TWICE IS NICE

Some 133 years after Springfield (GB) landed the inaugural running of the G1 Champion S., Juddmonte Farms' homebred **Twice Over (GB)** (Observatory) paid the race a final fitting tribute, emulating the likes of Brigadier Gerard (GB), Triptych and Alborada (GB) by landing back-to-back victories in this historic event. It was the last renewal to be run at Newmarket before its relocation to Ascot in 2011. Usurped as favorite by **Vision d'Etat (Fr)** (Chichicastenango {Fr}) as the rain fell leading up to yesterday's feature, the 7-2 chance showed no signs of unease on the rain-softened surface. He held a perfect position in the slipstream of GI Arlington Million victor **Debussy (Ire)** (Diesis {GB}) before sweeping past that rival and keeping on well to cap a memorable afternoon for connections, following Frankel's imperious G1 Dewhurst S. score. "It's absolutely amazing," said a beaming Tom Queally. "I can't do it without the horses under me, and [trainer] Henry [Cecil] gets them there 100 percent right." **Cont. p7**

Earning ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ status when winning a mile maiden on soft ground at Newmarket's July course on debut Aug. 13, Frankel showed what he was really capable of when he strolled home by 13 lengths from subsequent G1 Prix Marcel Boussac third Rainbow Springs (GB) (Selkirik) in a Doncaster conditions event on his next outing Sept. 10. The homebred stunned the crowd at Ascot on his last run, quickening clear at the quarter pole to destroy his rivals in the G2 Royal Lodge S. by 10 lengths. With news emanating from Newmarket of a spectacular piece of work last Saturday, further improvement seemed possible, and he was sent postward as a strong favorite despite the ground apparently softening in favor of his main market rival and dual Group 1 winner Dream Ahead (GB) (Diktat {GB}). Squeezed out as he broke from the stalls, the eventual winner pulled for his head at the rear of the field as Roderic O'Connor towed them through the early stages.

Queally allowed the muscular bay to stride on up to the leaders at the two-furlong marker, and his whip was not deployed as Frankel took it up 100 yards later before running on strongly to the line. Queally explained, "He received a bump leaving the stalls and it set him alight, whereas at Ascot he put his head down and relaxed, but he quickened up well and put the race to bed. Probably on the ground he wandered off a true line, but we'll forgive him that." Trainer Henry Cecil, taking this prestigious contest for the first time since Diesis (GB) in 1982, opined, "In his work he's very relaxed, but when you get a nasty bump like that, it makes a difference and it set him alight. He won well and Tom didn't need to hit him with the whip. It was lovely. I have to thank the Prince [Khalid Abdullah] for sending him to me." Regarding plans for next year, the veteran conditioner said, "I'm hopeful that he will make a [G1 2000] Guineas horse and maybe the [G1] St James's Palace; whether he will get further, we'll have to see, and I'll need to talk to the Prince about that." The owner's racing manager, Teddy Grimthorpe, expressed the view that his targets were not yet set in stone. "I think that we're not going to dismiss the [G1 Epsom] Derby lightly. He'll go straight to the 2000 Guineas and we'll see how he develops over the winter. The Guineas is the first part, and the second part will obviously be the issue. The Derby is a very important race for all concerned, and we'll have to look at him in the spring. Henry will be the best judge of that, and he's likely to have an extensive programme as a three-year-old." Frankel is a general even-money favorite with British bookmakers for the 2000 Guineas, and trades as the 3-1 favorite for the Epsom Derby. Aidan O'Brien, trainer of the runner-up, reflected, "He set a nice sensible gallop, and he's very straightforward. Everything's open to him." The lightly raced Joshua Tree earned the biggest victory of his career with this game effort. The bay broke his maiden by a nose at Gowran Park in August of 2009, and ran second in

handicap company at Listowel that Sept. 15. Sent into group company just 11 days later, he responded with a rallying victory in Ascot's G2 Royal Lodge S. at 12-1 odds, and was through for the year. Joshua Tree was out of action for

nearly 11 months, returning to be third in the Aug. 17 G2 Great Voltigeur S. at York. An even fifth in the G1 St Leger Sept. 11, he was adding Lasix as he took on his elders for the first time in his stateside bow. The three-year-old was rated in midpack as G1 Northern Dancer S. runner-up Fifty Proof (Whiskey Wisdom) took them along through glacial early splits. the G1 Prix Jean Romanet at
Deauville this August. A listed
winner at a mile at Vichy in July,
she prepped for this test with a
second in the 1 1/4-mile G3 La
Coupe de Maisons-Laffitte
Sept. 24. The bay was eased to
the back of the pack out of the
gate, and found herself in last
place as they toured the back-
stretch. With everyone to beat as

they came around the bend, she edged to the outside
to get clear running room in the lane and was put to a
drive. Miss Keller dug in when challenged in the final
furlong, but Reggane answered the call and was pulling
away late. "I watched her run many times in Europe, so
I know she is a late-finishing filly," said jockey
Christophe Soumillon, aboard for the first time. "She
doesn't like to take the lead early. Today, the pace was
fast enough for me to wait and, when I came into the
turn, I could tell that many horses in front of me were
slowing down, so when I asked her to go she gave me
a good turn of foot." The winner could go next in the G1
Breeders' Cup F/M Turf at Churchill Downs Nov. 5. Click

She hadn't hit the board since May and hadn't won since July of 2009, but Serious Attitude turned it around to beat the boys in style here. Perfect in three

starts as a two-year-old, the bay capped that season with a half-length score in the G1 Cheveley Park S. going six furlongs. The Irish-bred, seventh in the G1 1000 Guineas in her three-year-old bow, came back to take the G3 Summer S. at York that summer for her most recent victory. In six subsequent starts,

she was in the frame only once, finishing second in a listed event at Nottingham in May. The filly failed to make an impact when facing tough company in the June 19 G2 Golden Jubilee S., July 9 G1 Darley July Cup and Sept. 11 G2 Park S., and entered this off a fifth in the Sept. 26 G2 Diadem S. at Ascot. Content to caboose the field down the backstretch, the 23-1 outsider had a wall of horses in front of her when they turned into the lane. Serious Attitude was able to ease outside of the leaders approaching the eighth pole, however, and she hit the afterburners once free, powering past Canadian hopeful Grand Adventure to win going away. "She's just a pure racehorse," jockey Garrett Gomez said. The winner, a possible for the GII Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint Nov. 6, sells as [hip 146](#) at the Fasig-Tipton November Sale. Inglewood May 16, added an allowance score at nine panels June 12 and made it three in a row in the 1 1/4-mile GI American Oaks July 3. Last early in the Aug. 21 GI Del Mar Oaks, she came flying late and just missed, running second by a half length to Evening Jewel despite drifting out in deep stretch. The dark bay turned the tables in style this time. Settled in second as rank outsider Dade Babe (Cimmaron Secret)

cut out the fractions on a clear lead and the field raced in single file behind her, Harmonious went after the leader on the final bend. She got to the front at the top of the lane and, after dodging the left-handed whip for a stride, went about her business to win as much the best. "She was galloping along, and I just let her relax, find her stride," jockey Joel Rosario said. "Turning for home, I had a lot of horse. When I asked her, she tried to get in a little bit. I hit her left handed and she tried to get out a little bit. But she was fine. She did the job really easy." It has not been decided where the winner goes next. Twice Over landed his first victory at the highest level with a 14-1 success in last year's renewal of this race before shipping to California for the GI Breeders Cup

Classic on the Santa Anita Pro-Ride Nov. 7, where he ran an admirable third to Zenyatta (Street Cry {Ire}). He continued his globe-trotting adventures when a disappointing 10th from an unfortunate draw in the G1 Dubai World

Cup Mar. 27. Returning to Britain, he was arguably unlucky not to land the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot June 16 when, after struggling for room at a crucial moment, he was beaten just a half length by fellow Juddmonte homebred Byword (GB) (Peintre Celebre).

Unperturbed by that defeat, the gallant bay showed admirable determination to land a second Group 1 success in Sandown's Eclipse S. July 3. Narrowly beaten into second by Rip Van Winkle (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in the Aug. 17 G1 Juddmonte International at York, he was last sighted when third behind Cape Blanco (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in the G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown Sept. 4. Settling into the slipstream of the pacesetter Debussy here, he swept by that rival entering the "dip" and, as has become his trademark, he kept on bravely under a strong Tom Queally drive and was always holding the challenge of Vision d'Etat in the closing stages. "I've always loved him, and the Prince [Khalid Abdullah] has become very fond of him as well," offered winning trainer Henry Cecil after recording his fourth Champion S. success. "Hopefully, he'll stay in training next year, because although he's won a lot of money, stallion-wise he's not highly valuable at the moment, but he could be. I was very pleased with him going into today's race, and it's lovely when things go right. He was really well today, and he'll have a rest now and then go for another crack at the [G1] Dubai World Cup in March. I'd like to nail the Dubai World Cup--the Prince deserves it." The owner's racing manager, Teddy Grimthorpe, was similarly delighted, saying, "The Prince and Henry go back a long way and they are tremendous friends. He's a breeder who has horses that need a little bit of patience, and that's one of the reasons Henry Cecil suits them so well--why not have another year? This season is the most successful since 2003 for Juddmonte, when we had 18 victories at the top-level. There has been 16 altogether this year, but, in terms of English and European Group 1s, this is Prince Khalid's best-ever season." Eric Libaud, conditioner of the runner-up, opined that the ground played a part in his horses defeat. "It was his first time on a straight course," Libaud told [racingpost.com](#). "It was a bit tacky, and he'll go to Hong Kong next [for the G1 Hong Kong Cup], and the ground there will be much better for him." John Gosden, trainer of Debussy, was delighted with his representative's third-place finish. "He ran a cracker," Gosden said. "The other two horses were rated higher than him. He'll step up to a mile and four [furlongs] now. The owner's racing manager, Bruce Raymond, added, "We were a little apprehensive about the easy ground, because she picks up well on fast ground, but she managed to do that today. She had been working well, and we thought she had a good chance. She's an exciting horse for next year, she looks as though she'll stay at least another furlong, and I should imagine she will be heading for the [G1 1000] Guineas, but that's for Sir Michael to decide. Saeed would certainly like that. She ran well at Goodwood, but she couldn't cope with the ground there because it was very soft. Favorite vacation spot? I always love going back home to Ireland. I live in Co. Meath, but was always go Kildare and The Curragh. But we don't get much vacation though.

Favorite food or meal? I love a good steak.

What do you think you would do if you weren't in the horseracing business? Be miserable, that's exactly what I'd be. It's something I'm passionate about and I've always loved it.

I thought at one stage that she would have to go back to the farm, so I'm glad we persevered as that was a high-class performance, and she's got a great mind. She had a problem with a splint on her other foreleg after her victory at York last May [2009], and she had a hurried preparation for the Prix de l'Opera, then was only beaten a short head here in this race [last year]. She is in the [G1] Hong Kong Vase [at Sha Tin Dec. 12], and we are thinking very strongly of going there, as we'd have to pay a lot of money to make her eligible for the [G1] Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf. 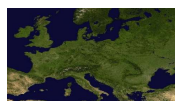

IFFRAAJ FILLY LEADS TATTS SATURDAY A

filly by leading first-season sire Iffraaj (GB) (Zafonic) from Maurice Burns' County Kildare-based Rathasker Stud starred at yesterday's final session of the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale in Newmarket when selling for 46,000gns. Michael Donohoe of BBA Ireland outbid Jamie Railton for [lot 2200](#), whose half-sister Matula (Ire) (Halling) recently made a winning debut. "Tom Whitehead of Powerstown Stud sold the half-sister this year and I have bought this filly for him," said Donohoe. "He'd seen her, but gone home, so asked me to bid, and she'll be coming back at the breeze-up sales." A 24,000gns Iffraaj colt knocked down to John Foley on behalf of J C Bloodstock is also set to reappear next year. The bay sold as [lot 2205](#). "He was bought to go breezing next year, and was just a nice colt by a good stallion," said Foley. A total of 1,418 of the 1,957 yearlings offered at the October Sale were officially registered as sold, with the 72 percent clearance rate falling from 78 percent in 2009. The 72,327,100gns turnover fell by 5 percent on last year, the 51,000gns average dropped by 8 percent and the 27,000gns median by 10 percent. Tattersalls Chairman Edmond Mahony commented, "This has been an arduous week, with Books 2 and 3 accommodating more yearlings than ever before, and, as noted at the end of Book 2, the numbers have had an adverse impact on the clearance rate. It remains true, however, that demand for quality, commercial yearlings has been sustained throughout the week, and it was encouraging to see leading buyers active to the very end of the sale. Another positive has been the cumulative spend on yearlings at the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale this year. The total turnover has held up remarkably well, falling just a notch short of last year's figure of around 76-million guineas, and matching the 2008 level of 72-million guineas." Mahony added, "The huge numbers have been challenging for all concerned, but, looking ahead, figures from the Thoroughbred Breeders' Association suggest a drop in the combined 2010 British and Irish foal crops of around 25 percent, which will make the task of managing the numbers more straightforward next year. While the decline in the foal crop is not confined exclusively to flat-bred yearlings, the fall in numbers should also bring supply more in line with current levels of demand, which is crucial for the industry going forward." 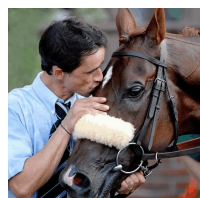
