the French champion two-year-old. Godolphin France's unbeaten **French Navy (GB)** (Shamardal) is the leading light this time. He bested the re-opposing **Salto (Ire)** (Pivotal {GB}) at Deauville twice in the space of 20

days during Deauville's August festival, and followed up with a smooth defeat of **Havane Smoker (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}) in Longchamp's G3 Prix des Chenes Sept. 18. Where he stands compared to the form of Newmarket's G1 Dewhurst S., where the Ballydoyle raider **Roderic O'Connor (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) was a clear second, is guesswork at present, but this test should provide some coherence to the Europe's juvenile scene. Another who offers some high-profile formlines is Ecurie Jarlan's **Maiguri (Ire)** (Panis), who annexed Longchamp's Listed Prix Roland de Chambure on Bastille Day, and came back to be third back at that track's G3 Prix la Rochette Sept. 5. No match for Wootton Bassett (GB) (Iffraaj {GB}) when dead-heating for second with the G1 Prix Morny runner-up Tin Horse (Ire) (Sakhee) in the G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere on his third visit to the Bois de Boulogne last time Oct. 3, he steps up to a mile without convincing that it will suit. **Cont. p5**

Zenyatta Tunes Up for Classic Defense

Defending G1 Breeders' Cup Classic heroine **Zenyatta** (Street Cry {Ire}) had her final workout at Hollywood Saturday morning, going six furlongs in 1:11 4/5 with jockey Mike Smith aboard. The six-year-old mare, accompanied by a pair of stablemates, went from the five-eighths pole to an eighth past the wire. The fractions were :12 4/5, :25 2/5, :48 3/5 and 1:00. "She went better than good," said Smith. "It was excellent. She went really, really well and probably a little better than last year. She galloped out strong and was happy coming back. She's ready. I'm always super confident with her. It's racing. She's going to have to get the trip, but if she does, I think we are going to see something phenomenal." Added trainer John Shirreffs, "It was a tune-up. It wasn't necessarily a fast work--she was fast at the end. That's her style. From here, we have fun, just play. that Life At Ten gets a good, honest work, we put her in company," Pletcher said. "She generally does a little better in company, and I thought this work went very smoothly. It was her first work here, and I thought she got over the track very well." As for Malibu Prayer, he remarked, "I thought she was typical of herself, as she's generally a very genuine work horse. She had a good finish with a good gallop out, and we're very pleased with the way she was getting over the ground."

E. Paul Robsham Stables's **R Heat Lightning** (Trippi), getting ready for the GI BC Juvenile Fillies, also drilled a half, getting the trip in :48.40 and galloping out five panels in 1:01.60. "She's a very tricky filly to ride," Pletcher said. "She's a little bit difficult going to the pole, but once she set off in her work, I thought it was very smooth, with a good finish and a good first eighth gallop-out. 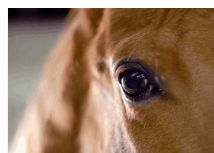

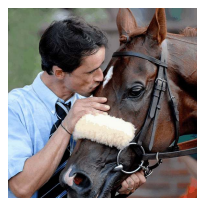
