BACK TO WORK

Haynesfield won four of his six starts ast term, capping the highly successful campaign with a narrow decision in the Oct. 24 Empire Classic and a 4 1/2-length tally in the Nov. 21 GIII Discovery H. The chestnut disappeared for seven months after that outing, but picked up right where he left off with a front-running score over state-breds in an optional claimer at Belmont June 13. Looking to make it four in a row, he stepped up for the July 3 GII Suburban H. and did it again, drawing off to take it by 2 3/4 lengths. But the waters proved too deep in the

Aug. 7 GI Whitney H. at Saratoga. Haynesfield broke through the gate before the race, then failed to find the lead once the doors opened and tired down the lane to finish a distant fourth. Things went much more in his favor yesterday. Gifted an easy lead, the four-year-old had three on the field after six furlongs, and was seven lengths in front when they hit the eighth pole.

Ramon Dominguez looked back one more time in deep stretch and posed the rest of the way to the wire. "It was clear that he was the speed in the race," Dominguez said. "I just did my best to slow him down, because he was pretty eager. I was so amazed when he hit the half-mile pole and switched to his left lead, the way he wanted to sprint from there. I wasn't sure what to do because I didn't want to discourage him, but I didn't want him to open up even more--it was too early in the race. I just slightly let him out some and then when he switched back to his right turning for home, he still had so much left in him. I know a lot of people will try to take something away from him because he was the only speed in the race, but he didn't have to run the way he did." Blame Game...

The odds-on favorite after putting the exclamation point on a five-race winning streak with victories in the GI Stephen Foster H. and in the Whitney, Blame rated in fourth and was all out to close on Haynesfield late. "I thought I was in a good spot as we headed up the backside," jockey Garrett Gomez said. "They slowed down the pace and I was moving along, but he wasn't taking me to them. I was squeezing him just to keep him where I had him, where I thought I had dead aim on them. At about the half-mile pole, Ramon's horse hit another gear and starting rolling. Down the lane my horse never actually bore down, because that horse was so far in front of him. He had nothing to look at in the eye." But it's still full speed ahead to the GI Breeders' Cup Classic Nov. 6. "You can't win 'em all," trainer Al Stall Jr. remarked. "We're in good shape though. He's had quite a bit of time off, so we'll be OK." Third-place finisher Fly Down will also be pointed for the Classic.

Richard's Kid captured the the 2009 GI Pacific Classic as a 24-1 outsider, and came back to be third in the GI Goodwood S. Sixth in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic, he took the rest of the year off before opening 2010 with a last-gasp victory in the GII San Antonio H.

Feb. 7. The dark bay was beaten just 2 1/2 lengths when seventh in the Mar 27 G1 Dubai World Cup, and earned a vacation after the intercontinental trek. He resurfaced with third-place efforts in the July 10 GI Hollywood Gold Cup and July 30 GIII Cougar II H. at Del Mar, and repeated in the Pacific Classic at 9-2. The crowd was less enthusiastic about his chances here, but Richard's Kid proved them wrong. The last one out of the gate and at the back of the pack through the opening quarter, he moved just a little bit closer while saving ground to the turn. The 8-1 shot cut into his deficit as they raced out of the bend and found running room up the rail down the lane, surging through in the final sixteenth and holding Crown of Thorns at bay late.

"He doesn't have that kind of speed to be close and, whenever he does, he doesn't run good," jockey Alonzo Quinonez said. "So I just followed the instructions--let him break and let him find his stride. We were last, and I said, 'Well, I'm just going to save ground.' From there everything went good." Undefeated Twirling Candy (Candy Ride {Arg}), the odds-on choice, had the lead in the stretch, but faded to fourth. "He never got into that comfortable rhythm that I wanted him to," jockey Mike Smith said. "I was hoping he'd drop the bit a little bit more, but he didn't. It hurt him at the end." Wheeled out at the top of the lane, she gave her legions of backers a minor heart attack when Switch stole away at the eighth pole, and the margin momentarily looked insurmountable, but Mike Smith went to the whip and the big mare responded. She was under wraps in the final strides. "Her heart must be huge," trainer John Shirreffs said. "She can always dig down and find a little more. She never gives up." He added, "I couldn't even begin to describe how special this was. You've seen how the fans have learned to really love her and enjoy her--I've been along for that, and it's just been great to see." Life At Ten kicked off what would turn into a six-race winning streak with a half-length victory over Persistently in a six-furlong allowance over a sloppy Aqueduct strip last November. What followed were decisive wins in the Dec. 12 Snit S., Feb. 20 Rare Treat S., Apr. 17 GIII Sixty Sails H., June 12 GI Ogden Phipps H. and July 17 GII Delaware H. In front every step in her last two victories, the chestnut had to concede the early lead to Horse of the Year Rachel Alexandra (Medaglia d'Oro) in the Aug. 29 GI Personal Ensign S. at Saratoga and, after dueling through seemingly reasonable fractions, faded badly to be a distant third behind 21-1 upsetter Persistently. It remained to be seen if she would rebound off the effort, and the bettors opted to make Unrivalled Belle the chalk. That was a mistake. Taken in hand as the favorite pressed the pace, Life At Ten swept to the front at the top of the lane and drew clear. "Our filly was training better leading into this race, and she really likes Belmont," Todd Pletcher said. "She ran OK at Saratoga, but I don't think that is her favorite surface. We made a tactical decision in her last race and it backfired. This time we had a better plan in letting her fall into a rhythm...and it worked out well. He was a maiden going into the race, but Jaycito persevered down the lane to graduate in Grade I style. The bay went right to the front in his career opener at Del Mar Aug. 21, but weakened late and was caught in the shadow of the wire to finish second. Connections opted to swing for the fences in his next start and, sent off at 19-1 in the Sept. 8 GI Del Mar Futurity, the bay was not embarrassed. Off slowly, he came running late to be second behind J P's Gusto. The order of finish was reversed as they stretched to two turns this time. Jaycito was rated just off the pace while on the outside in the early going, and seemed to have the leaders measured approaching the far turn. Put to a drive as they raced around the turn, he still hadn't closed much ground when they hit the lane, and looked to be running out of gas, but found another gear inside the final furlong and came running to catch the Del Mar Futurity winner and edge clear. "He's got a lot of room to grow, too," jockey Mike Smith said. "He seems like he can get even better. He's still got some baby fat on him and he's still growing, getting stronger every day. He's still a little green about running, but he's full of talent." It is undecided if the winner will head to Churchill for the Nov. 6 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile. 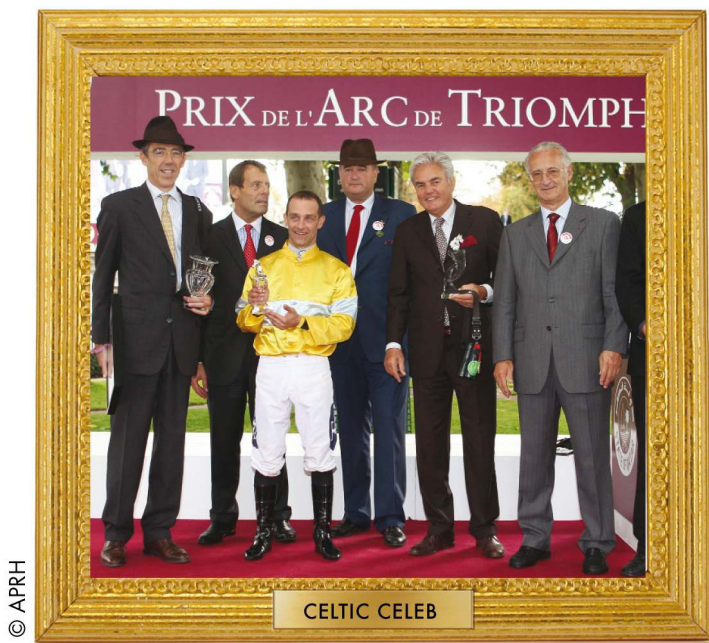

"We were a bit worried about her at the beginning of the season, as the trainer had problems with her and she didn't run well at Royal Ascot, but she really won well at Longchamp. She will probably go back to Japan now [for the Nov. 21 G1 Kyoto Mile Championship, in which she was third last year]. Last year, she ran well there, but the ground was a bit sticky, and I think she can do something nice this year." Trainer Robert Collet added, "After Ascot, she was sick and we were lost, but we found the problem thanks to the vets and she is now better than she has been in her life. I think we will go back to Japan, as it is worth a lot of money and the challenge is exciting. Brilliant on quick ground in the May 23 G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup at The Curragh, he benefited from a positive ride to follow up at the expense of Sariska (GB) (Pivotal {GB}) on her very best behavior in Epsom's G1 Coronation Cup June 4. Connections then stuck to the plan of a summer break, and Fame and Glory showed the wheels were still turning on his return in The Curragh's G2 Royal Whip S. Aug. 8. With his G1 Irish Derby and G1 Irish Champion S.-winning stable companion **Cape Blanco (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) in the line-up, jockey Johnny Murtagh would have been forgiven for jumping ship, but he has never wavered in his belief. "This has been his main target all year," Murtagh told *PA Sport*. "He's definitely strengthened up a lot since last year and he's a different horse now." Cont. p10

"He's been a great horse to have, and has given us tremendous fun and is well as he's been all year," trainer Mick Channon commented. "He's in great heart and is the Arc's Yardstick, which he's been for the past two years now, and I'm as confident as ever that he'll run another massive race." **Cont. p11**

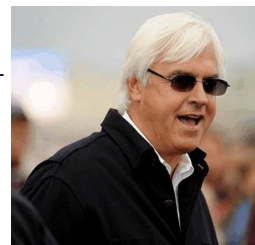

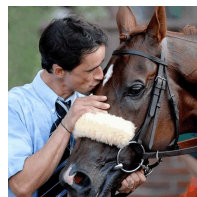

Trainer David Simcock yesterday refused to be drawn on whether his star colt **Dream Ahead** (Diktat {GB}) would contest the G1 Dubai Dewhurst S. at Newmarket on Champions' Day. Reported to be fine following his nine-length success in that track's G1 Middle Park S., Khalifa Dasmal's colt who was also successful in the G1 Prix Morny would be stepping up to seven furlongs if given the green light for the Oct. 16 contest. "He's absolutely fine this morning and has eaten up well," his conditioner said. "He didn't have a hard race but, having said that, it was still soft ground and it will have taken a bit out of him. We will see about the Dewhurst. It will be very much a case of seeing how the horse's wellbeing is and we'll see how we feel. Nothing is set in stone and we won't say we will run and we won't say we won't run. We're in the race and we can leave it as late as we like. There are some very, very good seven-furlong two-year-olds around at the moment. SCHWARTZ RAIDS ARQANA ARC SALE AGAIN

American owner Martin Schwartz hit the jackpot when purchasing subsequent G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulisches victress **Elusive Wave** (Ire) (Elusive City) at Arqana's Arc Sale two years ago, and he will be looking for lightning to strike twice after parting with €450,000 to secure the juvenile distaffer **Mambia** (GB) (Aldebaran) and top the sheets during yesterday's renewal at Saint-Cloud. Offered as hip **7** by Senonnes-Pouance trainer Joel Boissard, she has won four of her six starts and bagged the Listed Prix des Jouvenceaux et des Jouvencelles at Vichy in July, and the G3 Prix du Calvados, a race also won by Elusive Wave, at Deauville last month. She will bid to go one better than Elusive Wave by winning the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac at Longchamp today. Almost matching that price later in the session was His Highness The Aga Khan's G3 Prix de Fontainebleau victor **Rajsaman** (Fr) (Linamix {Fr}), who was knocked down to Chantilly Bloodstock for €440,000. Presented by Alain de Royer-Dupre's stable as hip **44**, he is closely-related to last year's G1 Prix Marcel Boussac victress and TDN Rising Star Rosanara (Fr) (Sinndar {Ire}), who is one of the leading fancies for today's G1 Prix de l'Opera on the Arc undercard.

Bronze medal position was secured by G3 Premio Regina Elena (Italian 1000 Guineas) heroine **Evading Tempete** (GB) (Dubai Destination), who, like Mambia, went the way of Oceanic Bloodstock, on behalf of Martin Schwartz, for €370,000. She was offered as hip **29** by trainer Francois Rohaut and was sold with an entry in next weekend's G1 Premio Vittorio di Capua at Milan's San Siro. Despite the usual swathe of withdrawals and RNAs at the boutique sale, a further eight lots broke through the €100,000 barrier and, with an improved clearance on last year, the average surged forward almost 20 percent, albeit on a select sample size. The sale aggregate jumped up 10 percent, but was slightly overshadowed once last year's private sales arrangements were taken into consideration.
