Hours after Juddmonte's green-and-pink colors were carried to victory by Midday (GB) in the G1 Nassau S. (see below), **Proviso (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) notched another top-level success with a thrilling finish in the G1 Diana S. at Saratoga.

They were five abreast at the line, with Proviso edging Shared Account (Pleasantly Perfect)

by a head, and two-time defending champion Forever Together (Belong to Me) a nose further back in third. "To come back to Saratoga and win a Grade 1 is awesome," said winning rider Mike Smith. "It wasn't a big field, but it was an extremely talented field, and she got the job done. I knew it was going to be a tough race, and that no one was going to draw off and win it easily, because they were all too good." **Cont. p4**

HER DAY AGAIN

Khalid Abdullah's **Midday (GB)** (Oasis Dream {GB}), successful in Goodwood's G1 Nassau S. 12 months ago, had to survive a stewards' inquiry to win back-to-back renewals at the expense of **Stacelita (Fr)** (Monsun {Ger}). Sent off the 15-8 favorite, the homebred--last seen finishing runner-up in the G2 Middleton S. at York May 13--looked to have put the race to bed when swooping to the front before the quarter pole under Tom Queally. Idling and surrendering the lead from 150 yards out, the bay veered over to her French rival where a renewed rally saw her regain the advantage in the final 75 yards and register a 1 1/4-length success. The stewards looked into the winner's drift into Stacelita late on, but judged that there wasn't significant interference. **Cont. p3**

A LITTLE WARM JUST DANDY AT THE SPA

A Little Warm (Stormin Fever) and **Miner's Reserve** (Mineshaft) provided the exakta in a big-fig allowance at Delaware June 29, and they mirrored that finish for the Saratoga crowd in yesterday's GII Jim Dandy S. "I felt strongly he was going to run a terrific race, but I didn't know if that was going to be good enough to win," admitted winning trainer Tony Dutrow. "He ran the way we wanted him to run at Delaware last time, and my feeling was that he was not 100 percent for that race. When we came up here to Saratoga shortly after that race, he really went over the moon. He loved the racetrack. I told Johnny [Velazquez] to ride him with confidence." **Cont. p4-5**

SHORE THING

Monmouth's Elite Summer Meet has been a tremendous success this season, and the Oceanport oval will feature the richest Thoroughbred card in the history of the Garden State when the \$1-million GI IZOD Haskell Invitational is contested this afternoon as part of a \$2.552-million card. In a flashback to 1987, when the Haskell provided a showdown between Triple Crown heroes Alysheba and Bet Twice with the up-and-coming Lost Code, the race brings together a clash between the respective GI Kentucky Derby and GI Preakness S. winners **Super Saver** (Maria's Mon) and **Lookin At Lucky** (Smart Strike), as well as the highly regarded **Trappe Shot** (Tapit).

Lookin At Lucky returned to California after the Preakness, and will be looking to give trainer Bob Baffert a record fourth win in the nine-furlong affair. "His biggest problem in racing has been his draws--he's been the most poorly drawn horse I ever had," Baffert told *Daily Racing Form*. "At least he's managed to do really well. He's just a good horse. Sometimes he overcomes it, sometimes he doesn't. It makes it harder for him. He's doing great, that's the main thing." **Cont. p2**

Lookin At Lucky endured a nightmarish voyage after breaking from the rail as the 6-1 favorite in the Kentucky Derby, and wound up sixth behind **Super Saver** in his perfect trip. He turned the tables on that WinStar runner in the Preakness May 15 and, though he has the rail once more, has just seven rivals here, as opposed to

the 19 he faced in the slop at Churchill. Martin Garcia, who was aboard the ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ for the first time at Pimlico, is back in the irons. At the other end of the starting gate is **Trappe Shot**, who has earned 105 Beyer Speed Figures in each of his last two starts. In his most recent appearance, the chestnut handled two turns for the first time in the Long Branch S. over this strip July 10, and trainer Kiaran McLaughlin was pleased with the post. "I asked [jockey] Alan [Garcia] what he preferred, and he said, 'I just want to be outside of the speed,'" McLaughlin explained to *DRF*. "Being that we're all the way out is maybe not ideal, but that's where we need to be...so he can break and let a couple of them go."

Midday was runner-up to Sariska (GB) (Pivotal {GB}) in the Epsom Oaks last June before dropping to third behind that rival when sinking in The Curragh's testing ground in the Irish equivalent the following month. Gaining a deserved first top-level success at the expense of Rainbow View (Dynaformer) on ground again eased by heavy rain in this race, she was reportedly undercooked by Henry Cecil when only third in the G1 Prix de l'Opera de Longchamp on Arc day. Bouncing back with that experience under her belt to conquer the Breeders' Cup F/M Turf on lively ground in November, she failed to let herself down properly on similar ground again as she gamely chased home her arch-rival Sariska under a five-pound penalty in the Middleton. Overnight rain had taken any sting out of Goodwood's turf in time for her comeback and Tom Queally settled her in third initially behind habitual front-runner Barshiba (Ire) (Barathea {Ire}) and Stacelita and Christophe Soumillon.

Allowed to cut loose on the approach to the final quarter, she was past Stacelita so quickly she was able to cross over to the rail in front of her with the race apparently in safe keeping. The eventual runner-up's switch seemed to build new momentum, and with the Juddmonte filly looking for company, Stacelita looked to have the upper hand for the handful of yards it took for her rival to gather a new head of steam. Despite her errant passage late on, Midday was the decisive winner at the line, and the outcome of the televised enquiry was always a formality. "She jarred up at York and we've taken our time," trainer Henry Cecil commented. "She needs a little bit of give in the ground, as she is quite heavy in the shoulder and hasn't got the most perfect joints, so I've got to be careful with her." Cecil added, "The G1 Yorkshire Oaks [at York Aug. 19] was the alternative and, maybe, if she is well, she could still go for that if the ground is good. It was firm enough at the Breeders' Cup, and she pottered around afterwards. She is stronger than last year and, all being well, she could have a nice autumn campaign. She likes a strong pace, and today they went slow and she had to sprint and then thought she'd done enough. When the other came to her, she was going on again, and is very genuine and very tough. We were asking a lot of her today off that slow pace, and I'd like to see her over a mile and a half again at York, so hopefully we can run her there." Stacelita's trainer Jean-Claude Rouget told *PA Sport*, "It is always disappointing to be beaten, but when you are beaten by a better horse, there is really nothing to say. We started her very late to protect her for the summer and autumn, and now she could have two or maybe three more races. There is only three weeks to Deauville, and then I would like to run her in the G1 Prix de l'Opera on Arc day, but that is just three weeks before the Breeders' Cup. Her main objective is the Breeders' Cup, so, depending on how things pan out, she will either run two or three more times." Proviso has been almost unstoppable at age five. When brought to the U.S. last fall, the bay was disqualified from first in the GI Juddmonte Spinster S. at Keeneland, then ran fourth in the GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic at Santa Anita. She stayed on synthetics for GI Santa Monica H. Jan. 31 and settled for second in that seven-furlong affair. A return to the weeds was in order, and the homebred has ably justified that decision. After prevailing by a nose against the boys in the GI Frank E. Kilroe Mile H. at Santa Anita Mar. 6, she edged a solid group in the GI Just a Game S. at Belmont June 5, and was the second choice here. Proviso broke from the rail and secured a perfect ground-saving spot in third, but began to get a bit anxious on the backstretch as 18-1 Dynaslew (Dynaformer) put up a :49.41 half on the front end. Guided to the outside by Mike Smith, the five-year-old ranged up three wide to take the lead inside the final furlong, and had her picture taken for the third straight time. Winning trainer Bill Mott isn't sure where his charge will run next. "Whether we want to go beyond [1 1/8th miles], I don't know," he said. "She's run at a mile and a quarter before and been effective, but we'll have to sit down and decide whether we'll want to take the next step. We've won three Grade Is this year, so I suppose the heat is off. Hopefully the rest is just fun and gravy." Forever Together, who stumbled at the start, made a bold run between horses before getting caught on the line by Shared Account. A Little Warm, who woke up in a big way in his juvenile finale at Philly Park, kicked off his sophomore campaign with a win in Gulfstream's Spectacular Bid S. Jan. 9 before finishing an honorable second to D'Funnybone (D'wildcat) in the GII Hutcheson S. at that track Feb. 20. The bay was caught at the wire in the GII Louisiana Derby Mar. 27, and missed an engagement in the GI Preakness S. May 15. Trainer Tony Dutrow brought the colt back at Delaware June 29, and he shadowed Miner's Reserve in that allowance before surging by him late, earning a 105 Beyer Speed Figure in the process. This race featured saltier foes, but the finish was exactly the same. Miner's Reserve bounded out to lead through a spritely :46.80 opening half, with A Little Warm sitting just off of him. The latter drew even turning for home, and both colts separated themselves from the others, with A Little Warm edging away in the final strides. He will likely head next to the GI Travers S. Aug. 28. "Absolutely," said Dutrow. "If he comes out of this race great, count us in." Afleet Express, who appeared to be backpedaling on the far turn, came on again to finish third despite drifting in on Friend Or Foe (Friends Lake) and favored Fly Down (Mineshaft). Nick Zito had mixed emotions after saddling both Miner's Reserve and Fly Down. "Throw out that race, I guess," he reflected. "[Fly Down] just didn't fire. Jose [Lezcano] said he didn't give him what he usually gives him. Hopefully, he comes back well and we'll try to regroup for the next race. Miner's Reserve is a good horse. He ran well down in Delaware to [A Little Warm] in his last race. I'm happy for Miner's Reserve and sad for Fly Down. We'll just regroup and come back in the Travers, I hope." Dakota Phone hadn't had his picture taken since winning the Forty Niner H. at Golden Gate in November 2008, but launched a wide, late run that carried him to a last-gasp victory here. In the interim, the bay gelding hit the board in six graded stakes, including a third-place finish in the GI Santa Anita H. Mar. 6. Seventh in the GII Oaklawn H. Apr. 3 and fifth in the GII Mervyn LeRoy H. at Hollywood May 8, he finished third in the GIII Berkeley H. on the Golden Gate Tapeta on Memorial Day, and came into this contest off a half-length loss to MGISW The Usual Q.T. (Unusual Heat) in an allowance on the Hollywood lawn June 27. Content to caboose the field as Enriched led, Dakota Phone took the overland route on the far turn and kept coming with every stride to deny Battle of Hastings at the wire. "He picked a good time to win," quipped winning trainer and co-owner Jerry Hollendorfer. "We've had this horse a long time and made money, but he's done it the hard way. With this win, maybe we can look at the big race [GI Pacific Classic, Aug. 28]. This horse picked up his training here and he gave us confidence that he'd run a good race." 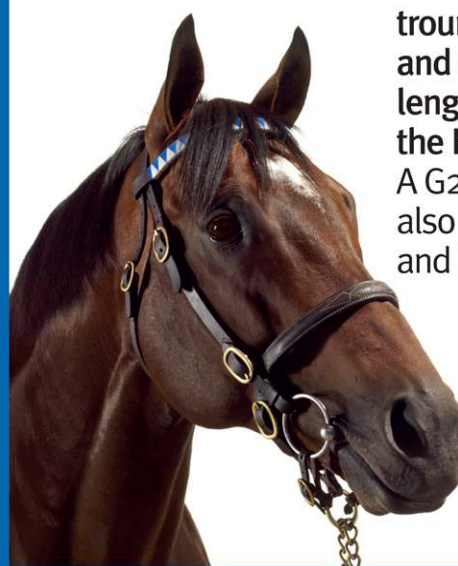

June 20, and will be trying conventional dirt for the first time in her career. "I think the biggest question mark coming in here is the surface, not her class," trainer Mark Casse told *Daily Racing Form*. "She has to prove she can run on dirt, but her breeding suggests she will, and I worked her over our training track at Woodbine, which is a regular dirt course, a couple of weeks ago and she went five-eighths in :58 and galloped out six furlongs in 1:11, so I'm not really concerned about her liking the dirt. Win, lose, or draw, I think this is the spot we should be in with her, and we're going to give it a try."

Cost of Freedom, who holds the track record here for six furlongs, closed out 2009 by finishing third by a head in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint at Santa Anita. The fragile seven-year-old is perfect in two appearances this year, taking a Hollywood optional claimer May 6 before defeating **E Z's Gentleman** and **My Summer Slew** in the GIII Los Angeles H. at the Inglewood oval June 5. E Z's Gentleman bounced back from the Los Angeles to capture the GI Triple Bend H. at Hollywood July 10, while **El Brujo**, a multiple graded winner on Polytrack in Kentucky, will be making his first start for Baffert and Zetcher. "I wasn't going to run E Z's Gentleman, but he worked well and he's doing well, so we might as well take a shot," Baffert told *DRF*. As for El Brujo, Baffert added, "I brought him home and freshened him up. He runs well on synthetic."

Get Stormy enjoyed a five-race winning streak that began with a pair of victories over this course last summer. "He's doing everything right, and had a great workout last week [seven furlongs around dogs in 1:26 on the Oklahoma turf July 23]." Contessa noted his charge's versatility. "Whatsthescript has been close to the pace, and has been last early," he said. "He can be wherever you want him to be. [Jockey] Garrett Gomez knows him well, and it will be his decision." The Patrick Biancone-trained Nownownow and Violon Sacre were cross-entered in the GIII Oceanport H. at Monmouth this afternoon, and are expected to stay on the Jersey Shore.

Goldikova was opening her account at the top level when besting Darjina (Fr) (Zamindar) in this race two years ago, and followed up with a defeat of the re-opposing **Elusive Wave** 12 months ago. Six of her amazing tally of nine Group or Grade I wins have come against the colts, and it is hard to imagine anything among her sex troubling her in the immediate future. "I truly think she is in top form, better than ever--I'm very happy with her," trainer Freddy Head told *Racing Post*. "She loves Deauville and always excels there and she came out of her Ascot race extremely well. She had a hard race, but was completely recovered one week later. She goes on all ground except heavy; I think all the boxes are ticked for this race." Chief among the sophomore brigade at this trip at present is **Music Show**, who put up a dramatically improved showing when putting her stamp on the G1 Falmouth S. at Newmarket last time July 7. That followed a trio of near-misses in the major fillies' prizes of the Spring and early Summer, but there was no mistaking her authority in beating the solid yardstick Spacious (GB) (Nayef) by two lengths with the June 16 G3 Jersey S. winner **Rainfall** a further 3/4 lengths back in third. Bruce Raymond, racing manager to owner Jaber Abdullah, told *PA Sport*, "I can't say we're confident of beating Goldikova, but we'd feel foolish if we weren't in the race and something went wrong with her before the race. I think our filly is on the up. She certainly produced a much better performance at Newmarket than she had in her previous races this year." So far this season, Elusive Wave has been missing the spark that saw her capture the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches at Longchamp last May and run second in this race and she could only manage fourth when dropped in class for the June 13 G3 Prix du Chemin de Fer du Nord at Chantilly last time. Owner Martin Schwartz's racing manager Michel Zerolo told *PA Sport*, "It looks like we're running for second place, but that's all right and she's in good form. She has some quirks, but she definitely has a lot of ability as well. I think she is coming into form now and just coming to hand. It has taken a while to get her right this year, but we hope she is getting there now."

BLUM HOPING FOR A SMASHING REDUX

If the best advertisement for a breeder of sales horses is performance on the racetrack, Peter Blum should be excited about next week's Fasig-Tipton Saratoga Sale. The Atlanta businessman's name has been attached to two recent **★ "TDN Rising Stars"** ★--first when his homebred three-year-old filly Flawless (Mr. Greeley) came up with a sparkling debut at Belmont May 23 and then when the Blum-bred Smash (Smart Strike) dominated his July 18 unveiling at Hollywood for trainer Bob Baffert and owner Kaleem Shah.

Through Gerry Dilger's Dromoland Farm consignment, Blum will send two yearlings through the Saratoga sales ring Monday night. The first, [hip 44](#), is a Henny Hughes half-brother to the impressive Smash. Out of Dixie Holiday, the bay is also a half-brother to Holiday Runner (Meadowlake), the dam of multiple Grade I winner Seventh Street (Street Cry {Ire}) and graded-stakes placed Reynaldothewizard (Speightstown).

"This colt reminds me of Smash a little," Dilger said.

"He's taller than his brother was at this time last year. He's very, very well-balanced, good bone, good shoulder, good hip and good length to him. He's a good colt."

Blum sells most of his horses as yearlings, but Smash was a bit of an exception, selling for \$400,000 at this year's OBS March sale. **Cont. p16**

"Last year we didn't sell Smash as a yearling because he was on the small side, and we thought time would help him," Blum explained. "The whole family has been rather small. Holiday Runner herself was small, Seventh Street was small. But this colt appears to have enough size."

Dilger, who has been working with Blum for two decades, agreed.

"Sometimes you get smaller horses by Smart Strike, but this horse has more length to him and is taller," the Irishman explained. "There is enough of a difference that I would definitely sell him as a yearling."

Dixie Holiday had a Malibu Moon filly this spring and is back in foal to Unbridled's Song.

Blum is also the breeder of [hip 58](#), a chestnut filly by Corinthian and the first foal out of Fusaichi Lady (Fusaichi Pegasus).

Fusaichi Lady was also bred by Blum, but took a circuitous route to his broodmare band. Blum sold the mare as a yearling; she was purchased by bloodstock agent Tim McMurphy on behalf of Stan Fulton for \$525,000 out of the 2004 Keeneland September sale. She showed tremendous potential, according to Blum, but never got a chance to show her true talent on the racetrack.

"The filly was breaking stopwatches," Blum recalled. "She went three eighths, I think, in :33. She got injured. She ran once, but it was after she had surgery and she just wasn't the same."

Fusaichi Lady's lone racetrack appearance resulted in a fifth-place effort at Santa Anita in March of 2007 for Fulton and trainer John Shirreffs.

Blum got a second chance at Fusaichi Lady in 2007, when he purchased her for \$140,000 out of the Keeneland November sale.

"I knew she had a world of talent, and when she went back through the ring as a broodmare prospect, I bought her," Blum said. "I bred her, sold her, and bought her back as a broodmare prospect, just because of the talent she had."

Fusaichi Lady is a half-sister to multiple graded stakes winner Multiple Choice (Mt. Livermore) and to stakes-placed Proposal (Mt. Livermore), the dam of graded stakes-placed Silver City (Unbridled's Song) and Elope (Gone West).

The seven-year-old mare has produced an impressive first foal, according to Dilger.

"She is a very, very nice filly," Dilger said. "She has good size and good length to her. She's a very good-moving filly and very pretty. I like her a lot."

Fusaichi Lady had a Bernardini filly this year and is currently in foal to Candy Ride (Arg).

Both of Blum's Saratoga yearlings are by young stallions. Darley's Henny Hughes (Hennessy), winner of the 2006 GI Vosburgh S. and GI King's Bishop S., is represented by his first crop to race this year, while Gainesway's Corinthian (Pulpit), winner of the 2007 GI Metropolitan H., as well as the inaugural Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile, has his first yearlings this year.

Selling yearlings by young sires in a market is leaning toward more established stallions, might be a concern to some, but Blum and Dilger aren't worried.

"In 12 months [these stallions] could be fantastic," Dilger said. "Medaglia d'Oro had to start, Tapit had to start and Candy Ride had to start, and they all have three-year-olds of this year. They have to start somewhere. If the individuals look right, that's what is important."

Blum added, "Historically, I've bred more to proven sires, but really, when you look at it right now, there is a limited number of what you would call great sires. Tapit is a horse that Gerry and I really liked, and he's turned out to be a pretty nice sire, and I think Corinthian has a chance to make a really good sire, too."

Flawless is a rare runner in Blum's colors. The three-year-old filly was a buy-back from the 2008 Keeneland September sale. Her success, coupled with Smash's promising debut for Shah, may have had some people considering racing some of their stock, but Blum is resisting the temptation.

"It always crosses my mind," Blum admitted. "But when you run a commercial breeding operation, you've got to sell. So, we've been selling all these years. The goal is to sell all the foals unless there are reasons why you can't sell them."

Flawless, meanwhile, is getting some time off after a runner-up effort at Belmont in her second start July 18.

"She came out of her second race with a little bit of a problem," Blum explained. "She'll be back, we're just going to give her some time." -*Jessica Martini*

The brilliantly fast GIII Bay Shore S. winner was most recently seen finishing last in the GII Woody Stephens S. on June 5. The colt underwent throat surgery after that race, and came down with pneumonia soon after. "He was very, very sick, and he looked like he was very sick," trainer Gary Contessa told *Daily Racing Form*. "More than likely we'll see him in the winter." Eightyfiveinafifty is currently continuing his recovery on Dr. Jerry Bilinski's Waldorf Farm in North Chatham, NY.

Concord Pointed to West Virginia Derby...

Concord Point (Tapit) turned in a bullet six-furlong work at Del Mar yesterday, covering the distance in 1:13.00--fastest of the 26 at the distance. The Bob Baffert-trained colt was last seen blitzing the GIII Iowa Derby field at Prairie Meadows June 26 over 1 1/16 miles, stretching away to win by 8 1/2 lengths in track-record time. "The more distance, the better my horse seems to run," stated jockey Martin Garcia after the race. Baffert's charge will be pointed to the GII West Virginia Derby at Mountaineer Aug. 7, with the step up to 1 1/8 miles likely to suit.

Jerken's Convocation Whitney Bound?

Conditioner Jimmy Jerkens is "50-50" about entering **Convocation** (Pulpit) in the GI Whitney Invitational H. at Saratoga Aug. 7. "We'll see how he does over the next couple of days," Jerkens explained after his colt worked a bullet five-furlongs in 1:00.60, at Saratoga's training track yesterday. Eclipsing the previous record shared by Lester Piggott, Kieren Fallon and Johnny Murtagh, he also helped trainer Richard Hannon to better the previous high of six wins set by Sir Michael Stoute during the 1989 festival. All of Hughes' wins came on Hannon-trained horses, with Canford Cliffs (Ire) (Tagula {Ire}) providing the highlight in Wednesday's G1 Sussex S., and the two-year-olds Zebedee (GB) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}), King Torus (Ire) (Oratorio {Ire}) and Libranno (GB) (Librettist) completing a clean-sweep of the juvenile pattern events. "It has been a fabulous week, and things have just gone from strength to strength," Hughes told *PA Sport*. "There was a lot of pressure before the Canford Cliffs ride, but after that, I had done my job and could enjoy the rest of Goodwood. It is unbelievable, and it is all thanks to the lads in the Hannon yard who make this possible for me." Hannon added, "We have had good weeks at Royal Ascot, the [Newmarket] July meeting, and now here. We have got plenty more coming, and I have never had a week like this--certainly not at Goodwood."
