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SMART STRIKE CO-TOPPERS AT KEENELAND

A pair of yearlings by Smart Strike, both consigned by Gainesway, topped Thursday's session of the Keeneland September sale in Lexington with identical bids of \$550,000. Zayat Stables was the first to bid that figure, bringing home a son of the Lane's End stallion ([hip 985](#)). Later in the session, George Bolton took home a daughter of the 18-year-old sire for the same price ([hip 1082](#)). "It's just all about power, passion and performance," Gainesway's Michael Hernon said yesterday. "The horses were very well-liked and we expected a good sale. We've had a great run of stakes

winner and graded stakes winners coming out of the Gainesway shedrow, and I think that set the tone for a good sale. And we have some popular horses selling tomorrow." During yesterday's fifth session of the September sale, 197 yearlings grossed \$23,234,000 for an average of \$117,939. The median for the third Book 2 session was \$100,000--up from \$97,500 Tuesday and \$85,000 Wednesday. There were 84 horses reported not sold for a buy-back rate of 29.89 percent. "The sale continues to go along as we hoped," reported Keeneland's Director of Sales Geoffrey Russell. "This session brought the highest median and highest clearance rate of Book 2 so far, which we view as a positive sign. We have lots of buyers on the grounds--a nice mix of familiar faces as well as new ones. They are all here looking for a good value on a quality horse, and, as we've seen all week, there's some spirited bidding going on for the really good horses. So far, we're pleased with how Book 2 is going." Through the first five days of the marathon auction, 724 horses have sold for \$118,690,000. The cumulative average stands at \$163,936, while the median is \$110,000. The buy-back rate is 31.63 percent.

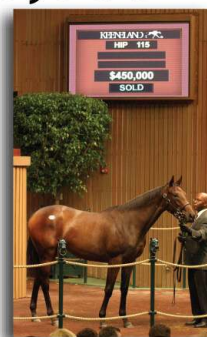
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Smart Strike Colt to Zayat Stables...

Zayat Stables went to \$550,000 to secure a colt by Smart Strike Thursday at Keeneland September.

"He was our favorite horse in Book 2," explained Bradley Weisbord, who handled bidding for the New Jersey-based operation of Ahmed Zayat. "Mr. Zayat loved the horse, his advisors loved the horse, and he thought this was a must buy."

Weisbord admitted he was quickly approaching his final bid. "I was stretching my limit," he said. "I was close. But Mr. Zayat said it was a must-have. He said, 'Go get the horse.' So I had to get the horse."

The handsome bay colt, consigned by Gainesway, is out of Madame Thor (Deputy Minister) and is a half-brother to stakes-placed Star Defender (Vindication). His second dam is GSW Broad Dynamite (Broad Brush).

The yearling was the most expensive of eight youngsters purchased so far at Keeneland by Zayat Stables. The organization also purchased a son of Awesome Again ([hip 102](#)) for \$325,000 and a colt by Empire Maker ([hip 220](#)) for \$260,000.

Smart Strike Colt a Team Gainesway Effort...

Madame Thor, with this foal in utero, was purchased for \$310,000 out of the 2008 Keeneland November sale. The now 11-year-old mare was purchased by Centennial Farm, in partnership with Gainesway, to support Centennial's Grade I winner Corinthian (Pulpit), who stands at Gainesway.

The yearling's path to the Keeneland sales ring, which began shortly after 6 p.m. on a February evening last year, was anything but smooth, according to Gainesway's Michael Hernon.

"This colt had a rather rocky start," Hernon recalled. "In the Greentree foaling barn upon his arrival, he was attended to by broodmare manager John Slugantz and [Gainesway general manager] Neil Howard. They quickly noticed he wasn't breathing. Johnny was on his hands and knees giving him mouth-to-mouth resuscitation, or really mouth-to-muzzle resuscitation, while Neil was whispering in his ear, 'Hurry up and breathe, I want to get to Jalapenos for dinner.'"

"The colt responded, took a good deep breath and, sometime later, decided to get up and give life a go. It was a real team effort from the beginning. Obviously the mare played her part, and the colt was ably assisted, literally, from birth and he blossomed on the fertile pastures of Greentree."

Hernon was satisfied with the yearling's \$550,000 price tag.

"The price was terrific," Hernon said. "The colt went up to the ring with an academic reserve of \$149,000--we bring them here to sell. Everybody recognized him as a horse with lots of potential. He just floats over the ground. He attracted many, if not all, of what would be considered the top horsemen attending the sale. He was vetted 16 times...once you got around him you could see his class."

Of Madame Thor, Hernon explained, "She was one of a handful of mares bought in partnership with Centennial to support Corinthian with quality mares in his initial years, to help him get off the ground. He's been remarkable at stud. Even this year, in the historically difficult third year at stud, Corinthian attracted 150 mares. He's a remarkably fertile horse and he's very well positioned going forward with three very large books of quality mares underneath him. We feel like we've done our job and now they have to go out and run on the track."

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Bolton Still Hot on Day 5...

George Bolton, centrally stationed inside the pavilion with advisor John Moynihan, was the winning bidder just once yesterday, but he certainly made it count, going to \$550,000 to purchase a filly by Lane's End stallion Smart Strike ([hip 1082](#)). Offered by Gainseway, acting on behalf of Jess Jackson's Stonestreet Thoroughbred Holdings, the bay is out of SW and GSP My Miss Storm Cat (Sea of Secrets).

"She's beautifully bred and was John's favorite filly in the sale," said Bolton. "He wanted me to stretch a little bit and get this one."

Was it more than Bolton anticipated paying to se-

cure the attractive filly?

"It's always more, but when everyone is going to \$350,000 to \$400,000, you know that's not where it's going to end," the San Francisco resident explained. "We knew it was going to be a little bit more, but we didn't want to lose her. This was pretty much our limit."

Moynihan was happy to pick up the Smart Strike filly after bailing out at \$650,000 for Wednesday's session toppler.

"We were underbidders on the Malibu Moon [who brought \$700,000 Wednesday]," he confirmed. "We would have had to pay \$750,000 for that filly, and we're happy to have this one at \$550,000."

Moynihan, whose main client is Stonestreet, said of yesterday's co-session topping yearling, and highest-priced filly, "This filly is one of the best we've raised this year. We absolutely loved the family. The mare was fast, fast, fast."

Moynihan, on behalf of Ed and Natalie Friendly, purchased My Miss Storm Cat at this sale in 2003 for \$70,000. A 10-length debut winner at Hollywood in May 2004, the fleet filly stopped the timer in :56 2/5 for five furlongs, just a tick off the track record. In her only other start at two, she was third in the GIII Landaluce S. A winner of four of five subsequent starts, including the six-furlong Desert Stormer H. at four, the Bob Baffert trainee was retired in 2006 because of ongoing issues with her feet. Bred to Unbridled's Song the following spring, she was entered in the 2007 Keeneland November sale.

"Ed Friendly didn't really have many broodmares, so we brought her to the sale," Moynihan explained. "He didn't breed much--his operation was primarily based on racing."



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Bidding for Stonestreet, Moynihan secured the the mare for \$925,000. The resulting foal, a colt named Albergatti, was retained by Jackson after colicking prior to an intended date at last year's September sale. He is currently in training with Steve Asmussen.

"We have very high hopes for him," said Moynihan.

Of the decision to send My Miss Storm Cat to Smart Strike, Moynihan explained, "We thought the physicals would work. Smart Strike is such a great stallion, and the mare is absolutely gorgeous--so is this filly. Hopefully, we'll have some good fortune with her."

Bolton, who employs trainer Bob Baffert for his West Coast division and has horses on the East Coast with Sreve Asmussen and Todd Pletcher, will not decide where to send his latest acquisition until next season.

"We'll make that decision in May, because when we make it early, something always goes wrong," said Bolton. "Jerry Bailey will break her down in Ocala and, by next May, we'll know a little bit about her and see how she's doing and where she's going."

Explaining the impetus to spend money this fall, Bolton added, "The bloodstock market feels like it's bottoming out, and a lot of good things are happening in racing. They're putting slots in New York and dirt back at Santa Anita, and new owners down here are buying. So we'll stretch a little more with some confidence versus last year at this time."--C Bossinakis

Hip 928, a bay filly by Tiznow, brought a \$350,000 final bid from Westrock Stables at Keeneland yesterday afternoon. Consigned by Taylor Made Sales Agency,

the bay, bred by WinStar Farm, is out of another WinStar-bred, six-year-old Lajitas (Siphon {Brz}).

"She was just a special filly," said WinStar's Elliott Walden. "She took the good qualities from Tiznow, and her dam, Lajitas, was a very pretty herself. She passed that on."

"We were very happy with the price, given this market," added Walden. "We were hoping for between \$200,000 and \$400,000."

Debating during her sophomore season, Lajitas--who is out of WinStar's Sweet Damsel (Turkoman)--showed little on the track in her first three career starts in the winter and spring of 2007 before finally breaking through with a win against \$25,000 maiden claimers at Arlington Park in June. A well-beaten seventh at Canterbury that July, she would make one more appearance, but was seventh once again at Arlington Aug. 26.

It is unlikely WinStar would have held on to her, were in not for an event a little more than a month later that changed the course of her future. Her year-younger half-brother by Tiznow--named Colonel John--was a close-up second in his career bow at Del Mar Aug. 19, and was named a ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ after a 4 1/2-length score at Oak Tree Oct. 7.

"Her value on the racetrack was limited," explained Walden. "But after Colonel John won, she became a lot more valuable as a broodmare, so we retired her."

Upon retirement, WinStar made the logical decision to send Lajitas, who is also a half-sister to GISP Mr. Hot Stuff (Tiznow) and GSP Caroline's Gold (Touch Gold), to WinStar resident stallion Tiznow.

"We decided to send her to Tiznow because of the Colonel John angle," confirmed Walden. "It's a cross that has worked very well in the past."--C Bossinakis

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Empire Maker Colt to Scatuorchio...

Trainer Todd Pletcher and owner James Scatuorchio walked into the Keeneland sales pavilion just before [hip 1149](#) entered the ring and stayed just long enough to secure the Empire Maker colt with a final bid of \$370,000. The yearling is out of Perfect Solution (Seeking the Gold), a daughter of multiple Grade I winner Dispute (Danzig).

"He's a classically bred, two-turn horse and he's the kind of horse we were looking for," Pletcher said after the purchase. "He's well-balanced, athletic and he looks like he can get the trip. I like Empire Maker, because he gives you the potential to get a Classic horse. I thought he was an exceptional individual."

The colt was the third-highest-priced yearling during Thursday's session.

"I guess it's on par with what I expected," Pletcher added. "There are usually a lot of people on horses that check all the boxes."

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EQB Strong at Sales...

The E in EQB might well stand for everywhere. As in, if you look at a Book 2 sales sheet, you'll see the EQB name *everywhere*. Or, if you walk around the backstretch, you'll see the operation's vice president Patti Miller *everywhere*. Or so it seemed.

run by Miller and Jeff Seder, has resulted in the purchase of no fewer than 16 yearlings at September, included seven during yesterday's session. EQB's top-priced purchase Thursday was [hip 958](#), a filly by Malibu Moon out of graded stakes-placed Listen (Chester House) who was knocked down for \$270,000. Craig and Holly Bandoroff's Denali Stud consigned the pinhooked chestnut, who had been acquired for \$160,000 by Alistair Roden

Bloodstock at last year's Keeneland November Sale.

"She was really quite nice," Miller said. "Everybody on the team liked her. She had a clean vet, a tremendous cardiac profile, and a very good physical. She was a fantastic individual."

EQB also purchased a Monarchos full-brother to champion Informed Decision--herself a one-time EQB acquisition--for \$200,000, as well as a colt by Tapit for \$200,000; a colt by Distorted Humor for \$160,000; a filly by War Front for \$120,000; a filly by Dixieland Band for \$100,000; and a colt by Arch for \$50,000. EQB was the day's leading buyer with \$1.1 million in expenditures, and the sale's third-leading buyer with \$2,785,000 in expenditures. That equates to an average of \$174,063 per horse.

Yesterday afternoon, Miller, hunkered down with her buying team in the Keeneland dining room, took advantage of a brief break in the action to talk about her busy September. Miller explained that the vast majority of her buys were for a single client who she declined to identify. Miller described the client as "a very successful businessman" with ties to the racing industry.

"He's a great client who wants to win some races," she said. "He already has a big racing stable and uses several different trainers. I've bought for him off and on through the years, and he just decided to step it up this year. He's always owned a lot of horses, but he often pinhooked or did things like that. But he decided he wanted to just focus on racing, so most of these horses are being pointed to the track."

Miller said her client is primarily looking for Classic-type horses.

"Since we do cardiac profiles, we're very good at spotting two-turn kinds of horses, and I have a pretty good eye for horses that have been successful going long," Miller said. "But we love sprinters, too. There's nothing better than a fast horse."

Miller said EQB's considerable involvement at September has everything to do with taking advantage of current market conditions.

"I think this is a buyer's market," she said. "I think we've gotten some top horses for very reasonable prices. There's a ceiling here that's not crazy, and I think it's a great time for people looking to get in the business and not feel like they have to spend a ton of money. That's one of the reasons we came here. We thought with the banks and all these people having to sell, that we'd at least get an honest shake. And we have--we're very happy. We've bought some terrific individuals for probably 60 cents on the dollar. I mean, I think we stole an Arch colt today for \$50,000 [\[hip 1142\]](#) from [Paul Mills and Philip J. Steinberg]. He was a lovely, lovely horse who was just completely overlooked. But I like all my horses. I don't feel I've had to compromise at all. That's a real luxury."

EQB, an agency that, according to its website, uses "equine biomechanics, cardiovascular characteristics, gait analysis, and fatigue curve" to judge horses, is coming off a banner few years. In addition to the aforementioned Informed Decision, EQB has purchased or recommended the purchases of horses such as Eskendereya (Giant's Causeway), champion Forever Together (Belong to Me), Zensational (Unbridled's Song) and recent Saratoga Grade I winner Rightly So (Read the Footnotes). -LM

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Good Results for Ex-Lakin Runners...

Prominent owner and breeder Lewis Lakin enjoyed a fine Thursday afternoon at Keeneland September when a pair of yearlings produced by mares he once raced

brought high prices. First up was [hip 884](#), a colt by Pulpit out of Just a Ginny (Go For Gin) who made \$300,000 on the strength of agent Ben Glass's bid. Glass is the bloodstock agent and racing manager for Gary and Mary West, whose homebred Major Gain (More Than Ready) just won the GIII Arlington-Washington Futurity at Arlington Park.

Just a Ginny wore Lakin's colors when she won a 10-furlong NW2X allowance on the Belmont lawn back in 2001. Unplaced in her lone stakes try, Just a Ginny is nonetheless batting 1.000 when it comes to stakes winners to starters. Her first foal, Logic Way (Freud), was a SW and GSP New York-bed that has banked over \$480,000. Her second was Big Truck (Hook and Ladder), who earned his way into the 2008 GI Kentucky Derby after winning the GIII Tampa Bay Derby. Big Truck was purchased by Eric Fein as a juvenile for \$90,000 at the Fasig-Tipton Midlantic Sale. Just a Ginny's third foal, Be a Ginny (Freud) was a modest \$6,500 KEEJAN short yearling in 2007, but kept the stakes-winning streak alive when she won a black-type event in Puerto Rico last term. Just a Ginny's three-year-old daughter Unforgettableginny (Unforgettable Max) and two-year-old son Cash Michael (Unbridled Energy), a \$100,000 BARMAR juvenile this year, are both unraced.

Lakin struck once again with [hip 952](#)--named Life's a Roar--a Lion Heart half-brother to this year's top sophomore speedster Eightyfiveinafifty (Forest Camp). The colt brought a bid of \$350,000 from bloodstock agent Reynolds Bell Jr. He was produced by the 11-year-old Lifeinthefastlane, a daughter of Unbridled's Song purchased by Lakin for \$150,000 as a two-year-old in training at the OBS February Sale back in 2001.

She made four starts with trainer Bill Mott, but failed to win and was retired. Lakin retained faith, however, and is now being rewarded.

Lifeinthefastlane's third foal, Grey Chatelaine (Forest Camp), was a \$150,000 FTKJUL yearling, and her fourth, the \$100,000 OBSMAR juvenile Eightyfiveinafifty, has put some real pep in the pedigree. That Gary Contessa-trained colt won the GIII Bay Shore S. this spring, but was sidelined by a bout of pneumonia.

"I think this colt is even better than Eightyfiveinafifty," Lakin said yesterday. "I think he'll get two turns. But he's going to be fast. He's an alert horse, and he's never taken a bad step."

Lakin bred the horses under the A. Lakin & Sons banner, and consigned them through Lakland Sales, of which he's a principal.

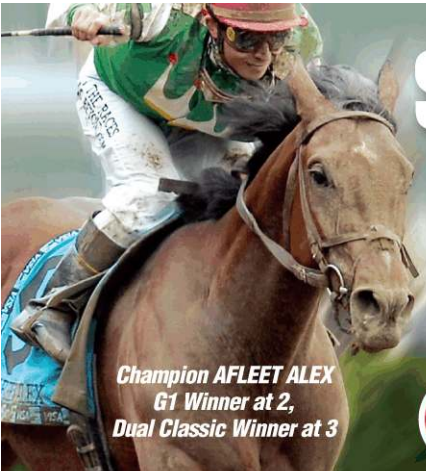
Asked about the success of his ex-runners, Lakin said, "They ran and they looked good, and sometimes they can be good mares when they're like that." -LM

Streets of Gold: Street Magician King Brings \$350K...

R. Larry Johnson was all smiles yesterday after watching [hip 989](#), a Street Cry (Ire) full-brother to GSW Street Magician that he bred out of Magical Meadow (Meadowlake), bring \$350,000. The horse was purchased by Northwest Stud Stable Inc. from the draft of Betz Thoroughbreds Inc. Making the transaction particularly special to Johnson was the fact that the colt represents the fourth generation of a family he's owned and cultivated for nearly 35 years.

"It all goes back to Ran's Chick," explained Johnson, referring to the chestnut's unraced third dam. By The Big Boss, Ran's Chick produced the stakes winners Turf To T. J. (Turn to Reason) and Special Kell (Parfaitement) for Johnson, and the latter produced hip 989's dam, Magical Meadow.

Johnson, who owns and operates Legacy Farm in Virginia, had initially offered Magical Meadow at the 1996 Fasig-Tipton Saratoga Sale, and sold her to Martin Gellman for \$120,000. But the filly was forced into retirement before she could race. Cont. p7

"She was a very pretty, attractive filly that just had bad luck and got hurt," Johnson explained. "So I made a deal with the guy who had bought her to buy her back. I love Meadowlake; he's a terrific broodmare sire."

From Magical Meadow, Johnson bred Street Magician, a fast sprinter who won five of 10 starts for Johnson and trainer Michael Trombetta. Street Magician won the six-furlong Aventura S. at Gulfstream as a three-year-old of 2007, then secured a career best when adding the GIII Hirsch Jacobs S. ([video](#)) at Pimlico later that spring. Street Magician also won the \$100,000 Karl Boyes Memorial S. at Presque Isle last term.

Last week, it was announced that Street Magician had been retired to Northview Stallion Station's Maryland division. The horse's introductory fee is \$3,000, stands and nurses. Johnson, who has a broodmare band of roughly 20 mares, has retained ownership of the stallion and said he will support him at stud.

"I might buy a few [to breed to him], but I've got a lot of my own I've already identified that I'll send to him," said Johnson. "I race more than I sell, so I'll breed three or four mares to more commercial stallions, then breed the ones I think can produce racehorses, but who are a little less commercial, to Street Magician."

Johnson sees some similarities between Street Magician and his yearling brother, but said the latter would be a standout regardless of his page.

"He's a special kind of horse," Johnson said. "Being a full to a graded stakes winner helps, but in his own right, he's pretty special. He has probably a little more Meadowlake influence than Street Magician. He's got more scope. He might go two turns, where Street Magician was much more at home around seven furlongs."

Other horses tracing to Ran's Chick that were bred and/or race by Johnson's Legacy Farm include MSW and MGSP Partner's Due (Partner's Hero) and SW and GSP Star Trace (Star de Naskra).

"I love the family, and it's been very good to me," said Johnson. "I think I've gotten something like 25 stakes horses from the family."

If the family's been good to Johnson, so too has Street Cry (Ire). In addition to Street Magician, he also bred this year's GI Shoemaker Mile upsetter Victor's Cry, a five-year-old by the Darley stallion. Victor's Cry was bred under the Legacy banner and sold for \$150,000 as an FTKJUL yearling.

"I loved Street Cry watching him race, and I think the people at Darley are the best," said Johnson. "I thought he had a legitimate shot to make it as a sire, and I bred to him in his first crop and every year since. Well, not now--not at \$150,000! I'll let somebody else do that. But I have bred to his sons Street Sense and Street Boss. Street Cry's horses can do anything--long, short, grass, dirt, synthetic."

In addition to being a breeder, Johnson is a forensic accountant and does considerable work providing expert witness testimony at trial.

"I figure out why a company went bust and who caused it," Johnson, previously a partner at the accounting powerhouse Ernst and Young, explained.

Johnson said he comes to racing honestly. "My grandfather was an old gypsy trainer who used to train at the half-mile racetracks," he chuckled. "He had \$500 horses, and I used to hang around the tracks with him."

Of his own operation, he said. "I've tried to work up from a reasonably inexpensive group of horses, and got lucky." -LM

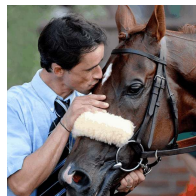

U.S. Stallions--Perception Versus Reality...

The old adage that perception is reality has always been applicable to the Thoroughbred industry, with more weight being given to word of mouth than facts and figures. Although this is beginning to change, as the Thoroughbred industry moves grudgingly with the times, there remains a tendency for fashion and opinion to dictate.

That reflection is in reference to the prevailing sentiment that U.S.-based stallions, especially the younger generation, are not suited to European racing. Yet U.S. stallions are enjoying another vintage year across the pond. While Darley's freshman sire Bernardini (A.P. Indy) was always likely to make an impact in his native land, his European runners have been somewhat of a revelation. Theyskens' Theory, Treasury Devil and Biondetti have excelled on the European turf, and feature prominently in the betting for next year's Classics.

As Keeneland's Director of Sales Geoffrey Russell so aptly put it, neither Northern Dancer nor Danzig ever ran on turf, but have excelled in Europe. In addition, War Front (Danzig), Kitten's Joy (El Prado {Ire}) and Henny Hughes (Hennessy) have had impressive European maiden winners recently, which augers well for the weeks and months ahead.

Jim Bolger often pioneers the use of unproven North American stallions, and such is the case with his current charge Glor Na Mara (Ire) (Leroidesanimaux {Brz}). The juvenile deserves to get his head in front after a series of second-place finishes in the G1 Phoenix S., G2 Futurity S. and G3 Round Tower S.

Not to be outdone, the established brigade have continued to produce the goods in 2010. Runners by Street Cry (Ire) (Machiavellian), Dynaformer (Roberto), Speightstown (Gone West), Giant's Causeway (Storm Cat), Elusive Quality (Gone West) and Medaglia d'Oro (El Prado {Ire}) have frequented the winner's enclosure.

Silverton Hill's Bonnie Hamilton, owner of G1 Vincent O'Brien National S. winner Pathfork (Distorted Humor), believes there is no reason why U.S.-sired runners cannot reach their full potential in Europe.

"I am really glad we didn't listen to that advice and become so narrow minded, or we might have missed out on Pathfork. The really good horses can go on anything, and the top stallions can produce runners on any surface," stressed Hamilton.

The Hamiltons' bloodstock consultant Ben McElroy has signed for several lots at Keeneland September thus far, so expect more Silverton Hill-owned horses to be competing in Europe next year.

"Future plans for the horses will be made early next year, but three or four will probably go to Ireland," explained Hamilton.

The European stallion roster is extremely healthy, but U.S. stallions add another dimension to European racing, if given the opportunity.--GTK

### The Jockey Club Releases 2009 Breeding Statistics:

*(Edited Press Release)* The Jockey Club yesterday reported that 3,130 stallions covered 49,404 mares in North America during 2009, according to statistics compiled through Sept. 8, 2010. These matings have resulted in 27,233 live foals of 2010 being reported to The Jockey Club on Live Foal Reports. As in past years, The Jockey Club estimates that the reporting of live foals, at this point in time, is approximately 90-percent complete. The reporting of live foals of 2010 is down 14.2 percent from last year at this time when The Jockey Club had received reports for 31,727 live foals of 2009. In addition to the 27,233 live foals of 2010 reported through Sept. 8, The Jockey Club had also received 5,138 No Foal Reports for the 2010 foaling season. The number of stallions declined 9 percent from the 3,439 reported for 2008 at this time last year, while the number of mares bred decreased 13.2 percent from the 56,901 reported for 2008. The statistics include 458 progeny of stallions standing in North America but foaled abroad, as reported by foreign stud book authorities at the time of publication.
