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HAPPY BIRTHDAY, MR. PLETCHER

Todd Pletcher didn't need any candles on his birthday cake yesterday, with **Devil May Care** (Malibu Moon) bringing home the GI Mother Goose S. trophy for the formidable barn. It was the first outing for the Glencrest

Farm colorbearer since finishing 10th in the GI Kentucky Derby May 1. "It was a big race from her, and I've always felt she was the best filly in her generation," said Pletcher, who was celebrating his 43rd birthday. "She had shown us every sign [after the Kentucky Derby] that she was as good as she had ever been. She trained brilliantly, like she always

does. Aside from losing a little bit of weight in the Derby like most horses, colts or fillies, will do, she came out of it really well. It was just a matter of making sure we gave her the proper time." Positioned ominously from the start, the distinctively marked bay assumed command at the top of the stretch and maintained her advantage over **Connie and Michael** (Roman Ruler) and **Biofuel** (Stormin Fever) in the final furlong. her resume warranted when battling to a 1 1/4-length defeat of **Flying Cloud (Ire)** (Storming Home {GB}) in the G1 Audi Pretty Polly S. at The Curragh yesterday. Last seen finishing third in the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup here May 23, the grey, sent off at 4-1, tracked the trailblazing **Akdarena (GB)**

(Hernando {Fr}). After wearing down that rival passing the quarter pole, she clung on gamely as Godolphin's raider stayed on to gain second. "It's absolutely amazing, as we were running out of time, with her being in foal," jockey Pat Smullen said. "She's been knocking on the door in Group 1 company from the beginning of her career, so it would have been criminal for her to finish without one." Cont. p3

STORMING THE FORT

Aidan O'Brien has had the G1 Irish Derby locked up, winning seven renewals--including the last four--so it may be significant that connections of **Monterosso (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}) have supplemented their highly progressive colt to tackle the Ballydoyle defence in today's Dubai Duty Free-sponsored renewal at The Curragh. Contesting handicaps until his hike in class for the G2 King Edward VII S., Sheikh Hamdan bin Mohammed Al Maktoum's son of the top-class mare **Porto Roca (Aus)** (Barathea {Ire}) dismissed rivals at Royal Ascot just nine days ago to earn this tilt. No winner of that race has followed up here since **Shareef Dancer** in 1983, but trainer Mark Johnston is confident that the bold move will be justified. "It was very hard to imagine when we were thinking about supplementing him for the King Edward that we would be supplementing for the Irish Derby a few days later, but it would seem crazy not to run him now," Johnston commented. "He didn't have a hard race at Royal Ascot--horses don't usually come out of those races so well as this horse did--and he lost a normal amount of weight, which he has put on again very quickly. We've only had him since September last year, and he was a very green horse who has come on leaps and bounds with every run. He looks a picture, and I'm looking forward to a bit of improvement again." Cont. p4-5

Devil May Care defeated Katy Now (Tiznow) by 4 3/4 lengths when unveiled on the GI Travers S. undercard at Saratoga, then added a hard-fought success in the GI Frizette S. going a mile around this sweeping turn Oct. 10. Freshened up after a disappointing 11th in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies on the Santa Anita synthetic Nov. 6, she was 4-5 in her season opener, the GIII Silverbulletday S. at Fair Grounds Feb. 20, but lost her cool and wound up fifth. She bounced back to take the GII Bonnie Miss S. at Gulfstream Mar. 20 before heading to Kentucky, and the decision to take on the boys in the "Run for the Roses" became much easier after stablemate Eskendereya (Giant's Causeway) was ruled out of the big dance. Devil May Care went postward at 10-1 and looked to be in with a solid chance at the top of the stretch before flattening out to split the field in 10th. The odds-on choice settled on the outside in third as Katy Now led from Connie and Michael through a :45.59 opening half, and Biofuel, who broke a bit tardily, brought up the rear. Jockey John Velazquez had the favorite in perfect striking po-

sition after six panels in 1:09.92 and, utilizing a vigorous hand ride combined with a couple of cracks of the whip, kept her busy while fending off Biofuel on the outside and a resurgent Connie and Michael from the inside. "She broke a little sharp today, a little close to the pace," Velazquez reported. "I didn't want to be that close to the pace, but, with blinkers on, she was very aggressive. I had to play with her down the backstretch, give and take a little bit. Down the lane, I let her do her thing, she took the lead, and it was good enough today." Devil May Care will head upstate next for the GI Betfair TVG Coaching Club American Oaks July 31 and GI Betfair TVG Alabama S. Aug. 21.

Chinese White recorded her first pattern-race success in this venue's G3 Dance Design S. last summer, and followed up in the G2 Blandford S. in September. Only 10th in the G1 Premio Lydia Tesio at the Capannelle in October, she returned to annex a second renewal of the Victor McCalmont Memorial H. at Gowran May 2 before finishing third behind Fame and Glory (GB) (Montjeu {Ire}) in the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup three weeks later. Kept close to the strong pace set by Akdarena and Kevin Manning, she was niggled at before the final turn to stay with the demanding tempo as Frankie Dettori moved Flying Cloud closer. When it came to a war of attrition in the final quarter, however, it was Chinese White who had the answer for the game pacesetter three-year-old, who was denied the runner's-up spot by Flying Cloud on the line. "I said to the boss beforehand, 'I'm not going to let Kevin [Manning] get away,'" jockey Pat Smullen said. "He set a very good pace on a filly that stays well, and when I got past her she rallied again, but thankfully I had the best horse." Trainer Dermot Weld added, "This is a very special moment and I am thrilled to have trained a first Group 1 winner for Lady O'Reilly, and also that Chinese White is the mare to do it." Trainer Saeed bin Suroor said of the runner-up, "I was very happy with the performance of Flying Cloud. She might prefer the step up to a mile and a half, but we will see how she comes out of today before making any plans for her." Remember When (Daneshill Dancer {Ire}) was sent off the 7-4 favorite, but could never get on terms with the front trio and finished a further six lengths behind in fourth. 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Out of the Blue...

Among the Ballydoyle winners, one trend is significant, and that is the Epsom factor. All of O'Brien's last six winners had run in the blue riband, and the last four all failed to win there before coming to Kildare to triumph. Johnny Murtagh's pick **Cape Blanco (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) did not appear in the June 5 Classic, with connections favoring the following day's G1 Prix du Jockey-Club at Chantilly. **Jan Vermeer (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) was sent off the 9-4 favorite at Epsom following a smooth success 13 days earlier in this track's G3 Gallinule S., but could only finish a distant fourth, one place ahead of the May 9 G2 Derrinstown Stud Derby Trial scorer **Midas Touch (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}), and behind the shock runner-up **At First Sight (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}).

At First Sight has since filled fourth spot in the King Edward, leaving Aidan O'Brien scratching his head. "At Epsom, you could say that At First Sight got away and Jan Vermeer was a little bit on and off the bridle, which might have been greenness or lack of race-fitness," O'Brien said. "He was just ready to start off at The Curragh two weeks before, and the original plan had been to go to France for an easier mile and a quarter rather than a grueling mile and a half at Epsom, so in hindsight, if we could go back, we might have stuck with that." O'Brien added, "He probably didn't get enough time from the Gallinule to Epsom to make the improvement fitness-wise that we would have liked, but he's been in good form since." **Cont. p5**

O'Brien added, "Midas Touch is in good form, and he was maybe not as close to the pacemaker as Colm [O'Donoghue] would have liked at Epsom. The Curragh is always the ultimate test, because it's probably the fairest track and you usually get an even gallop, which takes all the hard-luck stories out of it. Epsom can be very tactical sometimes and you can get different results, with some horses acting better than others."

Spoiling for a Fight...

Jim Bolger, who took this with St Jovite in 1992, saddles a duo that on recent evidence are not lacking in fight. Kevin Manning has opted for Ennistown Stud and Jackie Bolger's **Puncher Clynych (Ire)** (Azamour {Ire}), battling hero of the Apr. 18 G3 Ballysax S. at Leopardstown, over the June 4 Listed Silver S. scorer **Carraiglawn (Ire)** (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}), who bids to provide Davy Moran with a first Classic win. "Puncher Clynych is a very competitive horse who doesn't give up easily, so I'm sure he'll give a good account of himself while Carraiglawn could be a four-year-old before we see the best from him," their trainer said. "I think the pattern with Rock of Gibaltars is that they are later-maturers than he was himself." Michael Bell is hoping that ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ **Coordinated Cut (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) can step up from his Derby seventh on this galloping track. "As usual, Aidan O'Brien trains the majority of the field, but it would be great to see this horse take his chance in a Group 1 again," Bell remarked. "I think he was slightly unlucky in our Derby and was running on nicely at the end." Godolphin, who collected this with the filly Balanchine (Storm Bird) in 1994, rely on the Apr. 23 G3 Sandown Classic Trial winner **Chabal (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}). The colt needs to rebound from a fourth in the G2 Dante S. at York May 13. "We'll see how the ground is on Sunday morning, but he didn't like the fast ground last time," trainer Saeed bin Suroor commented. "He is stronger now and has worked really nicely, so if it's safe we'll run."

The highlight of the card was the Classic victory by **Lingote de Oro (Arg)** (Orpen), but just a neck behind were the larger-than-life farewell appearance by **El Garufa (Arg)** (Luhuk) in the Mile and the deja vu effort of **Ollagua (Arg)** (Pure Prize) in the Distaff. Lingote de Oro confirmed that, undoubtedly, he is the best stayer over sand in the country, shaking off a bad start to beat former Horse of the Year **Life of Victory (Arg)** (Incurable Optimist) by 1 1/2 lengths. El Garufa, who said good bye with another incredible victory over previously undefeated **Shangai Express (Arg)** (Vision and Verse), will now enter stud at Haras La Numancia.

Runner-up in the G1 GP Estrellas Juvenile two years ago and eighth in the G1 GP Estrellas Classic when it was contested on the turf at San Isidro in 2009, Lingote de Oro finally earned his first win in Argentina's Breeders' Cup with this decisive score. The four-year-old had been perfect in his last six starts over this track, taking the Feb. 12 Clasico Haras Argentinos, Apr. 10 G1 Gran Premio Copa de Honor and May 1 G1 Gran Premio Republica Argentina. Favored to make it seven straight at Palermo, he rated in the clear while midpack early. Lingote de Oro edged closer on the turn, burst from the crowd when they hit the stretch and set sail for home. 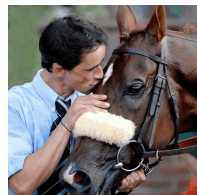

Welfare and Safety of the Racehorse Summit

By Maryjean Wall

The first analysis of equine injury data collected from 86 racetracks in North America is expected to highlight the third Welfare and Safety of the Racehorse Summit, set for Monday and Tuesday at Keeneland. The report is highly anticipated in the industry, and, "To date, it's the most comprehensive analysis," said Ed Bowen, president of the Grayson-Jockey Club Research Foundation. The Equine Injury Database, in charge of collecting

the data, was an initiative of a previous Racehorse Summit, and is expected to play a wide-ranging role in revealing variables that might contribute to on-track equine fatalities. Dr. Tim Parkin, a veterinarian and epidemiologist at the University of Glasgow, will be joined by Dr. Mary Scollay, equine medical director for the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission, in presenting the report. Parkin is overseeing statistical analysis of data, a compilation of information representing 86 percent of flat racing days in North America. Scollay is a consultant, and has been a key collaborator from before the database was launched. "It is such a rich field of information," said Bowen. "It is raw material that has

never been compiled before. We want to be open-minded on how it might be used." The Equine Injury Database presentation will begin at 11 a.m. Monday and run through 12:15 p.m. Among other industry "hot topics" will be the panel discussion at 9 a.m. on racetrack surfaces. "We're not looking for ways to tell racetracks how to spend another \$1 million," said Bowen, in light of the multi-million dollar conversions to synthetic surfaces. "We're just looking at small things we can do to make things safer." The Racing Surfaces Testing Laboratory was another initiative that grew out of a previous Welfare and Safety of the Racehorse Summit. In addition, an update on the Racing Medication and Testing Consortium is scheduled for 10:15 a.m. Monday. The summit is a two-day workshop for exploring ways to enhance the safety and soundness of Thoroughbred racehorses. Underwriting the summit will be The Jockey Club and Grayson-Jockey Club Research Foundation. For the first time, Keeneland will provide live video streaming of summit sessions at [keeneland.com](#). Monday's sessions begin at 8 a.m. and are open to spectators, as is one session on Tuesday. The summit will include 60 invited participants.
