the first time around the stands in the big one, the four-year-old made an eye-catching middle move on the outside to challenge Transcend for the lead down the backstretch. Victoire Pisa fought his way to the front after a thrilling stretch run, with the

pacesetter gamely holding off the imposing late charge of **Monterosso (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}), **Cape Blanco (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) and **Gio Ponti** (Tale of the Cat). "My horse usually has a good start, but this time he hit his head in the stall and we had a bad start," Demuro revealed. "But maybe it was lucky because there was a slow pace on the backstretch, so I could find a good position close to the leader. It was a really tight finish. We always believe in him. He's won his last race very easy giving two kilos away. He's a very nice horse. We were hoping to do well, but to win is amazing." Transcend, hero of the G1 Japan Cup Dirt Dec. 5 and G1 February S. Feb. 20, had a three-race winning streak snapped. "The horse was shying with the track but he did a very good job," jockey Shinji Fujita reported of the runner-up. "I'm very happy with this result because the people in Japan are having a difficult time at this moment, so we're very happy."

A Model of Consistency...

Victoire Pisa, capped a five-race winning skein in the G1 Japanese 2000 Guineas last April. Third in the G1 Japanese Derby, the dark bay disappointed in a pair of attempts in France, finishing fourth in the G2 Prix Niel Sept. 12 and was moved up to seventh via disqualification in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe Oct. 3. He quickly got back on track in the Land of the Rising Sun, placing a close third in the G1 Japan Cup Nov. 28 before delivering wins in the G1 Arima Kinen Dec. 26 and the G2 Nakayama Kinen most recently Feb. 27. 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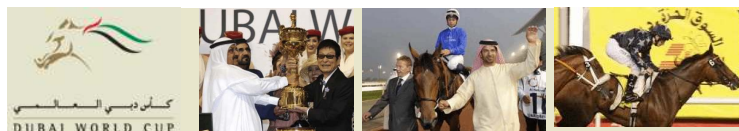

Poppin' Fresh...

Rewilding, third in the June 5 G1 Epsom Derby and winner of the Aug. 17 G2 Great Voltigeur S. last term, was making his first start since tiring to sixth in the Sept. 11 G1 St Leger S. at Doncaster. His connections have learned the colt does his best running with time between races. "Him being fresh is a good thing," Dettori told *Racing Post*. The bay broke well, but was taken in hand into the first bend. Dettori was content to sit off the pace down the backstretch, but picked up the reins and coaxed a quick move to the outside from his mount as they approached the head of the lane. In perfect position when they hit the straight, Rewilding drove to the front 150 meters out and opened up under a hand ride to win decisively. Trainer Mahmood Al Zarooni indicated the 4-year-old will get a well-deserved rest now. "He's a really big horse and that will take a lot out of him," Al Zarooni told *Racing Post*. "We have to treat him very carefully like a filly." As for what's next, he added, "[Godolphin Racing Manager] Simon Crisford and the boss will decide, but there are plenty of options, including the [G1] Coronation Cup [at Royal Ascot]."

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IM-PRES-IVE SCORE IN DUTY FREE

The hard-knocking **Presvis (GB)** (Sakhee), owned in part by Greek department store tycoon Leonidas Marinopoulos, was a bit dead on the international tote and was available at 13-1 pre-post. He ultimately settled as one of three joint-favorites at 5-1 and weaved his way between rivals in the stretch and outfinished South Africa's **River Jetez (SAf)** (Jet Master {SAf}) for a 3/4-length victory. It was the third consecutive Duty Free appearance for Presvis, who was runner-up to Gladiatorus (Silic {Fr}) in 2009 before a troubled 11th-place finish 12 months back. "He's a very talented horse--he deserved that," said victorious jockey Ryan Moore. "A lot of hard work goes into him in the mornings, and this is one for the whole team. They went a good gallop initially, then the pace slackened a bit and he got the gaps when I needed them. Usually, he quickens between horses and he had to fight to beat off the mare."

Pres-ing On...

Despite a first-up victory in last year's G2 Jebel Hatta, the course-and-distance prep for the Duty Free, it was a largely disappointing six-year-old season for Presvis. Fifth in defense of his title in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II Cup at Sha Tin, he filled the same spot behind G1 Dubai World Cup runner-up Lizard's Desire (Aus) (Orpen) in the G1 Singapore Airlines International Cup. He was spelled off a ninth in the G1 Prince of Wales's June 16, but has looked a different sort this term. The bay overcame a slow dispatch and streaked home a 4 3/4-length winner of the G2 Al Rashidiya S. over 1800 meters Jan. 27 and was exiting this year's Jebel Hatta, in which he caboosed the field after another slow start and came with a stretch run only to be run down by **Wigmore Hall (Ire)** (High Chaparral {Ire}) and Poet's Voice (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}).

While he went off at 5-1 in the win pool, Presvis was long odds-on to miss the kick, and so it was. Bringing up the rear as G1 Hong Kong Mile hero Beauty Flash (NZ) (Golan {Ire}) raced freely up front, the Luca Cumani runner was patiently handled by Moore and was still last of the 16--and apparently snookered--approaching the stretch. Given his cue at the quarter pole, Presvis dove down to the two path and found some clear sailing, drove through between a weakening Beauty Flash and Strawberrydaiquiri (GB) (Dansili {GB}) inside the final 200 meters. River Jetez was coming with her own run down the center and looked to have gotten the jump on her rivals, but Presvis outfinished the full sister to Pocket Power (SAf) for the victory.

Watching his charge run isn't always easy for Cumani. "He has to be ridden that way and it's always a question whether he gets the gaps or not," the conditioner explained. "My heart was in my mouth at the top of the straight, because it looked like he might have been held up but Ryan got him there at the end."

ROCKET MAN GETS HIS GROUP ONE

Coming into the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen, **Rocket Man (Aus)** (Viscount {Aus}) had been thwarted--narrowly second on each occasion--three times in International Group 1 company. That stretch included a half-length defeat at the hands of Kinsale King (Yankee Victor) in last year's Shaheen, a race in which he was expected to make the running, but instead was eased off the pace and just failed. But there were no mistakes in this recovery mission, as the newly anointed Singapore Horse of the Year stalked **Euroears** (Langfuhr) from close up and showed superior stamina in the final 200 meters for a 2 1/4-length victory. Winning jockey Felix Coetzee commented, "He is so gutsy. It was a great feeling, like being in a top sports car. He was flying." Coetzee knows a thing or two about top sprinters, as he was the regular rider of legendary Hong Kong short-tracker Silent Witness (Aus) (El Moxie).

He's the Man...

Returned to his home base following last year's disappointment, Rocket Man landed a domestic Group 1 in April, but was stunned by Hong Kong-raided **Green Birdie (NZ)** (Catbird {Aus}) in the G1 KrisFlyer International Sprint the next month. Given a well-deserved break, he bagged a pair of domestic Group 3s, then ventured to Hong Kong and dead-heated for the win in the Jockey Club Sprint, the local lead-up to the G1 Hong Kong Sprint. Backed down to 7-2 on International day, Rocket Man was close up early on and led inside the final furlong, but was overhauled late by J J the Jet Plane (SAf) (Jet Master {SAf}) and settled for second, ahead of former world champ Sacred Kingdom (Aus) (Encosta de Lago {Aus}). He was the easiest kind of winner in a six-furlong Polytrack event at Kranji Mar. 6 and was odds-on to get it done here.

Rocket Man jumped away smartly here, but was allowed to sit second as Euroears, trying a synthetic surface for the first time in his career, got his opening quarter mile in a shade over 24 seconds, a fast split for the surface. The Bob Baffert-trainee still held the call as the field rounded into the stretch, and looked for a few strides inside the final 200 meters like he'd stolen a winning margin. But Coetzee kept busy on his mount and Rocket Man surged by the game front-runner in the final half-furlong for a much-deserved win at the highest level. Sunny King (Ire) (Desert Sun {GB}) outfinished compatriot Green Birdie for third. The latter was supplemented to the race for \$200,000. "I was confident all week because I have never had him better," trainer Patrick Shaw commented. "Winning on an international stage like Dubai is very special. I don't know where we go next with Rocket Man. Royal Ascot wants him in the summer. But so do the Australians to take on Black Caviar (Aus) (Bel Esprit {Aus}), so we'll see." 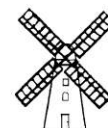

got me out of trouble," Barzalona commented. "She was very brave and finished really well. It's a dream to win here." Khawlah becomes the seventh UAE Derby winner for the Boys in Blue and Saeed bin Suroor. "We will target the Epsom Oaks," bin Suroor offered. "She will run in the Musidora Group 3 at York and then the English Oaks." A debut second at Salisbury Sept. 2, Khawlah earned her diploma 15 days later at Newmarket, then completed the trifecta in her seasonal finale in the G3 Oh So Sharp S. at Newmarket Oct. 1. The bay successfully switched to the all-weather in her sophomore debut in the Oaks, defeating Mahbooba (Aus) by 1 1/4 lengths.

Game in Defeat...

It was a heartbreaking loss for G1 Racing Post Trophy third-place finisher **Master of Hounds**, who appeared to be home free after striking the front in the stretch. The Susan Magnier colorbearer was making his first run since registering a close sixth-place finish behind Pluck (More Than Ready) in the GII Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf at Churchill Downs Nov. 6. "He ran very well for his first run of the season," jockey Ryan Moore said. "He felt to me like he would come on from that."

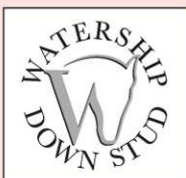
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SURF'S UP IN GODOLPHIN MILE

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All Over the All-Weather...

Skysurfers aired by 10 lengths on the Southwell all-weather in his career opener in October of 2009, and made it two-for-two in a conditions race at Meydan last February. The bay ran third in the 2010 edition of the Godolphin Mile in his fourth appearance, then headed to Britain. Placed in three straight Listed events on the turf, he was the 5-2 chalk in the Guisborough S. at Redcar Oct. 2, but faded late to be 10th. The Godolphin homebred returned to the synthetic for his 2011 bow, the Feb. 10 Firebreak S. at Meydan, and he was favored to make it two in a row on the year. His first group victory came as no surprise to trainer Saeed bin Suroor. "We knew he was coming into the race in very good form," bin Suroor remarked, adding, "He was traveling well turning for home. The second horse was very tough, but I was always confident that he and Frankie would get there. This is his best distance, and it's important that he has a break between races." Jockey Richard Hills was far from disappointed in the runner-up. "I had the best trip I could have had behind the leader," Hills offered. "He was at the front, but when Frankie came to me, I thought 'uh-oh.' He still ran a great race."

Sour Note for the U.S...

There were a trio of U.S. reps in the Godolphin Mile, but the best they could do was a lackluster seventh for **Make Music for Me** (Bernstein). **I Want Revenge** (Stephen Got Even) faded to 10th, and **Crowded House** (GB) (Rainbow Quest) trailed home last. Jockey Mike Smith had his hands full with Make Music for Me. "Leaving the gate, he wanted to get out pretty badly," Smith said. "I had two hands on the reins at one point. Finally I got him straightened out and he ran on well." I Want Revenge was the second choice at 7-2 off a fourth-place finish in the GI Donn H. at Gulfstream Park Feb. 5. He chased the pace, but had nothing left for the final drive. "He wasn't in the ideal spot where we wanted him to be," his rider, Ramon Dominguez, commented. "Turning for home, he emptied out." Crowded House chucked it early. "I had a little trouble in the first turn, and then he lost interest," jockey Joel Rosario explained.

Defending Shaheen Champ Declared...

Sheehy LLC's **Kinsale King** (Yankee Victor) was withdrawn from the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen due to swelling in his right foreleg, according to *Daily Racing Form*. "He had some kind of reaction to something," said trainer Carl O'Callaghan. "His leg blew up." O'Callaghan discovered the swelling in the six-year-old gelding's leg Saturday morning, just hours before he was set to contest the \$2 million event. The conditioner called an audible and took Kinsale King to the track to jog, but the leg still showed signs of swelling once returned to the quarantine barn and the decision was made. "We'll just do the right thing for him, get him back to America," O'Callaghan said. Kinsale King, seventh in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint at Churchill in November, opened 2011 with a wire-to-wire victory in a six-furlong Golden Gate sprint Feb. 17. He has won six of 12 lifetime starts and has earned \$1,502,320.

A close-up third in the G3 Dubai Duty Free World Trophy at Newbury that September, the South African-bred was out of the frame in his three other Hannon-saddled outings. It was time to go home. The gelding joined the Lucky Houdalakis barn, and the change of scenery did the trick. J J took a pair of Group 1 events in his native country before capping off the year with an upset score over **Rocket Man (Aus)** (Viscount {Aus}) in the Dec. 12 G1 Hong Kong Sprint. It was at that point that his connections decided to target the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen, and wisely decided a prep over the Meydan synthetic was in order. J J flunked that test, finishing 11th in a handicap Feb.

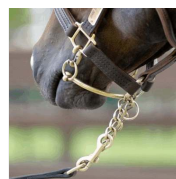

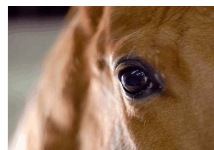
