SHAM WOW

Winchell Thoroughbreds' homebred **Tapizar** (Tapit), sent off as the even-money choice in the GIII Sham S. at Santa Anita, grabbed a hold of the bit early. He soon settled down, and drew off to defeat **Clubhouse Ride** (Candy Ride {Arg}) by 4 1/4 lengths. The bay colt was coming off a double-digit maiden win at Churchill Nov. 27, and will continue with the California path back to

the Twin Spires. "With the races that he ran at the end of Churchill, I thought he was ideal for the series that's here," explained winning trainer Steve Asmussen. "He had two-turn races in him and he could just stay at two turns and just try to continue on." The next local options for sophomores are the Feb. 12 GII Robert B. A FLAIR FOR THE DRAMATIC

Eclipse Award finalist **Big Drama** (Montbrook) previously raced just once at Gulfstream, finishing first in track-record time in the 2009 GII Swale S., only to be disqualified to second. Fresh off his GI Breeders' Cup Sprint triumph, Harold Queen's homebred shrugged off a challenge from **Custom for Carlos** (More Than Ready) and strode home impressively to establish a new mark of 1:08.12 for six furlongs. "I thought Custom for Carlos would run well today

and when a horse of that quality makes a run at you, you have to be a little nervous," admitted winning trainer David Fawkes. "But he showed how good he is--he wasn't even blowing when he came back. Now we'll keep our fingers crossed until Monday night." **Cont. p5**

WHAT'S LUCK GOT TO DO WITH IT?

It's a near certainty that the connections of **Blind Luck** (Pollard's Vision) will be carting home hardware at Monday night's Eclipse Awards ceremony in Miami Beach, but the popular chestnut will kick off her four-year-old campaign this afternoon at Santa Anita in the GII El Encino S. Though her fearsome stretch run could only get her second in the GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic at Churchill Nov. 6, she immediately resumed her iron-horse workout schedule. Blind Luck faces six rivals, including MGISW **Champagne d'Oro** (Medaglia d'Oro) and GSW **Always a Princess** (Leroidesanimaux {Brz}), and will need to overcome the trend of closers being at a distinct disadvantage on the glib new surface. "Absolutely it's a concern," assistant trainer Dan Ward told *Daily Racing Form*. "But she ran on a lot of tracks last year where they say you can't beat the speed, and she won. Oaklawn Park is a speed track; Delaware Park is a speed track." **El Encino cont. p6**

Tapizar rounded out the trifecta in his Aug. 22 career opener at Monmouth Aug. 22, but stumbled at the start of a Sept. 19 test at the Jersey Shore oval and lost his rider. He came back to finish fourth over at Churchill Nov. 4, but put all of his lessons to use as the favorite on the "Stars of Tomorrow" card under the Twin Spires Nov. 27. The homebred scampered home a 10 1/2-length winner that day ([video](#)), and was bet down to even-money for this stakes bow. Away alertly, the bay colt moved past 5-2 Uncle Sam (Tapit) entering the backstretch and made rider Garrett Gomez work for his paycheck through a :45.25 opening half. Tapizar soon settled into an easy rhythm, and forced the rallying Clubhouse Ride to shift to the outside turning for home. The Winchell colorbearer found another gear in front of the stands, with a mile split in 1:33.74, and crossed the line with his ears pricked. "He was little bit fresher than I had anticipated him to be," Gomez admitted. "He went ahead and settled down as soon as I let him make the lead. He put his ears up and kind of cruised around there. I felt like I was loaded. When I started to turn for home, the gate was parked on the outside, and there was a lot of stuff going on. When I asked him to pick it up, I couldn't quite get his focus going, but nothing ever got close enough to make him pay attention, either."




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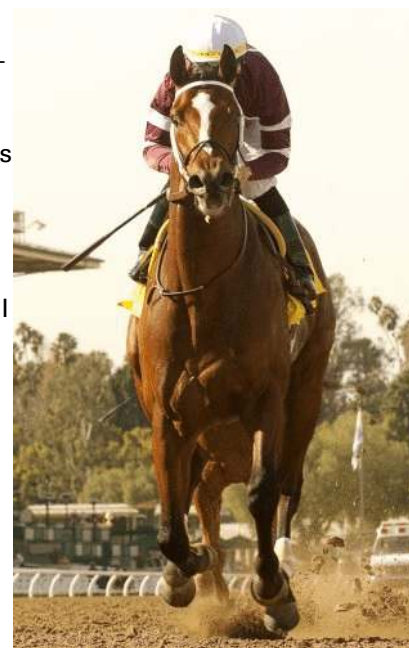
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Gomez continued, "Hopefully, he has many more gears. He traveled beautiful, and he's a beautiful mover. It was a pleasure to be on him today." Trainer Steve Asmussen added, "I was very concerned when they put up the [fractional] times, but honestly, if I wouldn't have looked up at the board, I wouldn't have been."

Tapizar is a grandson of Call Now (Wild Again), who established a stakes record of 1:21.40 when she captured the 1994 GII Del Mar Debutante S. for Verne Winchell. His dam, Winning Call, produced a colt by another Winchell runner, Zanjero (Cherokee Run), in 2010 and was bred back to that stallion.

California Nectar, second in her first two tries at Del Mar, graduated at the third time of asking in a Cal-bred test at Oak Tree Oct. 3. Stretched out for the Cal Cup Juvenile Fillies at Hollywood Oct. 30, the bay filly came up a nose short, and gave a decent account of herself when switched to turf for the GIII Miesque S. at Hollywood Nov. 28, finishing fourth after setting the pace. She captured her conventional dirt bow, the seven-furlong California Breeders' Champion S. over this strip Dec. 27, and had plenty of support here. On the engine from the start, California Nectar repulsed a challenge from favored Plum Pretty approaching the stretch, and dug in bravely to deny Zazu's stern challenge approaching the wire. "She broke really well and down the backside, I felt like Superman, because she felt like super girl--she was flying," said winning rider Pat Valenzuela, who was wearing the Superman logo-emblazoned silks of owners Pablo and Michelle Suarez. "When that filly [Zazu] came to her, my filly picked her head up and tried even harder. I don't think she was ever going to get by us." Leandro Mora, assistant to winning trainer Doug O'Neill, added, "Right now, there are no plans, because we'll go race by race, step by step. She's won two [straight] races at seven furlongs. We're going to try and stretch her out. She's only three, and everybody has Kentucky Oaks dreams."

Indian Firewater earned his diploma in his second start at two, but endured a string of nine losses before getting his picture taken once more in the Nashville S. on Hollywood's Cushion Track Nov. 18. He was second the whole way 'round to Sidney's Candy (Candy Ride {Arg}) last out in the off-the-turf GIII Sir Beaufort S. on Santa Anita's opening day, and was the third choice here. Away alertly under Mike Smith, the dark bay was shadowed by favored Thiskyhasnolimit (Sky Mesa) through splits of :46.95 and 1:10.52, but the chalk gave up the chase turning for home. Fellow Bob Baffert trainee Tweebster came after him and looked to have all the momentum, but began to drift out a bit, and Indian Firewater got the bob on the wire. "Going into this race, we thought we'd let him run away from there and if we made the lead, fine," Smith explained. "When I came out to the paddock, they told me Bob [Baffert] had called an audible, and there was a change in strategy--'Put him on the lead.' Down the backside, he was running easily and he was within himself and breathing really good. I wasn't sure if we won it, because the other horse was out so wide." Assistant trainer Jim Barnes handled the saddling duties for the vacationing Baffert. "I was just happy to see our two horses coming down the stretch together there. You want them both to win, but...that was as close to a dead-heat as you could get. At first I thought Indian Firewater won, then watching the replay I thought maybe the outside horse because it was at a different angle, way to the outside. But we'll take it one-two." Winner of the 2008 GIII Delta Jackpot S., Big Drama tackled longer distances after his Swale disappointment. He was fifth in the GI Preakness S. and second by a neck in the GII West Virginia Derby, but he faded to sixth in the GI King's Bishop S. at Saratoga, and was given some time off. The Florida-bred resumed 10 months later with a pair of victories at his Calder base, including the GII Smile Sprint H. July 10, then ran into a buzzsaw named Majesticperfection (Harlan's Holiday) in the GI A.G. Vanderbilt H. at Saratoga Aug. 8 and settled for second. The dark bay was runner-up once more in the GI Forego S. on Labor Day weekend at the Spa, but rebounded with an authoritative score in the GI BC Sprint at Churchill, and was named an Eclipse Award finalist in his division. Big Drama came away quickly from his outside post, with Custom for Carlos attempting to secure the rail. Jockey Julien Leparoux conceded the lead to the odds-on choice, however, and Big Drama rolled through splits of :22.12 and :44.43. Leparoux and 'Carlos came back to his throatlatch in the stretch, but Big Drama found another gear and drew clear through the final sixteenth to establish a new track record. "I knew there was very good competition in the field, but I knew they were really going to have to run to beat him today," said winning rider Eibar Coa. "He's not playing right now. When he out-broke those horses inside, and they're fast horses, I just let him go by himself. That horse (Custom for Carlos) made a good move and got next to me, but it wasn't enough. I knew Big Drama was going to run fast and good. I'm happy he got the track record. He deserves it."

The Drama Continues...

Big Drama will attempt to follow in the hoofprints of Midnight Lute (Real Quiet), the only two-time winner of the BC Sprint. "The goal for the season is to get back to the Breeders' Cup at Churchill Downs," trainer David Fawkes confirmed. "In the meantime, it's one race at a time. It's possible he could run here again, but he will get some breaks as the season goes along, so we'll see. We don't have anything planned for his next start right now." Tar Heel Mom, third by a head in last year's renewal of the Sugar Swirl, ran second in both the GIII Hurricane Bertie H. and GII Inside Information H. at Gulfstream before capturing the GII Distaff H. at Aqueduct in April. She then ran third by 3/4 of a length in the GII Vagrancy H. at Belmont May 29, but was subsequently sidelined with a condylar fracture in a hind cannon bone. The dark bay returned to round out the trifecta once more in the Garland of Roses H. at Aqueduct Dec. 4, and was the second choice here. In the thick of things from the start, Tar Heel Mom finally put away early leader D'wild Ride (D'wildcat) after a :44.84 half, and dug in gamely to deny favored Hilda's Passion. "We put a screw in it and she came back good, so we decided to go on with her," winning trainer Stan Hough said about Tar Heel Mom's layoff. "She might have been a little short for her race back. We'll run her through the series here like we did last year, and if she's still going well we'll keep her in training. If not, and shows signs of age, there is still a window to breed her." The El Encino is a tough race, but she's a tough filly." GII Indiana Oaks heroine Always a Princess, fourth in the La Brea will hope to take advantage of Santa Anita's speed-favoring tendencies. "We're just going to put **Always a Princess** on the lead and see how far she goes," said trainer Bob Baffert.

STREET SENSE COLT TOPS AT MM

Northern Hemisphere shuttlers featured nearest the top of the list Saturday as the select portion of the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale wrapped up. The day's proceedings were led by a colt by Darley's Street Sense (Street Cry {Ire}), whose first Australasian foals are yearlings of 2010-2011. The October foal is a son of the stakes-placed Aristocracy (Aus) (Danehill), a half-sister to Group 1 winners Bluebird the Word (Aus) (Bluebird) and Porto Roca (Aus) (Barathea {Ire}). The colt was consigned to the sale by Ron and Debbie Gilbert's Highgrove Stud and is another heading to the barn of Peter Moody after being acquired by Hong Kong-based Thomas Li. Also among the broodmare band at Highgrove is the SW & GSP Tears I Cry (Chester House), who was purchased by Vin Cox Bloodstock on behalf of the Gilberts' operation for \$735,000 at Keeneland November in 2009. Prior to her export to Australia, the mare produced a bay filly by Curlin Mar. 13, 2010, who now resides at Jim FitzGerald's Knockgriffin Farm in Kentucky. "The sale has gone very much in line with our expectations," Magic Millions Managing Director Stephen Silk noted. "We were cautiously optimistic that the sale would be around the figures of last year--and we went close with the average and gross figures falling only slightly. The clearance rate [Saturday] was excellent, and we're thrilled with the overall clearance rate of over 81 percent for the sale." He continued, "The high Australian dollar was obviously an issue with a number of international buyers--but we still had strong interest and activity from our clients who flew in from abroad." The fifth session of yearlings is set for this morning at 11 a.m. There will be a racehorse sale with drafts from Darley and Patinack Farm Tuesday followed by the sixth and final session of yearlings Wednesday.

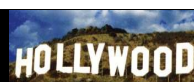

In his most recent attempt at this minimum trip, the former world champion turf sprinter defeated **Sweet Sanette (SAf)** (Jallad) in the Sha Tin Sprint Trophy Oct. 1. "He's had a little bit of a break to freshen him up and [jockey] Brett Prebble's really happy with him," says trainer Ricky Yiu. "He's seven now and maybe beginning to feel his age slightly, but Sha Tin and 1000 meters are his expert course and distance."
