array of international trophies were two victories in the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. "He took time and was a big, weak and immature horse who was very slow to mature, but he's gone from strength to strength since starting as a four-year-old," Weld continued. "When he won the November H. on heavy ground, this became his target. He's a beautiful-moving horse and a tremendous individual—he's such an athlete and an active horse, and I always believed he'd handle this faster ground. He's won twice on the flat, but also won two bumpers, including at Galway two years ago on firm ground."

Weld added of the Gold Cup, "It's a race I've always wanted to win and had been second with Vinnie Roe (Ire) and Vintage Crop (Ire), so it's third-time lucky."

As for Rite of Passage's next target," Weld offered, "A lot will depend on what handicap mark he gets for the G1 Melbourne Cup, and I have Profound Beauty (Ire) [Danehill] as a distinct possibility for that after she defeated Age of Aquarius two weeks ago. He'll have a summer break now, and come back for the G1 Irish St Leger [at The Curragh Sept. 11]." Weld is currently the subject of a new film about the campaigning of Vintage Crop in the Melbourne Cup.

Coming of Age...

Age of Aquarius's co-owner Derrick Smith told *PA Sport*, "We couldn't be more happy with him. He ran very respectably—I thought he was going to get swamped a furlong out, but he kept going and stayed every yard. He was beaten by a better horse on the day. You have to be delighted, although you are obviously disappointed to only just get beaten." As for third-place finisher Purple Moon, trainer Luca Cumani is looking at the July 29 G2 Goodwood Cup and G2 Lonsdale Cup at York Aug. 18, as well as a possible return to Flemington for the G1 Melbourne Cup. The chestnut gelding was runner-up by a half-length to Efficient (NZ) (Zabeel {NZ}) three years ago.

Approve was off the mark over five furlongs at Salisbury May 20 before stepping up a panel to finish fourth in the Listed Woodcote S. over Epsom's fast circuit 12 days ago. With that experience of battle in his favor, the bay was a model of professionalism here. He broke sharply and raced prominently, then rolled to the front with 150 yards remaining and drew clear of Reckless Reward, as well as the lone stands-side runner Excel Bolt. "He was drawn on the outside at Epsom and had to drop in, because I didn't want him on the outside learning nothing, so it probably cost him the race," trainer William Haggas explained. "He finished well there and, although we weren't in the first three, we weren't disappointed. I was cursing myself this morning, because I thought we should have run in the Listed Windsor Castle S., but fortunately we've been all right." Unsold when sent through the ring at Tattersalls October in 2008, the colt was secured soon after the sale by Highclere director and bloodstock advisor, John Warren. "He was a made horse," said Highclere Managing Director Harry Herbert. "He was a very attractive, precocious colt who was just ready to roll," recalled Herbert. "He was very much like his sire, Oasis Dream." In regard to the colt's sire, Herbert added, "This is the first one we've ever had by that sire. His offspring are very hard to buy because they're so expensive! We were very lucky to get him for that price."

Hibaayeb hit the board in her first two starts at Newmarket and Folkestone, and stepped out of maiden company to run second in the Sept. 11 G2 May Hill S. at Doncaster. She closed her juvenile campaign for previous trainer Clive Brittain with an auspicious victory in the Sept. 26 G1 Fillies' Mile at this track, then made the winter transfer into the care of Godolphin. Disappointing when only 16th of 17 in the G1 1000 Guineas back at Newmarket on seasonal return May 2, the bay filly regained her form to run third in the G1 Prix Saint Alary at Longchamp last time May 23, and continued back up the ladder with a dominant success here.

Hibaayeb raced under cover in midfield after an even break. Making steady headway into fourth turning for home, she quicked to the front approaching the final eighth and was ridden clear to score with a degree of comfort. She led home an exacta for her sire (by In the Wing {GB}), who has been suffering from fertility problems. "Hibaayeb was really disappointing in the Guineas where she didn't run a yard, and we were a little bit surprised by that," explained Racing Manager Simon Crisford. "She ran really well to finish third in the Prix Saint-Alary. We could have easily gone for the [G1 Epsom] Oaks after that, but we felt that race would be tough enough coming so quickly after France. Sheikh Mohammed decided to wait for Royal Ascot, as he felt we had a better chance in this, rather than in the Oaks. Now we'll try our luck in the [G1] Irish Oaks [at The Curragh July 18]."

He had to work harder here, but had his nose in front where it mattered to provide trainer Luca Cumani with his first Royal winner since 1997, and rider Kieren Fallon with a first in a barren four-year spell on the sidelines. Keen early, the

homebred eventually settled behind the leaders, and worked his way past The Queen's Quadrille on the front end with a furlong remaining. Made to dig deep by that rival in a thrilling touch-and-go drive to the line, Afsare was determined, and it was his final thrust that told.

It was the first time that last year's G2 Lowther S. and G3 Princess Margaret S. winner and G1 Cheveley Park S. runner-up had proven she stays this far, and she spearheads a strong dual representation of Jaber Abdullah here alongside the G2 Rockfel S. and G3 Nell Gwyn victress **Music Show**, who was a latest third in the Irish Guineas. "It's not ideal to run both fillies against each other, but they both deserve their place in the race, and there aren't many other alternatives for them," Racing Manager Bruce Raymond told *PA Sport*. "They are both in good form, and both had excuses for their last runs. Lady of the Desert was hampered several times in France, so I'm hoping she can improve on that, and I'm sure she can. Music Show was only beaten a neck and a head at the Curragh, and we think she is the kind of filly that will improve for each race that she's had."

One place ahead of Music Show at The Curragh was the G3 Prix de la Grotte winner **Anna Salai**. "Anna Salai was unlucky to get beaten on the line at the Curragh, but she has come out of that race in good form and I have been pleased with her preparation," said trainer Mahmood Al Zarooni. "I am looking forward to seeing how Frankie Dettori gets on with her, and she should go close."

Aidan O'Brien saddles the 100-1 G1 Epsom Derby runner-up **At First Sight**, who bids to defy a quick turnaround and prove his blue riband run was no fluke. "He seems to be in good form," O'Brien said. "We always thought he was a strong group-class horse, and he set a nice pace at Epsom and quickened up really well. It was his first run over a mile and a half, and he caught everybody by surprise by getting away from them there." **Bullet Train**, who was closest to At First Sight at Tattenham Corner before fading out of contention, was one of the race's biggest disappointments, having looked a progressive colt when winning the May 8 G3 Lingfield Derby Trial. Henry Cecil, who has already shown this week that he can get an Epsom flop back to top form in Timepiece (GB) (Zamindar), is hoping the fellow Juddmonte-bred can follow that example and register an eighth renewal for the stable. "I have no explanation for his Epsom run—he just didn't really handle the hill at all there and has come back very well, so you wouldn't think he'd had a race," Cecil said.

Godolphin's **Buzzword** completes the Epsom trio, and has another go at this trip following a non-threatening eighth 13 days ago. "Buzzword has run with credit at all of the major meetings throughout his career, and deserves to take his chance at Royal Ascot," trainer Mahmood Al Zarooni commented. "I thought that he stayed the mile and a half of the Derby, but came up against some very tough opposition. He is a very tough and consistent horse, and the step back to Group 2 company should help him. He goes into the race with a good chance."

ASCOT ON WORKFORCE AGENDA Connections of ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ **Workforce (GB)** (King's Best) gave their clearest indication yet that Ascot's G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. is a firm target when discussing Khalid Abdullah's brilliant G1 Epsom Derby winner yesterday. While the G1 Irish Derby at The Curragh June 27 remains an option for the Sir Michael Stoute-trained colt, Ascot's July 24 feature will take precedence in the decision-making process. "He had a loosener on his own yesterday morning--it wasn't a fact-finding mission--and he'll probably work again on Saturday, and then hopefully he'll mention to Sir Michael what he wants to do," Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe said. "He can either do the Irish Derby and the King George, or go straight to the King George. The Irish Derby is a natural stepping-stone, but, in this particular instance, the King George has always been seen as a very important race by Prince Khalid, and that will be uppermost in considerations."

TWICE HAS ECLIPSE AIM Khalid Abdullah's **Twice Over (GB)** (Observatory) looks set to contest the G1 Eclipse July 3, the owner/breeder's Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe announced yesterday. Beaten a half-length by fellow Juddmonte runner Byword (GB) (Peintre Celebre) in Wednesday's G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot, the Henry Cecil-trained five-year-old is unlikely to renew rivalry with his Andre Fabre-trained conqueror at Sandown. "It is more likely that Twice Over will go for the Eclipse than Byword," Grimthorpe said. "We have various options for Byword, and it's a question of seeing how he is. We will talk to Andre [Fabre] about a plan and see if he is a possible Arc horse, but we may have Workforce (GB) going that way. A race like the G1 Juddmonte International [at York Aug. 17] is pretty important on both horses' calendar."

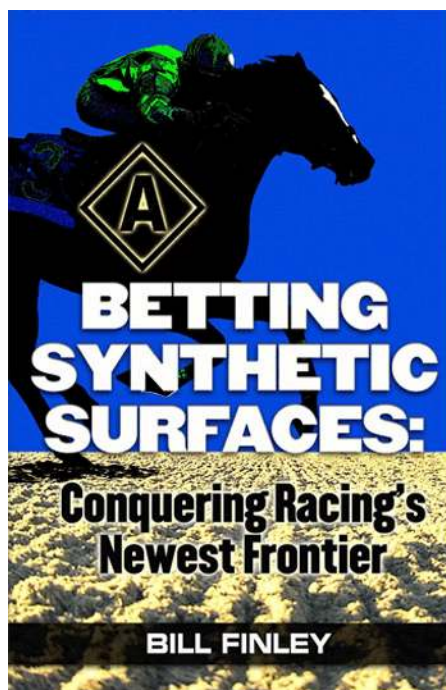
