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BOYS TO MAN

Boys at Tosconova (Officer) went to the post in yesterday's G1 Hopeful S. at Saratoga carrying plenty of hype as the heavy 1-2 favorite and proved he was worthy of all the buzz with a professional 1 3/4-length score against just three rivals.

The dark bay colt was reserved in a stalking third as **Stay Thirsty** (Bernardini) took the short field through fractions of :23.15 and :46.38 with **Wine Police** (Speightstown) in close attendance. Boys at Tosconova ranged up three wide into the lane and always looked the best as he reeled in the pace-setters down the stretch for a confident score. Stay Thirsty held on stubbornly for second, 1 3/4 lengths in front of Wine Police. "He was good enough

to get this job done the right way," trainer Rick Dutrow said of the winner. "He's very exciting to be around. I thought we had the best horse in the race." Boys at Tosconova also impressed jockey Ramon Dominguez. "When he broke, I just decided to put him where he was comfortable, so I just eased him to the outside," Dominguez explained. "He did it so easy and he even galloped out strong past the seven-eighths pole. Every time you give him a chance, he will take a deep breath, relax, and look around. He's very, very professional. I didn't have to hit him today and, hopefully, I won't have to. It was that easy." **Cont. p2**

GOTTA HAVE ANOTHER PALOMAR

Gotta Have Her (Royal Academy), the crowd's even-money pick, forged to the lead turning for home and outbattled **Go Forth North** (North Light {Ire}) to the wire to score by a neck in yesterday's GII Palomar H. at Del Mar. The six-year-old mare was always within striking distance behind moderate splits and moved to the front when Mike Smith asked her for more in upper stretch. "I was worried about hitting the front too soon," Smith admitted. "You don't want to do that with her. She'll pull herself up. But it worked out fine." Trainer Jenine Sahadi admitted to a few anxious moments. "I was concerned when I saw the :26 [first quarter]," Sahadi said. "I knew they were going slow and she doesn't have a real huge turn of foot. I'm really proud of her. She's really special." Gotta Have Her enjoyed a stand-out 2009 season, hitting the board in all nine of her starts, including victory in last year's Palomar. She ended her campaign with a runner-up effort in the Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint. When I asked her, she kicked it up very well. She had plenty of gas left." Trainer Tom Proctor said Keertana could start next in the Oct. 2 GI Flower Bowl Invitational en route to the Nov. 5 GI Breeders' Cup F/M Turf. Favored Forever Together looked to be enjoying an ideal stalking trip, but fell back on the final bend and couldn't keep pace with the top two. "She was sitting perfectly in the first half of the race," commented trainer Jonathan Sheppard. "But as they went on [jockey Julien Leparoux] let her drop farther and farther back, so then she had too much ground to make up."

SHOW ME THE MONEY... MONMOUTH 2010

MONMOUTH ELITE MEET ENDS The experimental Elite Summer Meet at Monmouth Park concluded Monday, and officials were thrilled with the results. "We were cautiously optimistic that this kind of boutique meeting would work, but I don't think any of us expected a blockbuster like this," said Dennis Robinson, president and CEO of the New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority. "The fans and the horsemen made this a meeting to remember." The 49-day meeting offered the highest purses in the nation at a daily average of \$797,079, which resulted in an average field size of 9.28 horses per race--up 24.7 percent from a year ago. "The dramatic increase in field size is one of the most critical factors in our increased business," Robinson said. "The fans responded enthusiastically to the larger fields the way we hoped they would." The handle for the meet totaled \$389,550,798, up 87 percent from the \$208,390,601 wagered over 82-stand in 2009. On-track handle was \$37,558,779 this season, up 7.1 percent from the \$35,050,572 bet on-track in 2009. The average attendance in 2010 was 10,651, up 47 percent from last year. There was a three-way tie for leading trainer, with Bruce Alexander, Steve Asmussen and Todd Pletcher each sending out 20 winners. Paco Lopez was leading rider with 69 victories, while George and Lori Hall topped all owners with 13 wins. Racing will continue at Monmouth Saturdays and Sundays Sept. 11 through Nov. 21, with purses averaging \$375,000 daily.

NUMBERS DOWN AT SARATOGA Daily average all-sources handle dipped 3.4 percent and daily average on-track handle was down 7.4 percent during the 2010 Saratoga meet, which concluded its expanded 40-day stand yesterday. Daily average attendance for the Saratoga meet was 21,957, down 7.4 percent from last year's 23,734. The numbers are compared with last year's 36-day meet, which saw 2.5 fewer races contested. A New York Racing Association press release pointed out that the track outperformed the 7.3-percent decline in U.S. wagering year-to-date compared to 2009, and the 8.0-percent decline in wagering in August over the same month last year. NYRA also reported that more than \$353 million of \$1.12 billion wagered on Thoroughbred races at some 35 tracks operating in August--32 percent--was bet at Saratoga. All in all, NYRA officials said that were happy with the meet's results. "We budgeted all-sources handle--our predominant financial measure--to be down about five percent due to the continued economic downturn, and the earlier July start, so we are gratified that these final figures beat our expectations," said President and CEO Charles Hayward.

REWILDING HEADS LEGER DOZEN

Godolphin's **Rewilding (GB)** (Tiger Hill {Ire}) yesterday headed the 12 entries remaining for Saturday's G1 St Leger at Doncaster. The Aug. 17 G2 Great Voltigeur S. winner is set to renew rivalry with the Baldydoyle duo of **Midas Touch (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}) and **Joshua Tree (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}), who chased him home in second and third, respectively, at York. Godolphin's Racing Manager Simon Crisford revealed that the July 8 G3 Bahrain Trophy winner **Corsica (Ire)** (Cape Cross {Ire}) would be used as a pacemaker for Rewilding. "Rewilding has done very well since winning at York--[trainer] Mahmood [Al Zarooni] has been extremely happy with Rewilding--he is a very straightforward colt and does not carry a lot of condition," said Crisford. There are some fabulous horses in the Ladbrokes St Leger, and he has to be every bit as good as he was at York. Corsica will be pacemaking for Rewilding. Obviously, he will be running on his own merits. He is a natural front-runner and has every right to be in the race himself, but his primary task will be to set the pace for Rewilding." Aidan O'Brien has two others engaged, including ☆ **"TDN Rising Star" ☆ Flying Cross (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), who made a successful belated three-year-old bow in a 12-furlong conditions event at Tipperary Aug. 26, while Ed Dunlop is looking to run Cristina Patino's G1 Epsom and Irish Oaks heroine **Snow Fairy (Ire)** (Intikhab). The Elite Racing Club's **Dandino (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) and Rachel Hood and Robin Geffen's **Arctic Cosmos** (North Light {Ire}), second and third, respectively, in the G3 Gordon S. at Goodwood last time July 27, are other notables left in the extended 14-furlong contest. While Doncaster's ground is currently good-to-firm, significant rain is forecast. Clerk of the Course David Williams said yesterday, "During this evening and overnight into Tuesday, we could get anything between 20 and 30 millimetres of rain, and we could see some more light rain on Friday, so it's looking unsettled. It's been dry for much of the year, and we've pretty much had a drought here, so it would be nice to see some rain but not that amount. It's certainly going to be on the easier side of good, and I think the ground is going to be pretty cut up by Saturday."

The sires' championship in Britain and Ireland may still have nearly four months left to run, but the race is surely as good as over following the Tattersalls Millions Irish Champion S. With Cape Blanco impressively defeating his paternal half-brother Rip Van Winkle, to remind us that he's very hard to beat when on song, their sire Galileo now looks to have the championship in his pocket.

According to *Racing Post*, the 12-year-old stallion's progeny earnings for 2010 currently stand at £3,904,099, a figure more than £2-million higher than that of his nearest pursuer, Dansili. It took "only" £3,827,297 for Danehill Dancer to secure the championship in 2009 and Galileo took the 2008 title with £3,974,492. If Galileo does indeed secure his second sires' title, it will mean that a Coolmore stallion has been champion every year since Blushing Groom topped the table way back in 1989, which amounts to an extraordinary achievement. **Cont. p8**

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Although Danehill Dancer is currently down in fourth place, behind Galileo, Dansili and Oasis Dream, he too is having another memorable season, with his daughter Lillie Langtry providing the highlights with her Group 1 victories in the Coronation S. and Matron S. She is one of eight group winners this year for her sire, who spent the first four years of his stallion career (1998 to 2001) at a Coolmore substation at fees no higher than 4,000 Irish guineas.

Those inexpensive crops did so well that Danehill Dancer became a Top 20 stallion in 2002 and 2003, sending his fee soaring to €30,000 in 2003 and €45,000 in 2004. However, it was his exploits in 2005 that effectively catapulted him into the big time. Second to his sire Danehill among the sires of two-year-olds, Danehill Dancer finished eighth on the general sires' table, even though his five crops of racing-age had all been sired at fees no higher than Ir£9,000.

That breakthrough year resulted in Danehill Dancer's fee being boosted to €75,000 in 2006, the year his current crop of three-year-olds was conceived. As this crop numbers around 160 foals, it is only fair to expect it to achieve some impressive figures. So far the stakes winner count stands at 11, with eight of them--a pleasing five percent of the crop--scoring at group level. This total of group winners should rise higher, as another seven members of the crop have been group placed, including Remember When (third in the Oaks after finishing a close fourth in the Irish 1000 Guineas) and Shamanova (beaten a neck in the G3 Prix Minerve).

Expectations are going to be even higher of Danehill Dancer's 2008 and 2009 crops, as they were sired at fees of €115,000. The 2008 crop has made a bright start, thanks to the dual group winner Memory, Group 1-placed Kissable and Group 2-placed Samuel Morse. As this crop is a good deal smaller than its immediate predecessor, with 111 foals, it may struggle to match the predecessor's number of stakes winners. I am also wondering whether there will be a significant change in the distance requirements of the horses from these very high-priced crops.

As Danehill Dancer gained his Group 1 wins over six and seven furlongs as a two-year-old, he was originally categorized by many breeders as cheap speed. That natural speed helped him become champion sire of two-year-olds in 2006, 2008 and 2009, but Danehill Dancer is now demonstrating the sort of versatility that marked Danehill's career, especially in his later crops. Danehill Dancer's 2010 stakes winners include Contredanse (G2 Oaks d'Italano over 1 3/8 miles), Planteur (beaten less than a length in the Grand Prix de Paris over a mile and a half), Rebel Soldier (G3 Gordon S. over a mile and a half) and Lady Eclair (a listed winner over 13.4 furlongs).

All horses in the *TDN* are bred in North America, unless otherwise indicated

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The broodmare sires of these last four stakes winners are Rahy, Giant's Causeway, Irish River and Explodent, none of whom raced beyond a mile and a quarter, so we can expect some mile-and-a-half performers among his progeny out of mares by such as Sadler's Wells, Galileo and Montjeu.

That said, there is plenty of stamina in the pedigree of Lillie Langtry, yet she has done her winning from six furlongs to a mile, and has yet to tackle more than a mile. The pedigree of her dam Hoity Toity features such noted influences for stamina as Darshaan, Shirley Heights, Mill Reef and Nijinsky, and Lillie Langtry's fourth dam Vive la Reine was a sister to the brilliant Arc winner Vaguely Noble.

Darshaan mares have enjoyed so much success with Sadler's Wells that they have spent much of their time visiting Sadler's Wells or his sons. To the end of 2009 there were roughly 475 foals of racing age bred this way. This emphasis on Sadler's Wells means that Darshaan mares have far fewer foals by Danehill and his sons--a total of 82. Lillie Langtry is the third of them to win at Group 1 level, following Danehill's Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud winner Mountain High and Rock of Gibraltar's Hong Kong Group 1 winner Eagle Mountain. Catcher in the Rye, another of Danehill's sons out of a Darshaan mare, was a rather unlucky loser of the 2003 French 2000 Guineas, and is now doing well as a sire in Argentina. **Cont. p9**



Danehill Dancer has nine foals out of Darshaan mares, all of which have started and seven of which have won. Four of the nine have earned black type, the other stakes winner being that tough Irish mare Jalmira, three times a listed winner at around a mile.

Lillie Langtry's dam Hoity Toity made only 15,000gns as a two-year-old from the Gainsborough Stud draft at Tattersalls' 2002 December Sales. Her price no doubt owed a lot to the fact that neither Hoity Toity nor her dam, the Shadeed mare Hiwaayati, had raced. Hiwaayati also hadn't made much of an impact up to that point, but she is now the second dam of the smart Winged Cupid.

As you would expect of a Gainsborough product, Hiwaayati was very well-related, being a half-sister to the very smart Nureyev colts Lead On Time (Prix Maurice de Gheest) and Great Commotion (Cork and Orrery S.).

Before leaving the topic of Danehill Dancer, he now has several stallion sons. One of them, Choisir, had a setback when his accomplished son Starspangledbanner disappointed as favorite in Saturday's Betfred Sprint Cup. Another son, Monsieur Bond, has some talented representatives in Gilt Edge Girl, Ladies Are Forever (inbred 3x3 to Danehill) and My Name Is Bond. The last named colt looked licensed to thrill when he landed Sunday's G3 Prix La Rochette with much more in hand than his winning margin suggested.



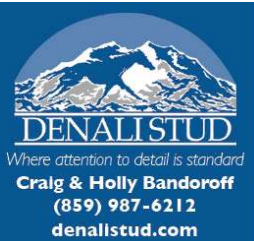

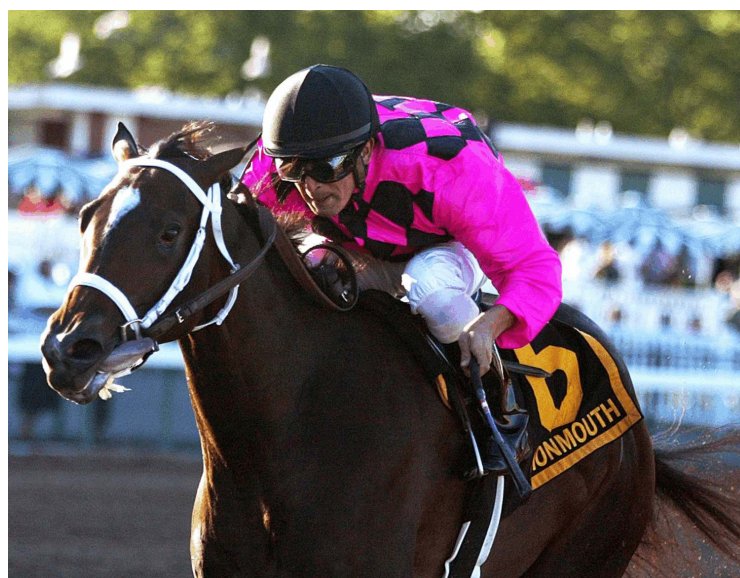

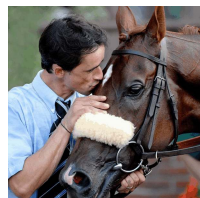
