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YOSHIDAS DOMINATE ARQANA OPENER

Arqana's Breeding Stock Sale got off to a flying start Saturday, when a trio of starlets fell to the heavyweight Japanese interests of brothers Teruya and Katsumi Yoshida. Chief among them was the sale of hip 134, the four-year-old **Celimene (Ire)** (Dr Fong) to Teruya's Shadai Farm for €800,000. One of trainer Carlos

Lerner's finest performers, the half-sister to the black-type winner and producer Lunaska (Fr) (Ashkalani {Ire}) was only just below the very best over the past two seasons. Aside from her wins in last year's G3 Prix Penelope and G3 Prix de Flore, the bay was also fourth in the 2009 G1 Prix de Diane and the most recent renewals of the G1 Prix Ganay and G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud on either side of a second in the G2 Prix Corrida. She had been withdrawn from Tattersalls December on Tuesday. Acting agent Patrick Barbe,

sitting with Teruya's son Tetsuya, commented, "She proved on the racecourse that she is a very good filly and she could be raced again before being bred later on. She is a very good-looking filly from a good family, so it was worth trying to buy her."

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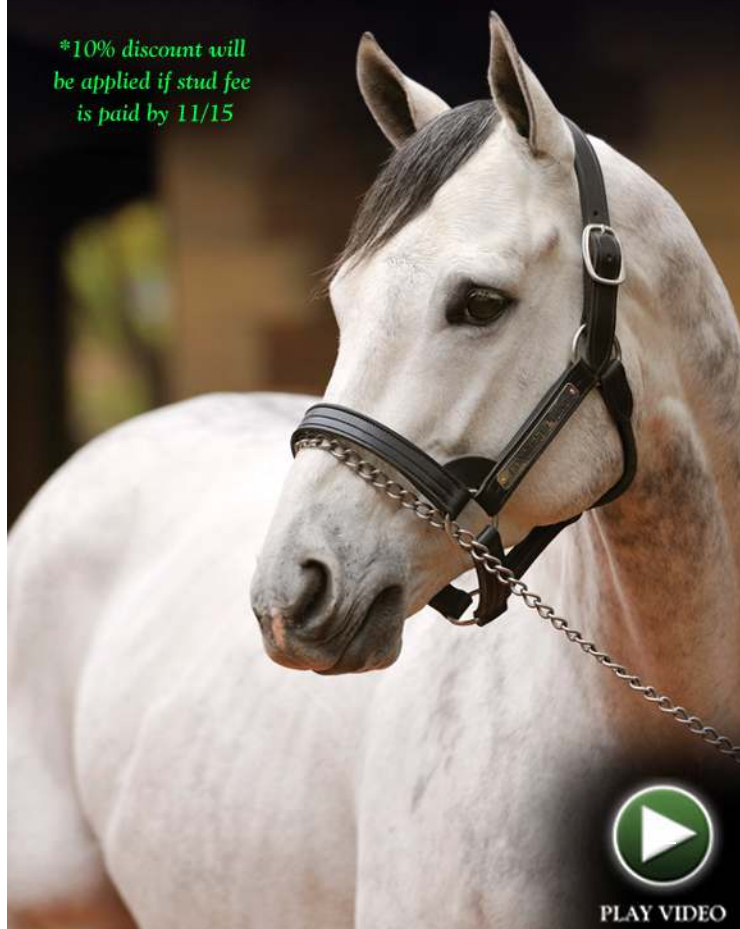

Japanese Continue Their Spending Spree...

Three lots later, the vet Dr Fumihiko Nakajima saw off Alan Cooper to sign the docket on behalf of Katsumi Yoshida for Haras du Mezeray's obvious star turn, the nine-year-old **Lune d'Or (Fr)** (Green Tune). A daughter of the group performer Luth d'Or (Fr) (Noir et Or {Fr}) from the immediate family of 1983 G1 Prix du Moulin and G1 Prix Jacques le Marois heroine Luth Enchantee (Fr) (Be My Guest), she proved more than capable on the track when capturing the 2004 G1 Premio Lydia Tesio,

G2 Prix de Malleret and G2 Prix de Pomone and finishing third in the following year's G1 Yorkshire Oaks. Her first foal, the Darley acquisition Learned Friend (Ger) (Seeking the Gold), sold for €700,000 as a yearling. One of only five mares offered in foal to Galileo (Ire) this

winter, she achieved a tag of €750,000 herself. "She is to go to Northern Farm in Japan and be covered by one of our stallions, of which there is a large choice," Nakajima explained. Moments before this frantic period of high-octane action, **La Boum (Ger)** (Monsun {Ger}) had lived up to her name by creating some fireworks when also selling to Shadai for €700,000. From Haras d'Auquainville, hip 121 held no secrets as she entered the ring at mid-afternoon. Since her first black-type success in the Listed Prix Panacee at Toulouse in October 2007, the highly consistent mare has flourished under the auspices of Robert Collet. Wins in that year's G3 Prix de Flore and the following year's G3 Prix Fille de l'Air remain her sole Pattern successes, but it is in her placed efforts that she has excelled over the subsequent three seasons of competitive racing. They include a second in the 2008 G2 Prix Corrida and third in last year's G1 Prix Jean Romanet, which preceded a seventh-beaten just under five lengths--in the 2009 Arc. "She's been a very consistent racemare and could maybe race on for another season, but that hasn't been decided yet," said Patrick Barbe after outlasting Japan's JS Company. "Ultimately, she will go to Japan to be covered there."

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A Successful Pont...

Seven lots after the sale of La Boum, the sole wild-card entry **Pontenuovo (Fr)** (Green Tune) took her own share of the headlines when fetching €450,000. A daughter of the high-class sprinter and 2003 G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest heroine Porlezza (Fr) (Sicyos), she made a splash this term when annexing the G3 Prix de Cabourg and finishing third behind Dream Ahead (Diktat {GB}) in the G1 Prix Morny at Deauville. Offered by her breeders Paul and Erika Hilger, the juvenile bettered the €300,000 sale of her dam at this auction 12 months ago. "I can't say who she is for, but it is an old client of mine," buyer Tom Goff of Blandford Bloodstock commented. "The only thing that I can say for certain is that she will be traveling to England very soon to be trained as a three-year-old. Again, I don't know who she will be trained by, but she was a very good filly at two with a great record from a very good family. She also has two good sisters by Oasis Dream (GB) and Galileo (Ire) to run, so there is plenty to look forward to. Hopefully, she'll train on and be a very nice filly." Arqana coverage cont. p4

An Early Premiere...

Not long into the session, the 13-year-old **Premiere Creation (Fr)** (Green Tune) provided the initial buzz when selling for €360,000. Hip 22, from Anna and Etienne Drion's Coulonces consignment, was third in the millennium renewal of the G1 Del Mar Oaks, and finished second in that year's G3 Prix Chloe and fourth in the G2 Prix d'Astarte. Her second foal was Anabaa's Creation (Ire) (Anabaa), now famous for being beaten just a head by the mighty Zenyatta (Street Cry {Ire}) in last year's G1 Clement L. Hirsch S. She was an early listed winner who was third in the 2007 G1 Prix Saint-Alary and fourth in the G1 Prix de Diane when in training with Alain de Royer-Dupre.

Premiere Creation also went on to produce Leo's Starlet (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}), successful in the 2008 G3 Prix Cleopatre before being nosed out by Treat Gently (GB) (Cape Cross {Ire}) in the G2 Prix de Malleret. That record saw her earn a prized covering by Sea the Stars (Ire) this spring and, as the sole mare in foal to that colossus, she was always going to feature prominently here. In the event, it was agent Tom Ryan who struck for the group of investors known collectively as SF Bloodstock. He said, "She is a very good mare who has already produced two group horses and is in foal to Sea the Stars, which is obviously very appealing. I don't know what we'll do with her now, but I think maybe she'll visit Lope de Vega (Ire) next year." Anthony Stroud was on the search for bluebloods once again and paid €320,000 for a gem from the Wertheimer consignment. Hip 81 is the winning three-year-old **Singuliere (Ire)** (Singspiel {Ire}), a full-sister to last year's surprise G2 Prix de Royallieu winner Balladeuse (Fr) and half to Plumania (GB) (Anabaa). The latter's victory in the latest renewal of the G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud is the icing on the cake of a career which also boasts placings in the 2009 G1 Prix de Diane and last two editions of the G1 Prix Vermeille. This is the family of sires Groom Dancer, Tagel, Slew the Slew and Falco (Pivotal {GB}), whose first crop of foals are selling this year. Pierre-Yves Bureaux, representing the vendors, commented, "I know Anthony Stroud bought her, but I don't know who for and we are very happy with the outcome. She is a very good-looking filly who is a sister to two very nice group winners and sold for the right price."

First-crop sire Henrythenavigator had a golden five minutes on Tuesday when two colts that happened to come up as successive hip numbers brought prices of **\$310,000 & \$450,000**, respectively.

A Regal Draft...

As ever, the consignment of His Highness The Aga Khan drew several admirers with the required deep pockets and the opening session proved a profitable one for the operation. Heading the list was hip 64, the three-year-old **Diyaraka (Fr)** (Clodovil {Ire}) who won a competitive handicap at Longchamp before finishing third in last week's Listed Prix Solitude for trainer Mikel Delzangles. Out of the group-placed Diamonaka (Fr) (Akarad {Fr}), she is a half to the top-class miler and sire Diamond Green (Fr) (Green Desert) and group-winning middle-distance mares by Linamix (Fr) in Diamonixa (Fr) and Diamilina (Fr). Arrowfield Stud's Louis le Metayer won the bidding war at €310,000, with his brother Bertrand signing the docket on behalf of Nigel Austin's Rosemont Stud in Australia. That eclipsed the €240,000 paid by Horse France for hip 61, the unraced three-year-old **Darinza (Fr)** (Dalakhani {Ire}), who is a half-sister to the 2007 G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches, G1 Prix d'Astarte and G1 Prix du Moulin winner and champion Darjina (Fr) (Zamindar) and €175,000 paid by Mags O'Toole for hip 63, the winning fellow three-year-old **Dialafara (Fr)** (Anabaa). From the same family as the aforementioned Diyaraka, her dam Diamilina took the 2001 G2 Prix de Malleret and G3 Prix de la Nonette and was also runner-up in that year's G1 Prix Vermeille. The day's trading began on the most positive note possible when the consignment's hip 1, the unraced three-year-old **Vedela (Fr)** (Selkirk) out of the high-class 2005 G1 Prix Saint-Alary victress Vadawina (Ire) (Unfuwain), sold to Patricia Boutin-Miller for €115,000.

Isla Saga Continues...

Islington (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) requires no introduction as the star of multiple Grade/Group 1 contests including the Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf in 2003. Her foal **Isla Canela** (Gone West) provided another episode when fetching \$2.4 million at the 2006 Keeneland November Sale. Since then, the regally-bred performer had managed to win just a minor race at Compiègne and had been led out unsold here 12 months ago at \$500,000. This time, it started less happily as she again failed to meet her reserve as hip 115 for Haras du Mezeray when the bidding stopped at €305,000. Eventually, she was bought privately by Ric Wylie on behalf of Alan Osburg for €290,000. Later, there was another notable lot to miss the mark when €500,000 was not enough to secure d'Etreham's hip 199, eight-year-old **Well Spoken (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells). The daughter of the 1999 G3 Princess Margaret S. winner Saintly Speech (Southern Halo) has a leading Classic contender to run for her in 2011 in the G3 C L Weld Park S. scorer Chrysanthemum (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) and is in foal to Dylan Thomas (Ire).

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Youngbloods Star...

There were some significant pedigrees among the clutch of foals on offer yesterday and they shone in their own right, despite the overwhelming precedence given to the broodmares. Topping proceedings was Gestut Wittekindshof's hip 74, the filly **Elle Same (GB)** (Samum {Ger}). Her dam, the champion Elle Danzig (Ger) (Roi Danzig), has produced four black-type performers already headed by this year's G3 Hessen-Pokal and G3 Belmondo-Preis winner and G1 Preis der Diana runner-up Elle Shadow (Ire) (Shamardal). Her latest offering was knocked down to Meridian International for €100,000. Another filly to steal a share of the limelight was Haras de Saint Pair's hip 58, a daughter of the 2005 G3 Prix Eclipse winner Damaoiseille (Sky Classic) from the first crop of Raven's Pass. From the extended family of Storm Cat, the January-foaled chestnut was snapped up by Agence FIPS for €70,000. Of the colts, it was Elevage de Tourgeville's hip 167 who enjoyed top billing when selling to BBA Ireland for €65,000. By the 2010 champion first-season sire Ifraaj (GB) (Zafonic), his dam is a half to the GII Santa Anita H., GII San Gorgonio H. and GII Buena Vista H. runner-up Garden In the Rain (Fr) (Dolphin Street {Fr}), now the dam of this year's G3 Grosser Preis der Jungheinrich Gabelstapler scorer Govinda (Pulpit).

On the Up and Up...

At the close of play, there was no need for spin from the Arqana brass with the figures telling their own story. Alongside the clearance rate of 84 percent, last year's median of €30,000--which at the time represented a huge 88 percent climb on 2008--was matched. The average of €62,106 was up by 22 percent on the preceding amount and has left behind the figure of €38,196 from two years ago. Arqana Chairman Eric Hoyer offered, "We are very pleased with the results of this first session and particularly to see that breeders who, despite the current economic climate, have trusted the Deauville market and its capacity to attract the right buyers for quality fillies and mares have been handsomely rewarded. Indeed, we have observed very good response from Japan and Australia, two great breeding countries who are looking more and more towards Europe, as well as from the U.S. and several European nations. As for the middle market, it has held up well thanks to the realistic assessments made by our vendors and resulted in an impressive clearance rate." Ebony Flyer justified favoritism with an easy debut victory going five furlongs at this track May 22, and was equally impressive when garnering the June 24 Listed Lady's Slipper S. at Arlington next time. She doubled her aggregate margin of success with a 5 1/2-length win in the Nov. 6 G2 Odessa Stud Championship last time and retained her perfect record with a comfortable win in this Classic. Settled five lengths off the pace in fourth after the initial exchanges here, she made smooth progress once into the stretch run to lead passing the quarter-mile marker and was ridden out in the closing stages to easily withstand the vain challenge of Igugu for a career high. Trainer Justin Snaith, who claimed

a third victory in four years with the win, indicated future plans may include an overseas campaign. "I have her in the colts' Guineas Dec. 18 and, if I knew she was going to get a decent draw, I would run her, but I ran Sparkling Gem in it two years ago from a bad draw and it knocked her," Snaith told *Racing Post*. "I have [also] nominated her for the [G1 J&B] Met [back at this track] Jan. 29 and I might well go there before we think about going overseas with her. She has to go to show people how good South African horses are. This race has proved that she is a filly of high quality because Igugu is very good." Ebony Flyer's win continues the hot hand of Team Valor International, which recently annexed the GII Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf with Pluck (More Than Ready) and the GI Matriarch S. with Gypsy's Warning (SAf) (Mogok). Barry Irwin's operation also won this race in 2007 with Ebony Flyer's half-sister, co-champion Captain's Lover (SAf) (Captain Al {SAf}).

She belied odds of 6-1 to score by a widening 1 1/4 lengths in the Cardinal Nov. 7 and offered good value while facing deeper here. Reserved in the second half of the field as the pace was slow to develop up front, Askbut I Won'ttell caught the eye on the turn as she began to slingshot past horses. She found a seam five wide into the stretch and displayed an excellent turn of foot to run down the front-running Trip For A. J. to win comfortably in the end. "She is a very easy filly to ride, so I'm able to put her anywhere in the race I want her" explained winning jockey Shaun Bridgmohan. While the latter was full out to keep pace approaching the stretch, Twilight Meteor was still traveling well for Luis Saez and pinched a break of two lengths entering the final furlong. Rahy's Attorney and Balletti came with late runs to try to make a race of it late, but Twilight Meteor had just enough in reserve for the victory. "Mr. Wolfson told me that this horse likes to run close to the lead, he doesn't have to be in front, but close to it," Saez commented. "He made the lead easily and in the stretch, when he sensed the pressure of horses chasing him, I could tell he wasn't going to let them pass." A nose second in an \$80,000 optional event at this track May 21, Aggie Engineer hooked a stakes-quality field in a June 27 money-allowance test on the turf, and acquitted himself nicely, setting the pace before holding for third behind MGISW The Usual Q. T. (Unusual Heat) and Dakota Phone (Zavata). A pacesetting runner-up in Del Mar's restricted Wickerr H. July 28, he was unable to get to the front in that track's Windy Sands H. Sept. 4 back on the synthetic and weakened out to finish last of a sextet. He was slated to return to the infield for his latest, an Oct. 22 heat during the Oak Tree meet, but he took full advantage when it was transferred to the Cushion Track and posted a 2 1/4-length victory. He loomed the lone speed of the Native Diver and so it proved. Allowed a soft time of it up front, Aggie Engineer got his opening quarter-mile in :25.55 and the half in an equally pedestrian :50.52. Joe Talamo was able to lay down another 25-second two furlongs to hit the six in 1:15.49, and from there it was academic, as Aggie Engineer was able to outspurt his rivals to the money. "It looked too good on paper, but it worked out that way," said trainer Paddy Gallagher, who also sent out Soul Candy. "When things look so obvious, that makes it more scary. The horse ran good, and yes he did have an easy lead and that's a big help to a horse like him. When I looked up and saw the fractions, I didn't like Soul Candy's chances, but he also ran very, very well. For once, everything went right." Dakota Phone, coming off his upset in the GI Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile Nov. 6, laid much closer to the pace than is his custom and couldn't kick with the winner, eventually finishing fourth.

In the absence of the 2009 winner and GI Breeders' Cup Classic also-ran Espoir City (Jpn) (Gold Allure), **Silk Mobius** will have an excellent chance to improve on his runner-up effort 12 months back. She exits a runner-up effort in the Treasure Chest S. at Delta Downs Nov. 20.

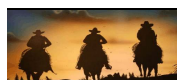

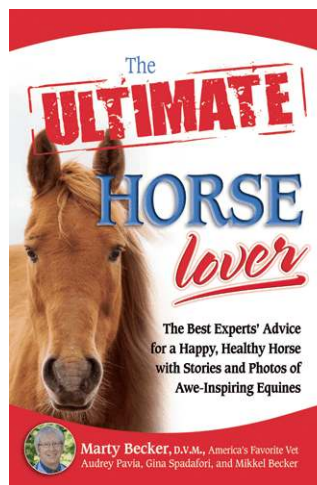
