Express Train...

A maiden winner in his lone juvenile appearance over a muddy Aqueduct inner track Dec. 5, Afleet Express finished runner-up in a Jan. 30 Gulfstream allowance over six furlongs and fifth traveling seven-eighths Feb. 25 before going missing. Given three months off, the striking dark bay returned with panache May 22 at Belmont Park, thrashing a field of older rivals by 7 3/4 lengths and earning his way into stakes competition. Sent off the 2-1 second choice behind GI Preakness third Jackson Bend (Hear No Evil) in Monmouth's GIII Pegasus S. June 19, Afleet Express raced with a sluggish pace and stayed on for a 1 3/4-length victory from **Afleet Again** (Afleet Alex). The Gainesway and Martin Cherry colorbearer was a 5-2 chance in this track's GII Jim Dandy S. July 31, but was bumped at the start, raced wide around the final turn and offered a mild rally to be third to **A Little Warm** (Stormin Fever) and **Miner's Reserve** (Mineshaft).

Have a Nice Trip...

As expected, Miner's Reserve made the early lead from his inside stall, with the newly blinkered **First Dude** (Stephen Got Even) in close attendance. **Trappe Shot** (Tapit), favored off his runner-up performance to Lookin At Lucky (Smart Strike) in the GI Haskell Invitational S. Aug. 1, raced alongside A Little Warm with Afleet Express slightly worse than centerfield while

saving some valuable ground.

Fly Down (Mineshaft), one of three Nick Zito trainees in the race, bided his time two from the tail down the backstretch. Back on the front end, Miner's Re-

serve and First Dude were still eyeballing each other, but Afleet Express pulled Javier Castellano through an opening at the fence and the duo found themselves right on the heels of the pacesetters as the field reached the quarter pole. Needing only to find some running room, Afleet Express was switched off the rail and struck the front, but was joined soon after by Fly Down, who began picking off rivals going ominously well leaving the turn. The two came to settle the race in the waning strides, with Afleet Express getting an exceedingly favorable bob.

"Turning for home I was very carefully watching the horse on the lead and we tried to squeeze through a little hole," Castellano explained. "I'm very, very proud of my horse for going through the hole between two horses. I thought I'd win the race by the eighth pole, but he hung a little bit in the last part of the race, and I give credit to the other horse for finishing very strong. I'm very lucky to get the bob and win the race. That photo could have gone either way, and I'm very lucky it went my way." "It wasn't the distance," trainer Kiaran McLaughlin said of the former, who was also under consideration for the GI King's Bishop S.. "He had no real excuse. He just did not fire today." Calvin Borel also offered no alibi for the performance of the WinStar runner. "I had a good trip and there are no excuses for that trip," he stated. "I got over fine and they weren't going that fast. Between the three-eighths pole and the quarter pole I tested him, and I had no pony. He just wasn't there."

Richard's Kid won the '09 Pacific Classic in the colors
of Arnold Zetcher, then was third in the GI Goodwood
S. Oct. 10 and sixth in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic
Nov. 7 before changing hands. Up to score by a head in
the GII San Antonio H. Feb. 7, the dark bay could not
close the gap off a slow pace in the G1 Dubai World
Cup at Meydan and settled for seventh, beaten under
three lengths. Given plenty of time to recover, Richard's
Kid had two starts in advance of his title defense,
rounding out the triple in the GI Hollywood Gold Cup
July 10 and in the July 30 GIII Cougar II H. Reunited
here with jockey Mike Smith, the Bob Baffert trainee
was reserved last but one down the backstretch as Isle
of Giant's (Giant's Causeway) scrimmaged on a moder-
ate pace with Cougar II hero Temple City (Dynaformer).
The plot thickened nearing the quarter pole, as the
frontrunners began to give way to the stormers.
Crowded House got first run and made his bid for the
lead three wide into the stretch, while favored The
Usual Q. T. (Unusual Heat) came with a four-wide bid
and actually led for a few strides at the eighth pole. But
it was Richard's Kid, five deep into the lane, who
charged home under the biggest head of steam to be-
come the third repeat winner of the Classic in its rela-
tively brief history.

tucky Derby May 1, Discreetly Mine returned to the one-turn game in the GII Woody Stephens S. June 5, but had the misfortune of running into D'Funnybone and settled for second.

He bounced back with a 1 1/4-length tally in the GIII Jersey Shore S. at Monmouth July 4 and exploded in the stretch to take the local prep for this--the GII Amsterdam S.--by an impressive 8 3/4 lengths Aug. 2. A value play at even-money, Discreetly Mine was sharp from the gate and towed the field along through an opening two furlongs in :21.90 chased intently by California raider Bulldogger (Dixie Union), with D'Funnybone and Hurricane Ike (Graeme Hall) a bit further in arrears. Still traveling comfortably on the turn, he got past a half in :44.11 and set sail for the wire. Discreetly Mine remained well clear passing the eighth pole and grew noticeably weary, but found the wire first, as Bank Merger and longshot Latigo Shore came with late anti-bias rallies. The winner is not likely to be seen again before the first weekend in November. "We'd be inclined to train up to the Breeders' Cup," winning trainer Todd Pletcher confirmed. "Twenty-six days [since winning the Grade 2 Amsterdam], 123 pounds--he's spotting everyone but D' Funnybone significant weight, but he was gutsy enough to get it done."

Rightly So remained perfect in three starts at the tricky distance of seven furlongs, leading every step of the way to take the prestigious Ballerina S. Nearly untouchable in eight starts against fellow New York-breds, the attractive dark bay was a debut second, then rattled off five wins in succession, capped by black-type scores in the Oct. 24 Iroquois S. at Belmont Park and the Nov. 19 Love Is Eternal S. at Aqueduct. She faltered in a pair of starts at odds-on over the winter at the Big A, finishing third by 3/4 of a length in a muddy renewal of the Broadway S. Feb. 28 and runner-up by a nose in the Mar. 31 Indistinctly S. She dipped her toe into open company in the May 29 Vagrancy H., and gave a good account of herself, going down by a half-length after setting a brisk pace, and was entering this on the heels of a head victory over Qualia (Saarland) in the GIII Bed o' Roses H. at her favored distance July 5. Hustled away from the stalls by Cornelio Velasquez, Rightly So got an opening quarter-mile in :22.26, with Warbling and Jessica Is Back her closest pursuers. Still going easily and comfortably in front after a half-mile in :44.80, Rightly So responded when popped the question in upper stretch and was never in any serious danger. "It was just a fantastic performance today," commented winning trainer Tony Dutrow. "She's a filly who is capable of running fast the entire race. She outdid herself today. She's been an overachiever, and once again she raised her game to the top. We just couldn't be any prouder of her." Qualia, the 3-1 second choice, exchanged bumps shortly after the break with Pretty Prolific (Lion Heart), had her saddle slip and was basically eased home.

El Brujo put together a very useful three-year-old season when trained in Canada by Malcolm Pierce, winning four of his eight trips to the post, including popular scores in the GIII Kentucky Cup Sprint in September and Keeneland's GIII Perryville S. the following month, but was shelved off a seventh in the GIII Kennedy Road S. Nov. 21. Third in his seasonal debut in the Jacques Cartier S. at Woodbine Apr. 11 and sixth in a grassy seven-furlong allowance May 15, he was purchased privately by Arnold Zetcher and turned in an even effort in his Southern California debut when fourth to Smiling Tiger (Hold That Tiger) in the GI Bing Crosby S. Aug. 1. The gelding was one of three entered in the race from the Bob

Baffert barn, but was left to fly the flag with the scratch of both Sangaree (Congaree) and GISW E Z's Gentleman (Yankee Gentleman). Quickly to the front despite his outside draw, El Brujo dictated terms in advance of Kanan Dume (Malibu Moon) and three-year-old Smiling Tiger and began to sneak away leaving the quarter pole. 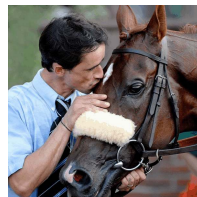

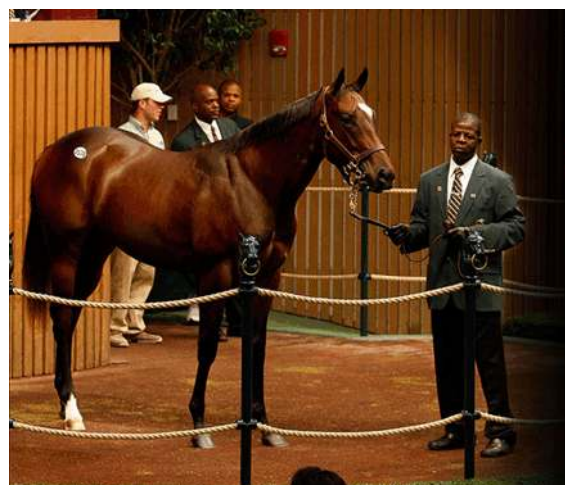

"I was," Rosen admitted, but added, "You never like to take it for granted. She has just done so well, and [trainer] Brian [Meehan] has been so high on her ever since he's had her. I spoke to him on Thursday after she did a bit of work, and he was thrilled. He expected her to run a big race."

Rosen had reason to expect a lot from Theyskens' Theory. He acquired the dam, Heat Lightning (Summer Squall), in foal to Birdstone, for \$1.1 million at the 2005 Keeneland November sale. That was just after her son Stevie Wonderboy (Stephen Got Even) captured the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile en route to an Eclipse Award as the top two-year-old that season. The first foal she produced for her new owner's A R Enterprises LLC was the unraced Lady Lightning. The second, a colt of 2007, is the unraced Arnell (Unbridled's Song), who has been working sharply over the Belmont training track this summer for Rosen. A yearling half-sister by Distorted Humor has been catalogued for Keeneland September ([hip 802](#)).

Theyskens' Theory was sent to the 2009 Fasig-Tipton Saratoga Selected Sale, but was bought back at \$250,000.

"Brian Meehan was at the sale, as was Hugo Merry--they do all my buying and evaluating," Rosen said. "John Stuart, who does all my work here in America, was there as well, and all three loved her. We put a value on her that she didn't bring, and I was happy to take her home."

"Brian said to me, 'This may be a blessing in disguise,'" he added. "So far, so good."

As is the case with the majority of the Rosen juveniles, Theyskens' Theory was sent across the pond to join the Meehan string at Manton. She rewarded the conditioner's faith with impressive wins in her last two outings, and will likely make her next appearance in elite company.

"She'll go back to Manton [Sunday], and then Brian and I will have a discussion over the next couple of weeks and decide where she'll run next," Rosen offered. "She is nominated to the [G1] Fillies Mile S. [at Ascot Sept. 25] and [G1 Prix Marcel Boussac at Longchamp Oct. 3]-- obviously, the Fillies Mile would be a good spot."

But a return trip to the U.S. for the GII Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf is not currently in the cards.

"I think that's very premature," Rosen said. "It looks like there's the possibility she might stay over there for next year."

Last summer, Rosen's Icon Project (Empire Maker) made headlines as the runaway winner of the GI Personal Ensign S. at the Spa. She was named for the "artistic and philanthropic arm of Theory," according to the Theory website, which continued, "Icon Project conceives of, collaborates on, and curates a program of events, exhibitions and sponsorships designed to encourage the development and exposure of iconic ideas and initiatives."

Describing how the tradition of naming his horses for his fashion initiatives began, Rosen said, "Back in 1973, my father was doing a line of tennis clothes, and he named a filly Chris Evert after that line. That was a success, and I've tried to follow in his footsteps. It worked for my father, so I thought, 'let me try to make it work for me.'"

And the idea behind Theyskens' Theory?

"Olivier Theyskens is a famous designer and, in June, he started doing a line of clothing together with me," Rosen explained. "I hadn't named the filly when he signed on to do the line, and I thought it would be a nice thing for me to name her after him. If you Google him, you'll see he is probably one of the top five designers in the world. He is a fantastic talent, a fantastic guy, and I hope she can show as much talent as her namesake."

Memory puts her unbeaten record on the line against a strong home defense here. Impressive when dealing with quality opposition in both the G3 Albany S. at Royal Ascot June 18 and under a subsequent penalty in Newmarket's G2 Cherry Hinton S. last time July 8, trainer Richard Hannon's confidence is infectious. "It is Memory's first Group 1 and her first attempt at seven furlongs, so we are taking nothing for granted but I have not seen a better two-year-old filly in England or Ireland this season and she has been absolutely flying on the gallops," he said. "The form of her races cannot be questioned--the two who chased her home in the Cherry Hinton at Newmarket (Soraaya {Ire}) and Hooray {GB}) have gone on to win the Princess Margaret and Lowther S. respectively--and we don't see the extra furlong being a problem as she settles so well in her races. Memory has grown up through the summer but, while she is no longer so playful in the mornings, she is still a very active filly and not one you would want to turn out in a paddock for a couple of weeks." Aidan O'Brien, successful in four of the last 10 renewals, saddles a quartet with Johnny Murtagh staying faithful to **Together**. She lost all hope of winning by veering markedly when third behind **Laughing Lashes** and stable companion **Misty For Me** in the Aug 8. G2 Debutante S. over this track and trip last time, but had previously accounted for that winner and **Kissable** in Leopardstown's G3 Silver Flash S. July 15. Kissable's trainer Kevin Prendergast caused an upset in this 12 months ago with Termagant (Ire) (Powerscourt {GB}) and is expecting improvement from his contender. "She's come on well and we're hoping for a good run," he said. "I think the track will suit her better, as Leopardstown was a bit tight for her and she got a bit far back before coming home well. She definitely needs a good dig in the ground and we'll be delighted if we are in the first three or four."

The big question is whether **Overdose** can carry on the winning thread returned to the scene of his 2008 success in this race.
