## BLIND LEADING THE WAY

In a rematch of the photo finish of the GI Delaware Oaks, **Blind Luck** (Pollard's Vision) surged late to deny **Havre de Grace** (Saint Liam) in the GI Betfair/TVG Alabama S. at Saratoga yesterday afternoon, with odds-on **Devil May Care** (Malibu Moon) finishing fourth.

The victory--her fifth at the top level--makes her the undisputed leader in her division. "It seems like we have the best three-year-old filly right now," said winning trainer Jerry Hollendorfer. "I hate to make those kinds of as-

essments. We'll see what she can do the rest of the year. She did all the work, and I just get to train her. I give Blind Luck all the credit. We've had a very consistent filly all year long. She's real flexible and got the job done today on a slow pace. I'm very proud of her the way she did it." Blind Luck will now head back to the Golden State before hitting the road again. "There's nothing for her on the West Coast, so we'll have to travel again," Hollendorfer added. "We'd like six or seven weeks between races." Trainer Jerry Hollendorfer has kept Blind Luck on an admirable throwback schedule this season. Having captured the GI Las Virgenes S. and GII Fantasy S. earlier in the year, the chestnut returned to California following her thrilling triumph in the GI Kentucky Oaks Apr. 30, only to settle for second to Switch (Quiet American) in the GII Hollywood Oaks June 6. She left regular rider Rafael Bejarano behind when shipped east for the GII Delaware Oaks July 10, and she carried Joel Rosario to a last-gasp win over Havre de Grace on a sloppy track ([video](#)).



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When the gates opened here, the second choice assumed her usual caboosing position under Rosario as Acting Happy and Havre de Grace dawdled up front through splits of :24.03, :49.45 and 1:14.81. Favored Devil May Care tracked them from fifth, but she failed to drag hot rider John Velazquez up to them on the far turn. Meanwhile, Blind Luck wound up her run going five wide, and set her sights on Havre de Grace once more. That Fox Hill colorbearer looked like she might hold off the California closer for a few strides, but the blinkered filly kept on coming to get the win by a neck. "I was expecting a pretty slow pace, but I sat in behind them and watched," Rosario reported. "I stayed back, and when I got to the quarter pole I was very confident and I knew I'd get there." Havre de Grace's connections were pleased with her effort. "Things went fantastic for us, and our filly stepped up to the plate and proved to everyone what she's capable of," said trainer Tony Dutrow. "Blind Luck is so, so special."

### The Devil Couldn't Do It...

Devil May Care was bet down to 3-4 by the Saratoga faithful on the strength of her win over the track in the GI CCA Oaks July 24, but flattened out to finish fourth after never really looking like a serious contender yesterday. "She didn't fire," trainer Todd Pletcher summed up.

Debussy bounced back from Epsom and Royal Ascot disappointment to take the G2 Prix Eugene Adam at Maisons-Laffitte last July, only to conclude his sophomore season on a low note when fifth--placed sixth--in the G2 Prix Guillaume d'Ornano at Deauville the following month. Sent to Dubai for the Carnival, the seal brown colt failed to make an impact on either turf or Tapeta with a pair of unplaced efforts, and trainer John Gosden regrouped once more. Debussy made a winning return in the G3 Huxley S. at Chester May 6, then finished seventh in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot June 16, and came into this contest off a fourth to Summit Surge (Noverre) in the G2 York S. July 24.

After breaking from the inside, Debussy skimmed the fence in fourth as stablemate Tazeez began to free-wheel up front on the backstretch. Princess Haya's flagbearer appeared to be swamped by his rivals for a few strides on the far turn, and the race looked a foregone conclusion as Gio Ponti came rolling six wide. But the wire's there for a reason. Though the chalk hit the front inside the final furlong, he seemed willing to coast to the line. William Buick lit a fire under Debussy, and the four-year-old angled back to the fence before finishing strongly in the final strides. Eclair de Lune won just one of her five starts in France last season for trainer Yves de Nicolay, taking a Chantilly conditions race in May. She concluded her campaign there with a close third in the G3 Darley Prix de la Nonette a year ago, and wound up being the third-highest-priced lot at the Arqana Arc Sale when going for €250,000 to the account of Narvick International. Shipped to Ron McAnally's California base, the bay was a rusty fourth going a mile on the Santa Anita sod Mar. 18, then finished fourth behind Tuscan Evening (Ire) (Oasis Dream {GB}) in the GII Santa Barbara H. Apr. 17.

She gave that ill-fated mare a run for her money when second by a half-length in the local prep for the Beverly D., the GIII Modesty H. July 17, and had sentiment on her side here.

Jockey Junior Alvarado settled Eclair de Lune in a clear second as Romacaca (Running Stag) set a fair pace up front. Treat Gently (GB) (Cape Cross {Ire}) made an eye-catching move on the far turn to reach contention, but the Duchossois colorbearer had first run. She forged to

the lead approaching the eighth pole and continued on resolutely to the wire. "This really inspires me," winning trainer Ron McAnally told *Daily Racing Form*. "Dick has been good to all the people here for a long time and always puts on a first-class show. Time is running out for both of us, Dick and I, so this is the icing on the cake. He really deserves this, Dick does." Sometimes the grass is just greener. No one could fault the connections of Paddy O'Prado for going on to the May 15 GI Preakness S. following his bang-up third in the slop in the GI Kentucky Derby May 1, but the grey colt has been unbeatable since going back to the spinach following his non-threatening sixth in the Pimlico Classic. A three-length winner of the GII Colonial Turf Cup June 19, he came up the fence to annex the GII Virginia Derby July 17, and was odds-on to repeat the feat of former Dale Romans inmate Kitten's Joy (El Prado {Ire}) with a first Grade I win here. Longshot Cherokee Lord (Sir Cherokee) made the early running over a rain-softened course, with Workin for Hops in second and Paddy on the rail in third. The favorite didn't seem to be going too well on the far turn, but, once eased off the fence by rider Kent Desormeaux, kicked into gear in the stretch. Though British shipper Wigmore Hall took an honest run at him in the final furlong, the popular colt was never in serious trouble late. Evening Jewel, who hasn't been worse than second since her career opener, maintained her perfect record on turf here. Beaten a nose by Blind Luck in the GI Las Virgenes S. Feb. 13, the feisty bay earned a narrow score in the GI Ashland S. at Keeneland Apr. 3, then missed by whisker in the GI Kentucky Oaks Apr. 30. She switched to the weeds to captured the GII Honeymoon H. May 31, and came into this feature off a determined victory in the GII San Clemente H. July 25. The crowd's choice took the shortest way around, but found herself looking for running room at the top of the stretch. Jockey Victor Espinoza tugged on his left rein and Evening Jewel darted willingly to the fence, and kept on running all the way to the wire. Harmonious made a big move on the far turn, but kept heading to the outside fence and couldn't quite catch the winner. "She's not that big, but she's perfectly balanced," Espinoza noted. "Just right. She shifts spots and she's easy to handle. I had to drop her down inside today, but it was no problem. It was a little tough down in there [waiting for room], but I knew everything was going to be OK. She's a really, really good filly--so athletic. Pathfork, impressive on debut in a course-and-distance maiden containing several well-touted individuals July 18, was sent off a hot favorite for this important

marker despite taking on proven group performers. Pulling himself straight into the lead under Fran Berry, the bay was initially keen until getting a lead from Ballydoyle's Rudolf

Valentino (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}) after the first furlong. Still cruising when left in front by the tiring pace-maker with three furlongs to run, he was tackled by Glor Na Mara, but was always holding his chief market rival to score comfortably. "We're delighted with that, and Fran said he was always just cruising," commented trainer Jessica Harrington, better known for her national hunt exploits. "He's such a laid-back individual to do anything with, and has an amazing temperament. He's not in the G1 Vincent O'Brien National S. [over course and distance Sept. 11], so would have to be supplemented, and there is also the G1 Dewhurst S. [at Newmarket Oct. 16] and G1 Racing Post Trophy [at Doncaster Oct. 23]."

Pathfork, produced by a 3/4-sister to top miler Spinning World (Nureyev), was bred by the Niarchos family before selling on the first day of the 2009 Keeneland September sale. Impressive when recording a debut success in a seven-furlong Newmarket maiden July 7, Native Khan was the warm favorite for this important staging post and, after a brief tense moment, rewarded his supporters with an ultimately comfortable win. Covered up in rear early, the grey was stuck behind rivals still full of run at the quarter pole but, after finding room towards the fence, rolled to the front passing the furlong pole and was kept up to his work to hold Measuring Time. "There was no pace early on and it was only his second run, so I didn't want to go round the outside," jockey Eddie Ahern explained. "When he was in behind he was traveling really well and always getting into those gaps for me, but when in front he was looking at the photographers. He has a big future ahead of him, and you would have seen the turn-of-foot he showed at Newmarket again here if there had been a fast pace." Trainer Ed Dunlop added, "He's a very talented horse and I think he will have learnt a lot today in a less-than-ideal race, as he got shuffled back. I like the way he relaxed today and he can obviously quicken, but he tends to prick his ears when in front--he does it at home. How far he'll stay in time I don't know, but, if he gets further than a mile, he could be very good. He is a French-bred, so the G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere [at Longchamp Oct. 3] is of interest, but he'll have one or two more runs and be put away. He's a very good-moving horse who floats across the ground and, although his dad was okay with some give in the ground, at times, he wouldn't want a bog."

Since the days of the legendary Francois Boutin, this prize has been dominated by the overseas challengers, with 13 of the last 16 renewals going to Britain and Ireland. The usual strong cross-channel representation is in evidence again here, headed by **Libranno**, who bids to extend his unbeaten record and add this to his successes in Newmarket's G2 July S. July 8 and the G2 Richmond S. at Goodwood July 30. Trainer Richard Hannon is hoping the easier underfoot conditions do not compromise his chances. "It could be Libranno's first time on soft ground, although we are told that the going is drying out fast and that it won't be far off good come Sunday," Hannon said on Friday. "All his three wins have come on good or faster ground, so we will have to see how he copes with a bit of cut if they have got the forecast wrong."

Hannon added, "He looks a sprinter through and through and wins his races by killing off the opposition by halfway with his early speed, so there seems no point in fighting him--best to let him jump and run. He seems very well at home and, although it looks a hot race, they will have him to catch." **Irish Field**, who was snapped up by Eddie Wong after his win in the July 25 G2 Prix Robert Papin, has joined Lambourn trainer John Hills from his Spanish conditioner Mauricio Delcher-Sanchez and represents some of France's strongest juvenile form lines. His defeat of the re-opposing **Broox** and subsequent G2 Gimcrack S. winner Approve (Ire) (Oasis Dream {GB}) in Maisons-Laffitte's 5 1/2-furlong contest followed a nose second to **Keratiya** in the G3 Prix du Bois over Chantilly's five three weeks earlier. "He came to me about four days after winning the Papin, and essentially he has been bought to go to Hong Kong," Hills told *PA Sport*. "The long and the short of it is he missed his first quarantine period to go out to Hong Kong. So, once they realised he had to spend the month of August in the UK anyway, the owner, Mr. Wong, asked me if I would take the horse for a few weeks and if I was happy with him to run him in the Morny. I haven't done a lot with the horse, but he looks a picture and is clearly in good condition. I would have thought this will be his only run for me before he heads off abroad. His form obviously looks good with Approve coming out and winning at York earlier this week, so he must have a good chance on Sunday." Another Brit with a chance is **Soraaya**, who was runner-up to Memory (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) in the G2 Cherry Hinton S. at Newmarket July 7 before annexing Ascot's G3 Princess Margaret S. at the expense of Margot Did (Ire) (Exceed and Excel {Aus}) last time July 24. The leading domestic hope is **Pontenuovo**, who beat Captain Chop by two lengths in the course-and-distance G3 Prix de Cabourg last time Aug. 1.

## On the Travers Trail...

No fewer than six contenders for next Saturday's \$1-million GI Travers S. at Saratoga put in their final works yesterday, and the New York Racing Association has footage available on their [YouTube](#) channel. Trainer Todd Pletcher sent out GI Kentucky Derby hero **Super Saver** (Maria's Mon) in company with The Roundhouse (Fusaichi Pegasus), and the WinStar homebred worked five-eighths in 1:01.13 with jockey Calvin Borel in the irons. "Calvin was going to leave last night, but he rearranged his schedule so he could be on the horse this morning," said Pletcher. "I wanted Calvin to have a feel for him, and he seemed to be pleased with the way he was going." The bay colt flattened out to be fourth in his latest, the GI Haskell Invitational at Monmouth Aug. 1. "I think he's going to run an improved race from the Haskell," Pletcher opined. "Having that race under his belt has helped him. If you look at his form this year, he ran decently in Tampa [third in the GIII Tampa Bay Derby], moved forward with a better race in Arkansas [second in the GI Arkansas Derby], and then another move forward [at Churchill Downs], so I think he's going to respond the same way."

GII Dwyer S. winner **Fly Down** (Mineshaft) went a half in :48.40 over the Oklahoma training track yesterday. The chestnut was most recently a troubled fifth in the GII Jim Dandy S. at Saratoga July 31. "He's a terrific, consistent horse," said trainer Nick Zito. "I don't think he had a good post last time. A mile and a quarter is different, but that mile and eighth last time when he had post nine, Jose [Lezcano] did a good job of getting him over. But the next thing you know, nothing worked out for him."

**A Little Warm** (Stormin Fever), coming off a sharp win in the Jim Dandy, completed five panels in 1:01.58 yesterday. "I am super-duper happy with him," exclaimed trainer Tony Dutrow. "My horse went around excellently. It's so rare and so special to feel this good about a horse with such a big race in front of him." The Ned Evans homebred is from the immediate family of Curlinello (Smart Strike), who made a successful debut at the Spa yesterday.

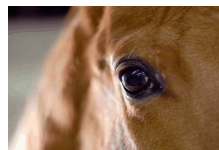

### Moore, Paragallo Denied Stud Book Privileges:

The Jockey Club's Board of Stewards has voted to deny all privileges of The American Stud Book to both Chad Moore and Ernie Paragallo after both men were involved with criminal animal cruelty cases. Moore was fined and sentenced to 180 days in jail following his guilty plea on Mar. 2 in Clermont County Municipal Court. Paragallo was fined and sentenced to serve a maximum of two years in jail after a judgement was entered against him in March in the Superior Court of the State of New York. Denial of Stud Book privileges, which is effective in both cases on Jan. 1, 2011, includes the privilege to register foals or submit any documents related to foal registration. "The Jockey Club fully supports and assists law enforcement agencies, the courts, and racing regulatory authorities in the investigation of matters involving cruelty to Thoroughbreds," Ogden Mills Phipps, chairman of The Jockey Club, said in a statement. "When there is a final determination by a court, an official tribunal, or an official racing body that a person has killed, abandoned, mistreated, neglected or abused, or otherwise committed an act of cruelty to a horse, The Jockey Club will not hesitate to take appropriate action under Rule 19."

### Phipps, Janney Re-Elected to JC Board of Stewards:

The Jockey Club announced that Ogden Mills Phipps and Stuart S. Janney III have been re-elected to four-year terms on the organization's board of stewards. Phipps, who has been a member of The Jockey Club since 1965, has served as chairman since 1983, while Janney, a member of the organization since 1992, has been the chairman of The Jockey Club's Thoroughbred Safety Committee since its inception in 2008. The Jockey Club also revealed that James C. Brady is stepping down from his position as its secretary-treasurer; he has served in that function since 1983. Brady will be succeeded by Ian D. Highet, effective immediately. Brady will continue to serve his term on the board of stewards, which expires in 2013. Highet, a Jockey Club member since 2006, is a partner at the private equity firm Court Square Capital.

The Jockey Club is projecting a 2011 North American registered Thoroughbred foal crop of 27,000, a decline of 10 percent from the estimate of 30,000 registered foals for 2010, it was announced today by Matt Iuliano, the organization's executive vice president and executive director. The foal crop projection, traditionally announced in mid-August, is computed by using Reports of Mares Bred (RMBs) received to date for the 2010 breeding season. RMBs are to be filed by Aug. 1 of each breeding season. The 2011 foal crop is projected to be the smallest foal crop since 1973, when 26,811 foals were registered. Stallion owners who have not returned their RMBs for the 2010 breeding season should do so as soon as possible. Submission of RMBs can be accomplished quickly and easily through Interactive Registration™ (IR), the online service that enables registered users to perform virtually all registration-related activities over the Internet. 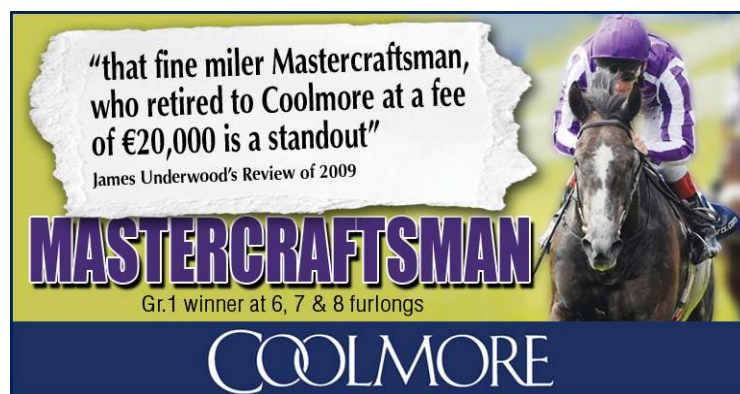
