

DAR RE MI RETIRED

Lord and Lady Lloyd-Webber's homebred **Dar Re Mi (GB)** (Singspiel {Ire}--Darara {Ire}, by Top Ville {Ire}), winner of this year's G1 Dubai Sheema Classic, has been retired from racing, according to *Racing Post*. John Gosden reported that minor issues had prevented him from training his charge for an autumn campaign. The five-year-old mare captured last year's G1 Pretty Polly S. and G1 Yorkshire Oaks and concluded her 2009 campaign with a third-place effort

in the G1 Breeders' Cup Turf at Santa Anita. She returned this term with a 3/4-length tally over the boys on the Meydan turf in the Mar. 27 Sheema Classic and concluded her career with a fourth-place finish in the July 3 G1 Eclipse S. On the board in 14 of 17 starts, Dar Re Mi won six times and earned \$4,356,980.

THE MAXIMUM OF FUISSE

Haras du Quesnay's **Fuisse (Fr)** (Green Tune) delayed the start of Sunday's G1 Prix du Moulin for 15 minutes after getting loose twice, but he made amends, getting up in the final stride to reign supreme in an intriguing tactical renewal of the Longchamp feature. Almost led off the track when eventually caught, the homebred--a detached fourth in the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois at Deauville Aug. 15--was given the green light to walk and trot back to the stalls, and was in relaxed mood by the time they opened for the action. Settled in rear by Stephane Pasquier as **Siyouni (Fr)** (Pivotal {GB}) led, the 10-1 shot was brought with his challenge wide in the straight to deny **Rio de la Plata** (Rahy) and the long-time leader by two heads to lead home a ★ **"TDN Rising Star"** ★ one-two-three. "What a script--no one would believe the story if they hadn't seen it," Fuisse's emotional owner/breeder Alec Head declared. "I was in the stand when he got loose, and we thought we'd run, as we had nothing to lose. He was unbelievable in the race and covers so much ground with his stride--he is just a lovely horse." **Cont. p3**

"LIGHTNING" STORMS TO SPINAWAY SCORE

Giving trainer Todd Pletcher his fourth win in the race in the last 12 years, **R Heat Lightning** (Trippi) collared front-running **Alienation** (Rock Hard Ten) in the stretch before drawing off to take the G1 Spinaway S. at Saratoga Race Course by four lengths. Pletcher did have an advantage in this edition, saddling four of the eight runners. Of the winner, he said, "R Heat Lightning had been training very well in her last couple of breezes and got a good, favorable outside post. I was trying to get her to settle a little bit and make a run, and I thought it was a big performance." Winning jockey Garrett Gomez added, "I was trying to keep her relaxed. Turning for home, I was a little concerned. My filly was doing more than I wanted her to do. But just as I came off the turn, Bob [Baffert]'s filly [Alienation] came back to us, and my filly went on." Pletcher's other Spinaway winners were Circle of Life (Belong to Me), 1999; Ashado (Saint Ballado), 2003; and Adieu (El Corredor), 2005. He has a way to go before catching his mentor, D. Wayne Lukas, however. Lukas has saddled six Spinaway winners. **Cont. p4**



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VINTAGE HOPEFUL

With the defections of Chipshot (Peace Rules), Nacho Saint (Yes It's True) and Printing Press (Tapit), third, fifth and seventh, respectively, in Saturday's GIII Sapling S. at Monmouth, the 106th running of the GI Three Chimneys Hopeful S. has drawn a very short field. But two of the four are ☆ **"TDN Rising Stars"** ☆. **Boys At Tosconova** (Officer) is the morning-line choice off a 12-length victory at Belmont Park July 2. He could be tested by fellow "Star" **Wine Police** (Speightstown). The chestnut opened his career with a 7 3/4-length romp going 5 1/2 furlongs at Saratoga July 24, stopping the timer in 1:03 1/5, just .23 off the track record ([video](#)).

"The most impressive aspect of his debut was the way he relaxed, and then, when I asked him, how professional he was," said jockey Shaun Bridgmohan. "Horses came around him and he didn't panic, and when I asked him to go, he took off." Soldat (War Front), a distant second that afternoon, came back to break his maiden by three lengths on the turf Sept. 3. Wine Police has been working well since his debut score, with a six-panel move in 1:12 4/5 Aug. 25.

Rounding out the field are **Settle for Medal** (Medallist), who closed from off a solid pace to take a six-panel Saratoga maiden test by two lengths July 31; and **Stay Thirsty** (Bernardini), a front-running 5 1/2-length winner over the Spa strip Aug. 14. Of the latter, owner Mike Repole said, "He's bred to go 1 1/4 miles. If you had told me he was going to run so well at 5 1/2 and six furlongs, I would have said, 'You're kidding me.' I believe he'll improve a couple of lengths with every extra furlong."

Fuisse, who earned ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ status in September 2008, gained a first black-type win in impressive style by six lengths in Maisons-Laffitte's Listed Prix Pontarme over a mile last May. The dark bay found only Le Havre (Ire) (Noverre) too strong in the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club over a 1 5/16-mile trip the following month, then was put on the shelf. Returning to be third to Byword (GB) (Peintre Celebre) in the Listed Prix Jacques Laffitte over nine furlongs back at Maisons-Laffitte Apr. 8, he rattled off a trio of wins at this trip in Longchamp's Listed Prix de Montretout May 6, Chantilly's G3 Prix du Chemin de Fer du Nord June 13 and the G3 Prix Messidor at his beloved Maisons-Laffitte July 17. Fuisse was not a factor in the G1 Jacques le Marois last time, but took a leap forward here. Switched off at the back by Stephane Pasquier, he demonstrated that his pre-race antics had cost him little energy. For much of the final furlong, the race looked to be between Siyouni and Rio de la Plata, but Fuisse had the final say in the bobber. "He is never naughty at the racecourse, but can be sometimes in the mornings," trainer Criquette Head-Maarek explained. "We have a few options now, but we will seriously consider the G1 Champion S. Night Magic confirmed her status as Germany's top three-year-old filly when wiring the G1 Preis der Diana (German Oaks) at Dusseldorf last August, but finished last of nine in the G1 Prix de l'Opera de Longchamp on Arc day on her next start. Nailed on the line when second in the G1 Premio Lydia Tesio at the Capannelle on her sophomore finale later in October, the bay was reportedly in season when only seventh in the G1 Premio Presidente Repubblica back at that venue on her seasonal bow May 16. Back to form with a facile score in the G2 Grosser Preis der Hauptstadtregion at Hoppegarten June 6, she was runner-up in the G1 Grosser Dallmayr-Preis at Munich last time July 25. Pulling for her head in rear as stablemate Northern Glory (GB) (Rainbow Quest) set modest early fractions, Night Magic was still last on the home turn, but was pulled wide and given the hurry up at the top of the stretch. Coming with a strong run to hit the front inside the final furlong, the distaffer ran on well to lead home the evergreen Quijano, who was running here for the first time since annexing this prize three years ago. Winning trainer Wolfgang Figge was overwhelmed with emotions afterwards. "Winning the German Oaks with Night Magic was great, but this here at Baden-Baden on the new start in German racing is really something very special and emotional," Figge said. No secret in her career bow, R Heat Lightning was bet down to 9-10 at Delaware July 5 and, despite getting off to a slow start and showing inexperience, galloped away to a five-length score. The bay made her next appearance as the 19-10 second favorite in the Aug. 7 Colleen S. at Monmouth. Rated near the back of the pack early, she fanned five wide into the stretch and closed well to be second, beaten just a length. She was the least fancied of the Pletcher-trained quartet in the Spinaway, but proved much the best.

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R Heat Lightning broke well, but was reined back to caboose the field as stablemate Sky Hosoya (Bluegrass Cat) led through an opening quarter in :21.89. Alienation, shaking off a stumble at the start, took the advantage after a half in :44.74, and still had daylight when they hit the eighth pole. But Garrett Gomez had R Heat Lightning in gear on the outside, and she swept past Alienation and pulled away to a decisive victory. "I think to anybody who had seen her first two races, particularly the Colleen, where she continued to close and close and close, it looked like more ground was going to help her, so it wasn't a surprise to any of us," Todd Pletcher remarked. Looking ahead, he added, "I think we'd have to take a look at the Frizette [GI, Belmont Park, Oct. 9], as long as she comes out of it well." The Pletcher-trained Valiant Passion, favored as 2-1 off a 9 1/4-length debut score at Saratoga Aug. 12, was outfinished late and had to settle for third. "I thought she ran a real big race to the sixteenth pole and, as you can see, she got a little tired," he conditioner said. The Craig homebred was 1-5 to run his record to four-for-four, but made his backers sweat for it. Breaking on top, he drifted wide on the first turn and bore out dramatically to carry Summer Movie (Holy Bull) out past the middle of the track as they hit the backstretch. Maintaining his advantage despite his errant course, he was guided back to the inside, shook off a challenge and, after winning in a hand ride, survived an inquiry to remain unbeaten. Lethal Combination closed out his European campaign with a nine-furlong conditions tally at Newmarket last September. Sixth behind Paddy O' Prado (El Prado {Ire}) in the Mar. 6 GIII Palm Beach H. at Gulfstream, the dark bay returned to win going 8 1/2 panels in allowance company at Keeneland Apr. 14. He was fourth as favorite in the Lamplighter S. at Monmouth May 29, then ran third in Belmont's GIII Hill Prince S. at a mile June 4. In his latest, the gelding was a rallying fourth in this track's one-mile Quick Call S. July 29. Installed the third choice here, Lethal Combination was content to settle off quick fractions carved out by Devon Rock (Rock Hard Ten). He moved into fourth as Turf Melody assumed command at the head of the stretch, surged past the tiring Devon Rock and had enough left to hand Turf Melody a narrow defeat. 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In 10 starts over the last two seasons, Get Serious has finished first--or fifth. Four-for-six in 2009 with a neck score in this event, the chestnut ended the year with a fifth-place finish in the GIII Cliffhanger S. at the Meadowlands in October. He captured a May 31 optional claimer at Monmouth and the June 12 GIII Monmouth S., then ran fifth once again in the July 3 GI United Nations S. Get Serious led gate to wire to take the Aug. 1 GIII Oceanport S., and was odds-on to make it four-for-five on the year. The dedicated frontrunner found himself sitting second after getting off to a rough start, letting longshot At The Disco (Disco Rico) lead through splits of :21.89, :45.10 and 1:08.32. He got the better of that rival at the eighth pole, opened a little breathing room and held on as Nownownow closed in the waning yards. With the win, Get Serious lowered his own course record two ticks to 1:32.37, and surpassed the million-dollar mark in earnings. The win had connections thinking big. "If he comes out of this race as good as he's been coming out of his races, we can't rule out [the GI Breeders' Cup Mile, Nov. 7]," trainer John Forbes said. 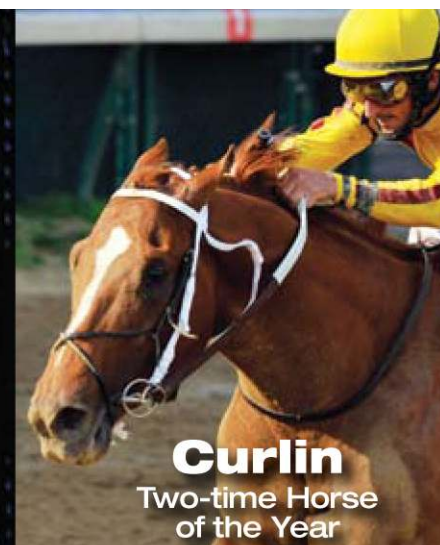

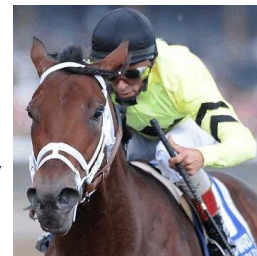

Quality Road Fine After Woodward Win...

Quality Road (Elusive Quality) exited his victory in Saturday's GI Woodward S. in excellent shape, according to trainer Todd Pletcher. "I think there was a lot more in the tank, based on the way he came back; he was hardly even blowing," Pletcher said. "He made the lead kind of easily and coasted home from the eighth pole—he was prepared to run a lot faster had it been necessary, but when you're 4 3/4 lengths clear, it's hard to ask for a whole lot more." Quality Road is expected to train up to the Nov. 6 GI Breeders' Cup Classic, where he will attempt to win at 10 furlongs for the first time in his third try at the distance. The four-year-old was third in last year's GI Travers S. and second in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup. Both of those losses came over sloppy tracks. "The Jockey Club Gold Cup was not a bad race," Pletcher said. "I think he gets 1 1/4 miles; obviously, we'd just like to do it on a fast surface."

Mine That Bird is winless since taking last year's GI Kentucky Derby as a 50-1 longshot, but Lukas doesn't think the bay is ready for retirement. "He's a gelding, we're not going to give him to the orphanage," the trainer said. "He might end up retiring to New Mexico to be a lawn ornament, but at this point, we're going to try and make him useful."

Majesticperfection Injured...

Majesticperfection (Harlan's Holiday), winner of Saratoga's GI Alfred G. Vanderbilt Aug. 8, sustained a condylar fracture to his right front leg during a Sunday morning workout at the Spa, reports *Daily Racing Form*. The four-year-old, who also won the Iowa Sprint H. June 25, was scheduled to undergo surgery at the Saratoga Equine Clinic yesterday morning to stabilize the cannon bone. The Vanderbilt was a defining race for him; he showed what he could do at Saratoga." Earlier this season, Padua took a hit with the loss of three-year-old Odysseus (Malibu Moon), who was euthanized due to complications from laminitis. "This is a very tough game," Sanan told *DRF*. "We lost Odysseus and then you lose this one; it's a very tough game."

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Here Comes Ben Looking Ahead...

Here Comes Ben (Street Cry {Ire}) appeared to be in fine shape Sunday, a day after his 3/4-length victory in the GI Forego S. "He was a little tired, but his legs and everything looked good," reported trainer Charles Lopresti. Here Comes Ben will ship to Kentucky Wednesday before a decision is made on his next start. "We'll bring him to Keeneland and evaluate," Lopresti added. "The Breeders' Cup is our goal." Godolphin's **Vineyard Haven** (Lido Palace {Chi}) and **Girolamo** (A.P. Indy), third and fifth, respectively, in the Forego, were both in good shape yesterday. "With Vineyard Haven, we're a little disappointed in him," admitted assistant trainer Rick Mettee. 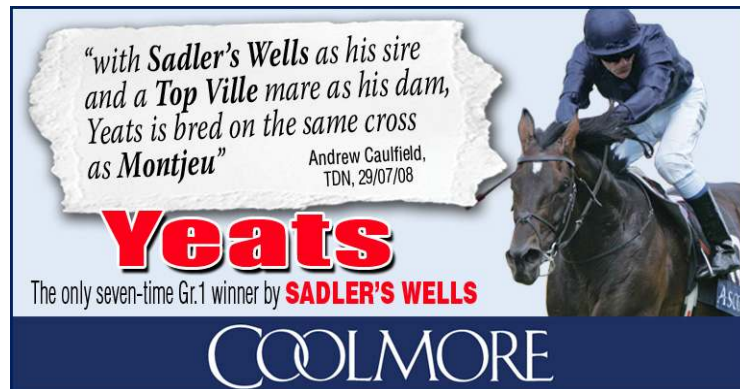
