Chinchon ventured to New York last July for the GI Man o' War S. and finished fourth, three lengths behind dual champion Gio Ponti (Tale of the Cat). He returned to France to finish second in the Listed Prix de Boulogne at Longchamp Sept. 6, and closed out 2009 victoriously in the G3 La Coupe de Maisons-Laffitte three weeks later. The Irish-bred annexed the G3 Prix Exbury in his seasonal opener at Saint-Cloud Mar. 20, but followed that with a sixth in the G1 Prix Ganay at Longchamp May 2 and, most recently, was beaten 1 3/4 lengths when fourth in the G2 Grand Prix de Chantilly June 6. Chinchon cabooseed the nine-horse field in the early stages as local hero Get Serious (City Zip) did his usual work on the front end, getting a half in :47.62 and six panels in 1:12.71.

Straight Story (Giant's Causeway) made a bold run at the pacesetter turning for home, but those two were quickly swallowed up by the closers. Though Take the Points looked to be on his way to victory in deep stretch, Chinchon, rallying boldly up the center of the course, moved right by in the final strides. Winchester rallied belatedly to steal third from Straight Story. "He was very unlucky in his last race," trainer Carlos Laffon-Parias explained. "He raced along the rail and it never opened. Today, I was pretty nervous halfway through the race with how slow the early pace was because I knew it would be tough for him to close. This horse doesn't care about the type of ground he's running on, he just runs. He doesn't like to be in between horses, though." The conditioner added, "After today, we'll keep the Breeders' Cup in mind. We'll watch the Man o' War next week to see how Gio Ponti does as well. But we will definitely keep the race in mind. It has been a long and winding road for Twice Over from his unbeaten juvenile campaign to here, with talk of the Classics proving just that after connections opted to take a different route in the spring and summer of 2008. Emerging from his sophomore campaign with wins in the G2 Prix Eugene Adam at Maisons-Laffitte in July and G3 Craven S. in April, the homebred was also runner-up to New Approach (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in the G1 Champion S., and it was not until the 2009 renewal of the latter contest that he broke through at this level. He followed with a third in the G1 Breeders' Cup Classic on Santa Anita's Pro-Ride in November, then disappointed when down the field in the Mar. 27 G1 Dubai World Cup at Meydan. After a troubled trip in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot June 16, he was closing hand over fist at the finish before failing by a half-length to get to Byword (GB) (Peintre Celebre). His task was made slightly easier here by the refusal of Champion S. runner-up Mawatheeque (Danzig) to load, and he was ridden from the gates to join Dar Re Mi (Singspiel {Ire}) on the front end. After shrugging off Dar Re Mi in early stretch, he had enough left in the tank to put him beyond reach of the staying-on Sri Putra and Viscount Nelson. "Tom [Queally] and I decided this morning that if there was no pace, we didn't want to mess around getting involved in a two-furlong sprint," commented trainer Henry Cecil, who was recording a fourth renewal, but first in 32 years.

"He rode a brilliant race, as he got the field beaten when Twice Over lengthened two out, and the writing was on the wall then. In the end, he was in front too long and was looking around at everything and getting a bit lazy--it's a stiff uphill finish. I think he was unlucky last time, as he never got a run at all and made up a lot of ground. He is a gentleman to train and a friend to me, and he may have a campaign geared around the Dubai World Cup or Breeders' Cup and there is also the G1 Champion S. [at Newmarket Oct. 16]. The Prince would love to win his own race, the G1 Juddmonte International [at York Aug. 17], so he's in all those races." Sri Putra's conditioner Michael Jarvis was delighted with the effort of the runner-up. "He finished in front of Byword last season and his best form is very good," Jarvis told *PA Sport*. "The way he ran today suggests to me he should step up to a mile and a half, either that or a galloping mile and a quarter again, and we might think of going abroad again." Aidan O'Brien added of Viscount Nelson, "We're delighted with that. He's moving up all the time--every time he runs he gets better and, hopefully, that will continue." The winner's dam has a two-year-old colt by Intikhab named Serious Breach (GB), as well as a yearling full-brother to the Eclipse hero. Haynesfield came into the 2009 GIII Gotham S. sporting a four-race winning streak, but that ended when he finished a well-beaten eighth in I Want Revenge's coming-out party. The chestnut returned to action seven months later and finished a head short in the Sir Keys S. for New York-breds at Belmont Oct. 2, but it's been nothing but the winner's circle since. He paired up wins in the Empire Classic Oct. 24 over this track and trip and the GIII Discovery H. at Aqueduct Nov. 21 before getting the winter off. The Turtle Bird Stable flagbearer kicked off 2010 with a state-bred optional claiming success going a flat mile at Big Sandy June 13, and was the third choice in the wagering here. The Suburban's complexion changed the second the gates flew open when Pictural (El Prado {Ire}), an intended rabbit for I Want Revenge, stumbled, allowing Regal Ransom to set a solid pace, with Haynesfield sitting in second. I Want Revenge made a big move on the turn, but the race-fit Haynesfield shrugged off that bid and was never seriously threatened in the final furlong. Convocation showed a good turn of foot to complete the exacta. "Ramon [Dominguez] did a great job," said Toby Sheets, assistant to winning trainer Steve Asmussen. "When he took the lead at the three-eighths pole, Ramon was just sitting on him. He did it the right way. We'll see how he comes out of it and go from there."

As for I Want Revenge, trainer Rick Dutrow Jr. offered, "The race was never about Pictural. Our horse ran well--it looks like he needed a race. [Jockey Joe Talamo] said he got a little tired. I thought he ran big. We'll see what happens next time."

Indy) is a full-brother to the 2009 hero, while **Giant's Tomb** is a son of 1997 victor Awesome Again. The most lightly raced of the trio is **Dark Cloud Dancer** (Storm Cat), and some might say the colt is born to win this event.

He is out of 2001 heroine Dancethruthedawn (Mr. Prospector), a full-sister to 2000 Queen's Plate winner Scatter the Gold, and his second dam is Dance Smartly (Danzig), who collected this contest during her 1991 Canadian Horse of the Year campaign. Dark Cloud Dancer came from off the pace to graduate in his second start May 16, and steps up in class following a narrow defeat in an off-the-turf allowance June 6. "He's a nice horse," said trainer Mark Frostad. "He's probably got more talent than the other two [Hotep, Giant's Tomb]. He just doesn't have the seasoning, but he can overcome that easily enough if he gets the right trip."

Ladies First?

No fewer than 33 fillies have prevailed in the Queen's Plate, and **Roan Inish** (Elusive Quality) and **Moment of Majesty** (Saint Liam) will attempt to add their names to that list. Roan Inish finished with a flourish to deny her rival by a head in the Woodbine Oaks June 13. "She's done everything very professionally the whole way," said Carolyn Costigan, who conditions the filly for her father, Robert Costigan. "I couldn't ask her to do anything differently, so we're looking forward to the race. She's something special, and there's a lot of races she can go for in North America, north and south of the border."

Espoir City Hoping to Make Breeders' Cup Classic...

The connections of Japanese star **Espoir City (Jpn)** (Gold Allure {Jpn}) checked out Churchill Downs yesterday in advance of a tilt at the G1 Breeders' Cup Classic Nov. 6. Trainer Akio Adachi gave rider Tetsuzo Sato a leg up aboard an Akiko Gothard trained-horse, and the two took a spin under the Twin Spires. Espoir City has been unstoppable on dirt in his native land, winning 10 of 12 starts, including the G1 Japan Cup Dirt in December. "Tetsuzo started riding him in the morning and observed he was much better on dirt than on grass, so we made the switch," Adachi explained. "He is able to handle all situations and he adjusts to the race." The five-year-old is expected to tune up for the Breeders' Cup in the Mile Champion Nambu Hai Oct. 10--a race he won last year--before shipping to the U.S. two to three weeks before the big event. Espoir City is owned by Yushun Horse, and has bankrolled over \$5.8 million to date.

The celebrity chef was quick to give trainer Todd Pletcher credit for selecting the Clarendon S. winner at OBSMAR earlier this year, and also for picking the ambitious debut spot.

"When we were buying him I realized he was an Ontario-bred, but basically forgot about it," Flay revealed. "When Todd said he wanted to send him to Canada for this Ontario-bred race, then I was like, 'Oh yeah, that's right. I forgot, he's a Canadian-bred.'"

The chestnut trained forwardly at Saratoga for his unveiling, most recently firing a five-furlong bullet in 1:02 over the Oklahoma training track.

"The first time Todd said, 'I'm going to send the horse to Canada,' was about 10 days ago," Flay explained. "We never really discussed racing in Canada before that. He told me a couple of times that the horse had been training fairly well, and that he was encouraged. My feeling is that if Todd is going to send a horse to a stakes race first time out, he probably thinks that he's competitive."

Flay was impressed by Sensational Slam's will to win after threading the needle in the stretch.

"The thing that I like about the race was for a first-time starter, he got in between horses and he didn't pack it in," he said. "He was encouraged to keep going."

Flay continued, "Todd told me recently that he thought the horse was a little bit lazy in the morning, and that he needs to be reminded what he's doing. When you are able to remind him what's up, he obviously has talent. I was listening to Patrick Husbands in the post-race interview, and he said the same thing."

Flay added that he would leave it to Pletcher to decide where and when Sensational Slam shows up in the entries next. -SS
