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## ON 'WARD, EVANS SOLDIER

Many considered Ned Evans's **Quality Road** (Elusive Road) a shoo-in for a divisional championship before he was upset by **Blame** (Arch) in the GI Whitney S. at Saratoga Aug. 7. And while a re-match, probably in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic Nov. 6, looms as the deciding factor, the four-year-old put himself back in the driver's seat with a professional 4 3/4-length score over **Mythical Power** (Congaree) in yesterday's GI Woodward S. at the Spa. Trainer Todd Pletcher said **Quality Road** would, in all likelihood, head straight to the Classic, where Eclipse honors in the handicap division--as

well as a Horse of the Year battle with **Zenyatta** (Street Cry {Ire})--will be decided. "I certainly think we can make a strong argument for [having the best horse in the country]," said Pletcher. "He's accomplished a lot this year with the GI Donn, the GI Met Mile, and this race. He's certainly put himself in a position, if he wins the next one. Right now, the plan all year has been to run in these races. He got beat a short head in the last one, but I think he redeemed himself today on a track that did not appear to be playing very fast." **Cont. p2**

### 'Road' to the Cup...

Winner of the GI Florida Derby at three, Quality Road began 2010 with an easy win in the GIII Hal's Hope S. at Gulfstream Jan. 3 before adding a second Grade I tally in the Donn H. in Hallendale Feb. 6. Still sharp after a 3 1/2-month absence, he won the prestigious Met Mile H. at Belmont May 31, but then just failed to see out the nine furlongs of the Whitney in his latest, coming up a head short to the rallying Blame. Breaking from post three here, he angled out going into the first turn to press Arcodoro (Medaglia d'Oro) through :24.06 and :47.76 fractions. He took over after three quarters in 1:11.52, pulled away to lead by three lengths in upper stretch, and was kept to task as Johnny Velazquez offered two smacks to each side in the final 3/16ths. "That was 'Plan A,'" Todd Pletcher said of race tactics. "The four horse [Arcodoro] showed enough pace that we were able to maneuver outside him and get the trip we wanted. I thought he ran a good race." Added Velazquez, "He was much, much better than last time. In the Whitney, I was struggling to get him going. But today he was much more willing and much more on the bridle. It was better for him to have a horse to follow. It made him much more competitive. And then down the lane, I just wanted to keep him focused, because once he gets to the lead sometimes he gets lazy. I guess he's older and smarter because he thinks he's done once he gets to the lead. But overall, he did it well."

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## Cape Blanks 'Em...

Prepared for the Irish Champion S. since that July 24 King George at Ascot, Cape Blanco, the G1 Irish Derby hero, was sent off a weak 6-1 after rain eased the ground at Leopardstown. But the sophomore instantly looked at home on the surface as Seamus Heffernan sent him into isolation. Still clear on the final turn, the chestnut had the race sewn up by the furlong pole, and maintained a relentless gallop to upstage his stable companion and 8-11 favorite Rip Van Winkle (Ire) by 5 1/2 lengths. "It was always the plan to make the running unless something wanted to go quicker than me," commented Heffernan, who had also made all on Misty For Me (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in the G1 Moyglare Stud S. six days before. "When we went past the four, he was getting into a rhythm and he came up with a turn of foot, and I thought then that whatever got to me would have to run. He stays really well, but he has a high cruising speed and, when I asked him, he really got down and stretched. He has improved for making his own running going that speed."

Prior to this contest, the imposing Cape Blanco had raced left-handed twice and had put up his most impressive visual displays on both occasions, when dominating the G3 Tyros S. at this track last July and putting Workforce (GB) (King's Best) firmly in his place in York's G2 Dante S. May 13. His record going the other way included hard-fought wins in the G2 Futurity S. at Fairyhouse last August and the June 27 G1 Irish Derby at The Curragh, plus his scarcely believable 11-length defeat at the hands of Harbinger (GB) (Dansili {GB}) in Ascot's midsummer showpiece. **Cont. p4**

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## Irish Champion S. cont.

When the rain came to Dublin yesterday morning, the proven top-of-the-ground performer looked to be compromised as he had been after a wet lead-up to his only unplaced effort in the June 6 G1 Prix du Jockey-Club at

Chantilly. Always happy and at home on ground described by jockeys as on the slow side of good, he was over a length ahead after the first quarter, over three in front by the half-way mark and maintained that gap to the quarter pole. He gained further ground from there, and it was left to Rip Van Winkle to edge ahead of Twice Over in a bunch for the minor medals. "He was a very good,

unbeaten two-year-old, and we always thought that a mile and a quarter on nice ground would be his best conditions," Aidan O'Brien, saddling his sixth winner in the race, explained. "[Son] Joseph [O'Brien] had said that since Ascot, he had progressed and got better with every canter and piece of work, and he's a big, strong determined horse with loads of class, speed and courage. He has been maturing and getting stronger with every week and is so laid-back at home, you could light a fire under him and he wouldn't move. He has a marvelous attitude and is a mile-and-a-quarter horse who gets a mile and a half. Johnny [Murtagh] said that he felt that the ground was too slow for Rip Van Winkle, and he got back a little bit in the race, but he's a miler that gets a mile and a quarter on fast ground, so he won't mind dropping back now. All the options are open to them both and we'll discuss it after the weekend." An Oratorio (Ire) half-brother to Cape Blanco sells as hip 340 at the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale Book 1. Murtagh added his own tribute to the winner. "It was a good, solid pace and Cape Blanco is a good horse," he said. "I always thought he was a top horse, and today, the way he was ridden suited him--it was a top-class performance. I got past Tom [Queally, on Twice Over] as I had [in the Juddmonte International] at York, but my lad didn't kick in at all today and from three out I was under pressure, so I think he's a horse who wants really fast ground." Twice Over's trainer Henry Cecil was offering no excuses for the consistent five-year-old afterwards. "Tom [Queally] was a bit disappointed, because he didn't pick up as we expected him to, and maybe he is better on faster ground," the master of Warren Place commented. "It is not too long since his last run at York, but I thought he was very well and definitely had a great chance. We wouldn't have beaten the winner anyway, so we'll see how he is and the G1 Champion S. [at Newmarket Oct. 16] is on the agenda along with the Dubai World Cup." Starspangledbanner (Aus) (Choirs {Aus}) was expected to cap a day of days for Ballydoyle, but the ex-Australian marauder had no more to give after a busy spell as the veteran Markab took centre stage when breaking the track record. Initially trained by Freddy Head for Sheikh Hamdan, Markab left France and joined Kevin Morgan after being snapped up at Doncaster's Horses-In-Training Sale, but suffered an inauspicious start to his British career when pulled up at Chester in late 2007. Pat Cosgrave's first ride on him came in a seven-furlong handicap, which he won on Kempton's Polytrack in March the following year and he had partnered him in all but two starts since. He was once considered a potential jumping prospect by Morgan, but it was clear that sprinting was his game by the time he was switched to Henry Candy's yard ahead of the 2009 campaign. Veteran Candy, who trained Kyllachy (GB), among others, soon sculpted Markab into a top handicapper and fourth placings in the calendar's prestigious events the Wokingham at Royal Ascot and Stewards' Cup at Goodwood were followed by a win in Ripon's Great St Wilfrid last August. This term, the bay took further steps up the ladder and, after opening his black-type account in The Curragh's G3 Greenlands S. May 22, was 1 1/2 lengths second to Equiano (Fr) (Acclamation {GB}) in Royal Ascot's G1 King's Stand June 15. Sixth in Newbury's G3 Hackwood S. last time July 17, he was totally in control of the six-strong group racing against the stand's rail here as Starspangledbanner blazed his own trail against the opposite fence. Despite drifting left across the track late on, he was always holding ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ Lady of the Desert, who had been left stranded in front on the far side after mastering the favorite passing the quarter pole.

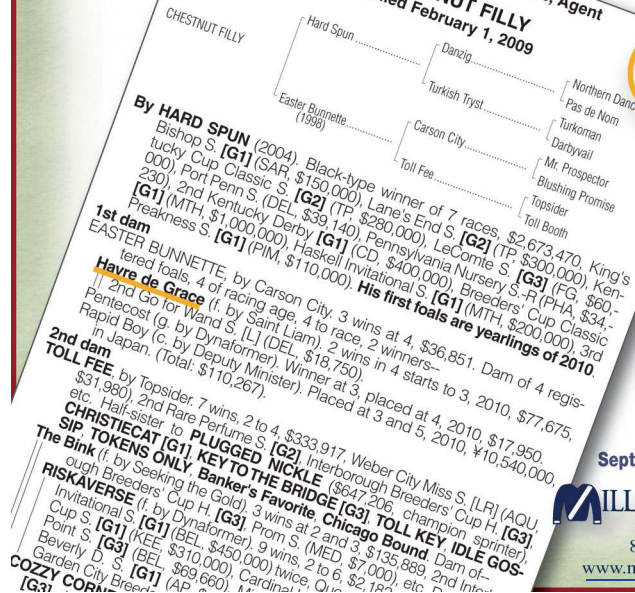

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"This makes up for Ascot, where he bumped into one and he's always been a very good horse," his rider said. "I don't think he was 100 percent last time, as the King's Stand had an effect on him, and he's bounced back today and proved how good he is." Candy added, "He's just a very happy horse now and is so relaxed, spending all his afternoons out in the paddock. He's blissfully content, and seems to get bigger and stronger. There was no option, being drawn where we were, than to get on the stand's rail and hope for the best. He had got a little bit jarred up after Ascot and I thought he had recovered in time for Newbury last time, but he hadn't. He'll go to Paris now [for the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye at Longchamp Oct. 3]." Aidan O'Brien believes Starspangledbanner's prolonged Australian/European campaign has caught up with him. "He is only flesh-and-blood and had a season before he came to us, so it was taking a chance coming here after a very tough race at York," he said. "He didn't do much in between, so we didn't really know how he was but obviously the Nunthorpe has left a little bit of a mark on him. He got a little bit tired, so we'll freshen him up and let him come back to his best. If the ground had been slow here, the decision would have been very easy as he wouldn't have run, so it was the wrong decision with the benefit of hindsight. 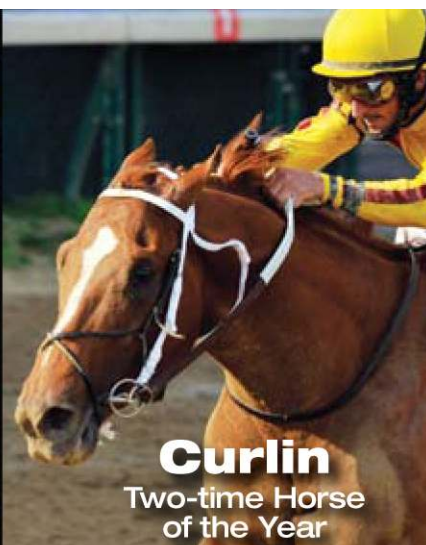

Purchased privately after being bought back for \$95,000 at the OBS March Sale, Tell a Kelly was last of nine in the early going of her debut going 5 1/2 panels July 25, but closed some ground to be fifth. At the back of the pack once again when adding a half-furlong next time out, she kicked into gear in the lane and drew off to win by 2 1/2 lengths. Confidently handled by regular jockey Alonso Quinonez, Tell a Kelly took a customary position as the caboose. Still second last as they turned for home, she came charging into the fray with a full head of steam, tipped wide for room at the 3/16ths pole, then lengthened clear with a powerful turn of foot to win going away. "I was hoping there would be a good pace, because she likes to ease back and settle," said trainer John Sadler, who was winning his first Debutante. "She was able to do that today. We'll stay home and run at Oak Tree in the GI Oak Leaf [at Hollywood Oct. 3], then head to Kentucky for the GI Breeders' Cup [Juvenile Fillies Nov. 5]." Tell a Kelly is the second 2010 Grade I winner for owners Ike and Dawn Thrash, following Line of David (Lion Heart)'s success in the GI Arkansas Derby. In addition to the winner's purse, the Thrashes also received a season to sponsor Darley's Street Boss (Street Cry {Ire}); the filly's breeder, Karen West, received a free season to Any Given Saturday (Distorted Humor). Tell a Kelly is named after the Thrashes' daughter. Favored Wickedly Perfect, unbeaten after a win in the GIII Sorrento S. at Del Mar Aug. 6, set fast :22 and :44 4/5 splits and held well for second. "My filly was relaxed up there and was running well," said jockey Rafael Bejarano. "She ran well at the end, too. Here Comes Ben was average in 2009, winning twice in eight starts, but after a breather, he returned a different animal. He began his campaign with an easy six-length win in a Keeneland allowance Apr. 11, won by a similar margin in a Churchill optional claimer May 21, and annexed his first black-type race in the Kelly's Landing S. under the Twin Spires June 25. Each of those starts was over seven furlongs, and trainer Charles Lopresti decided to take a shot at a field that included the Grade I winners Vineyard Haven, Warrior's Reward (Medaglia d'Oro) and Bribon (Fr) (Mark of Esteem {Ire}). Here Comes Ben was settled in seventh early as Big Drama pressed Checklist (Gone West), with Vineyard Haven a tucked-in third. Big Drama kicked on strongly in upper stretch, but couldn't stave off the hard-charging Here Comes Ben. "I was a little intimidated coming up here because I've never run in a Grade I before," said Lopresti. "We had to see if he was this kind of horse, and he proved it today." As for the future, Lopresti said, "There won't be many seven-furlong races for him, so we're going to have to make decision." Saeed bin Suroor, trainer Vineyard Haven and entrymate Girolamo (A.P. Indy), said of the former, "He was traveling well and in a good position all the way. It was a pretty easy race for him today, but he got beaten. I was disappointed with him. Girolamo, I know he needed the race. We'll take [Vineyard Haven] home, check [him out] and then look for another Grade I for him." With wins including the G2 Debutante S. and Tattersalls Timeform Fillies' 800 at two, Lillie Langtry sustained a serious knee injury in the BC Juvenile Fillies Turf. Few knew what to expect on her return in the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas, but she finished strongly in fifth in that May 23 Curragh Classic. Sent to Royal Ascot for the G1 Coronation S. June 18, the bay won by 1 1/4 lengths there, but was disappointing when only fifth as the 9-4 favorite for Newmarket's G1 Falmouth S. next time July 7. Showing the benefit of a subsequent break here, she was settled last early by Johnny Murtagh and closed widest of all on the final turn as Spacious was sent to the front. Taking time to reel in the game mare, she worked her way past with 50 yards remaining. John Magnier was on hand to say, "She'd had a bit of rest and looked like she was back to her best, but Aidan was of the opinion she might even improve from it. I wasn't sure she'd ever run again after her injury, but the vets did a great job, and it's miraculous really." O'Brien said, "Johnny gave her a marvelous ride, and the lads have done a great job with this filly--there are so many people involved. I think we might look at the Prix de l'Opera now, but we'll see how she comes out of this." Murtagh added, "I think she appreciated a little ease in the ground. Royal Ascot is a tough place to come back from. I was always going to get to Kieren [Fallon, on Spacious] and she stayed on nicely." 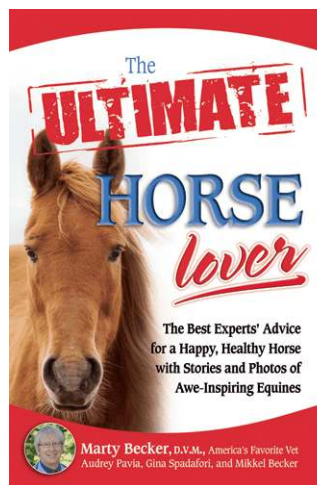

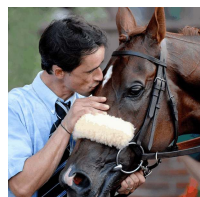

### Desormeaux Out for Three Weeks...

Kent Desormeaux will be sidelined for several weeks after suffering a fractured vertebrae, according to the rider's Facebook page. Desormeaux was injured in Friday's second race at Saratoga when his mount, Forest Whip, fell just past the eighth pole and unseated the 40-year-old. The two-year-old filly was a 3-2 choice in the \$60,000 maiden claimer. She reportedly suffered an apparent heart attack. Desormeaux was taken to Saratoga Hospital for x-rays. He initially posted that x-rays returned negative, but an hour later said a CAT scan revealed a fractured C7 vertebrae. Later on Friday, Desormeaux posted, "On my way home. Braced. More Details [Saturday] morning," and yesterday posted, "Dr says if things go as planned. I can return to riding in three weeks. Sept. 25." Desormeaux's agent, Mike Sellitto, told Daily Racing Form that the jockey won't have to have surgery, but will have to wear a brace for up to two weeks. "He isn't required to do anything, it will heal on its own," he said. "It's a minor crack."

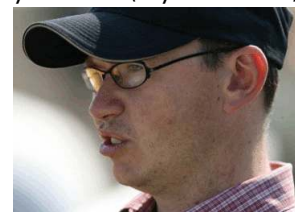
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## in sharper focus.

### SOUPER SPECTACULAR (Giant's Causeway)

It's been a breakthrough Saratoga meeting for native New Yorker Seth Benzel, who currently ranks in the top 10 in the deep trainer standings. The former assistant to Todd Pletcher and Bill Mott reached a milestone at the Spa last weekend, saddling Dynaslew (Dynaformer) to his first Grade II victory in the Ballston Spa H., and looks to have another promising turf runner on his hands with the well-meant Souper Spectacular (Giant's Causeway).

"I grew up in north New York and I call Saratoga my home now," the 35-year-old revealed.

"It's been incredible. Just a little over two years of being on my own, to have a meet like this, it's been a dream come true. I have a great staff--to do it with them, it's extra special."

The expectations couldn't have been any higher for Zenyatta's little bro after fetching seven figures as a yearling, and he looked like one to keep an eye on after coming on late to complete the superfecta in his unveiling ([video](#)).

"I was real happy with his first start," Benzel explained. "I felt like he was ready to go and we needed to lead him over there and introduce him to the game. He was coming hard at the end, and it's pretty much what I figured he would do given from what we had seen from him in the mornings."

Souper Spectacular failed to build on his promising debut after getting bumped soundly at the start when stretched to a route at the Jersey Shore ([video](#)).

"We thought that stretching out in distance would be what he would like, but, unfortunately, he lost all chance at the break when that horse broke into him and caused his hind end to really be compromised over the first couple of jumps of the race," Benzel continued. "From that point on, I thought he was a little flustered and he really didn't get into it. Surprisingly, he didn't have any cuts, but physically he was pretty body sore behind."

Benzel decided to switch things up with Souper Spectacular and put his charge on the infield after a trio of works on the spinach.

"We felt like he had shown that he was struggling with the dirt a little bit and, given his pedigree, we decided to see if he would like the turf," he explained. "Once he started working on it, I thought it was a good angle and it paid off today."

Benzel added that he would take the conservative approach with the son of Broodmare of the Year Vertigineux, and likely return in an allowance spot at the upcoming Belmont fall meeting. -SS
