'NORMAL, PLUCK PUNCH BC TICKETS

New Normal (Forestry) and **Pluck** (More Than Ready) punched tickets to their respective Breeders' Cup races by taking the GIII Natalma S. and GIII Summer S. at Woodbine yesterday afternoon. Both races are "Win and You're In" events for the championship affair. New Normal, a homebred for Robert S. Evans, led at every call in her Natalma victory and, all being well, is poised to make the trip to Louisville for the GII Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf Nov. 5.

"I'm certainly hopeful," winning trainer Mark Frostad offered. "I'm sure we're all of the same mind at this point. If everything's well, it'll be a go."

Pluck, coming off a DQ after dead-heating for second in Monmouth's Continental Mile S. Aug. 14, put in a professional effort in his off-the-pace victory in the Summer. "He always was travelling really well," said winning rider Garrett Gomez. "Once I put him on the outside he just started hitting gears." Winning owner Team Valor's Terry Smith, relieved that the colt had a clean trip after the Monmouth disappointment, added, "He's got a great turn of foot and he didn't bodycheck anybody today." **Cont. p5**

ANOTHER ADVENTURE AT WOODBINE?

Sam-Son Farms has two GI Woodbine Mile trophies courtesy of Quiet Resolve and Soaring Free, and a third could be coming in the form of **Grand Adventure** (Grand Slam). The four-year-old seems primed for a break-out performance in today's extremely contentious million-dollar event. After two straight graded wins over the sweeping Woodbine course, the dark bay was a gallant second in the nine-furlong GII Nijinsky S. July 24, and has been pointing to this contest since. "He had a pretty tough race in the Nijinsky," trainer Mark Frostad told *Daily Racing Form*.

"The turf came up soft, and a mile and an eighth is at the outer limits of his distance capability. We decided to give him lots of time going into the Mile. He's come up to it great." **Cont. p3-4**

CHECK HER OUT

Gretchen and Roy Jackson's Lael Stables stepped up to acquire **Check the Label** (Stormin Fever) following her third straight graded win in the GIII Virginia Oaks at Colonial Downs July 17, but were forced to wait to see the filly carry their colors for the first time after Saratoga's GII Lake Placid S. was washed off the turf. It was worth it, though. Last of all early in yesterday's GI Garden City Breeders' Cup S., the dark bay was forced to check off heels on the far turn before sorting herself out, and was confidently ridden in the lane by Ramon Dominguez en route to her first Grade I success. "I have a lot of confidence in this filly," said winning trainer Graham Motion, who kept her in his care following Check the Label's sale from breeder Brereton C. Jones. "The Jacksons and I will discuss what's next for her; we'll look at the [GI] Queen Elizabeth Challenge Cup [at Keeneland Oct. 16]." Barbara Hunter's homebred bridesmaid **Snow Top Mountain** (Najran) completed the exacta for the fifth consecutive time.

Check the Label capped her juvenile campaign with a runner-up effort in the Caressing S. at Churchill Nov. 28. After finishing a distant third in the off-the-turf Sweetest Chant S. at Gulfstream Jan. 17, the dark bay came up 3/4 of a length short in the Coconut Grove S. over the Hallandale infield on Valentine's Day, then missed by a length when fourth in the GIII Herecomesthebride S. over the same course Mar. 6. She put Florida in her rearview mirror, and hasn't tasted defeat since.

After defeating a solid group in Keeneland's GIII Apalachian S. Apr. 15, the sophomore rallied to claim the GII Sands Point S. over this course and distance May 31, and most recently strutted her stuff at Colonial Downs in the GIII Virginia Oaks July 17.

The even-money choice was content to caboose the field early as Queen of the Creek (Theatrical {Ire}) was her usual headstrong self through splits of :23.39 and :47.80 over ground termed yielding. She began to advance ominously approaching the far turn, but her progress was checked when the leaders remained bunched. Ramon Dominguez guided her to the outside entering the stretch and Check the Label responded to get the job done under a vigorous hand ride. "On soft ground like this, it's very difficult to make up that kind of ground, and she just overcame all the trouble," Dominguez commented. "She gave me a great kick--really, it's hard to appreciate how much I had to take away from her. For any horse it would have been a perfect excuse not to finish up after that because of all the run that I took away from her, but she was there for me."

Trainer Graham Motion offered, "I thought she would handle the going; she's handled just about everything thrown at her. She's got such a tremendous turn of foot--she can get herself out of almost any situation. That's part of what makes her special."

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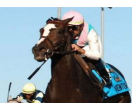

Excellent Adventure...

Grand Adventure took the GIII Summer S. over course and distance in his second start as a juvenile before a failed run in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf. He came back in August the following year to score easily in a 6 1/2-furlong allowance, and his confident

connections elected to throw their lightly raced charge into the deep end, trying him in last year's running of the Woodbine Mile. The dark bay set an impossibly fast pace that day before understandably tiring to ninth of 10, and was subsequently relegated to 5 1/2 and six-furlong events with no wins in four tries. Stretched back out a bit to seven furlongs here in the GIII Connaught Cup May 30, the \$75,000 FTKJUL yearling raced wide for much of the running before kicking clear by a length in a visually impressive performance. He then was given an extra furlong to work with in the June 27 GII King Edward S., and

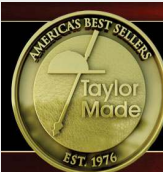
beat that tough field, which included subsequent GII Fourstardave H. and GII Bernard Baruch H. winner Get Stormy (Stormy Atlantic) and 2008 Woodbine Mile Winner Rahy's Attorney (Rahy), in similar fashion. Grand Adventure disappointed to be second in the Nijinsky, but the extra furlong and yielding ground may have been to blame. "He didn't give in," trainer Mark Frostad noted. "He battled hard from start to finish. Right from the beginning, he was hounded. With him, you know you'll always get an honest effort, and that was a perfect example."

The Usual Suspects...

The Usual Q.T. (Unusual Heat) gets back on the grass after finishing fifth as the favorite in the GI Pacific Classic at Del Mar Aug. 28. The four-year-old Cal-bred gelding reeled off six consecutive turf victories last term and was fourth in the G1 Dubai Duty Free at Meydan in March. Back in the States, he was a winner of a one-mile allowance in June and the GI Eddie Read H. over **Victor's Cry** (Street Cry {Ire}) July 24 before the Del Mar flop. "He came out of the race (Pacific Classic) really well," said trainer Jim Cassidy. "I thought, initially, three weeks [between races], that's a little tight. But he doesn't seem to be any worse for it. He's put on his weight again. He acts good. I really have no reason to think he won't perform well." **Zifzaf** (War Chant), a Shadwell cast-off who was scooped up for \$25,000 at Keeneland this January, has improved with every start in three tries for Jimmy Toner. He was most recently third behind the aforementioned Get Stormy in the Fourstardave H. Aug. 1, while struggling with his lead changes. This longshot late bloomer could turn in a huge performance.

After making a smart impression when winning on debut over five furlongs at Newmarket May 2, Temple Meads followed up in this track's July 17 Weatherbys Super Sprint again over that trip. Ridden by Jimmy Fortune with his regular pilot Richard Mullen suspended when upped to this distance for the G2 Gimcrack S., he looked a possible non-stayer when fading into fourth as favorite in that Aug. 18 York contest. Proving that form wrong with a commanding success here, the chestnut confirmed his earlier promise as well as his stamina. Settled in rear early after a slow break, he cruised into contention with a quarter mile remaining, and after striking the front 100 yards later, drew away to put his stamp on proceedings as Formosina stayed on at safe distance. "At York, it was the fault of no one and he took Jimmy [Fortune] by surprise as he didn't switch off and had been so laid-back in his first two races," Mullen explained. "A lot of things could have contributed to his run there and maybe it was the walk across the Knavesmire beforehand and the fact that he got a bump early on, but he learnt a lot and we knew we had to drop him out. He switched off lovely today and traveled and did it with ease." Trainer Ed McMahon added, "There was never any question in my mind that he'd get six furlongs. It wasn't Jimmy [Fortune]'s fault that he ran a bit free at York and it was just one of those things. The G1 Middle Park S. [at Newmarket Oct. 1] is the only way forward, and I think the track there will suit him better than here."

Pluck ran third behind the promising Bail Out the Cat (Tale of the Cat) and Soldat (War Front) in his career debut, a June 10 maiden on the Belmont main track. The nearly black colt duly graduated when switched to the turf at the Elmont oval July 11. He then dead-heated for second in the blanket finish of Monmouth's Continental Mile S. Aug. 14 ([video](#)), but was disqualified and placed fourth. The co-favorite here at 5-2, Pluck strummed along in the early stages, but began to wind up his run on the turn. He rallied up the center of the course, forged past maiden Rockin Heat inside the furlong marker and maintained his advantage to the wire.

Shel Evans' homebred graduated as the favorite Aug. 28, and came away running from post five here. Though she looked like she might get swallowed up in the long Woodbine stretch, the dark bay kept digging in, and fended off odds-on More Than Real to secure her first black-type success. "She's a big, strong filly," said winning trainer Mark Frostad. "She was a little plain, but she's developed very nicely all the way along. We thought we'd give her a shot in here, and she rewarded us." New Normal RNA'd for \$125,000 when offered at Keeneland September last year, but her half-brother by Malibu Moon sold to Spendthrift Farm for \$650,000 at the sales opening night last Sunday. 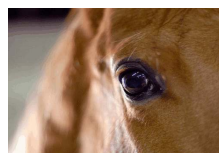

THUMBS UP

Here's what happened in Keeneland's first week, which ended Friday, under the new format: it was a success. In fact, it wasn't just a success. It was a rousing success. It wasn't an unqualified success--the average did fall every day of Book 2, but, at the end of the four days the variance from the overall four-day average of \$120,002 was no more than 10 percent in either

direction, and there's no way to assess whether that was significant in market terms without an objective conformation rating on all 1,170 yearlings sent through the ring in Book 2 (impossible). Given that caveat--and making the assumption that

'market values' were roughly the same as last year--some pretty impressive numbers (relatively speaking, given current price levels) were rung up.

The change in format was, in statistical terms, pretty dramatic. The number catalogued in Book 1 was cut almost exactly in half: 211 this year, 418 in Book 1 in 2009. The number catalogued in Book 2 was expanded from two sessions with almost 400 catalogued in each (794 total) last year to four sessions, with about 325 catalogued in each (1,302 total) this year. So 64 percent more horses were catalogued in Book 2 this year--508 more yearlings, of which 207 presumably came down from Book 1, while the rest presumably came up from the first day of Book 3. The 325 per session in Book 2 was very popular with buyers. I heard several comments that the new first-week format gave them more time to look and get organized, and the Book 2 sessions ending by 7 p.m. gave people time to have their dinners at a reasonable hour.

Assuming market levels (prices) remained stable with 2009, I had projected in my Sept. 1 column ([click here](#)) that, by the end of the week, about 900 yearlings would have sold for \$129 million, an average of \$142,273. The sale actually did better than that: 941 yearlings grossed \$141,987,000, and averaged \$150,890. Compared with last year's four-day first week, 25-percent more horses were catalogued, 34 percent more were sold (an extra 238 yearlings), for a \$24-million increase in gross (up 21 percent), and a 10-percent drop in average. **Cont. p12**

But here's the good news: Keeneland succeeded in selling 34-percent more yearlings than last year, for \$25-million more in revenue to consignors, while the clearance rate through the ring-- with 283 more yearlings offered--improved by three percent, and the clearance rate from the catalogue by four percent. This included 56 yearlings that sold for \$400,000 or more, of which 44 did not sell to Shadwell (the sale's biggest buyer), Darley, or Coolmore. For the whole week, in fact, it's a fairly dramatic statistic that 941 yearlings actually averaged slightly more than \$150,000, or, to put it more precisely, over 800 yearlings averaged \$120,000, after the first 127 sold had averaged almost \$350,000. Either way you look at it, it's a lot of money. Even the median for the 941 sold stood at an even \$100,000. As for the return on retail 2008 stud fees paid (as opposed to foal-shares, for example), best not to ask; the important thing was to get them sold, which was achieved at a slightly higher rate than in 2009.

Of the 67 stallions that had five or more catalogued in the first two books (*see table p17*), nine registered averages above \$200,000 for Keeneland's first week, according to data extracted or compiled from the Keeneland website. Leading sire on average was A.P. Indy, who had 14 yearlings average \$546,000, from 21 offered; 67 percent of his yearlings sent through the ring were listed as sold, with 69 percent the figure for all sires. Second on average was Distorted Humor (\$364,130); he had the distinction of having 23 of his 24 yearlings offered (96 percent) listed as sold, confirming he's the sire everybody wants, especially after Pathfork's win in Ireland's G1 National S. gave him newfound cachet in Europe at just the right time. Dynaformer, clearly one of Sheikh Hamdan's favorites (he bought four this year) had 15 average \$277,667 (of 19 offered) to claim third spot, followed by Smart

Strike (23, of 27 offered, averaged \$233,348) and hot first-year sire Bernardini (26, averaged \$226,231). North America's newest Top 10 sire, Malibu Moon, averaged \$219,500 (26 of 41 sold), followed by Empire Maker (\$210,762, but with only 21 of 38, or 55 percent, sold); Street Cry (21 of 29, averaged \$205,095); and Unbridled's Song (33 of 44, averaged \$202,576). Interestingly, none of those top nine comes from the Northern Dancer sire lines: five are Mr. Prospector line, three from the main branch (Smart Strike, Distorted Humor, and Street Cry) and two (Empire Maker and Unbridled's Song) from the Fappiano branch through Unbridled. Three more are from the Seattle Slew line--A.P. Indy and his sons Bernardini and Malibu Moon--while Dynaformer is a son of Roberto.

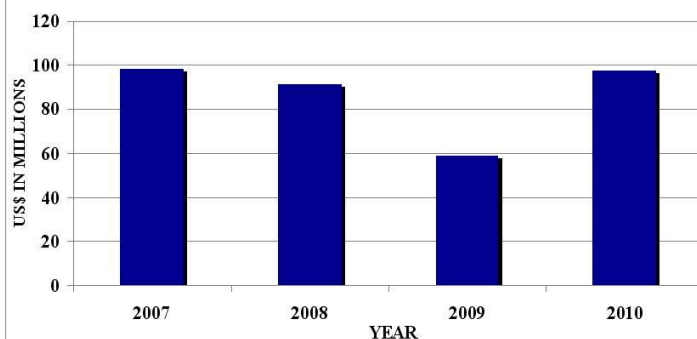

"The new Keeneland September first-week format -- 1,513 yearlings catalogued over six days, of which 941 were listed as sold -- was a success. There were 238 more yearlings sold (a 34 percent increase) than in last year's four-day first week, for 21 percent more money (an increase of over \$24-million), and, while the average dropped 10 percent (to \$150,890), the revision in format resulted in considerably more revenue for breeders and consignors. The sale was considerably easier to work for agents and buyers also, though some consignors did have to move barns twice instead of once." --Bill Oppenheim

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Don't get me wrong: the whole deal is a long way from being out of the woods. We're not even a third of the way through the sale, in terms of numbers, with eight days of selling and over 3,300 yearlings still catalogued to sell. A lot of them are by sires whose retail 2008 stud fees were well above what you'd hope to have in 'second-week' yearlings; there are 25 Tiznows catalogued in the next four books, for example. But that does mean there's a lot more sire power in the second week than might have been the case in previous years. And the second week was always going to be tough, no matter what happened in the sale's first week. But there's also no denying Week 1 did go pretty well. Over 900 yearlings sold for an average of \$150,000, with a median of \$100,000, after all; it's no small thing.

Another View: Up 4 Percent

I ran into Keeneland Sales Director Geoff Russell on my way out of town yesterday, and he kindly pointed out to me that the number of horses sold through Friday equaled exactly the number of yearlings sold last year through the end of the first day of Book 3: 941 in both cases. So this gives us another way to measure this year's first week results; what were the statistics for the first 941 sold each year? As the small table indicates, with seven percent fewer catalogued this year (meaning the clearance rate did improve by three to four percent), you can sure make the argument the results show the sale is up four percent from last year; the first 941 sold were up four percent in gross and average. We'll have to see how this plays out later on in the sale, but the comparison being made here is the first six days this year against the first five days last year, rather than, as I have done elsewhere in this column, the first four days last year.

Success Bittersweet for Hertrich

Fred Hertrich and longtime friend and business partner Dr. Phil McCarthy enjoyed considerable success during their 12 years together operating Watercress Farm. The two men bred, raised and sold European champion Shamardal, as well as Grade I winner Street Boss, and graded stakes winners Even the Score, Sir Greeley, Half Ours, La Chunga, Snow Dance and Got the Last Laugh.

A third Grade I winner was added to their honor roll when Boys of Tosconova (Officer) came home 1 3/4 lengths the best in the GI Three Chimney's Hopeful S. at Saratoga. But Dr. McCarthy didn't get to see this latest success from the Paris nursery. The noted veterinarian, who specialized in reproductive issues, passed away last November at the age of 58.

Both men began in the Standardbred industry, Hertrich recalled.

"I miss him every day, both personally and professionally," Hertrich said of his friend. "We were not only business partners, we were best friends. Our friendship probably goes back 22 to 25 years. He sold me a Standardbred the first year I got in the business. He told me how good this filly was and that I should buy her. So I did. And she was no good at all. I never let him forget it."

"Dr. McCarthy actually went to practice over in Italy and when he came back, he decided to make a break from the Standardbreds and go strictly with the Thoroughbreds," Hertrich continued. "So I bought the farm and then we formed the partnership. I was going to have Standardbreds there, except the partnership was buying Thoroughbred mares. The original partnership was with Lou Guida, who was in the Standardbred business, Ben Walden, Jr. and Dr. McCarthy and myself and we called it Aspiration Partnership. We went out and bought some mares to get into the breeding business."

The partnership dispersed three years later, but Hertrich and McCarthy continued to develop the 400-acre Watercress Farm and a broodmare band of some 60 to 70 head.

Hertrich has watched as the last yearlings of his partnership with McCarthy have gone through the Keeneland sales ring, highlighted by a son of Kentucky Derby winner Street Sense ([hip 1183](#)) who sold for \$435,000 to the bid of Demi O'Byrne. The yearling is out of Priceless Storm (Storm Cat), a half-sister to MGSW Master Command (A.P. Indy). Also selling through the Taylor Made consignment last week was a filly by Mr. Greeley ([hip 684](#)), who was purchased by bloodstock agent Steve Young for \$200,000.



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"We did very well," Hertrich said of his September results so far. "Like everybody here, we had a few break-out horses that sold very well. We had a number of horses that we broke even on and we had some losers. That's kind of the way it's been for everybody."

A Tiznow half-brother to Boys of Tosconova will go through the ring today at Keeneland as [hip 1760](#).

Mares owned in the Hertrich/McCarthy partnership are scheduled to sell this November at Keeneland and Fasig-Tipton, as well as at the Keeneland January sale next year. Little Bonnet (Coronado's Quest), the dam of Boys of Tosconova, will sell at Fasig-Tipton in foal to Bluegrass Cat.

Hertrich is already restocking his broodmare band.

"We know we're going to be selling mares from Dr. McCarthy's estate and we're replacing those every day," Hertrich explained. "We're buying privately and we're buying at the sales. I think in the last nine months we've bought 12 mares privately."

Hertrich admitted it can be tough to watch mares like Little Bonnet go through the sales ring.

"We're excited about it and we're not excited about it, if you know what I mean," he confided. "That's the business we're in and we have to sell her because of Dr. McCarthy's estate. So we'll just have to see what happens."

Zayat Stables Staying Active in September

After a tumultuous year that included bankruptcy reorganization, Zayat Stables is busy restocking at Keeneland September. The stable has already purchased nine yearlings during the first six sessions, including a son of Smart Strike who was the co-topper Thursday with a final price tag of \$550,000.

"We exited bankruptcy a few months ago and business is as usual," explained Bradley Weisbord, the stable's finance and racing manager, who has been handling the bidding for Ahmed Zayat's operation this week. "We bought two horses at Saratoga, we bought a horse at OBS that went to Canada and we've bought nine horses so far here."

In addition to the Smart Strike colt ([hip 985](#)), Zayat Stables has also purchased an Awesome Again colt ([hip 102](#)) for \$325,000 and an Empire Maker colt ([hip 220](#)) for \$260,000.

"The Smart Strike colt was the pick of our sale," said Weisbord, who admitted Thursday he was stretching his limit for the \$550,000 colt. "Mr. Zayat, over the past, has bought in all types of price ranges, but it's very hard to make money once you move over the \$400,000 number. Especially when we're buying mostly colts. Mr. Zayat likes to buy some fillies, but colts are his thing. He is looking for the big horse. Of the nine we've purchased so far, two are fillies and seven are colts."

"Generally we like a Classic horse--a horse that can get some distance," Weisbord continued. "We have had some success with sprinters. We had Zensational (Unbridled's Song), who we bought as a sprinter and who turned out to be a big stallion prospect."

The Zayat shopping spree should continue into the September sale's second week.

"We're going to continue shopping through book 4 and 5, or maybe it's book 3 and 4 this year," Weisbord explained. "Although we know two and three were merged and it's more like book 4 and 5 horses to us. We got a steal in book 3 last year in Jaycito (Victory Gallop), who we bought for \$110,000 and he ended up running second in the GI Del Mar Futurity and is now being pointed toward the [Oct. 2] GI Norfolk. So we think there is great value later on and we're looking forward to it."

Zayat Stables has about 15 homebred yearlings and is supplementing the crop with sales horses to reach a target number of between 35 and 40 two-year-olds next season.

"We currently have approximately 50 broodmares," Weisbord said. "A few years ago, which was this year's yearling crop, we had fewer mares. We're going to try to breed half and buy half; now that we have so many broodmares, we won't need to buy as much. In the next couple of years, we might buy less at the yearling sales because we have so many broodmares."

Weisbord admitted it has been competitive in the Keeneland sales pavilion this week.

"We got outbid on some and we stretched our budget on some," he said. "Buying has been tough for us. It's a very healthy market--more healthy than we thought. We thought by now some of the big buyers would be done, but it seems like all four days of book 2 have been pretty strong."

When the September sale is over, there is still plenty for Zayat Stables to look forward to this fall. The stable currently has a trio of horses pointing towards the Breeders' Cup Championships.

"We have three horses that look like they're definite," Weisbord said. "We have Rightly So (Read the Footnotes), who won the [Aug. 28] GI Ballerina, and she is not going to start again until the [GI] Breeders' Cup F/M Sprint [Nov. 5 at Churchill]. She's doing great. We have Jaycito, who is going to run next in the Norfolk and we're really excited to put him on dirt for the first time in the [GI] Breeders' Cup Juvenile [Nov. 6]. And we have A Z Warrior (Bernardini), who ran fifth in the [Sept. 4 GI] Del Mar Debutante and

was second in the [Aug. 6 GI] Sorrento. [Trainer Bob] Baffert is going to bring her to the East Coast, hopefully to run in the [Oct. 9 GI] Frizette [S. at Belmont], and then on to the [GI] Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies."

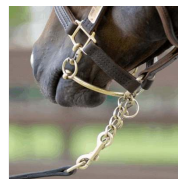

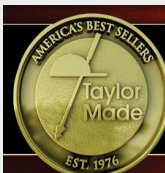

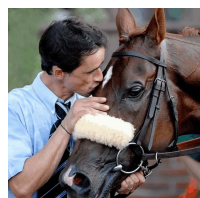
